### Golf

The 2006-07 golf season proved to be another successful one at the University of Cincinnati. Under the tuteledge of LPGA National Coach of the Year Janet Carl and former pro Doug Martin, both Bearcats' squads won team and individual titles during the year. By season's end, both squads were hungry to once again challenge for BIGEAST supremacynext year.

**CARL EARNS BIG HONOR:** During her coaching career, golf coach Janet Carl has won many awards, but none bigger than one she received in September 2006. At that time, Carl was named the Ladies Professional Golf Association (LPGA) National Coachof the Year, an award presented by Etonic. During the 2005-06 season Carl led the women's squad to three team titles, while coaching Hillery Wilson to four individual crowns. Carl became eligible for the award after being named the LPGA Midwest Section Coach of the Year, an honor she also earned in 2003.

**AN IMPORTANT WIN:** The women's golf team scored one of its biggest victories ever when it captured the team title at the Lady Irish Invitational, Sept. 23-24, 2006. The field for tournament was a strong one, consisting of six teams ranked between 25th and 100th nationally. The Bearcats, who won the tournament crown by six strokes, overcame a four-stroke deficit to earn the team title. The Bearcats' charge to victory was spurred by junior Hillery Wilson, who took individual medalist honors for the sixth time in her career. Wilson shot a second round 69 to take the lead and in the process, matched her own school record for lowest single round.

**ANOTHER YEAR, ANOTHER COMEBACK:** For the second year in a row, the men's golf teams aved its best for last at the BIG EAST Championship. One year after climbing four spots in the final round, UC improved from 11th to a tie for sixth in the last round of the latest edition of the league championship. Cincinnati's vast improvement (final round score of 284) was keyed by career-best performances from senior Geoff Newman and sophomore Blake Tucker. Playing in his final collegiate round, Newman matched his career-low with a round of 69 to finish the event in a tie for 24th. The Cincinnati native shaved eight strokes off his round two total. Tucker was also at his best, establishing a new career-low with a score of 70, one shot below his previous best. He finished in a tie for 29th overall.

**NEW LEADERSHIP:** The Bearcats began the 2006-07 season with a change at the top as Doug Martin replaced Sonny Rinala as assistant coach incharge of the men's program. Martin added a great deal of experience to the team as he played on the PGA Tour from 1991-99 and was very accomplished as an amateur. In 1989, he was ranked as the top amateur player in the country and was also a three-time All-American at the University of Oklahoma. Professionally, Martin scored two tour victories and lost a five-hole playoff to Vijah Singh at the 1995 Buick Classic at Westchester. Currently, Martin is an instructor in the Cincinnati-area and is manager and part owner of The Golf Ranch in Burlington, Ky. Martin brought immediate improvement to the program as the team shaved five strokes off its season average from the year before, while securing a team and individual title.

**LEADING THE WAY:** The unquestioned leader and top player for the men's team was senior Geoff Newman. In 13 tournaments, Newman finished in the top-20 seven times, with a pair of top-five tallies to his credit. The Cincinnati native finished the year with a team-best 74.9 average. In the latter part of the season, classmate Joe Young stepped up, winning the LaRosa's Collegiate Cup on the strength of rounds of 68 and 69. Young followed it up with top-20 finishes in three of the final four tournaments of the year.

**HOPING FOR MORE:** Through three seasons at Cincinnati, junior Hillery Wilson has already accomplished a great deal. As a Bearcat, Wilson has won nine tournaments, set the school record for lowest round and the mark for lowest single-season average. She enjoyed another great season this year, holding a team-best 76.1 average. At the Rio Verde Invitational (March 9-11), Wilson broke her own school record and established a new tournament-best with around of 68. With four wins and five other top-10 finishes, Wilson was ranked 182nd nationally by *Golfweek* at the end of the season. Last fall, Golfweek tabbed Wilson as one of the nation's five players to keep an eve on.

**SHARING THE WEALTH:** While Hillery Wilson has been the big winner for the Bearcats over the past two years, Allison Mayborg and Sarah Stamper got in the act at the Cross River Shootout vs. Northern Kentucky on Sept. 29, 2006. The UC duo shared the individual medalist award with scores of 75, marking the first win for both players in the college ranks.
