CINCINNATI - The University of Cincinnati volleyball team welcomes West Virginia for Education Day on Thursday. First serve is scheduled for 11 a.m. inside Fifth Third Arena.

The Bearcats will then travel to Colorado for a 2 p.m. ET matchup on Saturday in Boulder. Both matches will be streamed on ESPN+.

- Cincinnati split a pair of road matches last week, sweeping UCF in straight sets on Wednesday before a four-set loss to Houston on Friday. The win over UCF marked Cincinnati's first season sweep of the Knights since 2019. Cincinnati hit .274 and received a match-high 16 kills from outside hitter Carly Glendinning in the victory.
- Freshman libero Faith Frame continues to shine, recording double-digit digs in 16 matches this season. Her 4.05 digs per set rank sixth in the Big 12, and she's averaging 4.42 digs over the last three matches.
- Fellow freshman Lilly Gillespie has also stepped up defensively, averaging 3.08 digs per set in the past three matches, including a career-best 16 digs against Texas Tech. Gillespie played a key role against Houston, serving during a stretch when the Bearcats fought off seven set points in the second set.
- Sophomore middle blocker Zeta Washington tallied a season-high 12 kills at a .417 hitting percentage against Texas Tech, and she's contributing 1.63 kills and 0.73 blocks per set in conference play.
- Freshman Gretchen Sigman has been an asset on the right side in recent matches, averaging 1.05 kills, 1.16 digs, and 0.37 aces per set over the last four games.
- The Bearcats have used a 6-2 rotation in their last seven matches, with Katelyn Lefler and Caroline Endres handling the setting duties. Lefler made her return to the court at Baylor after missing the Kansas match with an injury. She has recorded eight double-doubles this season and ranks ninth in the league in assists per set (8.95). She had 36 assists and 11 digs vs. Houston.
- Junior Carly Glendinning leads the Bearcats in multiple categories, including kills (3.72), points (4.18), and aces (0.26) per set. She ranks fifth in the Big 12 for both kills and points per set, leading the team in kills in 14 matches and posting double-digit kills in 15, with five matches surpassing 20 kills. She's recorded 16 or more kills in the last three outings.
- Sophomore Sydney Nolan is second on the team in kills (2.68) and third in digs (2.05). She has reached double-digit kills in 12 matches and boasts five double-doubles on the season.
- Senior Abby Walker is a defensive standout, ranking fifth in the Big 12 in blocks per set (1.12) and 12th in hitting percentage (.339). She has led the team in blocks 16 times and has five or more blocks in seven matches
- Cincinnati ranks fourth in the conference with 2.25 blocks per set, and their 15-block performance against Bowling Green remains the league's top showing for a three-set match.
- Cincinnati is 12-1 when outhitting opponents.
- Walker needs 27 more kills away to reach 1,000 and two more aces to reach 100 in her career. Endres also stands close to 1,000 career assists, needing just 112 more to reach the mark.
- Head coach Molly Alvey is one victory away from securing her 200th win at Cincinnati.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- Cincinnati leads the all-time series vs. WVU, 14-3. The two teams split the series a season ago. Prior to that, Cincinnati had won nine straight against WVU.
- UC will be meeting Colorado for the second time in program history. The two teams faced off in 2006 at Colorado's Invitational, resulting in a sweep for the Buffaloes.

#### **SEASON SWEPT 'EM**

- Cincinnati took down UCF in straight sets on Oct. 5 in Orlando. The win marked Cincinnati's first season sweep of the Knights since 2019. Cincinnati hit .274 and received a match-high 16 kills from outside hitter Carly Glendinning in the victory.
- Defensively, Faith Frame and Lilly Gillespie anchored the back row, accounting for 25 of Cincinnati's 43 digs.
- The Bearcats only committed two service errors, after committing 26 the two matches prior. Conversely, UCF had 15 service errors in the match.
- Zeta Washington and Fallon Stewart also made contributions in their Florida homecoming, combining for seven kills.

### THE FUTURE IS BRIGHT

- Faith Frame has been recognized as one of eight standout freshmen on NCAA correspondent Michella Chester's mid-season top freshman list, released on October 20. The list highlighted freshmen who are having breakout seasons in
- Notably, Frame is the only Big 12 volleyball player included, as well as the sole libero on the list. She has also earned the title of Big 12 Rookie of the Week twice this season.

#### STUDENT-ATHLETE OF THE BIG 12 MONTH

- Junior Carly Glendinning has been honored as Cincinnati's Big 12 Student-Athlete of the Month for September. Selected for the conference-wide recognition, she is celebrated as one of the "best of the best.
- This award acknowledges athletes who excel in their sport while also demonstrating leadership, perseverance, and a strong commitment to academics and community service. Introduced last season, Glendinning is the second volleyball player to receive this accolade, following Abby Walker's recognition last November.

Middle blocker Zeta Washington showcased her artistic flair by custom designing and painting Nike Dunks for both the staff and players. Known for her creativity, she combined her passion for graphic design with her talent for art.



#### TWICE AS NICE

- Freshman libero Faith Frame was named Big 12 Rookie of the Week for the second time this season. the conference announced on Tuesday, Oct. 8. She is the first Cincinnati volleyball player to win multiple Big 12 weekly awards in a season.
- She totaled 30 digs on the week for a 4.29 digs per set average. She recorded a match-high 17 digs in UC's sweep of UCF. The total helped the Bearcats be plus-12 in the category (59-47).

#### **FLIPPED THE SCRIPT**

- Cincinnati launched its Big 12 home slate with a commanding sweep over UCF on Oct. 5. The Bearcats picked up their first win over UCF since 2019, snapping a nine-match losing skid to the Knights. The victory was significant for the senior class, as it represented their first win against their former AAC rivals.
- The defensive duo of Faith Frame and Julie Wittekind shined in the straight-set victory. They combined for 30 of UC's 59 digs and helped the Bearcats be plus-12 in the category (59-47). Frame posted a match-high 17 digs while Wittekind finished with a career-high 13.

#### A LONG-AWAITED RETURN

- · Fifth year right side Irbe Lazda made her muchanticipated season debut vs. Iowa State after missing the first 12 matches due to injury. She came off the bench in the second set and finished with six kills and four blocks.
- Sophomore middle blocker Zeta Washington, who also faced injury challenges early in the season, added a match-high six blocks in three sets vs. ISU.

#### **BIG 12-OPENING SWEEP**

- Cincinnati kicked off its Big 12 campaign with a sweep over West Virginia on September 25 in Morgantown. The victory marked the Bearcats' second consecutive win in a league road opener.
- UC improved to 10-3 in conference openers under head coach Molly Alvey.
- Cincinnati extended their win streak to seven in row, their longest since 2019, when the Bearcats won 11 consecutive victories.
- Senior Molly Harrison's serving was a game changer for the Bearcats. She ignited two key scoring runs, starting with a 6-0 spurt in the first set. When UC was trailing by three in the second set, Harrison stepped up again with a 4-0 run that featured two

#### **NON-CON NUGGETS**

- The Bearcats concluded non-conference play with a 9-2 record, their most non-conference wins since the 2018 season. The .818 winning percentage was the fifth-best among Big 12 teams.
- The non-conference winning percentage is also the Bearcats' best since the 2003 season (.867, 13-2).
- The Bearcats earned five sweeps, their most in nonconference play since 2019.
- Abby Walker and Katelyn Lefler were named to the Best Western Invitational All-Tournament Team while Walker and Sydney Nolan earned All-Tournament accolades at the Bellarmine Classic.

# FRAME NAMED BIG 12 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

- Freshman libero Faith Frame has been named Big 12 Rookie of the Week, the conference announced on Tuesday. Frame averaged a conference-leading 5.14 digs per set in a 2-0 week for the Bearcats.
- She posted a career-high 27 digs in the Bearcats' four-set win over crosstown rival Xavier. The 27 digs were the most in a match by a Conference player during the week. Frame is Cincinnati's second weekly Big 12 award winner, joining Zeta Washington (rookie) from Sept. 5, 2023.

#### **INJURY BUG BITES BEARCATS**

- The team has dealt with significant injury challenges over the past two seasons. The 2024 campaign was no different with Zeta Washington and Irbe Lazda both sidelined with injuries to start the year.
- Washington, who was out with a thumb injury, made her return to the court vs. Kent State (Sept. 14). Lazda made her season debut at Iowa State (Oct. 2).
- In 2023, the Bearcats lost their two starting outside hitters prior to Big 12 play. In total, six Bearcats missed at least one match due to injury.
- Two seasons ago, the team was without its starting setter, and Ligia Williams suffered a season-ending injury after just six matches.

#### 250 FOR ALVEY

Head coach Molly Alvey earned her 250th career win with a three-set victory over Chicago State on Aug. 31. She took Cincinnati to the NCAA Tournament in 2016 and 2018 before leading the Bearcats to one of the greatest seasons in school history in 2019. She guided the Bearcats to a first-ever Sweet 16 appearance in the NCAA Tournament and an American Athletic Conference regular season championship.

#### **RETURNING TALENT**

- Cincinnati returns 12 letterwinners, including four starters, from a season ago. The Bearcats bring back four of their top six point scorers, including Zeta Washington (3.44 pts/s) and Abby Walker (3.01 pts/s).
- Setter Katelyn Lefler returns at the setter position after dishing out 1,011 assists last season. She was the first Bearcat since 2019 to eclipse 1,000 assists in a single season.
- Cincinnati returns 78.8% of its blocking, 72.7% of its point-scoring and 70.8% of its kill production.

#### **NEW 'CATZ ON THE BLOCK**

- Cincinnati welcomes eight newcomers to the 2024 roster, including six true freshmen and two transfers.
- UC's freshman class features Janelle Green, Faith Frame, Fallon Stewart, Gretchen Sigman, Amanda Mack and Lilly Gillespie. The Class of 2024 was ranked No. 37 by Prep Dig, marking the second consecutive year with a top-40 recruiting class for the Bearcats.
- Transfers Sydney Nolan (UNC) and Irbe Lazda (Towson) also join the Bearcats.

# IMPACT TRANSFERS POISED TO LEAD BEARCATS

- Transfers Irbe Lazda (Towson) and Sydney Nolan (UNC) bring a wealth of experience to the 2024 squad and will look to make an immediate impact on the court.
- Lazda, a 6-foot-3 right side, joins the Bearcats after an impressive three-season stint at Towson (2021-23), where she led the Tigers to two NCAA Tournaments. She will be using the NCAA's extra year of eligibility, having initially begun her collegiate career at UTEP (2019-20).
- Nolan, a 6-foot-4 outside hitter, arrives in Clifton after a standout freshman season at UNC. She earned ACC All-Freshman honors, led UNC with a .391 hitting percentage (7th in the ACC), and averaged 1.06 blocks per set. She will shift to the outside hitter position, a role she played in club.

#### **BACK FOR MORE**

- Named to the Big 12 All-Rookie Team, Zeta Washington made history as the first Bearcat to earn a yearly Big 12 volleyball honor. She led the Bearcats with a .316 hitting percentage and ranked second on the team in both kills (250) and blocks (88) in 2023.
- Washington posted 13 double-digit kill performances as a freshman, including 10 in conference play, and recorded five or more blocks in eight matches.
- One of her standout moments came in her collegiate debut, where she delivered a 25-kill performance (25k-2e-42a) in a four-set victory over Kennesaw State.

#### **ABBY UNLEASHED**

- Walker, a 6-foot-1 middle blocker, has been a cornerstone of the Bearcats' volleyball program, playing in every set over the last three seasons (333). She led the team in points (325), kills (260), and service aces (23), while also ranking second in hitting percentage (.277) and third in blocks (78) in 2023.
- Due to team injuries over the past two seasons, she has split her time between the right side and middle blocker positions.
- She was a two-time All-Conference selection in the American and named its Freshman of the Year in 2021.

#### QUEEN CITY CONNECTION

- Former high school teammates and best friends Sydney Nolan and Kayla Hostetler are set to reunite on the court as they compete for the Bearcats this season. The duo attended Notre Dame Academy in Northern Kentucky.

- She was also the second Bearcat to medal from the 2024 Paris Olympic Games, joining Annette Echikunwoke (silver, hammer throw).
- One particularly special moment occurred off the court in Paris when Thompson connected with her former college coach, Molly Alvey, before the team's final pool play match.

"I have a really close relationship with that whole coaching staff still, so to have Coach Molly come over and have time to share this experience with her, it meant a lot because she played a massive role in me getting to this point," Thompson said to NCAA.org. "To say that her impact was huge is an understatement. She helped me not only as a player, but as a person and growing into the woman that I am today. She had confidence for me when I didn't have it for myself and really pushed me because she saw the potential and so that meant the world to me. feel like it's not just an amazing experience for me, but to share that with her I think is such a gift and I feel really honored."

  The award, initiated in the 1992–93 academic
- year, honors collegiate and high school volleyball teams that display excellence in the classroom by maintaining at least a 3.30 cumulative team GPA.

- Glendinning continues to make impressive strides both on and off the court. As an industrial management major and a member of the Lindner Business Honors program, she is committed to excelling in her academic pursuits.

- · The Big 12 finished the 2023 season with five ranked teams, the most for the league since 2009 and tied for the most in Big 12 history.
- The Conference had seven teams selected to the Women's Volleyball Championship, the second time in the last three years the Big 12 has placed seven teams into the tournament.
- Four new teams join the Big 12 in Arizona State (preseason pick No. 3), Utah (preseason pick No. 9), Colorado (preseason pick No. 10), Arizona (preseason pick No. 12).
