OFFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Kevin Mensah • UConn • Jr. • RB • Worcester, Mass.

Mensah rushed for 164 yards and a career-high five touchdowns – the most by an FBS player this season – in UConn's 56-35 win at Massachusetts. Mensah's first two touchdowns gave the Huskies the lead as he became the first UConn player with five rushing TDs in a game since the 1993 season.

Jamale Carothers • Navy • So. • FB • Bowling Green, Ky.

Carothers rushed for 154 yards and three touchdowns and had a 31-yard touchdown reception to help Navy to a 41-38 win against Tulane, improving the Midshipmen to 6-1 overall and 4-1 in The American. Carothers scored all four touchdowns by Navy's offense, converting runs of 52, 35, 31 and 15 yards.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Patrick Nelson • SMU • Sr. • LB • Chicago, Ill.

Nelson had seven tackles, 2.5 sacks, 3.5 tackles for loss and a forced fumble to help SMU to a 34-31 win at Houston, keeping the Mustangs unbeaten at 8-0 overall. Nelson's strip sack early in the third quarter gave SMU the ball at the Houston 2-yard line, allowing the Mustangs to build a 28-13 lead.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Bijan Nichols • Navy • Fr. • K • Heath, Texas

Nichols scored 11 points, including the game-winning field goal from 48 yards as time expired, to help Navy to a 41-38 win against Tulane. Nichols also connected on a 31-yard field goal to give Navy a 24-0 lead in the second quarter and was 5-for-5 on PATs to help the Midshipmen clinch bowl eligibility.

A League Of Our Own

American Athletic Conference teams are a combined 28-1 (.966) against opponents from outside the power conferences this season.

Conference Call

American Athletic Conference teams are 6-0 against Conference USA this season. The American is 4-0 against the Sun Belt, 3-0 against the Mountain West and 1-1 against the MAC. Teams from The American are 3-0 against FBS independents in 2019.

To Be The Best ...

American Athletic Conference teams have played eight games against top-25 opponents in 2019. Conference teams have faced three top-10 teams this season.

Exclusivity

SMU is one of nine unbeaten FBS teams nationally. The Mustangs are 8-0 along with Alabama, Clemson, LSU, Minnesota, Ohio State and Penn State. Appalachian State and Baylor are both 7-0.

Home Is Where The Wins Are

UCF has won 19 straight home games, trailing only Alabama (31) for the nation's longest active streak. UCF is tied with Clemson for the second-longest streak.

Feels Like The First Time

Temple has two wins against top-25 teams (Maryland, Memphis), marking the first time in program history that the Owls defeated two top-25 opponents in the same season.

Ground Troops

Navy leads the nation in rushing, averaging 350.7 rushing yards per game.

Two Steps Back

USF, UCF and SMU are ranked second, third and fourth, respectively, in tackles for loss. USF has averaged 9.1 tackles for loss per game, while USF is at 9.0 and SMU is at 8.8. Ohio State leads the nation at 9.3 per game.

They're Honored

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell and Temple C Matt Hennessy were named to the Associated Press Midseason All-America team. Both players were second team selections.

We'll Take That

USF and Cincinnati are ranked first and second nationally in turnovers gained. USF leads the nation with 20 takeaways, while the Bearcats are second with 19.

This Is Our House

Home teams were a combined 30-18 in American Athletic Conference games in 2018. The home team is 14-10 in conference games this season.

It's East vs. West

The American's East Division finished the 2018 season with a 10-8 head-to-head record against the league's West Division, marking the first time in the four-year history of the conference's two-division format that the East had the better head-to-head record. West Division teams hold a 41-36 all-time lead against East Division opponents since 2015.

Nice Runs

Cincinnati is 17-3 since the start of the 2018 season. SMU is 14-4 in its last 18 games. UCF is 31-3 since the start of the 2017 season.

Best In Class

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell is ranked seventh nationally in rushing at 122.4 yards per game. Temple RB Re'Mahn Davis is averaging 81.9 yards per game. Gainwell and Davis are the two leading freshmen nationally in terms of rushing yards.

Malcolm In The Mid

Navy QB Malcolm Perry leads all quarterbacks in rushing at 133.4 yards per game. Oklahoma's Jalen Hurts is second at 100.1 ypg. Perry ranks third among all FBS players in rushing trailing only Oklahoma State's Chuba Hubbard (1726 ypg) and Ohio State's J.K. Dobbins (138.8 ypg).

The 2019 Championship

The 2019 American Athletic Conference Football Championship will be played Saturday, Dec. 7, at 3:30 p.m. ET and will be televised nationally on ABC for the fifth consecutive season.



The championship will be played between the champions of the East and West divisions, based on the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The site of the championship will be the home venue of the division winner with the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The following tiebreakers are in place for the 2019 season.

Two-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

- Head-to-head result
- Divisional winning percentage
- Head-to-head results within the division against the team with the next best conference winning percentage, in descending order
- Winning percentage against common non-divisional conference opponents
- College Football Playoff Selection Committee rankings, provided that team wins in the final weekend of the regular season. If the higher-ranked team loses in the final weekend, then a composite average of computer rankings will determine the divisional champion.
- Overall winning percentage, excluding exempt games
- Coin toss

Multiple-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

The following is used to eliminate teams until two teams remain, at which point the two-team tiebreaker is used

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Rob Mullens (chair), Frank Beamer, Paola Boivin, Jeff Bower, Joe Castiglione, Herb Deromedi, Ken Hatfield, Chris Howard, Bobby Johnson, Ronnie Lott, Gene Smith, Todd Stansbury, and Scott Stricklin.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The **Military Bowl presented by Northrop Grumman** takes place at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in Annapolis, Maryland, while the events and activities surrounding the game are based in Washington, D.C. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2019.

The **Birmingham Bowl** takes place at Legion Field in Birmingham, Alabama. The American/Big East has partnered with the bowl since its inception in the 2006 season. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Southeastern Conference.

The **Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl** is played at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa, Florida. Conference USA will provide the opponent for The American's team in the 2019 season.

The **Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl** began in 2014 and is played at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, Florida. The American representative will play a team from the Mid-American Conference in 2019.

The **Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl** will be played for the third time in 2019. An American Athletic Conference team will face an opponent to be determined at Toyota Stadium in Frisco, Texas.
