Focus of the Month

KYSU Lack of Institutional Control

- A Former Kentukcy State President directed athletics department staff to impermissibly certify the eligibility of a former football student-athleteso he could compete for an additional season.
- The violations occurred after the school determined that a football student-athlete had exhausted his eligibility following 10 full semesters of collegiate enrollment.
- The school submitted a waiver request, and the former president then called a meeting where he pressured athletics staff to certify the student-athlete's eligibility. After that meeting, the former athletics director withdrew the waiver request and based on the former president's direction, the school improperly certified the student-athlete and knowingly permitted him to participate in competition.
- Ultimately the student-athlete went on to compete in eight games and received actual and necessary expenses while ineligible.
- Penalties included:
 - Two years of probation.
 - A \$2,000 fine.
 - A vacation of records of contests in which the student-athlete participated while ineligible.
 - A two-year show-cause order for the former president, during which time he will be prohibited from any involvement in eligibility certification for student-athletes.
 - An external audit or review of Kentucky State's compliance program and certification and eligibility processes during the probationary period.

IS THIS PERMISSIBLE?

Brooks DeChambeau is a DI Student-Athlete golfer for Jupiter University and over summer break he wants to get a job teaching golf lessons at his home course. Is this permissible?

Answer: Yes, with the following conditions:

- a) Institutional facilities are not used;
- (b) Playing lessons shall not be permitted;
- (c) The compensation is paid by the lesson recipient (or the recipient's family member) and not another individual or entity;
- (d) Instruction to each individual is comparable to the instruction that would be provided during a private lesson when the instruction involves more than one individual at a time; and
- (e) The student-athlete's name, picture or appearance is not used to promote or advertise the availability of fee-for-lesson sessions.
