A LOOK AT THE 2011 SCHEDULE

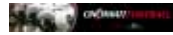
- UC will play its 124th football season in 2011.
- The Bearcats travel to Tennessee and Miami (OH) in non-conference play. UC will welcome Akron, Austin Peay, and NC State to Nippert Stadium.
- UC last faced Tennessee in 1992 and Austin Peay in 1993. It is the sixth meeting with Akron, second with NC State, and 116th with Miami (OH).
- In BIG EAST Conference play, UC, winners of two of the last three conference titles, will have home games against Connecticut, Louisville, and West Virginia while facing road tests at Pittsburgh, Rutgers, Syracuse, and USF.

Entered the starting lineup for the second game of 2009 and started the final 12 games at linebacker ... second on the team with 100 tackles, ranking eighth in the BIG EAST Conference ... set a career best with 14 tackles against Illinois and added his second double-digit tackle game with 10 against Florida in the Allstate Sugar Bowl ... added 5.5 TFL, 3 INT, 3 PBU, and 1.5 sacks.

STREAKS, STORYLINES, SIDEBARS

- The University of Cincinnati wrapped its 123rd football season with an all-time record of 551-550-51 (.502).
- Cincinnati (1885) is one of the five oldest programs in college football along with Rutgers (1869), Michigan (1879), Navy (1880), and Minnesota (1883).
- UC had seven new starters on defense and four on offense this season. UC has 63 players at sophomore level or below.
- The Bearcats started eight sophomores on defense and no seniors, making UC the youngest defensive unit among all BCS Conference teams in 2010.
- UC's 4-8 mark is its worst record since 2005, the same year the Bearcats last missed a bowl game.
- UC had seven student-athletes earn all-BIG EAST honors, including first-teamers Armon Binns and Zach Collaros.
- Collaros made 11 starts, missing one game due to injury, and was 225-of-383 for 2,902 yards and 26 touchdowns. He led the BIG EAST in passing yards per game (263.8), total passing yards (2,902), and total offense (282.2).
- Binns led the league in both receptions per game (6.2) and receiving yards per game (91.8). He caught 75 balls for 1,101

yards and a team-high 10 touchdowns. Binns became just the seventh UC receiver to eclipse the 1,000-yard mark.

- Ben Guidugli, Jason Kelce, Isaiah Pead, J.K. Schaffer, and D.J. Woods were named to the second team.
- Guidugli was the fifth-leading receiver on the squad, catching 24 balls for 197 yards and a pair of touchdowns.
- Kelce made the switch to center from guard late in camp and did not miss a beat, making 11 starts and helping pave the way for UC's first 1,000-yard rusher since 2004, Pead.
- Pead rushed for 1,029 yards and six touchdowns on 157 attempts, despite missing almost two full games due to injury. He ranked third in the league in rushing, but led the conference for the second-straight year with his 6.6 ypc avg.
- Schaffer led the defense with his 111 tackles and 67 solo stops. It was his second-straight 100-tackle campaign
- Woods was second on the team with 57 receptions for 898 yards and eight TDs. He was second in the BIG EAST in receiving yards (74.8 ypg) and third in receptions (5.3 rpg).
- Kicker Jacob Rogers recently became the school's all-time scoring leader and has 335 career points.

FRESNO, Calif. (AP) - The University of Cincinnati football team scored the first 14 points of the game but could not hold on, surrendering 28 unanswered points to Fresno State, dropping its season opener by a 28-14 margin.

Fresno State ended Cincinnati's 18-game regular-season winning streak, a 10-game road streak, and a run of five-straight wins in season opening games.

Fresno's Ryan Colburn connected for four touchdowns to help the Bulldogs overcome an early 14-0 deficit and hand Butch Jones a loss in his first game as Cincinnati's coach.

Held to one first down on their first seven drives, the Bulldogs scored touchdowns on their next three, taking a 21-14 lead early in the third quarter on Colburn's 28-yard pass to Devon Wylie. The turnaround came one play after they converted a fourth-and-2 with a short pass to Tapa Taumoepeau.

The turnaround was just as stark on the other side of the ball as the Bearcats were held to minus-6 yards in a span of more than 22 minutes after taking a 14-0 lead on Zach Collaros' touchdown run early in the second quarter.

The Bulldogs sacked Collaros on three successive plays on UC's first drive of the fourth quarter as the Bearcats offense struggled to find a rhythm. Collaros completed 24 of 41 passes for 219 yards, throwing for one touchdown and running for another, but he was sacked eight times.

The Bearcats were held to 15 yards rushing in their first regular-season loss since a 40-16 defeat at Connecticut on Oct. 25, 2008.

The Bearcats got off to the early lead, getting a 23-yard TD pass from Collaros to D.J. Woods following an interception by Pat Lambert. Collaros' 5-yard run early in the second quarter made it 14-0. At that point, Cincinnati had outgained Fresno State 195-8 and had two more touchdowns than the Bulldogs had first downs.

CINCINNATI (AP) - Zach Collaros threw for two touchdowns and ran for another, and Cincinnati's offense found its legs in the second half, pulling away to a 40-7 victory over Indiana State.

The Bearcats (1-1) led 12-7 at the half, overcoming some early offensive struggles. Collaros directed Cincinnati to touchdowns on all four of its drives in the third quarter.

The two-time defending Big East champions improved to 13-0 at home over the last three seasons, two shy of the school record for consecutive home wins.

Collaros finished 11 of 17 for 130 yards. He also scrambled for 32 yards as Cincinnati's running game got on track. Sophomore Darrin Williams started in place of Isaiah Pead, out with a sore knee, and ran for 117 yards. John Goebel had two short touchdown runs in the third quarter.

Collaros had more time to throw but still struggled to complete anything more than a short pass in the first half, when he went 8 of 13 for 70 yards with one sack.

The Bearcats headed for the locker room at halftime up 12-7. They'd managed only 150 yards, and two of their points came on a safety.

It was Cincinnati's first game without receiver Vidal Hazelton, who tore up his left knee at Fresno State. Hazelton was one of Cincinnati's best downfield threats, expected to replace the departed Mardy Gilyard as a playmaker.

Something was missing.

Collaros put a spark in the offense by doing a lot of it himself. He scrambled for three straight first downs, then hit Armon Binns down the left sideline for a 29-yard touchdown that made it 26-7. The Sycamores helped Cincinnati pull away, fumbling at their own 10-yard line to set up another score.

RALEIGH, N.C. - Playing its third game in 12 days, the University of Cincinnati football team fell to NC State in a 30-19 contest at Carter-Finley Stadium.

Cincinnati (1-2) didn't run a play inside the N.C. State 32 until the final minutes, but the Wolfpack had a big lead by that point. Zach Collaros connected with D.J. Woods twice for touchdowns, the first from 68 yards late in the first half.

The Bearcats dropped their season opener on the west coast at Fresno State before getting back in the win column against Indiana State last week at home. The road does not get easier for first-year head coach Butch Jones next week as the University of Oklahoma comes rolling into Cincinnati.

The Wolfpack's Russell Wilson completed 26 of 40 passes, including an 8-yard touchdown strike to Taylor Gentry with about 7 1/2 minutes left to make it 30-7.

Jay Smith and Curtis Underwood Jr. had first-half touchdown catches, and Mustafa Greene had a 31-yard scoring run that gave N.C. State a 14-0 lead in the first quarter.

While Wilson had the offense going, N.C. State's defense did its part, too. The Wolfpack finished with five sacks, hurried Collaros four times and notched a fourth-and-1 stop early in the fourth quarter. N.C. State also blocked a punt to set up Gentry's touchdown catch.

UC's J.K. Schaffer was all over the field and set a career high with 16 tackles. Safety Wesley Richardson also had a career night with seven tackles and a pair of fumble recoveries. Linebacker Maalik Bomar continued the strong start to his season, racking up a career-best eight tackles.

Collaros finished the night 19-of-31 for 310 yards and three touchdowns. He was sacked five times. Woods finished a career-night with six catches for 146 yards and a pair of touchdowns. Marcus Barnett caught five balls for 61 yards and his first touchdown of the season. Barnett moved into the starting lineup last week, replacing Vidal Hazelton, who was lost for the season to a knee injury.

CINCINNATI (AP) - The University of Cincinnati football team scored 17 fourth-quarter points but the eighth-ranked Sooners withstood a late Bearcats rally for a 31-29 win that kept them unbeaten.

Landry Jones ran an Oklahoma offense, throwing for 370 yards and two touchdowns.

Oklahoma (4-0) did a little of everything behind its sophomore quarterback, who completed a career-high 36 passes in 51 attempts with one interception. Ryan Broyles had his seventh straight 100-yard receiving game.

Jones' only interception helped Cincinnati (1-3) make a late charge. Zach Collaros followed with a 36-yard touchdown pass to D.J. Woods that cut it to 24-22 with 9:45 left.

Woods then fumbled a punt at Cincinnati's 7, setting up Jones' clinching touchdown pass.

Woods also fumbled at the 5-yard line at the end of a long run-and-catch in the first half, part of a self-destructive showing by the two-time defending Big East champions.

Collaros led a touchdown drive in the closing minutes against a defense willing to trade yards for time, throwing his third touchdown pass with 58 seconds left. Broyles recovered the onside kick to seal it. Collaros finished 23 of 38 for 305 yards. He also threw an interception in the end zone - his first this season - and fumbled.

Cincinnati drove to a first-and-goal at the 2 on its opening drive, but had to settle for a field goal, starting some grumbling in the less-than-capacity crowd of 58,253 at Paul Brown Stadium.

Collaros got the offense moving better than it had all season. Woods had a career-high 171 yards on seven catches, and Isaiah Pead ran for 169 yards.

Jacob Rogers, kicking with a foot injury, connected on three field goals from 22 yards and twice from 43 yards.

Linebacker JK Schaffer finished with a team-high 13 tackles.

CINCINNATI - The two-time defending BIG EAST champions got their swagger back just in time.

Zach Collaros threw three touchdown passes - two of them long strikes to Armon Binns - and Isaiah Pead had a pair of long runs during Cincinnati's big first half, sending the Bearcats to a 45-3 victory over local rival Miami (OH).

The Bearcats (2-3) were determined to build on their momentum from a close loss to No. 6 Oklahoma. A quick-strike offense sent Cincinnati into conference play with plenty of momentum.

Collaros threw a 48-yard touchdown pass to Binns down the left sideline on the game's second play, setting the tone. He also threw a 32-yarder to Binns down the other sideline as Cincinnati pulled ahead 45-3 in the first half. Collaros finished 14 of 17 for 216 yards, leaving midway through the third quarter.

The Bearcats' balance was their best asset.

Pead broke a career-best 80-yard touchdown run and a 69-yard run that set up another score, carrying 10 times for 197 yards. Pead, who missed most of two games because of a knee injury, returned against Oklahoma and ran for 169 yards.

Miami (3-3) lost to its southwest Ohio rival for the fifth year in a row. The RedHawks gave up 28 points in the first quarter, its worst quarter since 2002.

Pead had two scintillating runs. On his 80-yard score, he found a hole and made two full-speed cuts before outrunning Miami's defensive backfield. On his 69-yard run, he made two cutbacks and pushed one defender out of his way to keep going.

LOUISVILLE (AP) - Zach Collaros threw a career-high five touchdown passes--three to Armon Binns--and Cincinnati overcame the loss of another receiver, beating Louisville 35-27 in its BIG EAST opener.

The two-time defending champs lost receiver D.J. Woods to a concussion after his second touchdown catch in the third quarter. Cincinnati (3-3) already was short-handed at receiver with Vidal Hazelton's season-ending knee injury.

Binns' 62-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter decided a game of try-to-top-this plays. He also scored on catches of 47 and 10 yards in the best game of his career. Collaros was 18 of 28 for 275 yards with a pair of interceptions.

Bilal Powell ran for a career-high 209 yards and two touchdowns, keeping Louisville (3-3) in the game. He had an electrifying 85-yard touchdown run that helped the Cardinals take a 24-21 lead into halftime.

Out of timeouts, Louisville went for it on fourth-and-goal from the 12 with 4:20 left. Adam Froman's pass was broken up by Camerion Cheatham and Cincinnati ran out the clock.

The Ohio River rivalry - a keg of nails goes to the winner - got off to a raucous start and never slowed down.

Collaros rolled right and saw Woods running several yards beyond the coverage for a 47-yard touchdown on Cincinnati's first play. In the end zone, Woods got a 15-yard penalty for going face-to-face and talking trash at safety Shenard Holton - just the start of a lot of jawing and shoving throughout.

Nothing tricky about Cincinnati's passing game. Receivers ran past defenders for their big plays.

Collaros' 14-yard touchdown pass to Woods put Cincinnati ahead 28-24. Woods' head slammed on the ground after a hard hit in the end zone, his helmet rolling off, and he was slow getting up.

Binns made the final big play, beating cornerback Bobby Burns for his 62-yard catch.

CINCINNATI - Zach Collaros threw three touchdown passes, going 30 of 53--both career highs--for 463 yards but it was not enough as a late rally came up short and UC fell 38-30 to USF.

B.J. Daniels got the Bulls going by completing one long pass after another against Cincinnati's defense. The Bearcats (3-4, 1-1) have the youngest defense in the BCS, starting eight sophomores.

Daniels' 64-yard completion to Dontavia Bogan set up a third-quarter touchdown, and his 70-yard pass to Faron Hornes put the Bulls up 31-16 late in the third quarter. Daniels finished 13 of 16 for 286 yards without an interception.

The Bearcats had won 13 straight Big East games, tied for third-longest streak in league history. They hadn't lost at Nippert Stadium since 2008.

The Bearcats put themselves in position for one final shot to pull it out.

Collaros took a hard hit and was on the sideline with a leg injury for Cincinnati's final drive, which ended with Chazz Anderson's incompletion from the Bulls 15-yard line with 7 seconds remaining.

The Bearcats self-destructed with dropped throws and 12 penalties for 115 yards.

Cincinnati's inexperienced defense--eight sophomore starters, no seniors-- had only two interceptions all season and was looking for a breakout game against Daniels. Sophomore safety Drew Frey stepped in front of a receiver on Daniels' first pass, but lost the ball as he hit the ground.

South Florida's defense made a pivotal stop, stopping Collaros on a fourth-and-1 from the Bulls 30-yard line late in the third quarter.

Collaros' 15-yard touchdown pass to Armon Binns cut it to 38-30 with 5:35 left, but the quarterback was hit hard and went to be evaluated for a leg injury. The Bearcats got the ball back at their 29-yard line with 3:25 remaining and drove to the 15, where Anderson threw one away while getting sacked on fourth down.

CINCINNATI - The University of Cincinnati football team turned the ball over three times and dropped a 31-7 decision to Syracuse on Homecoming at Nippert Stadium.

Cincinnati (3-5, 1-2 BIG EAST Conference) was without started quarterback Zach Collaros, who missed his first career game due to injury.

Junior Chazz Anderson made his first start since 2008 and finished the game 18-for-31 with 148 yards, one touchdown and one interception. He also added a team-high 66 yards rushing. Collaros, who bruised his left knee during UC's loss to USF, tried to warm up, but was not able to go. The junior was on the UC sideline in sweats and a headset doing his best to contribute.

Anderson connected with D.J. Woods on his lone touchdown of the day, a 33-yard strike over the middle that Woods took to the end zone. It was Woods' seventh TD of the season and the first passing TD for Anderson since Oct. 3, 2008 at Marshall.

The three Bearcats turnovers, two of which occurred in the red zone, led to 17 points for the Orange (6-2, 3-1 BIG EAST). Orange QB Ryan Nassib threw a pair of touchdown passes, going 16-of-26 for 125 yards and an interception. Delone Carter helped the cause with his 109 yard effort on 19 carries.

UC's defense sacked Nassib four times and tallied an interception and a fumble recovery. Sophomore Walter Stewart finished with a career best 13 tackles. Junior J.K. Schaffer added nine stops, two tackles for a loss, a sack, forced fumble, and a pass break up.

MORGANTOWN, W.Va.- BIG EAST Conference passing leader Zach Collaros returned after missing a game due to a knee injury but his return was not enough to spark the University of Cincinnati as the Bearcats dropped their third-straight game, 37-10, to West Virginia at Milan Puskar Stadium.

Collaros, who suffered a knee injury against South Florida was 25-of-45 for 221 yards and two interceptions, but did not connect on a touchdown for the first time in 13 career starts.

West Virginia (6-3, 2-2 BIG EAST) broke a two-game losing skid and Geno Smith threw four first-half touchdown passes as the Mountaineers took advantage of some early Cincinnati miscues to lead 30-3 at the half. Smith finished the game 15 of 25 for 174 yards. He threw two TD passes apiece to Taven Austin and Jock Sanders.

Cincinnati (3-6, 1-3) was snake bitten early in the game. After a defensive three-and-out on the first series, the ensuing WVU punt ended up in the Mountaineers hands after the officials ruled the ball hit Munchie Legaux, who was blocked back into returner D.J. Woods. WVU scored a few plays later and never looked back. Replays later showed the ball hit a WVU player first but the call was not reviewed.

UC has been vexed by turnovers in 2010 with 13 turnovers in the team's seven losses and only four in its three wins. The Bearcats have lost three straight games for the first time since the 2005 season. The Bearcats closed that year by dropping three consecutive games from Nov. 9 to Nov. 26. UC is 44-17 since 2006. The loss snapped UC's seven-game BIG EAST Conference road winning streak, dating back to Oct. 25, 2008, a loss at Connecticut.

JK Schaffer tied a career high with 16 tackles. He had nine solo stops, seven assists, a tackle for a loss, and forced fumble. Armon Binns finished with 10 catches for 115 yards, his fourth 100-yard receiving game of the season and the seventh for his career.

CINCINNATI - Isaiah Pead scored a career-high five touchdowns - four running, one receiving - and Cincinnati's offense put together a bevy of big plays on Saturday night, beating Rutgers 69-38 in the highest-scoring game in Big East history.

The Bearcats (4-6, 2-3) piled up 41 points in the first half alone and finished tied for third-most points in school history. Pead had a career-high 213 yards on 31 carries, becoming the first Bearcat to run for 200 yards since 2004.

Zach Collaros was 23 of 39 for 366 yards, throwing for four touchdowns and running for another. The Bearcats gained 661 yards, the second-most in school history.

Pead paced Cincinnati with touchdown runs of 24, 9 and 24 yards. He also caught a 34-yard pass for Cincinnati's first score.

Collaros stood his ground against a heavy pass rush and threw a 34-yard touchdown to Pead down the right sideline on the Bearcats' first drive. Pead ran 24 yards for a touchdown on the Bearcats' next possession, putting Cincinnati ahead to stay, then pitched to receiver D.J. Woods on a reverse for a 9-yard touchdown.

No matter what type of defense Rutgers played, Cincinnati found a hole in it. Usually, a big one.

Pead's 9-yard touchdown leap - he soared over the pylon and the line judge got bowled over, signaling a touchdown from his knees - highlighted the wide-open half. It ended with another Cincinnati flourish. Collaros led the Bearcats 62 yards in only 33 seconds, hitting Woods with a 16-yard touchdown pass with 5 seconds to go.

EAST HARTFORD, Conn. - Zach Collaros threw for a touchdown and ran for another Saturday, but it was not enough as Cincinnati dropped a 38-17 decision to Connecticut at Rentschler Field.

Collaros threw for 288 yards and ran for 84 yards in the loss for the Bearcats (4-7, 2-4 BIG EAST), but also had four interceptions.

Connecticut's Jordan Todman ran for 175 yards and three touchdowns. UConn capped a 14-point swing just before halftime as defensive lineman Kendall Reyes had a key interception deep in Husky territory just before halftime, setting up a 1-yard Todman touchdown run that made it 24-10 UConn.

The Bearcats pulled within one score in the game's closing minutes but could not overcome its five turnovers on the day. Todman, who carried the ball 31 times, scored twice more in the fourth quarter to put the game away. Collaros engineered an 8 play 88 yard touchdown drive to make it 24-17. He was helped by three pass interference penalties on UConn's Dwayne Gratz.

Armon Binns caught nine balls for 107 yards and a touchdown for the Bearcats. He became the eighth UC receiver all time to eclipse the 1,000-yard mark in a single season.

A week after putting up 69 points and 661 yards on Rutgers, Cincinnati had 399 yards in this one, but just 111 on the ground.

UConn quarterback Zach Frazer was 11-of-24 for 121 yards, with a touchdown and one interception.

Late in the second quarter, with the Huskies up 17-10, Cincinnati drove to the UConn 6-yard line. But Reyes batted a Collaros pass and grabbed it out of the air. His 84-yard return was called back to the Cincinnati 15 on a blocking penalty.

Collaros scrambled out of trouble and found Binns on a 15-yard touchdown pass that cut UConn's lead to 14-10 midway through the second quarter.
