OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Malcolm Perry • Navy • Sr. • QB • Clarksville, Tenn.

Perry rushed for 218 yards and three touchdowns on 20 attempts to lead Navy in a 45-17 win at Tulsa. Perry averaged 10.9 yards per carry and scored on touchdown runs of 29, 35 and 3 yards as Navy scored 28 consecutive first-half points. It was Perry's fourth career game with 200 rushing yards, tying for the second-most in school history.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Ja'Von Hicks • Cincinnati • So. • S • Cincinnati, Ohio

Hicks figured in three of Cincinnati's five takeaways on defense in a 38-23 win at Houston, keeping Cincinnati tied atop The American's East Division at 2-0 in conference play. Hicks finished with two interceptions and a fumble recovery, setting up two Bearcat touchdowns and denying the Cougars a score at the end of the first half.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Will Mobley • Temple • So. • K • Lititz, Pa.

Mobley scored 12 points, going 3-for-3 on field goal attempts and on PATs as Temple took a 30-28 win against No. 20 Memphis, giving the Owls their second win against a top-25 team this season. Mobley hit first-half field goals from 31, 29 and 44 yards to help Temple build a 16-0 lead, giving him seven field goals in eight attempts this season.

Rushed for 158 yards and two touchdowns on 26 carries in a 27-23 win against BYU. Scored the go-ahead touchdown with 7:37 left in regulation.

Had a team-high nine tackles with 2.0 tackles for loss, an interception, a forced fumble and a pass breakup in a 30-28 win against Memphis.

Justin McMillan • Tulane • Sr. • QB

Completed 18 of 24 passes for 231 yards and two touchdowns and added 37 rushing yards with a TD in a 49-7 win against UConn.

To Be The Best ...

American Athletic Conference teams have played eight games against top-25 opponents in 2019. Conference teams have faced three top-10 teams this season.

Exclusivity

SMU is one of 11 teams that is 6-0 through Week 7.

Home Is Where The Wins Are

UCF has won 18 straight home games, trailing only Alabama (29) for the nation's longest active streak. UCF is tied with Clemson for the second-longest streak.

It's Been A While

SMU is 6-0 for the first time since 1982. Tulane is 5-1 through six games for the first time since 1998.

Feels Like The First Time

Temple has two wins against top-25 teams (Maryland, Memphis), marking the first time in program history that the Owls defeated two top-25 opponents in the same season.

Ground Troops

Navy leads the nation in rushing, averaging 327.2 rushing yards per game. Navy is the only team in the nation that is averaging more than 300 rushing yards.

Two Steps Back

USF is the national leader in tackles for loss. The Bulls have averaged 10.3 tackles for loss per game. UCF is fourth at 8.8 per game.

Keeping Up With Jones (and Perry)

SMU RB Xavier Jones and Navy QB Malcolm Perry rank third among all FBS players with 12 rushing touchdowns. They trail only Wisconsin's Jonathan Taylor (14) and Oklahoma State's Chuba Hubbard (13).

Rank And File

Seven American Athletic Conference teams were either ranked or received votes in the Oct. 6 national polls.

This Is Our House

Home teams were a combined 30-18 in American Athletic Conference games in 2018. The home team is 8-5 in conference games this season.

It's East vs. West

The American's East Division finished the 2018 season with a 10-8 head-to-head record against the league's West Division, marking the first time in the four-year history of the conference's two-division format that the East had the better head-to-head record. West Division teams hold a 41-36 all-time lead against East Division opponents since 2015.

Cincinnati is 16-3 since the start of the 2018 season. Tulane is 10-2 in its last 12 games. SMU is 11-4 in its last 15 games. UCF is 29-3 since the start of the 2017 season.

Best In Class

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell is ranked fifth nationally in rushing at 121.0 yards per game. Temple RB Re'Mahn Davis is averaging 95.8 yards per game. Gainwell and Davis are the two leading freshmen nationally in terms of rushing yards.

Malcolm In The Mid

Navy QB Malcolm Perry leads all quarterbacks in rushing at 120.8 yards per game. Perry ranks sixth among all FBS players.

The 2019 Championship

The 2019 American Athletic Conference Football Championship will be played Saturday, Dec. 7, at 3:30 p.m. ET and will be televised nationally on ABC for the fifth consecutive season.



The championship will be played between the champions of the East and West divisions, based on the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The site of the championship will be the home venue of the division winner with the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The following tiebreakers are in place for the 2019 season.

Two-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

- Head-to-head result
- Divisional winning percentage
- Head-to-head results within the division against the team with the next best conference winning percentage, in descending order
- Winning percentage against common non-divisional conference opponents
- College Football Playoff Selection Committee rankings, provided that team wins in the final weekend of the regular season. If the higher-ranked team loses in the final weekend, then a composite average of computer rankings will determine the divisional champion.
- Overall winning percentage, excluding exempt games
- Coin toss

Multiple-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

- UCF had defeated 19 consecutive American Athletic Conference opponents before falling to Cincinnati. The Knights' last loss against a conference opponent was against USF in the 2016 regular-season finale.
- UCF has had a rushing touchdown and a passing touchdown in 32 consecutive games, the longest current streak in FBS football.

- QB Brady White passed for 363 yards and two touchdowns with an interception against Temple for his second 300-yard game of the season.
- TE Joey Magnifico had a career-high 87 yards on six receptions against Temple. Magnifico has 995 career receiving yards and should become the second tight end in school history to reach 1,000 (Alan Cross).

- Perry registered his fourth career day with 200 rushing yards, tying for the second-most in school history.
- Navy ran the ball 58 times on 63 offensive plays against Tulsa.

- SMU went 6-for-6 on fourth down conversion attempts in the fourth quarter and in overtime against Tulsa.
- The Mustangs have clinched bowl eligibility for the second time in three years. SMU and Ohio State are the only teams nationally that are bowl-eligible.
- SMU trailed Tulsa 30-9 in the fourth quarter, but scored 21 points in the final 14:56 of regulation to force overtime before winning in the third extra session.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Rob Mullens (chair), Frank Beamer, Paola Boivin, Jeff Bower, Joe Castiglione, Herb Deromedi, Ken Hatfield, Chris Howard, Bobby Johnson, Ronnie Lott, Gene Smith, Todd Stansbury, and Scott Stricklin.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The **Military Bowl presented by Northrop Grumman** takes place at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in Annapolis, Maryland, while the events and activities surrounding the game are based in Washington, D.C. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2019.

The **Birmingham Bowl** takes place at Legion Field in Birmingham, Alabama. The American/Big East has partnered with the bowl since its inception in the 2006 season. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Southeastern Conference.

The **Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl** is played at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa, Florida. Conference USA will provide the opponent for The American's team in the 2019 season.

The **Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl** began in 2014 and is played at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, Florida. The American representative will play a team from the Mid-American Conference in 2019.

The **Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl** will be played for the third time in 2019. An American Athletic Conference team will face an opponent to be determined at Toyota Stadium in Frisco, Texas.

The **AutoNation Cure Bowl** made its debut in 2015 at Exploria Stadium in Orlando, Florida. An American Athletic Conference team will be paired against an opponent from the Sun Belt Conference. Net proceeds from the game will benefit the Breast Cancer Research Foundation.
