WEEKLY HONORS

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Antonio Gibson • Memphis • Sr. • WR • Stockbridge, Ga.

Gibson, who also was named Walter Camp National Player of the Week, set an American Athletic Conference record with 386 all-purpose yards – the most by an FBS player this season – to key Memphis' 54-48 win against No. 14 SMU. He became the first FBS player in 2019 to score touchdowns three different ways as he found the end zone on a rushing attempt, a reception and on a kickoff return. Gibson had six catches for 130 yards and a 50-yard touchdown, 97 rushing yards on three carries, including a 78-yard TD and added a 97-yard kickoff return for a score to start the third quarter.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

P.J. Hall • Tulane • Sr. • S • Hoover, Ala.

Hall had five tackles, a tackle for loss and a forced fumble to go with five pass breakups, the most by an American Athletic Conference player this season, in Tulane's 38-26 win against Tulsa. Hall's forced fumble was returned by the Green Wave for a touchdown, giving Tulane a 24-13 lead on its way to clinching bowl eligibility for the second straight season.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Riley Patterson • Memphis • Jr. • K • Edwardsville, Ill.

Patterson scored 18 points – the most by an American Athletic Conference kicker in a game this season – to help Memphis to a 54-48 win against No. 14 SMU. Patterson made field goals of 30, 49, 34 and 50 yards and was 6-for-6 on PATs.

American Athletic Conference teams have played eight games against top-25 opponents in 2019. Conference teams have faced three top-10 teams this season.

Exclusivity

The American is the only FBS conference that has four one-loss teams through Week 10.

Home Is Where The Wins Are

UCF has won 20 straight home games, trailing only Alabama (31) and Clemson (21) for the longest home winning streaks nationally.

Ground Troops

Navy leads the nation in rushing, averaging 357.9 rushing yards per game.

Two Steps Back

UCF leads the nation in tackles for loss, averaging 9.9 TFL per game. USF is third at 9.1, while SMU is fourth at 8.8.

They're Honored

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell and Temple C Matt Hennessey were named to the Associated Press Midseason All-America team. Both players were second team selections.

We'll Take That

USF and Cincinnati are ranked second nationally in turnovers gained. The Bearcats and Bulls both have 20 takeaways in 2019, trailing only Illinois (22).

This Is Our House

Home teams were a combined 30-18 in American Athletic Conference games in 2018. The home team is 17-12 in conference games this season.

It's East vs. West

The American's East Division finished the 2018 season with a 10-8 head-to-head record against the league's West Division, marking the first time in the four-year history of the conference's two-division format that the East had the better head-to-head record. West Division teams hold a 41-36 all-time lead against East Division opponents since 2015.

Cincinnati is 18-3 since the start of the 2018 season. SMU is 14-5 in its last 19 games. UCF is 32-3 since the start of the 2017 season.

Best In Class

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell is ranked eighth nationally in rushing at 118.6 yards per game. Temple RB Re'Mahn Davis is averaging 81.9 yards per game. Gainwell and Davis are the two leading freshmen nationally in terms of rushing yards.

Malcolm In The Mid

Navy QB Malcolm Perry leads all quarterbacks in rushing at 130.3 yards per game. Perry ranks fourth among all FBS players in rushing trailing only Oklahoma State's Chuba Hubbard (178.2 ypg), Boston College's A.J. Dillon (142.9) and Ohio State's J.K. Dobbins (138.8 ypg).

Any Way You Want It

Memphis WR Antonio Gibson became the first FBS player to score touchdowns by rushing, receiving and on special teams in a game this season. Gibson scored on a 50-yard reception, a 78-yard run and a 97-yard kickoff return in the Tigers' 54-48 win against No. 14 SMU.

The 2019 Championship

The 2019 American Athletic Conference Football Championship will be played Saturday, Dec. 7, at 3:30 p.m. ET and will be televised nationally on ABC for the fifth consecutive season.



The championship will be played between the champions of the East and West divisions, based on the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The site of the championship will be the home venue of the division winner with the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The following tiebreakers are in place for the 2019 season.

Two-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

- Head-to-head result
- Divisional winning percentage
- Head-to-head results within the division against the team with the next best conference winning percentage, in descending order
- Winning percentage against common non-divisional conference opponents
- College Football Playoff Selection Committee rankings, provided that team wins in the final weekend of the regular season. If the higher-ranked team loses in the final weekend, then a composite average of computer rankings will determine the divisional champion.
- Overall winning percentage, excluding exempt games
- Coin toss

Multiple-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Rob Mullens (chair), Frank Beamer, Paola Boivin, Jeff Bower, Joe Castiglione, Herb Deromedi, Ken Hatfield, Chris Howard, Bobby Johnson, Ronnie Lott, Gene Smith, Todd Stansbury, and Scott Stricklin.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2019.

The **Birmingham Bowl** takes place at Legion Field in Birmingham, Alabama. The American/Big East has partnered with the bowl since its inception in the 2006 season. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Southeastern Conference.

The **Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl** is played at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa, Florida. Conference USA will provide the opponent for The American's team in the 2019 season.

The **Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl** began in 2014 and is played at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, Florida. The American representative will play a team from the Mid-American Conference in 2019.
