WEEKLY HONORS

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

James Proche • SMU • Sr. • WR • Dallas, Texas

Proche, who was also chosen as the Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week, had 11 receptions for 153 yards and two touchdowns, including the game-winning TD in the third overtime period, in SMU's 43-37 win against Tulsa. Proche's two touchdowns helped SMU rally from a 30-9 fourth-quarter deficit and kept the Mustangs unbeaten at 6-0 entering an open week.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jarell White • Cincinnati • Jr. • LB • Cincinnati, Ohio

White had seven tackles with a tackle for loss, a forced fumble and a key fourth-quarter interception to help Cincinnati to a 27-24 win against No. 18/19 UCF and end the Knights' 19-game winning streak against American Athletic Conference opponents. White's interception came at the Bearcat 6-yard line and with Cincinnati holding a 27-16 lead. He led a defense that held the Knights to one touchdown in six red-zone chances.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

James Smith • Cincinnati • Jr. • P • Wangaratta, Australia

Smith, a 2018 Ray Guy Award finalist, averaged a modest 40.0 yards on eight punts in Cincinnati's 27-24 win against No. 18/19 UCF, but put five of his eight kicks inside the 20-yard line and three inside the 10 to help the Bearcats win the field position battle. Only two of Smith's eight punts were returned, for a total of six yards.

HONOR ROLL

Kenneth Gainwell • Memphis • Fr. • RB

Rushed for 209 yards and two touchdowns on 14 carries, averaging 14.9 yards per attempt, in a 52-33 win at Louisiana-Monroe.

Malcolm Perry • Navy • Sr. • QB

Rushed for 111 yards and two touchdowns on 23 carries and completed 5-of-7 passes for 144 yards in a 34-25 win against Air Force. Scored the go-ahead touchdown with 23 seconds left in regulation.

Dwayne Boyles • USF • So. • LB

Tied for the team lead with eight tackles, including a sack and 3.0 tackles for loss, in a 48-22 win at UConn. Led a defense that held UConn to 293 yards and 2-of-13 on third down conversions.

Isaiah Wright • Temple • Sr. • WR

Had 173 all-purpose yards, including 104 yards on nine receptions with a touchdown in a 27-17 win at ECU. Added a 55-yard kickoff return and a 14-yard punt return.

Amare Jones • Tulane • So. • RB

Had six receptions for 104 yards and a touchdown and rushed for 65 yards and a TD on nine carries in a 42-33 win at Army, ending the Black Knights' 15-game home winning streak.

A League Of Our Own

American Athletic Conference teams are a combined 26-1 (.963) against opponents from outside the power conferences this season.

American Athletic Conference teams are 6-0 against Conference USA this season. The American is 4-0 against the Sun Belt, 3-0 against the Mountain West and 1-1 against the MAC.

To Be The Best ...

American Athletic Conference teams have played eight games against top-25 opponents in 2019. Conference teams have faced three top-10 teams this season.

Exclusivity

SMU is one of three teams that is 6-0 through Week 6 (Ohio State, Florida). SMU and Ohio State are the only two teams nationally that are bowl-eligible.

Home Is Where The Wins Are

UCF has won 18 straight home games, trailing only Alabama (29) for the nation's longest active streak. UCF is tied with Clemson for the second-longest streak.

It's Been A While

SMU is 6-0 for the first time since 1982. Tulane is 4-1 through five games for the first time since 1998.

The Gauntlet

Tulsa's first five opponents were all unbeaten going into their games against the Golden Hurricane..

Ground Troops

Navy ranks second the nation in rushing, averaging 312.0 rushing yards per game. The Midshipmen are behind only Louisiana, which has averaged 314.0 yards per game.

Air Traffic Controllers

Memphis is third the nation in pass defense, in terms of yards allowed (146.2 ypg). Temple is third nationally in pass efficiency defense (89.39).

Two Steps Back

USF ranks fourth nationally in tackles for loss, registering 9.8 TFL per game.

Keeping Up With Jones

SMU RB Xavier Jones is second among all FBS players with 12 rushing touchdowns. Jones trail only Oklahoma State's Chuba Hubbard, who has 13 TDs.

Rank And File

Six American Athletic Conference teams – half of the conference's membership – were either ranked or received votes in the Sept. 15 national polls.

This Is Our House

Home teams were a combined 30-18 in American Athletic Conference games in 2018. The home team is 6-3 in conference games this season.

It's East vs. West

The American's East Division finished the 2018 season with a 10-8 head-to-head record against the league's West Division, marking the first time in the four-year history of the conference's two-division format that the East had the better head-to-head record. West Division teams hold a 40-34 all-time lead against East Division opponents since 2015.

Conference Call

UCF saw a streak of 19 consecutive wins against American Athletic Conference opponents (regular season and championship) end with Friday's loss at Cincinnati. That was the longest active winning streak nationally for any team in its conference.

Nice Runs

Cincinnati is 15-3 since the start of the 2018 season. Tulane is 9-2 in its last 11 games. SMU is 11-4 in its last 15 games.

New Wave

Tulane won five of its last six games of the 2018 season and is 3-1 to start the 2019 campaign, giving the Green Wave eight wins in its last 10 games. UCF is 29-3 since the start of the 2017 season.

The 2019 Championship

The 2019 American Athletic Conference Football Championship will be played Saturday, Dec. 7, at 3:30 p.m. ET and will be televised nationally on ABC for the fifth consecutive season.



The championship will be played between the champions of the East and West divisions, based on the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The site of the championship will be the home venue of the division winner with the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The following tiebreakers are in place for the 2019 season.

Two-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

- Head-to-head result
- Divisional winning percentage
- Head-to-head results within the division against the team with the next best conference winning percentage, in descending order
- Winning percentage against common non-divisional conference opponents
- College Football Playoff Selection Committee rankings, provided that team wins in the final weekend of the regular season. If the higher-ranked team loses in the final weekend, then a composite average of computer rankings will determine the divisional champion.
- Overall winning percentage, excluding exempt games
- Coin toss

Multiple-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

The following is used to eliminate teams until two teams remain, at which point the two-team tiebreaker is used

- If one team defeated all other teams, it will be the divisional champion

- The Knights saw a streak of 31 straight games with at least 30 points come to an end against Cincinnati. It was the longest such streak in FBS football since 1936.
- UCF had defeated 19 consecutive American Athletic Conference opponents before falling to Cincinnati. The Knights' last loss against a conference opponent was against USF in the 2016 regular-season finale.
- UCF has had a rushing touchdown and a passing touchdown in 32 consecutive games, the longest current streak in FBS football.

- The crowd of 40,121 for the game against UCF was the second-largest in Nippert Stadium history, trailing only the 40,140 against UConn in 2015.
- DE Elijah Ponder had 2.0 sacks to lead a Cincinnati defense that ended UCF's streak of 31 consecutive games with at least 30 points.
- The Bearcats had four takeaways against UCF (three interceptions, one fumble recovery).

- SMU went 6-for-6 on fourth down conversion attempts in the fourth quarter and in overtime against Tulsa.
- The Mustangs have clinched bowl eligibility for the second time in three years. SMU and Ohio State are the only teams nationally that are bowl-eligible.
- SMU trailed Tulsa 30-9 in the fourth quarter, but scored 21 points in the final 14:56 of regulation to force overtime before winning in the third extra session.

Memphis remains as one of the nation's 16 unbeaten teams after the Tigers scored a 52-33 win at Louisiana-Monroe in Week 5 ... The Tigers are 5-0 for the fourth time in program history and the second time since 2015 ... Memphis is 9-4 as a ranked team as a member of The American ... QB Brady White has thrown for 1,163 yards and 11 touchdowns against three interceptions in five games ... Freshman RB Kenneth Gainwell has rushed for 620 yards and six touchdowns ... Gainwell leads The American in rushing at 124.0 yards per game and is the Tigers' second-leading receiver with 17 catches out of the backfield ... COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Rob Mullens (chair), Frank Beamer, Paola Boivin, Jeff Bower, Joe Castiglione, Herb Deromedi, Ken Hatfield, Chris Howard, Bobby Johnson, Ronnie Lott, Gene Smith, Todd Stansbury, and Scott Stricklin.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2019.

The **Birmingham Bowl** takes place at Legion Field in Birmingham, Alabama. The American/Big East has partnered with the bowl since its inception in the 2006 season. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Southeastern Conference.

The **Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl** is played at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa, Florida. Conference USA will provide the opponent for The American's team in the 2019 season.

The **Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl** began in 2014 and is played at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, Florida. The American representative will play a team from the Mid-American Conference in 2019.
