

# MEDIA INFORMATION

## Credentials:

Media and photo credentials may be secured by contacting the Sports Communications Office. Credential requests must be received by the Sports Communications Office no later than 48 hours in advance of the game, and may be made via fax (513-556-0619) or e-mail (Michael.Harris@uc.edu). Credentials will be held at the Media Entrance (South-east corner of Fifth Third Arena at Shoemaker Center) for pick up on the day of the game, unless other arrangements are made.

Credentials shall be allocated and space in the media seating areas shall be assigned according to the following priority:

- (1) originating radio and television outlets;
- (2) daily newspapers providing regular coverage of Cincinnati and its opponent;
- (3) national news agencies servicing the print and broadcast media;
- (4) radio and television outlets providing regular coverage of Cincinnati and its opponent;
- (5) national or regional print, broadcast and electronic media;
- (6) officially-sanctioned student media, specialty publications and electronic publications of Cincinnati and its opponent;
- (7) other types of print and broadcast media.

## Parking Passes:

May be obtained only by making requests for credentials one week in advance of the game to allow for delivery.

---

## Photographers:

Are limited to working in the designated areas at each end of the court, unless special arrangements have been made. Courtside lighting averages 180 candlepower, daylight-equivalent.

---

## Radio & TV:

Permission to broadcast or telecast a Cincinnati game from the Fifth Third Arena at Shoemaker Center must be requested through Assistant AD Mike Harris. Phone and ISDN service are installed for use by visiting radio stations on a reciprocal basis.

---

## Postgame Interviews:

Per BIG EAST Conference policy, the head coaches of both teams will be brought to the interview room. The order of appearance will be determined by postgame radio/television commitments of the coaches and how to provide access to the coaches as quickly as possible. The Cincinnati locker room is closed to all members of the media. Players requested for interview by the media will be brought to the interview room in Fifth Third Arena; or, when on the road, to an interview area.

## Interviews:

Coach Cronin is available each day prior to practice at 2:40-2:55 p.m. Players will be available at practice generally the day prior to each game from 2:30-2:45 p.m. To request a specific interview with Coach Cronin or a player, call or email Mike Harris (513-240-8884; email: Michael.Harris@uc.edu). The best time to reach Coach Cronin is mid-day, while players are available between 2:30 p.m.-2:45 p.m. EST. Home or cell phone numbers will not be provided.

### FROM I-71 South (Columbus)

- I-71 south to Exit 3 - Taft Road (Taft is one-way going west).
- Stay on Taft approximately seven blocks to the intersection of Jefferson Avenue. University Plaza will appear on the right.
- Turn right at the University Plaza onto Jefferson Avenue.
- At the first light, turn left on Corry Street.
- Corry Street Garage is on the left.

### FROM U.S. 50 (Portsmouth and East)

- U.S. 50 to Taft Road (Taft is one-way going west).
- Stay on Taft to the intersection of Jefferson Avenue.
- Turn right at the University Plaza onto Jefferson Avenue.
- At the first light, turn left on Corry Street.
- Corry Street Garage is on the left.

### FROM I-75 North or South

- Take Exit 3 - Hopple Street. At the end of the ramp (stop light) turn left (east).
- Cross over interstate and through Central Parkway. Hopple eventually becomes Martin Luther King Drive, the campus will appear on the right.
- At the sixth light, turn right onto Jefferson Avenue.
- At the second light, Corry Street, turn right. Corry Street Garage is on the left.

### FROM I-74 (Indianapolis and West)

- Take I-74 to I-75 south
- Follow directions above from I-75.

Fifth Third Arena at Shoemaker Center is to the right with Nippert Stadium next to it. Armory Fieldhouse is behind the Shoemaker Center. Gettler Stadium is on the left.

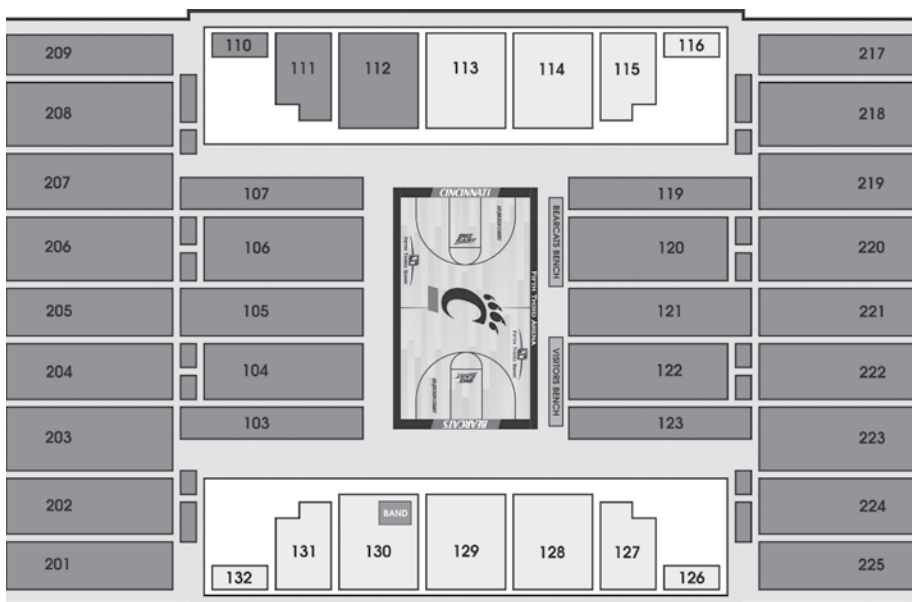

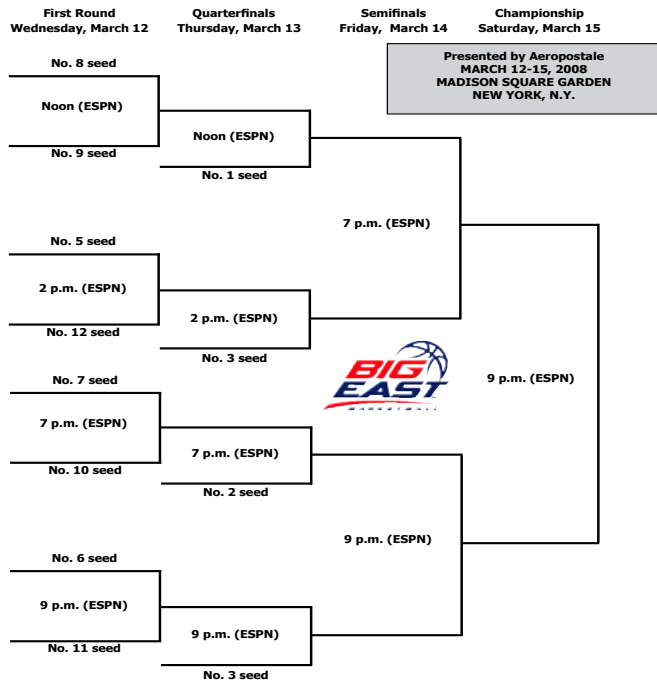
## Fifth Third Arena Seating Chart





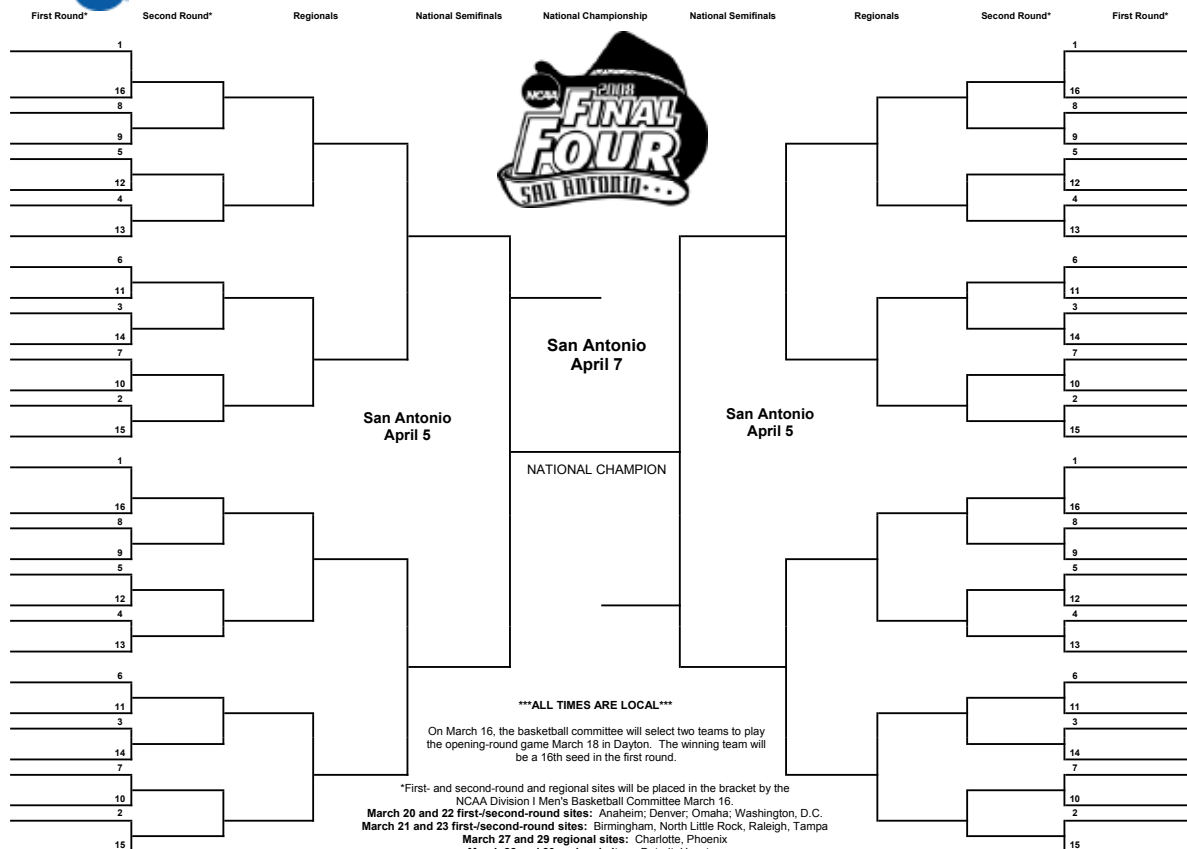

# RADIO AND TELEVISION

University of Cincinnati followers have had no trouble tracking the Bearcats due to their expansive media exposure.

WLW-AM 700, the signature station of ClearChannel's Cincinnati properties, has been the Bearcats' broadcast partner for the past 13 years. The station's 50,000-watt signal can project Cincinnati games to 38 states and a third of Canada, making it possible for UC basketball fans to hear every game.

UC's broadcast coverage can be heard world-wide via XM Satellite Radio's Channel 173.

WLW augments the broadcast coverage with pregame and postgame programming. Additionally, head coach Mick Cronin is featured in an hour-long call-in show each week which originates from a local restaurant, allowing for Cincinnati fans to meet the coach and ask their questions up close and personal.

A veteran broadcast crew provides detailed coverage and up-to-the-minute information.

Dan Hoard is in his eighth year as the play-by-play voice. Hoard has been a focal point of Bearcat broadcasts since coming

to Cincinnati from Syracuse, N.Y. in 1995. He served as the Bearcats' radio voice in 1996 and handled the play-by-play on the local television football and basketball telecasts from 1996-2000. He took over the radio play-by-play duties in 2000.

Chuck Machock, a UC grad and long-time coach, is in his 15th season of providing analysis and colorful insights.

WXIX-TV 19, a Fox affiliate, is UC's television partner. Fox 19 produces and televises the weekly Mick Cronin Show, at 11:30 a.m. on Sunday mornings. Brian Giesenschlag, the station's sports director, serves as the primary host of the show.

Fox 19 originates the telecasts of about a dozen UC games annually and is the Cincinnati home for the BIG EAST television package, carrying all UC games plus other contests from the series. Jeff Picoro provides the play-by-play on the Fox 19 telecasts with former Bearcat Anthony Buford as the analyst. The Fox 19 telecasts are directed by Emmy-winning producer/director Dave Ashbrock.

The BIG EAST has extensive television arrangements with ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPN Regional Television for national telecasts and a regionally-syndicated game of the week package.
