GAMEDAY INFORMATION

Senior Jordanne Scott was selected as a unanimous pick to the 2012 All-BIG EAST First Team by a vote of the league's head coaches. Scott finished the season ranked second in the BIG EAST with 4.40 kills/set and second with 4.84 points/set.

Seniors Emily Hayden and Becca Refenes and junior Emily MacIntyre were all selected to the All-BIG EAST Second Team.

Senior Megan Turner was named to the BIG EAST Championship All-Tournament team after averaging 2.75 kills/set and a .500 hitting percentage in two matches at the BIG EAST Championship.

STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

- Senior Jordanne Scott has recorded double-digit kills in all but four matches this season. Overall, Scott has hit in double digits in 43 of the last 47 matches, dating back to Oct. 18, 2011 vs. Western Kentucky. Scott set a career-high with 30 kills on Nov. 16 against No. 4 seed UConn in the first round of the BIG EAST Championship.
- In BIG EAST matches, Cincinnati finished fifth with a .234 hitting percentage, fifth with 12.63 assists/set, fourth with 13.49 kills/set and seventh with 15.79 digs/set.

- In BIG EAST matches, Emily Hayden ranked fourth with a .351 hitting percentage. Jordanne Scott ranks second with 4.39 kills/set, Rachel Rohlf ranks fourth with 10.27 assists/set, and Emily MacIntyre ranks third with 5.74 digs/set.
- Jordanne Scott's 30 kills in the quarterfinal round of the BIG EAST Championship against No. 4 seed UConn ranks second in the conference tournament record book. The record of 31 kills was set by Marquette's Kimberly Todd in 2006. Scott is tied with Syracuse's Dana Fiume, who had 30 kills in 1999.

BEARCATS IN THE RECORD BOOK

Four current players are ranked among the program's elite in 10 different career statistical categories.

- Senior Emily Hayden is sixth in career hitting percentage with a .309 mark.
- Junior Emily MacIntyre sits at second in the record book with a 4.25 career digs per set clip and ranks third with 1,561 career digs. She also is on track to break the record for digs/set in a season with 5.26 and will currently rank second with 568 digs in 2012.
- Senior Becca Refenes is currently in sixth with 409 block assists. She also has 465 career blocks to put her at ninth. Refenes has played in 138 matches to rank second and 487 career sets to rank her seventh.
- Senior Jordanne Scott has recorded 1,605 career kills to rank her fifth in program history. She also ranks eighth with 3,599 total attempts and 10th with a 3.26 kills/set average. She has registered 341 block assists to rank ninth. Her 138 matches played rank her second while her 492 sets played rank her fourth. Scott also is on track to rank ninth with 4.37 kills/set during the 2012 season.

BIG EAST HONORS FOR THE BEARCATS

At the 2012 BIG EAST Championship banquet on Thurs., Nov. 15, four Bearcats were given BIG EAST honors. Senior Jordanne Scott was unanimously selected to the All-BIG EAST First Team, making her second straight appearance on the first team (she was also picked in 2011). Seniors Emily Hayden and Becca Refenes along with junior Emily MacIntyre were all chosen to the All-BIG EAST Second Team. It was the first conference honor for all three.

SCOTT SHINES

Jordanne Scott recorded 30 kills on Nov. 16 in the quarterfinal round of the BIG EAST Championship against No. 4 seed UConn. The senior set a new career high while also falling one shy of tying the BIG EAST Championship record. In 2006, Marquette's Kimberly Todd has 31 kills against Louisville. Scott is tied with Dana Fiume of Syracuse who hit 30 kills against Providence in 1999.

MAC'S MOMENT

On Sept. 15, Emily MacIntyre recorded 38 digs against No. 23 Illinois during the Time Warner Cable Texas Invitational. The total is a new program record for the Bearcats for digs in a match. The previous record was 37 digs set by Jaime Frey on Nov. 17, 2007 against Notre Dame. The mark is also a record for digs in a four-set match (Frey's 37 was set during a five-set match). It also is a new career high for the junior, besting her previous high of 34 set on Nov. 13, 2011 at Villanova.

MACINTYRE 1K

During the first match of the season (a 3-0 loss to No. 10 Iowa State), junior Emily MacIntyre recorded her 1,000th career dig for the Bearcats. The defensive specialist ranks third in the record book with 3.80 digs/set and also ranks tenth with 1,111 total digs.

SCOTT SUPERIOR

Jordanne Scott was named the BIG EAST Player of the Week on Oct. 15 after leading her team to two conference wins over Connecticut and St. John's. The senior recorded 4.56 kills/set and 2.78 digs/set en route to two double-doubles in two matches. She also added 1.33 blocks/set while tallying 49.5 points on the week. Against UConn, Scott hit 19 kills with 12 digs and four blocks to lead UC to a five-set victory. In the 3-1 win over St. John's, she had a match-high 22 kills with 13 digs and match-high eight blocks, while also registering a .259 attacking percentage. It was the first player of the week honor for Scott, who was a unanimous preseason All-BIG EAST pick.

GOING THE DISTANCE

Seniors Jordanne Scott and Becca Refenes both played in their 400th career set while participating in the La Quinta Invitational in Las Cruces, N.M. Scott's milestone came in the second set of a 3-1 loss to Northwestern on Sept. 1. Refenes reached the mark in the third set of a 3-0 victory over Drake, also on Sept. 1. Senior Emily Hayden participated in her 400th career set during the third game of a 3-0 loss at Marquette.

BIG DAY FOR TURNER

Megan Turner used her experience to pace the Bearcats in a 3-0 victory over Drake on Sept. 1 in the finale of the La Quinta Invitational in Las Cruces, N.M. The Senior hit a career-high 20 kills for a .594 hitting percentage, also a career high. She added four digs, one block and a service ace in the victory.

BIG EAST HONORS FOR MACINTYRE

Junior Emily MacIntyre was named to the BIG EAST Honor Roll on Sept. 24 after the team posted a 1-1 record the week prior. She recorded 34 digs against Notre Dame and 28 digs against DePaul for a 6.89 digs/set average. It was the first BIG EAST honor for the Bearcats this season.

REFENES ON THE HONOR ROLL

Senior Becca Refenes was named to the BIG EAST Honor Roll on Oct. 1 after a 1-1 record. She recorded 14 kills and tied a career high with 10 digs at Pittsburgh and then had 15 kills and 10 digs at USF for a 3.62 kills/set average and a 2.50 digs/set average.

DOUBLE THE HONORS FOR SCOTT

Jordanne Scott was named to the BIG EAST Honor Roll on Oct. 8 after leading her team to a 2-1 record the week prior. The senior had 55 kills for a 4.23 kills/set ratio as well as a .219 attacking percentage. She also recorded 19 digs and 10.0 blocks in the three matches against Xavier, Rutgers and Seton Hall. The honor marked the third consecutive week that a Bearcat was named to the BIG EAST honor roll.

She made a repeat appearance on the weekly honor roll list on Nov. 5 after pacing the Bearcats to a 2-1 week with wins over Georgetown and Villanova. She tallied 4.22 kills per set and a .275 hitting percentage in three matches, including 4.50 kills/set and a .395 clip in BIG EAST matches. The win over the Wildcats also secured Cincinnati's spot at the BIG EAST Championship, held Nov. 16-18 in Milwaukee, Wis.
