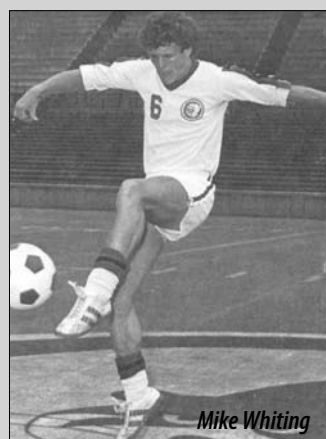

UC HALL OF FAME

In 1990, **Mike Whiting** became the first men's soccer player to be inducted into the James P. Kelly, Sr. University of Cincinnati Athletics Hall of Fame. **Andrew Kean**, the first all-American in UC men's soccer history, will be inducted with the Class of 2009-10.

Whiting, a 1979 graduate and four-time All-Ohio selection, is UC's all-time record holder in points and assists and ranks second in goals. He led the Bearcats in assists and points in each of his four seasons.

Kean was a two-time NSCAA all-America selection and the 1999 Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year. Kean also earned C-USA all-Freshman Team honors in 1997 and two all-conference nods.

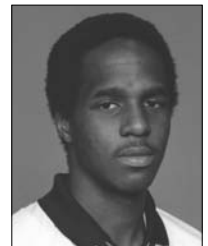

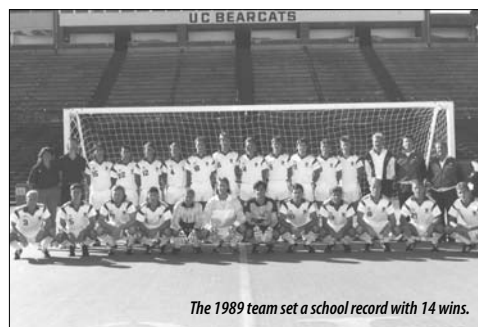
