OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Tyler Snead • ECU • So. • WR • Raleigh, N.C.

Snead finished with 19 receptions – the most by an FBS player in a game this season – for 240 yards and three touchdowns in ECU's 59-51 loss at No. 23 SMU. Snead's receptions total ranks second on The American's single-game chart, behind only former ECU standout Zay Jones, who had 22 against South Carolina in 2016. The 240 yards rank sixth in conference history. Snead had touchdown receptions of 36, 47 and 57 yards against the Mustangs.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Reggie Robinson II • Tulsa • Sr. • CB • Cleburne, Texas

Robinson led a Tulsa defense that held UCF without a second-half touchdown, allowing the Golden Hurricane to rally for a 34-31 win. Robinson had five solo tackles to go with three pass breakups and a key interception which set up the game-winning field goal.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Thomas Bennett • Tulsa • Sr. • P • Carlsbad, Calif.

Bennett averaged 46.3 yards on six punts, with a long of 62 yards, in Tulsa's 34-31 win against UCF. None of the six punts were returned, while Bennett put three of his punts inside the UCF 20-yard line.

To Be The Best ...

American Athletic Conference teams have played eight games against top-25 opponents in 2019. Conference teams have faced three top-10 teams this season.

Exclusivity

The American is the only FBS conference that has four one-loss teams through Week 11.

Home Is Where The Wins Are

UCF has won 20 straight home games, trailing only Clemson (21) for the longest home winning streaks nationally.

Ground Troops

Navy leads the nation in rushing, averaging 357.9 rushing yards per game. Tulane is ranked 10th nationally at 261.2 rushing yards per game.

Two Steps Back

UCF ranks second in the nation in tackles for loss, averaging 9.4 TFL per game. USF is third at 9.0, while SMU is fifth at 8.6.

They're Honored

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell and Temple C Matt Hennessey were named to the Associated Press Midseason All-America team. Both players were second team selections.

We'll Take That

USF and Cincinnati are ranked third nationally in turnovers gained. The Bulls and Bearcats both have 21 takeaways, trailing only Illinois (26) and Clemson (22).

It's East vs. West

The American's East Division finished the 2018 season with a 10-8 head-to-head record against the league's West Division, marking the first time in the four-year history of the conference's two-division format that the East had the better head-to-head record. West Division teams hold a 46-39 all-time lead against East Division opponents since 2015.

Cincinnati is 19-3 since the start of the 2018 season. SMU is 15-5 in its last 20 games. UCF is 32-4 since the start of the 2017 season.

Best In Class

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell is ranked ninth nationally in rushing at 118.6 yards per game. Gainwell is the only freshman ranked among the top 40 players in rushing.

Malcolm In The Mid

Navy QB Malcolm Perry leads all quarterbacks in rushing at 130.3 yards per game. Perry ranks fifth among all FBS players in rushing trailing only Oklahoma State's Chuba Hubbard (178.2 ypg), Boston College's A.J. Dillon (145.1), Wisconsin's Jonathan Taylor (139.9) and Ohio State's J.K. Dobbins (133.3 ypg).

Passing Fancy

SMU QB Shane Buechele is fourth nationally in passing yards, averaging 319.5 yards per game. Buechele trails only Washington State's Anthony Gordon (421.6), LSU's Joe Burrow (355.3) and Alabama's Tua Tagovailoa (323.0).

Any Way You Want It

Memphis WR Antonio Gibson became the first FBS player to score touchdowns by rushing, receiving and on special teams in a game this season. Gibson scored on a 50-yard reception, a 78-yard run and a 97-yard kickoff return in the Tigers' 54-48 win against No. 14 SMU Nov. 2.

The 2019 Championship

The 2019 American Athletic Conference Football Championship will be played Saturday, Dec. 7, at 3:30 p.m. ET and will be televised nationally on ABC for the fifth consecutive season.



The championship will be played between the champions of the East and West divisions, based on the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The site of the championship will be the home venue of the division winner with the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The following tiebreakers are in place for the 2019 season.

Two-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

- Head-to-head result
- Divisional winning percentage
- Head-to-head results within the division against the team with the next best conference winning percentage, in descending order
- Winning percentage against common non-divisional conference opponents
- College Football Playoff Selection Committee rankings, provided that team wins in the final weekend of the regular season. If the higher-ranked team loses in the final weekend, then a composite average of computer rankings will determine the divisional champion.
- Overall winning percentage, excluding exempt games
- Coin toss

Multiple-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

The following is used to eliminate teams until two teams remain, at which point the two-team tiebreaker is used

- If one team defeated all other teams, it will be the divisional champion
- If two teams defeated the other tied team(s), the defeated team(s) is eliminated

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Rob Mullens (chair), Frank Beamer, Paola Boivin, Jeff Bower, Joe Castiglione, Herb Deromedi, Ken Hatfield, Chris Howard, Bobby Johnson, Ronnie Lott, Gene Smith, Todd Stansbury, and Scott Stricklin.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2019.

The **Birmingham Bowl** takes place at Legion Field in Birmingham, Alabama. The American/Big East has partnered with the bowl since its inception in the 2006 season. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Southeastern Conference.

The **Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl** is played at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa, Florida. Conference USA will provide the opponent for The American's team in the 2019 season.

The **Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl** began in 2014 and is played at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, Florida. The American representative will play a team from the Mid-American Conference in 2019.
