WEEKLY HONORS

OFFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Dillon Gabriel • UCF • So. • QB • Mililani, Hawaii

Gabriel set American Athletic Conference single-game records for passing yards and total offense in the Knights' 50-49 setback to Memphis. He completed 35 of 49 passes for 601 yards and five touchdowns, adding 49 rushing yards and another TD to account for 650 yards of total offense. His 601 passing yards broke the previous conference mark of 557, set by Cincinnati's Hayden Moore against Memphis in 2015, while his 650 yards of offense bettered the old mark of 635, set by SMU's Garrett Gilbert against Temple in 2013. Gabriel leads all NCAA FBS players with 1,756 passing yards in 2020.



Brady White • Memphis • Gr. • QB • Santa Clarita, Calif.

White, who was chosen as the Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week, led Memphis to a 50-49 win against UCF as the Tigers overcame a 21-point second-half deficit for their largest come-from-behind win in program history. White completed 34 of 50 passes for a career-high and school-record 486 yards and six touchdowns, while he also had 30 rushing yards with another score, tying The American's single-game record with seven total touchdowns. White threw two touchdown passes in the final 3:41 of the fourth quarter, including the game-winning TD with 1:08 left to help Memphis end a 13-game series slide against the Knights.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Arnold Ebiketie • Temple • Jr. • DE • Silver Spring, Md.

Ebiketie keyed Temple's 39-37 win against USF, giving the Owls their first win of the 2020 season. Ebiketie finished with six tackles, including a sack and 3.5 tackles for loss, and delivered the biggest defensive play of the game when he returned a fourth-quarter fumble 11 yards for a touchdown, giving Temple a lead it would not relinquish.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Chris Naggar • SMU • Sr. • K • Arlington, Texas

Naggar scored 13 points, including the game-winning field goal in overtime, to help SMU to a 37-34 win at Tulane. Naggar made field goals of 48, 33 and 34 yards and was 4-for-4 on PATs to help the Mustangs improve to 5-0 in 2020.

Good Company

SMU enters Week 8 of the 2020 season as one of four teams nationally with a 5-0 record (BYU, Clemson, Liberty).

Giant Killers

SMU has won its last three games against nationally ranked opponents.

When It Counts

Navy, the only 3-0 team in American Athletic Conference play, has won its three conference games by a total of nine points.

Next Man Up

Cincinnati, which has won 16 straight at Nippert Stadium, has The American's longest home field winning streak. The streak ranks fifth nationally behind Clemson, which has won 25 straight at home, followed by Notre Dame (21), UAB (20) and Ohio State (20). Memphis has won 10 straight home games, which ranks seventh nationally.

This Goes To 11

Tulsa's first two games this season have been against teams ranked No. 11 in the Associated Press poll at gametime. The Golden Hurricane is 1-1 in those games (16-7 loss at Oklahoma State, 34-26 win at UCF).

Road Warriors

Tulsa is one of two teams nationally (Charlotte) that has started its season, but has not yet played a home game.

Conference Calls

The American Athletic Conference ranks second among the five NCAA FBS conferences that have played more than one nonconference game in 2020.

UCF is also the national leader in passing offense at 439.0 yards per game. SMU is fifth at 359.2 ypg.

Throw The Record Book Out The Window

Saturday's game between Memphis and UCF was the most prolific game in American Athletic Conference history in terms of total offense. The game featured six individual or team conference records that were either tied or broken.

Temple leads the nation in fewest passing yards allowed (114.5 ypg), while Cincinnati is the national leader in pass efficiency defense (80.46).

Keep The Offense On The Field

Memphis is 7-for-7 in fourth-down conversion attempts this season.

1-2 Punch

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel leads all NCAA FBS players with 1,756 passing yards. SMU QB Shane Buechele is second with 1,170 yards.

Career Day

SMU QB Shane Buechele is the NCAA FBS active career leader in passing yards (10,275). Memphis QB Brady White is third with 8,631 career yards.

Penetration

Tulsa LB Zaven Collins is ranked second nationally with 3.8 tackles for loss per game. Houston DE Payton Turner is third at 3.0, while Temple DE Arnold Ebiketie is fourth at 2.3.

Get These Hands

UCF WR Marlon Williams is the national leader in both receiving yards (114.8 per game) and receptions (11.3 per game).

Long Division

After playing five years as a 12-team, two-division conference, The American will feature 11 teams in a single-division format for the 2020 season. Each team is scheduled to play eight conference games this season. The top two teams in the final regular season standings will play in the 2020 American Athletic Conference Football Championship, which will take place either Dec. 12 or 19 at the home stadium of the first-place team.

Leadership

Tulsa OT Chris Paul is the chair of the American Athletic Conference Student-Athlete Advisory Committee and is one of 32 student-athletes nationally on the NCAA SAAC, which reports directly to the NCAA Division I Council.

2020 COLLEGE FOOTBALL RULES CHANGES

Players Numbering

No more than two squad members may be assigned or wear the same jersey number. There were no limits to duplicate numbers in previous seasons. With the recognized popularity of the single-digit numbers, the digit "0" is added as a legal number. Any number to be preceded by "0" such as "07" or "00" remains illegal.

Targeting - Disqualified Player

There were no changes to the targeting rule from an on-field officiating perspective and the rule continues to serve the game well and is changing player behavior in terms of use of the helmet. The change for 2020 is that now a player disqualified for targeting will be declared ineligible for further participation in the game, but the player may remain in the team area.

All other disqualifying fouls such as fighting, two unsportsmanlike conduct fouls, flagrant personal fouls, etc. will be reclassified as fouls requiring ejection. Players ejected will be required to leave the playing enclosure and must remain out of view of the field of play under team supervision.

Pregame Warmup /Officials' Jurisdiction

The Rules Committee address issues of unsportsmanlike behavior in the pregame and took steps to clean this action up. The officials' jurisdiction will now begin at 90 minutes before kickoff (previously 60 minutes). Additionally, when any squad member enters the playing enclosure prior to the game, the head coach or an assistant coach from that team must be present on the field. Furthermore, when any squad member is present within the playing enclosure after the officials' jurisdiction, they must be wearing their jersey or have their numeral readily visible. Players without their numeral readily visible must leave the playing enclosure.

Defensive Linemen on Scrimmage Kick Plays

To further enhance the protection of the snapper on scrimmage kicks, if the offense is in a scrimmage kick formation at the snap, any defensive player within one yard of the line of scrimmage must be aligned completely outside the frame of the body of the snapper at the snap. This change paired with the current rule that does not allow the defense to initiate contact with the snapper until one second has elapsed on these type plays will further protect the snapper on kick downs.

Instant Replay/Clock Adjustment and Review Time

If the clock expires at the end of a half, and replay determines that there was time remaining on the clock, and the clock would start on the referee's signal after review, there must be at least three seconds remaining when the ball should have been declared dead to restore time to the clock. With two seconds or one second remaining on the clock, the half is over. This change will not impact situations when the clock is stopped and will remain stopped until the snap such as incomplete passes and runners out of bounds. In addition, the expectation is that the instant replay official will not exceed two minutes to complete any review. The exception is if the review has end-of-game impact or has multiple aspects as a part of the review, it should be completed efficiently but will have no stated time limit.

Other Changes:

- A second jersey meeting all requirements of the jersey rule worn concurrently is allowed.
- The penalty for a team not complying with the jersey rule (i.e., legal and contrasting numbers or a colored jersey in violation of the rule) will be a 15-yard penalty after the kickoff of each half and the loss of a timeout in each quarter that illegal jerseys are worn.
- Defensive team substitution infractions will now be treated as a live ball foul.
- All fouls that have an option to carry over to the succeeding kickoff will also contain an option to carry over to the succeeding spot in extra periods.

Tulsa has played a challenging early schedule to a 1-1 record ... The Golden Hurricane's first two opponents were ranked No. 11 nationally at the time of the game (Oklahoma State and UCF) ... Tulsa's 34-26 win against UCF marked the first win against a top-15 opponent for the Golden Hurricane since a 35-34 win against then-No. 15 Texas A&M in the 1991 season ... Tulsa's game against USF is the Hurricane's third game in a six-week span ... Tulsa has bottled up two potent offenses in its first two games, allowing an average of 21.0 ppg ... COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Gary Barta (chair), Paola Boivin, Tom Burman, Joe Castiglione, Rick George, Ken Hatfield, Ronnie Lott, Terry Mohajir, Ray Odierno, R.C. Sillocum, Todd Stansbury, Scott Stricklin and John Urschel.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The American Bowl Lineup

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances annually as part of the conference's new postseason lineup, which begins with the 2020 season and is in place through 2025..

The American, as it has done three times in the first five years of the current bowl cycle, will continue to send its champion to a New Year's Six bowl if that team finishes higher than the champions of four other conferences in the final College Football Playoff rankings. American Athletic Conference teams are also eligible for the College Football Playoff if they are among the top four teams in the final CFP rankings.

As part of the new bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Military Bowl presented by Perspecta against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, the Fenway Bowl in Boston, also against an ACC team, and a third annual spot which will alternate between the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the SoFi Hawaii Bowl.

Additionally, The American will annually have four appearances in a group of eight bowls. The American has extended its existing partnerships with the TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl, the Gasparilla Bowl, the Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl, the Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl and the Cure Bowl.

New to The American's lineup are the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

THE AMERICAN ON TELEVISION

The American and ESPN reached agreement on a 12-year media rights extension that begins with the 2020-21 academic year.

With the new agreement, The American will have a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary TV networks - ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU. The Conference will also be a valuable part of ESPN+, ESPN's industry-leading direct-to-consumer sports streaming service.

In football, a minimum of 40 regular-season telecasts per season will be televised on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, including at least 20 across ABC, ESPN and ESPN2, which represents increased annual exposure across those ESPN networks. The American Championship game will be televised each year on ABC or ESPN.

Beyond select Navy football games, all conference controlled football games from The American will air on an ESPN network or ESPN+.
