### The Game:

- No. 15 Cincinnati plays the last match of a three-game homestand at Gettler Stadium, playing Illinois on Saturday, Sept. 11 at 7 p.m.
- The match has been dubbed the "Remembrance Game" as the women's soccer program will have a pre-game tailgate for active military personnel, veterans, military family members and 9/11 victims
- There will be a special collection box at the entrance for the Thank You Foundation which will use the collection to help military veterans or families in need
- Veteran and active military children will serve as ball girls/boys during the match and Honorary Captain, Jennifer Wells, will meet with the coaching staff on the field and participate with the captains in the coin toss

### Storylines and Notes:

- The Bearcats are 5-0-1 to start the season, the first time in school history that UC has been unbeaten in its first six games of the year
- UC moved up in the national rankings, from the No. 19 spot in the *Soccer America* Women's Top 25 poll to its current ranking of No. 15
- The Bearcats have not been nationally ranked since 2002 season when they cracked the Top 25 on two different occasions
- That year the Bearcats finished the season with an overall record of 17-4-3, won the Conference USA Tournament, and knocked off Kentucky 1-0 in the NCAA Tournament before bowing out, 2-1, to No. 11 Tennessee. UC was ranked as high as No. 21 during that season
- Head coach Michelle Salmon is 23-17-5 in her three seasons at UC and is five wins away from her 100th career win (95-79-11) during her 11 years as a head coach

### Series History:

- The match against Illinois is the second time UC has played the Fighting Illini
- UC lost in the last contest, 3-0, at Illinois in 2002

### Awards and Honors:

- Rachel Barnette was named to *TopDrawerSoccer.com* Women's Team of the Week for Monday Aug. 30 through Sunday Sept. 5 after back-to-back shutouts and six saves
- Kelli Pawelko was named a *CollegeSoccer360.com* Primetime Performer of the Week #2
- Kelli Pawelko was twice named the BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week (8/30/10 and 9/6/10)

## 2010 WOMEN'S SOCCER NOTES

- Pawelko scored the game-winner against No. 20 Wisconsin on Aug. 29
- Rachel Barnette was twice named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll (8/30/10 and 9/6/10)
- Barnette has recorded four straight shutouts, the first time since the 2008 season that a UC goalkeeper has recorded four consecutive shutouts
- Emily Hebbeler was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll (8/23/10)
- Hebbeler scored two goals against Morehead State, her first multi-goal game and UC's first since Sept. 13, 2009

### 30 Years:

- During the 2010 season UC will celebrate 30 seasons of varsity women's soccer
- On Saturday, Oct. 2, the Bearcats will have a special evening for all former players and on Sunday, Oct. 3, all former players in attendance will be honored at halftime of the BIG EAST contest against Pittsburgh

### Depth and Firepower:

- Head coach Michelle Salmon has noted that the 2010 squad is her deepest since she has been at UC
- There are 11 midfielders, nine forwards, three defenders and two goalkeepers on the roster
- Junior Emily Hebbeler, who was one of the team's top scoring threats in 2009, picked up where she left off, scoring two goals in the season opener. She leads the team with three goals and seven points in 2010
- UC's Logan Ballinger (MF), who missed most of last season due to an injury, scored the game-winning goal at Bowling Green
- The 2010 team captains are senior Sydney Barker, and juniors Logan Ballinger and Kay Young

### Challenging Schedule:

- Four of UC's opponents on the 2010 schedule were ranked in the NCAA Women's Division I Preseason Poll
- Notre Dame, the second BIG EAST opponent UC will take on this year, is currently ranked No. 3
- Rutgers and Georgetown are also in the Top 25 with Louisville, Illinois and Marquette receiving votes
- Cincinnati defeated No. 20 Wisconsin on the road, the second time in as many seasons that the Bearcats have knocked off a ranked opponent (winning 1-0 on 10/4/09 at No. 12 St. John's)

### Last Time Out:

- Cincinnati posted two shutouts at Gettler Stadium, defeating Charleston, 2-0, and Western Michigan, 1-0
- Emily Hebbeler scored a goal and handed out an assist to Sydney Barker against CoC
- Kelli Pawelko served up an assist on Julie Morrissey's game-winner against Western Michigan

### Up Next:

- Cincinnati hits the road for the next three games, playing its first BIG EAST Conference match at Louisville (9/16), heading across town to take on Xaver (9/19), and then playing at Notre Dame (9/24)
