#### **SETTING THE SCENE**

- » Connor McVey was named the NCBWA National Hitter of the Week and the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week for games played through May 11. The freshman hit .800 with a 1.200 slugging percentage and a .824 on-base percentage in four games last week. He hit a go-ahead grand slam for his first-career homerun to win the game against Toledo on May 7.
- Redshirt junior Matt Ring was named to the American honor roll this week. He pitched his second-career complete game on Friday, May 9 in the final home game of his career. He did not allow an earned run and struck out three.
- Senior Matt Williams is currently riding a career-high 12-game hit streak. McVey failed to get on base during the loss to Ohio State, effectively ending his eight-game hit streak.
- The Bearcats are currently on the outside looking in for the American Athletic Conference baseball championship but can play their way into a spot this weekend. UC will earn a bid to Clearwater if it wins one more game than Memphis on the weekend. The Tigers are hosting Rutgers for three games beginning on Thursday. If the Bearcats do not win a game, they will be eliminated from contention.
- Louisville is currently in play to earn the American regular-season crown and the No. 1 seed at the championship. The Cardinals must win one more game than UCF, who plays at UConn this weekend.

#### THE LAST TIME OUT

- » The Bearcats earned a series victory against Memphis last weekend with two wins on Friday and Sunday.
- » In Friday's 5-1 win, redshirt junior Matt Ring worked his second-career complete game. He pitched 9.0 innings and did not allow an earned run for a 0.00 ERA on the night. He allowed just seven hits and two walks while striking out three batters.
- » On Sunday, freshman Andrew Zellner got the start and struck out a career-high eight batters in 5.0 innings, doubling his previous high of four.
- » Zellner and reliever Colton Cleary combined to strike out 11 Memphis batters, setting a new season-high for the team.
- » Freshman Connor McVey has been on a tear as of late and recorded an .800 batting average with a 1.200 slugging percentage and a .846 on base percentage in four games last week. He led the team with eight hits and eight RBIs, including a go-ahead grand slam in a win over Toledo on May 7
- » In their most recent game, the Bearcats fell 11-3 against Ohio State in Columbus on May 13.

# **LOUISVILLE CARDINALS**

- » Louisville is 40-13 on the year and currently tied for first in the American Athletic Conference with a 16-5 mark in league play.
- » The Cardinals have reached the 40-win plateau for the fourth consecutive season and are looking to make a repeat run into the College World Series after earning the nod in 2003.
- Jeff Gardner, a front-runner for American Player of the Year, leads the team with a .337 batting average and a .563 slugging percentage. He has 64 hits with 18 doubles, two triples and seven homeruns this season.
- » Cole Sturgeon leads the team with 68 hits in 2014.
- » On the mound, the Cardinals are led by reliever Nick Burdi, the reigning American Pitcher of the Week. Burdi has a remarkable 0.59 ERA through 24 appearances. He has recorded 53 strikeouts with just eight walks.
- » Starters Kyle Funkhouser and Jared Ruxer have ERAs of 1.86 and 2.27, respectively, and have combined for 153 strikeouts.

#### **McVey Reigns**

- » Freshman Connor McVey was named the National Hitter of the Week by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) on Tuesday, May 15.
- » He also was named the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week on Monday, May 12.
- » He finished the four games last week against Toledo and Memphis with an .800 hitting percentage, a 1.200 slugging percentage and a .824 on-base percentage. He led the team with eight hits, eight RBIs and four walks and also scored two runs.
- » In the 12-7 comeback win against Toledo, McVey hit a go-ahead grand slam his first collegiate homerun to give the Bearcats the lead.

#### Streaking

- » After having a 10-game streak snapped earlier in the season, senior Matt Williams has finally broken the plateau and is currently at a career-high 12 straight games with a hit.
- » He singled in a run in the second inning against Ohio State to keep the streak alive on May 13.

#### **Spring Cleaning**

- » UC got its brooms out during a three-game series at Army on May 2-4, winning all three to earn the sweep. Army is the co-champion of the Patriot League and was receiving votes in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association national poll at the time of the series.
- » The Bearcats won the first two games by one run apiece, including a 3-2 comeback win on Saturday where they rallied to score two runs in the ninth to steal the victory. UC blew out Army in the series finale, winning 15-3 after knocking 18 hits and two homeruns.
- » The sweep represented the first three-game series sweep of the season for Cincinnati.
- » It is also the first time a UC team has gone on the road to sweep a series since beating Georgetown in three games back in 2011.

#### Walsh Named Pitcher of the Week

- » Redshirt sophomore Connor Walsh was named the American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Week on Monday, April 28 after shutting out No. 12 Houston on Saturday, April 26 and leading the Bearcats to a 3-0 victory.
- » Walsh pitched a no-hitter through 5.2 innings against the nation's twelfth-ranked team.
- » He finished the game with 7.0 innings pitched, just two hits and six strikeouts.

#### Not Intimidated

- » Cincinnati hosted No. 12 Houston on April 25, 26 and 27 for a three-game series and the Bearcats did not back down from the nation's twelfth-ranked team.
- » UC beat the Cougars 3-0 on Saturday, April 25, shutting out UH for just the second time this season.
- » Houston entered the weekend with an NCAA-leading team ERA of 1.88, the only team in the country with a sub-two ERA. The Bearcats took the challenge and rattled off 28 hits, the most the Cougars have allowed in a three-game series all season.

#### **Queen City Bandits**

- » As of May 12, the Bearcats rank 14th in the nation with 84 stolen bases.
- » UC also ranks 16th in the country for 1.71 stolen bases per game.
- » Four players on the Cincinnati roster boast at least 10 stolen bases on the season, including Ian Happ (17), Matt Williams (13), Justin Glass (10) and Connor McVey (10).

#### Walker Player of the Week

- » Junior Grant Walker pitched his second consecutive complete game and his first-career complete game shutout against crosstown Rival Xavier on Tuesday, April 15. He scattered 6 hits and struck out five to give his team a 2-0 win.
- » Walker was named the American Athletic Conference Player of the Week by College Sports Madness on Tuesday, April 22.
- » He was named to the American honor roll by the league on April 21.

#### **Glass Half Full**

- » Justin Glass struggled out of the gate for his senior season, batting just .196 through the first 14 games of the year. In that span he had a mere nine hits with 11 strikeouts and only one extra-base hit (a double).
- » In the 15th game of the season at Dayton, Glass broke through for two hits, two runs scored, two RBIs and two walks.
- » In the 36 games since his season-opening slump, Glass has batted .320 with 41 hits, 30 runs scored, 27 RBIs, five homeruns and 19 walks. He also has a slugging percentage of .484 and an on-base percentage of .435.

#### **Swinging Ian**

- » Sophomore Ian Happ was named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason 50-man watch list as announced by USA Baseball on April 10.
- The Golden Spikes Award is designed to honor the top amateur baseball player in the country.
- » Happ was previously named to the 60-man watch list prior to the start of the season and was kept on the 50-man list along with 27 other players. 23 new players were added to the "rolling list" for the top-50.
- » A 30-man watch list will be announced on May 8 while semifinalists will be released on May 27. The finalists will be named on June 3 with the Golden Spikes Award presentation on July 17.
- » At the time the watch list was announced on April 10, Happ was hitting .356 with 37 hits, 23 RBIs, 22 runs scored, 10 doubles and three homeruns to go with a .558 slugging percentage and a .473 on-base percentage.

#### **Rounding Third and Heading for Home**

- » As the 2014 senior class closes out its last season as Bearcats baseball players, a couple are making their mark in the UC baseball career record book.
- » Justin Glass ranks fifth in career games played with 219, making him just the 10th player in UC baseball history to play 200 career games. Matt Williams is ninth with 205 career games and is just the 11th player to crack the mark.
- » Glass ranks second with 867 career at bats while Williams sits in ninth with 720 at bats.
- » Glass's 284 hits ranks him third in UC history. He is 29 hits away from passing UC great Kevin Youkilis (1998-01) who collected 313 career hits.
- » Glass ranks fourth with 55 doubles while Williams is tied for 9th with nine career triples.
- » Glass has 141 RBIs to rank seventh.

- » 396 total bases puts Glass in fourth place for his career in that category.
- » Glass has been hit by a pitch 32 times in his career to rank him fourth all time.
- » Glass is tied with Youkillis and Craig Tewes (1998-01) for second with 13 career sacrifice flies and Williams is close to cracking the top-10 with seven.

#### **Glass Leads the Nation**

- » Senior Justin Glass leads the nation in games started among players who have started every game of their career. The native of Fort Wayne, Ind. has started all 219 games of his career (57 freshman, 56 sophomore, 56 junior and 50 senior).
- » Glass' 219-straight starting appearances also ranks first in the NCAA for consecutive starts. Ethan Gross of Memphis ranks second with 204 consecutive starts.
- » Additionally, Glass is tied for 8th in the nation in outfield assists, having thrown out seven base runners this season.

#### First of Many Championships

- » When head coach Ty Neal took over the UC baseball program, he couldn't stress enough the goal of the program to win championships.
- » The Bearcats took their first step towards that goal on April 9, winning the Joe Nuxhall Classic title over Wright State University, Miami University and Xavier University.
- » Cincinnati won the classic for the third time in its six year history and for the first time since 2011.
- » With the win, the Bearcats became the only school with three victories in the tournament. Wright State has won twice, Xavier once and Miami has yet to win the classic.
- UC beat WSU 8-7 in the first game on April 8 to advance to the championship match. Russell Clark has two hits and two RBIs while Andrew Zellner picked up the win on the mound and Colton Cleary earned his third save of the season.
   In the championship game against Miami, Grant Walker pitched his first-career complete game and threw a career-high six
- » In the championship game against Miami, Grant Walker pitched his first-career complete game and threw a career-high six strikeouts to give UC the victory. Connor McVey had three hits, two RBIs and two runs scored while Ian Happ had two hits, including his third homerun of the season.

#### **Streaks Snapped**

- » Senior Matt Williams was unable to record a hit in the 8-0 loss to Akron on Saturday, March 15, effectively ending his 10-game hitting streak.
- » He is the second Bearcats player to record a 10-game hitting streak this season redshirt sophomore Will Drake had a hit in the first 10 games of the season before ending his streak in the 11th game at Kentucky.
- » Freshman Connor McVey was riding an eight-game hit streak (with multiple hits in six of the eight games) until going hit-less against Ohio State on May 13.

#### **Offensive Explosion**

- » The Bearcats drubbed the University of Dayton 18-5 on Tuesday, March 11, setting many new season and career highs in the process.
- » The team scored 18 runs, a new season high and the most runs scored for Cincinnati since March 10, 2012 when it beat Chicago State 20-4.
- » The 19 hits ties a season high for UC.
- » The Bearcats scored eight runs in the second inning, the most in one inning this season.
- » Sophomore Russell Clark tied a career high with two runs scored.
- » Sophomore Ian Happ tied two career-high marks with three hits and three runs scored.
- » Freshman Connor McVey tied a career high with two hits, but set new career bests with four total bases and four runs scored while also hitting his first-career triple.
- » Sophomore Mitch Patishall struck out a career-high six batters.
- » Freshman Jake Richmond set new career-marks with three hits, four total bases, and six at bats while tying his previous marks with one double, one RBI and two runs scored.
- » Sophomore Devin Wenzel hit a homerun and two doubles to tie his previous career high with three hits and recorded a career-high eight total bases.

#### **Delightful Debuts**

- » Freshman Connor McVey became the first freshman to see action in the 2014 season when he started at first base in the second game of the Elon series on Feb. 17. McVey notched his first two career hits, including a two-out single in the ninth inning to keep the Bearcats alive. The freshman also recorded a team-high seven putouts at first base.
- » Andrew Zellner earned his first collegiate action and first-career start on Feb. 23 against Missouri. Zellner tossed a perfect game through 4.1 innings and finished with 5.1 innings pitched, four hits, three strikeouts and only two walks.
- » Redshirt freshman Colton Cleary made his UC debut on March 1 against UMass-Lowell when he came out of the bullpen in the third inning. The lefty finished the game, going 7.0 innings and scattering six hits.
- » Austin Woodby continued the streak of successful debuts on March 5 when he entered in the seventh inning of an 11-4 loss to No. 22 Kentucky. The freshman pitched 2.0 innings, facing the minimum six batters and striking out the 1, 2, and 3 hitters in Kentucky's lineup.

#### Oh, HAPPy Days

- » Sophomore infielder/outfielder Ian Happ spent the preseason raking in honors and awards from a variety of different organizations and publications.
- » Prior to the start of the season, Happ was named to the 60-man watch list for the Golden Spikes Award by USA Baseball. The Golden Spikes Award is given at the end of the season to the best player in college baseball.
- » In a poll of the American Athletic Conference head coaches, Happ was named to the preseason All-American Athletic Conference team.
- » Perfect Game magazine picked Happ as the preseason Player of the Year in the American and named him to their preseason All-American Athletic Conference team.
- » Perfect Game also selected him as a preseason second team All-American and tabbed him the fifth-best sophomore in the nation.
- » Baseball America named Happ a preseason first team All-America selection and the second-best sophomore player in the country.
- » College Sports Madness named Happ a first team preseason All-American Athletic Conference selection.
- » He started all 56 games last season and ranked first on the team with 41 runs scored, 13 doubles, six homeruns and 47 walks. He recorded a team-high .322 batting average, a .483 slugging percentage and a .451 on-base percentage in 2013.

# **HEAD COACH TY NEAL**

Ty Neal, who was regarded as one of the top assistant coaches in college baseball, was named the University of Cincinnati's 27th baseball head coach on June 7, 2013.

Neal, a native of Southwest Ohio, spent the previous eight seasons at Indiana University as the program's top assistant and recruiting coordinator. Neal helped direct the Hoosiers to their first appearance at the College World Series in 2013.

He was previously an assistant for the Bearcats in 2004 and both played and coached at Miami (Ohio).

During his coaching career, Neal has mentored 18 pitchers who have been drafted in the first 10 rounds of the Major League Baseball Draft.

Neal joined the Hoosiers after serving as the pitching coach under IU head coach Tracy Smith at Miami in 2005.

Prior to his stint at UC in 2004, Neal coached at Southern Illinois from 2001-03 and started his coaching career at Miami in 2000, when the RedHawks went 40-23 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

During the summer of 2002, Neal served as pitching coach for the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox of the Cape Cod Baseball League.

Neal wrapped up his playing career at Miami as a four-year letterwinner, earning 19 career victories. As a senior, he served as a team captain and was presented with the RedHawk Award. He was also named an All-American by the National Strength and Conditioning Association.

Neal, a native of West Elkton, Ohio, graduated from Miami in 1999 with a bachelor's degree in health and sport studies. He and his wife, Christine, have two sons, Silas and Beckett and one daughter Paisley.

#### **Glass Honored**

- » Senior Justin Glass was honored by Perfect Game magazine as a preseason All-American Athletic Conference pick.
- » Glass a three-year starter for the Bearcats, tied for the team lead with a .322 batting average in 2013. He notched a team-high 77 hits with 41 runs scored and 39 RBIs. Glass also recorded a .439 slugging percentage with a .978 fielding percentage during his junior season

#### Ones to Watch: Walsh, Happ and Patishall

» Redshirt sophomore RHP Connor Walsh, sophomore infielder/outfielder Ian Happ and sophomore RHP Mitch Patishall both have bright baseball futures ahead of them according to Perfect Game. Walsh was named the No. 2 prospect in the American Athletic Conference to watch for the 2014 MLB first-year player draft while Happ and Patishall were named the No. 2 and No. 8 players to watch, respectively, for the 2015 draft.

#### » Not so Familiar Faces

- » Throughout the 2014 season, the Bearcats will face four opponents they have never faced before in program history and will play three more they have only played once or twice before.
- » The Bearcats recorded their first official games against Radford University during the second weekend of the season in Winston-Salem, N.C. They also played the University of Massachusetts-Lowell for the first time Feb. 28-March 1, UCF for the first time on March 21-23 and will play Temple for the first time April 4-6.
- » Cincinnati's first opponent, Elon University, has only matched up once before with the Bearcats, a 6-3 EU win in 1964. Cincinnati and Missouri have played two games against each other in 1907, however scores were not recorded for the games. The Bearcats have only matched up with Army once in program history, a 3-1 UC win in 1969.

#### America's Pastime in the American

- » With the start of the 2014 season comes big changes for the University of Cincinnati baseball team notably the switch in athletic conferences. The Bearcats are now a member of the new American Athletic Conference in its inaugural season.
- » Nine team will comprise the American. Cincinnati is joined by the University of Connecticut, University of Houston, the University of Louisville, the University of Memphis, Rutgers University, Temple University, UCF and USF.
- » Two members of the American, Connecticut and Louisville, were selected as 2013 NCAA regional teams while Louisville advanced to the College World Series.
- » Prior to the creation of the American Athletic Conference, UC has shared a conference with six current American members, including four simultaneous stops with Memphis. Cincinnati, Memphis, Houston and Louisville all played together in the Missouri Valley Conference (UC was a member from 1957-1970) and the Metro Conference (UC was a member from 1975-1991). UC was in the Great Midwest Conference with Memphis from 1991-1995 before joining Conference USA (1995-2005) with Houston, Louisville, Memphis and USF. Cincinnati's last home was the BIG EAST Conference (2006-2013) which was also the conference for Louisville, USF, Connecticut and Rutgers.
- » It its last season as a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Cincinnati posted a 6-18 record in conference play and failed to make the conference tournament.

#### MARGE SCHOTT STADIUM

- » Marge Schott Stadium has been the home of the Cincinnati Bearcats baseball team since the end of the 2004 season.
- » The first game played at the 3,085-seat, on-campus facility occurred on May, 20 2004 when the Bearcats hosted UAB in the final series of 2004. The opening game was played on a Thursday night, before a crowd of 2,200.
- » The facility was later named Marge Schott Stadium in the spring of 2006 after the Marge and Charles J. Schott Foundation made a \$2 million gift to the Richard E. Lindner Varsity Village. Marge Schott was a well-known Cincinnati philanthropist who held controlling interest of the Cincinnati Reds from 1985 to 1999. She passed away in March, 2004, leaving the majority of her estate to the foundation.
- » Recently voted the favorite road stadium in the BIG EAST Conference to visit, Marge Schott Stadium is located directly east of the spot where Johnny Bench Field, the Bearcats' previous home, sat for a number of years.
