## WEEKLY HONORS

### OFFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

**McKenzie Milton • So. • QB • UCF • Kapolei, Hawaii**

Milton completed 16 of 23 passes for 208 yards and four touchdowns and added a rushing touchdown before coming out of the game late in the third quarter of a 45-19 win against Temple, clinching at least a tie for first place in The American's East Division. Milton engineered scoring drives on seven of 10 possessions.

**Trevon Brown • Jr. • WR • ECU • Wilmington, N.C.**

Brown set ECU's and The American's single-game record for receiving yards as he had nine catches for 270 yards and two touchdowns in a 48-20 win against Cincinnati. Brown matched his own conference record with a 95-yard touchdown catch to start the third quarter, one of five receptions of at least 20 yards on the day. His 270-yard effort ranks second among NCAA FBS players this season.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**Auggie Sanchez • Sr. • LB • USF • St. Petersburg, Fla.**

Sanchez matched his career high with 14 tackles, including a sack and 3.0 tackles for loss, to lead USF to a 27-20 win against Tulsa. Sanchez, who moved into third place on The American's career tackles chart, finished the game with a USF career-record 378 tackles.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**Emilio Nadelman • Sr. • K • USF • Miami, Fla.**

Nadelman scored nine points, going 2-for-2 on field goals with three PATs, in USF's 27-20 win against Tulsa. Both of Nadelman's field goals came in the second half as he connected from 41 and 48 yards and set USF's single-season record with his 19th and 20th field goals of the season.

## One Half Of The Equation

Memphis has clinched The American's West Division title and will play in The American Football Championship for the first time.

## For All The Marbles

The American's East Division title will be decided Friday, as USF visits UCF. UCF holds a one-game lead in the standings, but a win by the Bulls would forge a tie atop the standings and give USF the head-to-head tiebreaker.

## New Blood

The 2017 American Football Championship will feature two teams that have not previously played in the title game. Temple had won the East Division in each of the first two years of the conference's divisional format, while Houston and Navy have represented the West Division.

## The One And Only

The American Athletic Conference is the only NCAA FBS conference that has three teams with one loss or fewer.

## Playing The Percentages

The American Athletic Conference ranks sixth among the 10 NCAA FBS conferences in nonconference winning percentage in 2017 (through Nov. 18).

UCF is one of four remaining unbeaten teams nationally. The Knights, at 10-0, join Alabama (11-0), Miami (Fla.) (10-0) and Wisconsin (11-0) as the FBS teams without a loss in 2017.

## You Make Many Good Points

UCF leads the nation in scoring offense, averaging 48.2 points per game.

## Caretakers

Three American Athletic Conference teams rank among the top 10 nationally in turnover margin. UCF leads the nation at 1.60, while USF is fifth (1.10) and SMU is sixth (1.09).

## We'll Take That

USF is second in the nation with 17 defensive interceptions, one shy of the national lead (Florida Atlantic).

## New Territory

UCF is 10-0 for the first time in program history.

## Play On

SMU has clinched bowl eligibility for the first time since the 2012 season.

## Reception Quality

SMU WR Trey Quinn is the national leader in receptions per game (9.1).

## Many Happy Returns

Memphis WR Tony Pollard has scored three touchdowns on kickoff returns this season and has five TDs on kickoff returns in the last two seasons. Pollard is one of three players nationally with three TDs on kickoffs this season.

## This Goes To 11

Memphis WR Anthony Miller has 13 touchdown receptions each this season, trailing only West Virginia's David Stills (18) for the national lead.

## Multiplicity

The American has had at least three teams ranked in the same week 14 times in its history as of Nov. 12. The American had a record four teams ranked in the polls of Nov. 15, 2015.

USF head coach Charlie Strong is a combined 21-2 as an American Athletic Conference coach. Strong went 12-1 with Louisville in the 2013 season when the Cardinals were members of the conference and is 9-1 with USF.

## Body Of Work

USF LB Auggie Sanchez is ranked fourth among active FBS players in career tackles (374). Tulane CB Parry Nickerson leads all active FBS players with 15 career interceptions, while UConn CB Jamar Summers is sixth with 12 career picks. Memphis WR Anthony Miller is fourth in receptions (217) and receiving yards (3,196).

## December Plans

Six American Athletic Conference teams have clinched bowl eligibility in 2017. USF, UCF, Houston, Memphis, Navy and SMU have assured themselves of postseason play thus far.

## Perfect 10

# COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

## Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

## Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

## Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

## Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

## Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

## Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Kirby Hocutt (chair), Frank Beamer, Jeff Bower, Herb Deromedi, Chris Howard, Tom Jernstedt, Bobby Johnson, Jeff Long, Rob Mullens, Dan Radakovich, Gene Smith, Steve Wieberg and Tyrone Willingham.

## Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

## Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

# BOWL PARTNERSHIPS

## The American Bowl Lineup

In addition to the College Football Playoff and New Year's Bowls, The American will have either a primary or secondary affiliation with 12 bowl games during its current six-year bowl cycle. The American works annually with its member schools and bowl partners to create the most sensible and attractive postseason matchups.

The **Military Bowl presented by Northrop Grumman** takes place at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in Annapolis, Maryland, while the events and activities surrounding the game are based in Washington, D.C. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference each year in the current cycle.

The **Birmingham Bowl** takes place at Legion Field in Birmingham, Alabama. The American/Big East has partnered with the bowl since its inception in the 2006 season. The American Athletic Conference will annually face an opponent from the Southeastern Conference.

The **Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl** is played at Tropicana Field in St. Petersburg, Florida. The American Athletic Conference will supply a team to the bowl during each year of the six-year cycle. Conference USA will play in the game in 2015, 2017 and 2019, while the Atlantic Coast Conference provides the opposing team in 2014, 2016 and 2018.

The **Boca Raton Bowl** began in 2014 and will feature an American Athletic Conference team three times during the six-year cycle at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, Florida. The American representative will play a team from either the Mid-American Conference or Conference USA in 2016.

The **DXL Frisco Bowl** will be played for the first time in 2017 as the former Miami Beach Bowl was relocated to Toyota Stadium in Frisco, Texas. An American Athletic Conference plays in the bowl each year.

The **Hawai'i Bowl** is played on Hawaiian Airlines Field at Aloha Stadium on the campus of the University of Hawaii. The American Athletic Conference will participate in the bowl in 2015, 2017 and 2019, facing an opponent from the Mountain West.

The **AutoNation Cure Bowl** made its debut in 2015 at the newly renovated Citrus Bowl in Orlando, Florida. An American Athletic Conference team will be paired against an opponent from the Sun Belt Conference. Net proceeds from the game will benefit the Breast Cancer Research Foundation.

The **Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl** is played at Amon G. Carter Stadium on the campus of Texas Christian University. The American Athletic Conference sends a team to the bowl in 2014, 2016 and 2018. The opponent will be a Big 12 team in 2016 and 2018, with Conference USA as a secondary affiliation.

The **Bahamas Bowl** is played in at Thomas A. Robinson Stadium in Nassau, Bahamas. The American Athletic Conference will face the Mid-American Conference or Conference USA in 2016 and 2018.

The **RSL Carriers New Orleans Bowl** is held at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome in New Orleans. The American Athletic Conference has agreed to play in the bowl in 2018 and 2019.

In addition to the conference's primary bowl affiliations, The American holds secondary partnerships with the **AutoZone Liberty Bowl** in Memphis, Tennessee, and the **Independence Bowl** in Shreveport, Louisiana, as well as with other ESPN-owned bowls.
