## GAMEDAY INFORMATION

The University of Cincinnati baseball team (11-19, 1-8 BIG EAST), the reigning two-time Joe Nuxhall Classic champions, will look to make it a three-peat at the fourth annual tournament when the Bearcats play Wright State University (19-10, 10-2 Horizon League) in a 3 p.m. Tuesday first-round matchup at Hayden Park's McKie Field in Oxford, Ohio. Cincinnati will give the ball to freshman right-hander Ryan Atkinson, who is fresh off BIG EAST honors for his April 3 performance at Ohio University where the former Colerain Cardinal struck out 11 and allowed just three hits in seven shutout innings to earn his first career win. Wednesday's game time and opponent will be based on Tuesday's results. Regardless of Tuesday's outcomes, host Miami University will play the 6:30 p.m. game Wednesday. All four Joe Nuxhall Classic games can be viewed live on MURedhawks.com/allaccess (subscription required). Real Talk 1160 WQRT-AM will broadcast both of the Bearcats ballgames, including 30-minute pregame coverage.

**SETTING THE SCENE**

- ▶ The Bearcats will look to defend their Joe Nuxhall Classic Championship after winning the four-team tournament each of the past two seasons.
- ▶ After winning three of five ballgames, including wins over intra-state rivals Dayton and Ohio, the Bearcats fell to 1-8 in BIG EAST play after getting swept by USF in a three-game series.
- ▶ Head coach Brian Cleary earned his 405th career win after UC topped Ohio 11-2 on April 3. The 405 wins surpassed UC hall-of-famer and longtime Cincinnati Reds scorekeeper Glenn Sample's program standard of 404 career victories, which Sample accrued from 1961-1981.
- ▶ Freshman right-hander Ryan Atkinson made his first collegiate start against the Bobcats April 3 and pitched a gem after striking out 11 batters and tossing eight scoreless innings.
- ▶ Freshman left-hander Zach Morris has gone his last 18 1-3 innings pitched without allowing an earned run. The stretch includes seven innings vs. USF and eight shutout innings against Pitt.

**ON THE MOUND FOR THE BEARCATS**

- ▶ Freshman right-hander Ryan Atkinson will make his second career start on Tuesday against Wright State. If start No. 2 goes anywhere near as well as his first, the Bearcats will be playing for their third straight Joe Nuxhall Classic crown on Wednesday. In his first start at Ohio University on April 3, Atkinson struck out 11 Bobcats and allowed only three hits in seven shutout innings pitched.
- ▶ Wednesday's starter for Cincinnati is to be determined.

**CLEARY ATOP UC'S ALL-TIME WINS MARK**

- ▶ Bearcats baseball head coach Brian Cleary earned career win No. 405 after UC defeated Ohio 11-2 April 3.
- ▶ With 405 career wins, Cleary surpassed UC hall-of-famer and longtime Cincinnati Reds official scorekeeper Glenn Sample, who from 1961-1981 recorded 404 career wins, 13 of which occurred during the autumn season.
- ▶ The career milestone is the second Cleary has achieved this year after he earned career win No. 400 when the Bearcats defeated Chicago State 6-0 in the first game of a March 10th doubleheader.

**FRESHMEN HURLERS CARRY THE LOAD**

- ▶ Cincinnati has received a ton of production from its freshman pitching class in 2012, as the group has accounted for 63 percent of the team's wins, 47 percent of the team's starts, 45 percent of innings pitched and 36 percent of the team's strikeouts.
- ▶ Freshmen have started the past seven of the past eight games for the Bearcats heading into the Joe Nuxhall Classic.
- ▶ Freshmen Ryan Atkinson (April 9) and Zach

Morris (April 2) have been named to the BIG EAST Conference weekly honor roll in the last two weeks.

**ATKINSON EARNS UC'S 4TH BIG EAST HONOR ROLL**

- ▶ Freshman right-handed pitcher Ryan Atkinson was named to the BIG EAST Conference weekly honor roll on Monday for his performance at Ohio University last Tuesday.
- ▶ Atkinson pitched a gem against the Ohio Bobcats in his first collegiate start, throwing seven scoreless innings, striking out 11 batters and allowing just three hits. The 11 strikeouts were the most by a Bearcats pitcher since April 30, 2010 when Nick Johnson punched out 11 against West Virginia University.
- ▶ On the season, Atkinson has appeared in four games with one start, totaling 11 1-3 innings. The 6-foot-3 hurler owns a 2.38 ERA with two walks and 16 strikeouts while limiting opponents to a .214 batting average.
- ▶ Atkinson is the fourth Bearcat to be named to the BIG EAST Honor Roll in 2012 and the second in as many weeks. Sophomore outfielder Justin Glass (Fort Wayne, Ind./Carroll) received the distinction April 2, freshman left-hander Zach Morris (Edgewater, Md./DeMatha Catholic) earned the honor March 12 and freshman third baseman Joey Bielek (Scottsdale, Ariz./Chapparral) won the award March 6.

**MORRIS LIGHTS OUT**

- ▶ Freshman left-hander Zach Morris has gone the last 18 1-3 innings without allowing an earned run.
- ▶ In his previous start against USF, Morris allowed one unearned run on three hits in seven innings.
- ▶ Against Pitt on March 9, Morris threw eight shutout innings.
- ▶ Morris last surrendered an earned run with two outs in the third inning at No. 21 Louisville on March 24.

**GLASS NAMED TO BIG EAST HONOR ROLL**

- ▶ Sophomore right fielder Justin Glass was named to the weekly BIG EAST Conference honor roll on Monday for his performance March 28-April 1.
- ▶ Glass recorded a .500 batting average (8 for 16) with one home run and nine RBIs, while slugging .688

and reaching base at a .524 clip in four ballgames against Dayton and Pittsburgh.

- ▶ On March 28 at Dayton, Glass produced a career-high five RBIs and scored twice after hitting 5 for 6, including his first longball of the season. The five hits were also a career-best for Glass.

**A CAREER DAY IN DAYTON**

- ▶ Several Bearcats recorded multiple career highs during the Bearcats' 17-8 shellacking of Dayton on Wednesday.
- ▶ Sophomores Justin Glass and Matt Williams each produced five RBIs, which are new career highs for both.
- ▶ Glass (7) and Williams (6) also set career highs in total bases while Glass and tied his career best in at-bats (6).
- ▶ Senior outfielder Braden Kline scored four runs against the Flyers to set a new personal best.
- ▶ Junior center fielder Jake Proctor tied his career best with two doubles and set a new career standard for at-bats with seven.
- ▶ Sophomore infielder Ryan Quinn scored twice for a career high and tied his career best in hits with two.
- ▶ Senior first baseman Nic Spence's six at-bats were a career high for the Australian.

**GLASS & BIELEK GO STREAKING**

- ▶ Freshman third baseman Joey Bielek (13 games) and sophomore right fielder Justin Glass (12 games) have the two highest hitting streaks for the Bearcats in 2012.
- ▶ Glass saw his streak, which began during the second game of a doubleheader against Oakland, come to end against Louisville on March 24. During the streak, Glass batted .408 (20 of 49) with six RBIs, 12 runs scored and a .491 on-base percentage.
- ▶ Freshman third baseman Joey Bielek saw his 13-game hitting streak that began Feb. 26 vs. UMBC at the Wake Forest Invitational in Winston-Salem, N.C. come to end Wednesday against No. 2 Kentucky after he recorded an 0-for-4 day.
- ▶ During the streak, Bielek hit .415 (22 of 53) with 13 RBIs and .429 on-base and .547 slugging percentages.
- ▶ Twice during the streak, Bielek recorded a 4-for-5 game: Game 1 of a March 3 doubleheader vs. Oakland; and the second game of a doubleheader on March 10 vs. Chicago State.

**BIELEK NAMED TO BIG EAST HONOR ROLL**

- ▶ Freshman 3B Joey Bielek was named to the weekly BIG EAST Conference Baseball Honor Roll on March 6 after hitting .438 (7 for 16) with four RBI and a .500 slugging percentage during UC's four-game series against Oakland.
- ▶ In the first game of a doubleheader on March 3, Bielek hit a walk-off, two-RBI single in the bottom

of the ninth inning to lift UC past Oakland 5-4 and finished the game with a career-high four hits in five at-bats.

**LOOK WHO'S BACK**

- ▶ Cincinnati returns 19 letterwinners from 2011, including seven of eight position players from a UC team that went 30-27 and finished fourth in the BIG EAST with a 14-13 record.
- ▶ UC returns 68.5 percent of its home runs from last year, led by 1B Nic Spence's six and OF/C Braden Kline's five.
- ▶ The Bearcats also return 63.4 percent of its RBI from 2011, led by Justin Glass' 45 and Braden Kline's 31.

**THREE 'CATS EARN PRESEASON HONORS**

- ▶ So. OF/Justin Glass, Sr. OF/C Braden Kline and Jr. OF Jake Proctor were all named 2012 preseason All-Buckeye State baseball honorees by FOX Sports Ohio.
- ▶ Last season, Glass batted .326 with four home runs and 45 RBI in 57 games on his way to being named a second-team All-BIG EAST Conference honoree, as well as a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American. Additionally, the 6-foot-2 left-handed slugger was named to the 2011 BIG EAST/Big Ten Challenge All-Tournament Team and was the MVP of '11 Joe Nuxhall Classic during his freshman campaign
- ▶ Kline hit .326 with five home runs and 31 RBI after moving from catcher to the outfield last year, and was named a third-team all-conference choice. The 6-foot-1 power hitter finished the season in the BIG EAST top 10 in home runs (5 - 16th) and hitting (.356 - ninth) during league play.
- ▶ After starting 56 of 57 games in the outfield in 2011, Proctor ended the season with a .286 batting average with a team-best 51 runs scored, 30 RBI and three home runs. In 23 attempts, the 6-foot-2 speedster led the Bearcats with 21 stolen bases, which were just three shy of cracking the UC all-time single-season top 10.
- ▶ Glass and Kline each now have two preseason honors to their names after both were named 2012 Preseason All-BIG EAST selections by College Sports Madness.

**UC PICKED SEVENTH IN BIG EAST PRESEASON POLL**

- ▶ For the second consecutive year, the Bearcats were picked to finish in seventh in the BIG EAST Preseason Coaches Poll.
- ▶ St. John's was chosen as the favorite to take the 2012 title in the BIG EAST preseason coaches' poll.

- ▶ Glass started all 57 games for UC as the designated hitter and finished second on the team with a .326 batting average with four home runs, 45 RBI and nine stolen bases. Glass is the seventh freshman all-American recipient in UC history.
- ▶ In 2010, right-hander Andrew Streng was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America.

**UC SHOWS OFFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT DESPITE NEW NCAA REGULATIONS**

- ▶ The 2011 college baseball season marked the initial year of the NCAA's Batted Ball Coefficient of Restitution (BBCOR) bat standards. As designed, BBCOR bats greatly reduce offensive efficiency; however, the opposite was true for the UC offense
- ▶ The Bearcats increased their runs scored per game from 4.9 in 2010 to 5.6 in 2011. Comparatively across NCAA Division I baseball, scoring was down 1.35 runs per game per team from 2010.
- ▶ UC also raised its team batting average from .251 in 2010 to .285 in 2011, while nationally, team batting averages were down by .026 points from 2010.

**JENSEN CONTINUES UC'S MLB DRAFT STREAK**

- ▶ Senior right-handed pitcher Dan Jensen was selected in the 20th round (No. 625 overall) by the Cincinnati Reds in the 2011 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.
- ▶ Jensen led the Bearcats with a 3.11 ERA and 87 Ks in 89.2 innings pitched. His 56 strikeouts during BIG EAST play ranked third in the conference. With the Reds' drafting of Jensen, UC has now had at least one player selected in the MLB First-Year Player Draft in each of the past seven years.

**REWRITING THE RECORD BOOK**

- ▶ Two graduated Bearcats ended stellar careers following the conclusion of the 2011 baseball season.
- ▶ Senior shortstop Chris Peters finished his career playing in 225 games, which ranks fourth in the all-time UC career record book. Peters, who signed a free-agent contract with the Toronto Blue Jays in June of 2011, also ended his Bearcats career in the top 10 in at-bats - 827 (3rd), walks - 118 (4th), sacrifice hits - 18 (tied for 5th), stolen bases - 49 (6th), hits - 226 (7th), runs - 155 (8th) and doubles - 46 (9th).
- ▶ Senior outfielder Justin Riddell concluded his four-year playing career sitting in the UC top 10 in games played - 203 (7th), RBI - 141 (7th), total bases - 343 (8th), at-bats - 699 (8th) and hits - 217 (9th). Riddell's 67 RBI in 2011 ranks 6th on the all-time UC single-season record book.

# HEAD COACH BRIAN CLEARY



In 16 seasons at the University of Cincinnati, Brian Cleary has established himself as one of the top coaches in UC baseball history. After taking over a struggling program in 1997, Cleary has led the Bearcats to 405 wins in his career, breaking the school record for all-time wins previously owned by the legendary Glenn Sample.

Cleary has established a strong core of athletes. Due to his energy and passion to deliver a winning product for the University, he has upgraded the talent level within the program thanks to an emphasis on aggressive recruiting. With the influx of talent, Cleary has set his sights on taking the program to the NCAA Tournament after a 30-plus year absence.

For the past six seasons, Cleary has rebuilt a team that's poised to contend for BIG EAST championships. With the completion of the state-of-the-art Marge Schott Stadium and the signing of multiple top recruiting classes, the foundation has been built to allow Cincinnati to compete for BIG EAST Championships and NCAA Tournament appearances for years to come.

For the fourth consecutive year, UC advanced to the BIG EAST Championship in 2011 after tying for fourth place with a 14-13 conference record. The Bearcats' 30-27 overall record in 2011 marked their sixth straight non-losing season. The '11 campaign saw the development of several young players, highlighted by freshman DH Justin Glass and junior LF/C Braden Kline, who were named second and third-team All-BIG EAST selections, respectively, in their first full-time seasons. It also featured the further skill advancement of multiple veterans, such as seniors Justin Riddell and Dan Jensen. Riddell was named an All-BIG EAST First Team selection after finishing second in the conference in RBI. Jensen was one of the league's most dominant

pitchers after finishing third in strikeouts on his way to being drafted by the Cincinnati Reds in the 20th round of the MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Cincinnati produced back-to-back 29-29 overall records in 2009 and 2010, advancing to the conference tournament both seasons. Three Bearcats - Andrew Burkett, Brian Garman and Jimmy Jacquot - were named third-team All-BIG EAST honorees following the 2010 season. Burkett set the single-season school records for saves with 14. Freshman RHP Andrew Strenge was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American after setting the BIG EAST single-season record with a 0.62 ERA. Strenge finished 2010 as the league leader in conference-only play not only in ERA, but in opponents' batting average (.208), hits allowed (22), runs allowed (5), earned runs allowed (2), and walks allowed (1).

Regarded as one of the top coaches in country to develop hitters, Cleary has coached 42 position players that have either been drafted or signed as a free agent, only seven of which were drafted out of high school. One of those 42 players was Mike Spina, who cemented himself as one of the top hitters in Bearcats history in just two years of action. After breaking UC's single-season home run record and tying the program's single-season RBI record with 21 home runs and 79 RBI in 2008, Spina drove in 69 runs and broke his own single-season home runs record with 23 in 2009. Additionally, Spina ranks in the Top 10 in UC's career record books in slugging percentage (.703, 1st), home runs (44, 3rd), on-base percentage (.443, 4th), and RBI (148, 6th).

The fortunes of the Bearcats were never better in 2008 as Cleary's charges set a school record for wins in a season (39) and conference wins in a season (19). UC battled for the BIG EAST Regular Season Championship all year, finishing second in the standings and advancing to the Championship game of the postseason tournament. At the conclusion of the year, another mark was matched as four of Cleary's players were selected in the MLB Draft (Josh Harrison, Dan Osterbrock, Tony Campana and Mike Spina). None of those players were drafted out of high school.

The progression began to show dividends during the 2006 season as Cleary guided the Bearcats to their sixth 30-win season ever and first post-season appearance since 2001. Following the season, Logan Parker became the 11th draft pick in the Cleary era when the Cincinnati Reds selected him in the 12th round of the MLB Draft.

The 2005 season brought an improvement of 10 victories from the year before, as the Bearcats finished the campaign with a 25-30 mark. The season concluded with Josh Kay and Mark Haske both being selected in the MLB Draft. Later in 2005, UC's recruiting class received honorable mention nationally from Collegiate Baseball magazine.

In 2001, UC garnered 34 wins, the second-most in school history, and went 16-11 in Conference USA to finish tied for third. That finish is the best ever by a Bearcat team in Conference USA. Kevin Youkilis was a third-team all-American and one of three Bearcats taken in the 2001 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft. Tony Maynard was named a freshman All-American, and Chris Hamblen was a finalist for the Johnny Bench Award, given to the top catcher in the nation. That season, Baseball America named Cleary one of the Top-10 coaches on the rise in Division I.

In 2000, the Bearcats won a school record 35 games and advanced to the finals of the C-USA Tournament. The squad also set four individual and eight school records.

The 1999 squad posted a breakthrough 30-29 season, shattering 17 individual and eight team records and finishing as the eighth most improved team in the nation (12-game improvement). The 30 wins marked just the third 30-win season in UC's 115 years of baseball and the first winning campaign since 1995.

Cleary made an immediate impact upon joining the Bearcat family. After inheriting a team that won only five games in 1996, Cleary pushed his teams to increased win totals each of his first four years. After winning 12 games in his first year, he increased that total to 15 in 1998, 30 in 1999 and 35 in 2000.

Alongside his experience on the collegiate level, Cleary has also served two stints coaching on the international level. Cleary coached the British National Team in the Baseball World Cup (2009) and the European Championships (2007). During his time with the teams, Cleary served as an assistant coach and worked primarily with the pitchers, helping the squad capture a second-place finish at the European Championships in 2007 and a second-round appearance at the Baseball World Cup in 2009.

Cleary came to UC after three seasons at Tulane, where he helped the Green Wave to a 116-70 mark and two NCAA Tournament appearances. Cleary's efforts as an associate head coach, assistant coach and recruiting coordinator helped Tulane to the 1996 C-USA championship and a top-25 national ranking. In addition to his duties as recruiting coordinator, Cleary coached the hitters, infielders and baserunners and served as the team's third-base coach.

A 1990 graduate of Fairfield University, Cleary, a native of Boca Raton, Fla. earned four letters and was a two-time Metro Atlantic Conference All-Academic team pick.
