The Game:

- After earning its first BIG EAST win on Saturday, the University of Cincinnati men's soccer team looks to make it two straight when it welcomes DePaul to Gettler Stadium on Oct. 19 at 7 p.m.

Series History:

- UC leads the all-time series againsts DePaul, 14-9-4, including 7-5-1 in games in Cincinnati.
- The Bearcats are looking to snap a four-match winless streak against the Blue Demons (0-3-1 since 2007).
- UC and DPU have met each year since 1991 as members of the BIG EAST, Conference USA, and Metro Athletic conferences.

Story Lines:

- The Bearcats have started five true freshmen and a first-year transfer this season.
- Freshman Cole DeNormandie and junior college transfer Leon Powell have combined to score eight of UC's 18 goals this season. Newcomers have accounted for 12 goals in 2011.
- Nine different players have accounted for goals this season for UC.
- DeNormandie is tied for BIG EAST lead in goals scored amongst freshmen with six.
- UC's win against Villanova extended its unbeaten streak to seven straight against the Wildcats (6-0-1) since joining the BIG EAST in 2005.
- UC's win against SIU Edwardsville snapped a five-match winless streak and was the 90th win at Cincinnati for head coach Hylton Dayes.
- UC and crosstown rival Xavier played to a 1-1 draw on Sept. 28 in Gettler Stadium, extending the Bearcats' unbeaten streak against XU at home to 14 matches (11-0-3).
- The Bearcats' seven combined goals against Central Arkansas and IUPUI are the most since scoring seven in back-to-back contests against Canisius (5-0) and Wright State (2-0) on Sept. 4 and Sept. 6 of 2009, respectively.

2011 MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

- Head coach Hylton Dayes is in his 11th season at Cincinnati and 22nd as a head coach. Dayes holds an 91-86-30 mark at UC and a 187-171-49 overall record.
- Dayes is the second-winningest coach in UC history behind only Bob Muro, who posted a 114-111-13 mark in 12 seasons on the Bearcats sideline.
- Redshirt freshman Taylor Hafling made his first career start in goal against Villanova, earning the win and making five saves.
- Junior midfielder Shamar Shelton scored the game-tying goal and assisted on another in UC's 3-1 season-opening win at Western Michigan.
- Senior defender Sam Klosterman scored the game-winner at Western Michigan from the penalty spot and was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll for his efforts.
- Freshman midfielder Emmanuel Appiah tallied his first career goal in the second half at Virginia Tech in the Hilton Garden Inn Invitational.
- Freshman Will Diebold scored his first career goal against Oakland, giving the Bearcats a lead in the 67th minute.
- Freshman Matt Remaley scored his second career goal, the game-winner, against SIU Edwardsville in the 36th minute.
- Junior Mike Brizzi scored his first career goal late in the first half to give UC a 1-0 lead at Rutgers.
- In 2010, UC posted a 7-5-7 overall mark, including a 5-1-3 ledger in BIG EAST play and a second-place BIG EAST Red Division finish. The Bearcats advanced to the BIG EAST Championship semifinals for the first time in program history.
- Returning to the roster this season are second-team all-BIG EAST midfielder Matt Bahner and all-Ohio selection Roger Thompson, both currently sidelined with injury.
- The Bearcats look to replace a starting forward, two starting midfielders, a starting defender, and a third-team all-conference goalkeeper from a season ago.
- UC welcomes a class of 14 newcomers in 2011, a recruiting class ranked No. 28 in the nation by *CollegeSoccerNews.com*.

BIG EAST/National Honors:

- Cole DeNormandie was named the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week on Sept. 12 after scoring three goals, including a pair of game-winners, in wins against Central Arkansas (Sept. 9) and IUPUI (Sept. 11).
- Senior defender Sam Klosterman and freshman midfielder Emmanuel Appiah were named to the Hilton Garden Inn Invitational all-tournament team following the weekend tourney in Blacksburg, Va., on Sept. 4.
- Senior captain Sam Klosterman was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll after scoring the game-winner from the penalty spot in a 3-1 win at Western Michigan on August 27.

2011 MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Last Time Out:

- Cole DeNormandie and Shamar Shelton scored to lead UC to a 2-1 win against Villanova on Oct. 15 at Gettler Stadium.
- The Bearcats (5-8-1, 1-4-0 BIG EAST) got their first BIG EAST win and are unbeaten against Villanova all-time, leading the series 6-0-1.
- DeNormandie got the scoring started in the eighth minute when he ran on to a lob from Mike Brizzi, shielded his defender and beat Villanova keeper John Fogerty low to the left. It was the freshman's sixth goal of the season, which is tied for the BIG EAST lead amongst freshmen.
- In the 21st minute, Shelton gave the Bearcats some breathing room with his second goal of the campaign. He played a pass into Will Diebold, who worked a one-touch pass back to Shelton streaking up the left sideline. Shelton corralled the pass, settled it just inside the 18-yard box and blasted a left-footed shot to the far post for a 2-0 lead.
- UC held the two-goal advantage going to the locker room, but Villanova cut the deficit in half in the 56th minute. Ryan Whalen found some space along the right flank and cut a pass back through the UC box, where Dylan Renna finished past keeper Taylor Halfling for his second goal of the season.
- UC was able to hang on the rest of the match thanks to a strong backline effort and solid play from Halfling, who was making his first career start in place of an injured Joey Barnard. Halfling finished with five saves.

Up Next:

- UC will travel to Syracuse for a date with the Orange on Oct. 22 at 7 p.m.
