WEEKLY HONORS

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jerome Ford • Jr. • RB • Cincinnati

Ford set a career high for the second consecutive week as he rushed for 189 yards and four touchdowns to lead Cincinnati to a 56-21 win against UCF, keeping the Bearcats unbeaten. Ford had all four touchdowns in the first half, helping to stake the Bearcats to a 35-0 lead late in the second quarter as he scored on runs of 1, 2, 79 and 4 yards. He averaged 9.5 yards per carry for the game, hitting his career high on 20 attempts, and enters Week 8 as The American's rushing leader at 118.2 yards per game with a league-leading 12 rushing touchdowns.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Justin Wright • Jr. • LB • Tulsa

Wright had a team-high seven tackles, which included 2.5 sacks, to help Tulsa to a 32-31 come-from-behind win at South Florida. Wright's final sack came on the Bulls' final possession after the Golden Hurricane had taken its first lead, while he had a first-quarter sack that effectively ended another potential scoring opportunity.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Bryan Battie • Fr. • RB • South Florida

Battie became the ninth American Athletic Conference player in league history to register a 100-yard kickoff return when he took a second-quarter return from end zone to end zone in the Bulls' 32-31 loss to Tulsa. Battie's return gave South Florida a 17-10 lead after Tulsa had tied the game at 10-10. Battie is averaging 28.6 yards per return this season, which ranks second among American Athletic Conference players.



HONOR ROLL

Coby Bryant • Gr. • CB • Cincinnati

Scored a touchdown on a 74-yard interception return to lead a defense that limited UCF to a season-low 296 yards and 141 passing yards in a 56-21 win.

Xavier Cullens • Sr. • LB • Memphis

Had a game-high 12 tackles, including eight solo stops and 0.5 tackles for loss, in a 35-17 win against Navy. Led a defense that limited the Midshipmen to 241 total yards.

Antonio Grier • Jr. • LB • South Florida

Had seven tackles, a tackle for loss, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a 69-yard interception return for a touchdown in a 32-31 loss to Tulsa.

Shamari Brooks • Sr. • RB • Tulsa

Rushed for 145 yards and a touchdown on 23 carries in a 32-31 win at South Florida. Scored the game-winning touchdown with 47 seconds left in the fourth quarter.

Deneric Prince • Jr. • RB • Tulsa

Rushed for 110 yards and a touchdown on 19 carries in a 32-31 win at South Florida.

Austin III:16

Memphis WR Calvin Austin III has eight touchdown receptions in 2021, putting him fourth among NCAA FBS players. Austin has had touchdown receptions of 11, 21, 25, 30, 50, 55, 60 and 75 yards this season. He also has scored on a 94-yard punt return and a 69-yard run.

Keeping Up With Jones

Houston CB Marcus Jones, who was the 2020 American Athletic Conference Special Teams Player of the Year, is one of only two NCAA FBS players with two touchdowns on punt returns in 2021 (Jayden Reed of Michigan State).

Active Claims

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel is the NCAA active career leader in passing yards and total offense per game. Gabriel has averaged 309.1 passing yards and 323.4 yards of total offense per game.

Bend But Don't Break

Cincinnati leads the nation in red zone defense (42.9 percent). The Bearcats are second nationally in pass efficiency defense (86.04), trailing only Georgia (85.22).

Familiar Faces

The American Athletic Conference returns 10 of its 11 head coaches from last season. The only new head coach in The American in 2021 is UCF's Gus Malzahn.

Draft Class

The American Athletic Conference saw 19 players selected in the 2021 NFL Draft, the most in conference history. Former Tulsa LB Zaven Collins (16th to Arizona) and former Houston DE Payton Turner (28th to New Orleans) were both first-round selections.

2021 COLLEGE FOOTBALL RULES CHANGES

Overtime

Teams will be required to run a 2-point conversion play after a touchdown when a game reaches a second overtime period. Previously, a 2-point attempt was required after the third overtime period.

Also, if the game reaches a third overtime, teams will run alternating 2-point plays, instead of starting another drive at the opponent's 25-yard line. This is a change from the previous rule, which started to use 2-point plays in the fifth overtime period.

This rules change is being made to limit the number of plays from scrimmage and bring the game to a quicker conclusion. Teams can still choose whether to kick the point after touchdown or run a 2-point conversion play during the first overtime period.

Team Area

The Playing Rules Oversight Panel approved the team area being permanently extended to the 20-yard lines, starting in the 2021 season. Previously, the team area extended to the 25-yard lines, but this area was expanded to the 15-yard lines last season to create more spacing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Unsportsmanlike Tactics

In an editorial change to the rules book, video board and lighting system operators have been included in those personnel who may not create any distraction that obstructs play.

Feigning Injuries

The panel supported the Football Rules Committee proposal to provide a framework to allow a school or conference to request a postgame video review about questionable actions through the NCAA secretary-rules editor/national coordinator of officials

Points Of Emphasis

- For the 2021 season, it will be a point of emphasis for officials to penalize any taunting action directed toward an opponent. Committee members think these actions reflect poorly on the game and can lead to unnecessary confrontations.
- Officials are directed to be alert to players who are significantly in violation of uniform rules and to send violators out of the game to correct the issue. This will include specifically the pants, jerseys and T-shirts that extend below the torso.
- Coaches should not enter the field of play or leave the team area to debate officiating decisions. Those who do so will have committed an automatic unsportsmanlike conduct foul.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

Every Game Counts

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a postseason event to determine college football's national champion on the field, while emphasizing the significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Rankings

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Tradition

The New Year's holiday period belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl Game and Sugar Bowl.

Championship Monday

The two teams that win the Playoff Semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. The national championship game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of 13 high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are Mitch Barnhart, Gary Barta (chair), Paola Boivin, Tom Burman, Charlie Cobb, Boo Corrigan, Chris Del Conte, Rick George, Will Shields, Joe Taylor, John Urschel, Rod West and Tyrone Willingham.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The American Bowl Lineup

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances annually as part of the conference's new postseason lineup, which began in the 2020 season and is in place through 2025..

The American, as it has done four times in the first six years of the current bowl cycle, will continue to send its champion to a New Year's Six bowl if that team finishes higher than the champions of four other conferences in the final College Football Playoff rankings. American Athletic Conference teams are also eligible for the College Football Playoff if they are among the top four teams in the final CFP rankings.

As part of the new bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Military Bowl presented by Peraton against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, the Fenway Bowl in Boston, also against an ACC team, and a third annual spot which will alternate between the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the EasyPost Hawaii Bowl.

Additionally, The American will annually have four appearances in a group of eight bowls. The American extended its existing partnerships with the TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl, the Union Home Mortgage Gasparilla Bowl, the RoofClaim Boca Raton Bowl, the Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl and the Cure Bowl.

New to The American's lineup are the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl, the New Mexico Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

THE AMERICAN ON TELEVISION

The American and ESPN reached agreement on a 12-year media rights extension that began with the 2020-21 academic year.

With the current agreement, The American has a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary TV networks – ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU – than at any point in its history. The Conference will also be a valuable part of ESPN+, ESPN's industry-leading direct-to-consumer sports streaming service.

In football, a minimum of 40 regular-season telecasts per season will be televised on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, including at least 20 across ABC, ESPN and ESPN2, which represents increased annual exposure across those ESPN networks. The American Championship game will be televised each year on ABC or ESPN.

Beyond select Navy football games, all conference controlled football games from The American will air on an ESPN network or ESPN+.
