SEASON REVIEW



BEARCATS ROUND OUT DECADE IN STYLE

For just the fifth time in program history and the first time since 1995-96, Cincinnati won 25-plus games in back-to-back seasons after finishing 25-11 overall. UC capped off its season with its second straight trip to the NCAA Tournament and also posted a 12-0 record in Fifth Third Arena, marking the first time in program history UC went undefeated at home in consecutive seasons.

NIEMER NAMED AVCA ALL-AMERICAN

In the annual release of the American Volleyball Coaches Association Division I Volleyball All-American list, junior Stephanie Niemer earned AVCA Honorable Mention All-America honors for the first time in her career and marked the third year in a row that UC has placed a player on the AVCA All-America list. Niemer earned first-team all-conference and BIG EAST All-Tournament honors en route to becoming the 11th player in school history to eclipse 500 kills in a season with 541 on the campaign. Niemer concluded the season

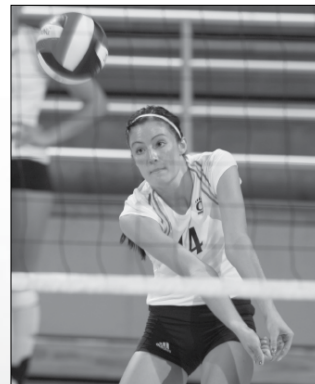
ranking third in the BIG EAST in kills per set (4.19), aces per set (0.41), and points per set (4.88). Niemer is the fourth player in program history to earn all-America honors joining Jessie Nevitt, Laura Lauder, and Julie DuPont, who was a third-team AVCA All-America selection in 2003.

NIEMER, HARPENAU EARN AVCA ALL-REGION HONORS

After helping the University of Cincinnati volleyball team advance to the NCAA

Tournament for the second year in a row, junior Stephanie Niemer sophomore Missy Harpenau earned American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) All-Region honors. Niemer was one of 14 players selected to the All-Northeast Region team, while Harpenau was one of six players to earn honorable mention Northeast Region honors. Niemer led the Bearcats in kills this season with 541, the sixth-highest single-season kills total in program history. Harpenau had a terrific all-around season and greatly improved her numbers from her freshman to sophomore campaigns.

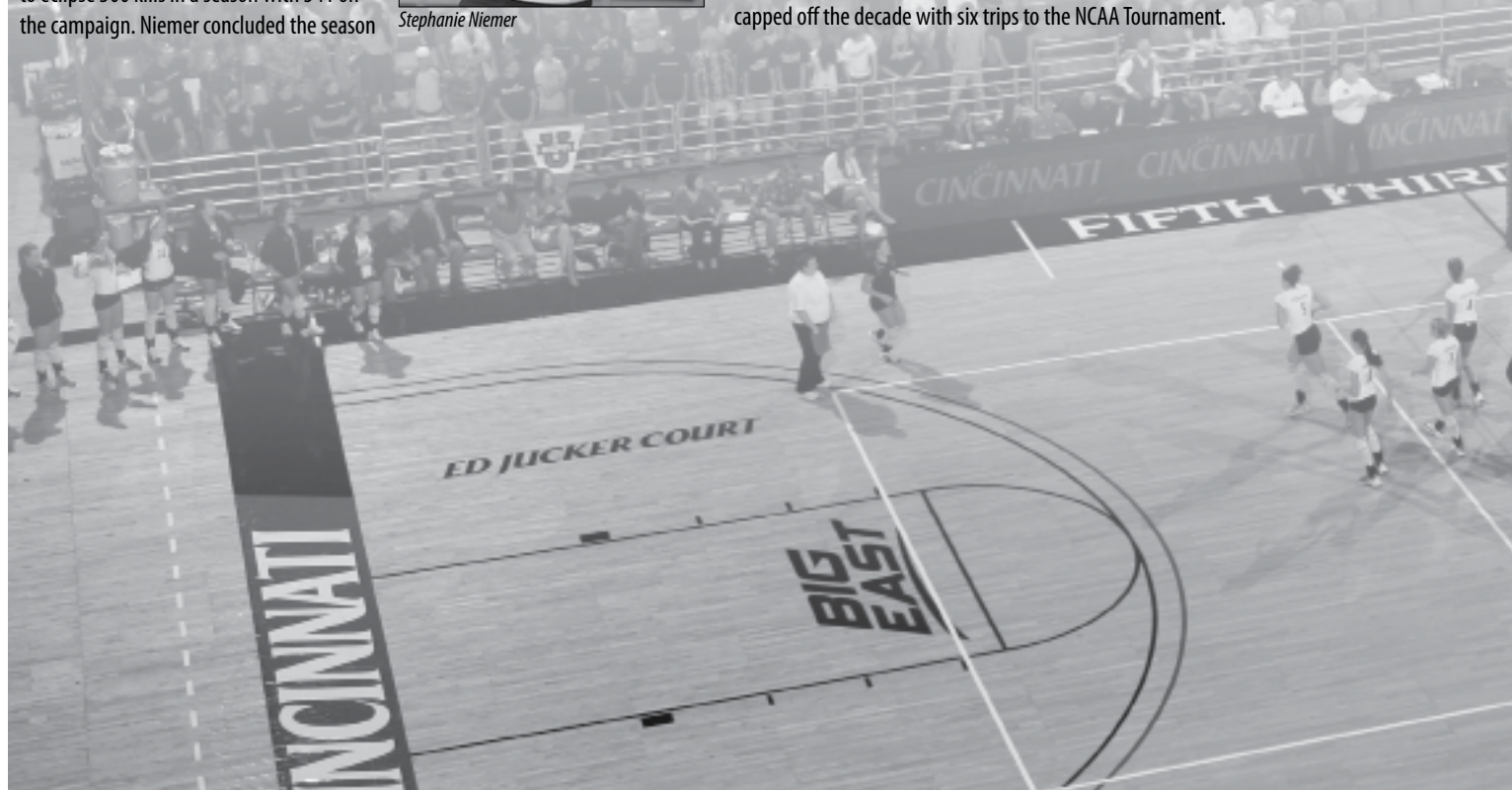
After finishing with 272 kills (2.23 kps), 301 digs (2.47 dps), and 41 aces in 2008, Harpenau finished the 2009 campaign with 375 kills (2.91 kps), 408 digs (3.16 dps), and 54 aces. Harpenau's 3.16 dps and 54 aces were tops on the squad, while her 2.91 kps average ranked second. The Cincinnati native was a second-team all-BIG EAST honoree.

BACK IN THE DANCE

Cincinnati made its second straight appearance in the NCAA Volleyball Tournament when the Bearcats took on Ohio State in Columbus, Ohio, in the opening round of the 2009 NCAA Tournament. UC fought to the end but fell short, 3-1, to the Buckeyes and capped off the decade with six trips to the NCAA Tournament.





PROGRAM FIRST

With wins over seventh-seeded Connecticut and sixth-seeded USF, Cincinnati advanced to the BIG EAST Volleyball Championship to face tournament host Louisville. The championship appearance marked the first for UC since joining the BIG EAST in 2005. Despite falling short, 3-1, in the finale televised on ESPNU, junior Stephanie Niemer and freshman Emily Hayden were named to the BIG EAST All-Tournament Team.

TRIO TAKES HOME ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

At the annual BIG EAST Volleyball banquet, juniors Annie Fesl and Stephanie Niemer, and sophomore Missy Harpenau were selected as all-conference performers. Niemer and Fesl were first-team all-BIG EAST selections, while Harpenau was a second-team selection. Niemer was a unanimous first-team selection and is now a three-time all-conference selection after earning first-team distinction last season and second-team honors in 2007. Fesl joined Niemer on the first team, marking the second year in a row that UC had two representatives earn first-team all-conference honors. For the first time in her career, Harpenau earned all-conference distinction after being named to the second team. Harpenau led the Bearcats with 16 kill-dig double-doubles and finished as the team leader in digs, while ranking second on the team in kills.

20-10

With a three-set win over USF on Sunday, Nov. 8, Cincinnati won its 20th game of the season, marking the ninth time that UC reached the 20-win plateau under the direction of head coach Reed Sunahara. UC finished 25-11 overall and posted a 12-2 BIG EAST record. The 12 conference wins equalled the most conference wins since joining the BIG EAST in 2005.

X-FACTOR

One of the keys to success for Cincinnati in 2009 was its serving. In wins, UC averaged 1.74 service aces per set compared to just 1.00 sa/s in losses. In its 25 wins, Cincinnati has collected 146 of the team's 191 service aces and the Bearcats recorded at least four service aces in 22 of its 25 wins. On the other hand, the Bearcats tallied fewer than four service aces in six of its 11 losses. In wins, junior Stephanie Niemer and sophomore Missy Harpenau combined for 84 of the team's 146 service aces (57.5 percent). Nationally, the duo of Harpenau and Niemer finished 37th and 41st, respectively, in service aces per set.

DEFENDING HOME

With a three-set wins over Miami (OH) on Nov. 28, Cincinnati extended its home winning streak to 28 matches. The previous school record for consecutive home wins was 23 matches, which spanned from Nov. 17, 2002 to Oct. 24, 2004. The Bearcats' home winning streak dates back to 2007 where Cincinnati won its final two home matches of the season, before going 14-0 in 2008 and 12-0 in 2009. The Bearcats own the second longest home winning streak in the country, trailing only back-to-back-to-back National Champions Penn State. Below are the three longest home winning streaks in the country entering 2010.

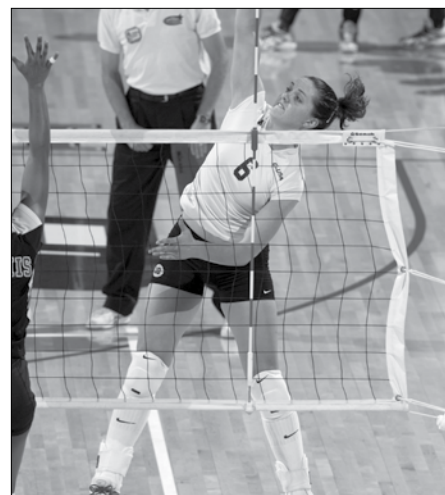
UC'S FIRST ALL-AMERICAN JULIE DUPONT

Julie DuPont's road to All-American status at Cincinnati began after a stellar prep career at Muskego (Wis.) High. Upon arriving at UC, DuPont spent her freshman year as both a middle blocker and right side hitter. But it was during DuPont's sophomore year with a move back to outside hitter that she began to flourish into one of Conference USA's premier players.

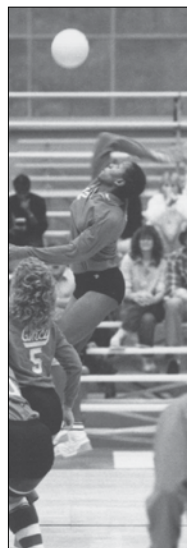
As a sophomore, DuPont showed a preview of things to come when she earned second-team all-conference honors. It was the 2003 season that DuPont really shined, however, as she won her first of two consecutive C-USA Player of the Year awards. During that same season, DuPont gave UC its first volleyball all-American when she was tabbed to the third team by the American Volleyball Coaches Association. One year later, DuPont was again honored by the AVCA as an honorable mention All-American, while taking her second C-USA Player of the Year award.

In addition to the individual honors, DuPont also contributed to the Bearcats' team success. During her career, UC posted a combined record of 95-34, went to the NCAA Tournament three times and won or shared two C-USA crowns. Off the court, DuPont was a three-time CoSIDA Academic All-American, including a first-team choice in 2004.

VOLLEYBALL REPRESENTED BY THREE IN UC ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME



Sonja Jackson (left) was inducted into the UC Athletics Hall of Fame in 2002. Jackson was the first Bearcat with 1,000 career kills and 1,000 career digs, while twice being named first-team all-conference.

UC'S FIRST THREE-TIME ALL-AMERICAN

In 2008, Jessie Nevitt capped off one of the finest careers in UC volleyball history by earning her third AVCA Honorable-Mention All-America Honor. Nevitt became the first player in program history to be named an all-American three times, and she

also became the first player in school history to earn four first-team all-conference honors. For her career, Nevitt finished with 1,498 career kills and 652 total blocks, becoming the second player in BIG EAST history to finish her career with at least 1,400 career kills and 600 total blocks. A staple in the UC record books, Nevitt ranks in the Top 10 on eight of Cincinnati's career charts.

PREISS, LADUSAW AMONG ALL-TIME NCAA STATISTICAL LEADERS



A pair of former Cincinnati greats in Lisa Preiss (1981-84) and Trish Ladusaw (1999-2002) are ranked among the NCAA all-time leaders in a pair of statistical categories.

Preiss is one of the NCAA's leaders in service aces per game. The four-year letterwinner connected on 180 aces over her final two seasons, spanning 152 games for an average

of 1.18 per game. She is the only player in NCAA history to average more than an ace per game. Although Preiss played four seasons at UC, aces and games played were not kept as statistics until 1983.

Ladusaw closed out her remarkable career having accumulated the third-most digs in NCAA history with 2,074, 706 behind all-time leader Kim Diehlmann of Hartford. Ladusaw also ranks among the Top-10 in digs per game with 4.38.

OLYMPIAN SHARON (MOORE) FURLONG

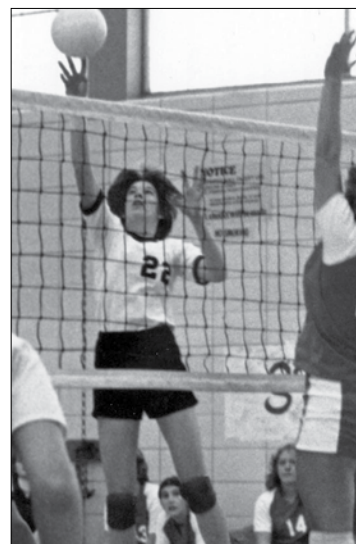
Sharon (Moore) Furlong raised the level of Cincinnati volleyball in her career with the Bearcats then stepped to greater heights to pursue her dream of being an Olympian. Furlong, a 5-11 hitter, concluded her Bearcat career after her junior year when she led UC to a 34-10 mark and a runner-up finish in the state tournament under head coach Georgeanne Green.

Furlong withdrew from UC on Dec. 27, 1976, and joined the U.S. squad in Pasadena, Texas, to begin training for the 1980 Olympic games. She trained with the national team for four years, helping the U.S. qualify for the Olympics in April of 1979 after finishing second to Cuba in the North, Central America and Caribbean Volleyball Championships in Havana, Cuba. Furlong's Olympic dream was dashed when the United States boycotted the 1980 Olympics in Moscow.

In 1981, Furlong returned to school at Indiana and graduated in 1984 with a B.S. in education. After graduation, she began a 12-year career in the Finneytown school district. She began teaching and coaching at Finneytown to pass on her dreams of success to future Olympic hopefuls.

Furlong was the head coach at Finneytown from 1984-1990, leading the team to five Cincinnati Hills League championships, three district titles, one regional championship and a state runner-up finish in 1990. She acted as an assistant coach at Mount Saint Joseph from 1991-93 and is frequently consulted for her volleyball knowledge.

"UC was my first intense experience in training for volleyball. Back then, we worked hard simply for the love of the game because we had no scholarships. We were there because we wanted to be. I've stayed in touch with the program at UC, and it's a treat to watch the program turn around, especially by bringing in the local athletes." —Sharon (Moore) Furlong.
