THE RUNDOWN

- Cincinnati is coming off a 74-53 setback to No. 21-ranked Baylor on Tuesday. The Bearcats closed out their home slate with an 8-7 record inside Fifth Third Arena.
- The Bearcats (13-15, 5-12) sit 11th in the league standings and will enter the 2024 Phillips 66 Big 12 Women's Basketball Championship next week, hosted March 7-12 at the T-Mobile Center in Kansas City, Mo.
- Senior Jillian Hayes registered her 22nd double-figure scoring performance with a team-high 13 points (7-8 FT) vs. Baylor. She is averaging nearly a double-double with 12.9 points and 8.6 rebounds and is shooting 42.3% from the field this season. She sits third in the Big 12 and 71st nationally in rebounding (8.6).
- Sophomore Ariel Jackson has been a spark for the Bearcats in Big 12 action, averaging 10.4 points, 3.1 rebounds and 2.0 assists during the stretch.
- Senior Malea Williams sits ninth in the Big 12 in blocks per game (1.0). She has recorded eight multi-block performances and has led the team in blocks 15 times this season. She currently ranks sixth in blocks (95) in program history and is three blocks away from 100 in her career after recording two her freshman year at Louisville.
- One of the nation's top-rebounding teams, Cincinnati has outrebounded its opponent in 19 games this season and has either won or matched the rebounding battle in 13 of its 17 Big 12 contests (+3.6 margin).
- UC sits first in the league and 17th in the country in offensive rebounds per game (15.1). The Bearcats also pace the league with 14.3 offensive boards/contest in Big 12 play.
- The Bearcats lead the Big 12 and rank 15th nationally in free throws made per game (15.7). Cincinnati has made 613 trips to the free throw line this season, sinking 440 of its attempts (.718).
- Hayes is getting to the free throw line at a high rate, making the most foul shots in the Big 12 (135-186 FT). Her makes and attempts both rank sixth for a single season in UC history.
- Cincinnati is 12-0 when leading at the half, and 11-0 when leading with five minutes remaining. Conversely, the Bearcats are 1-15 when trailing at the break, and 1-15 when trailing with five minutes to go. The Bearcats overcame a first-half deficit for the first time this season at UCF (Feb. 7).
- Cincinnati has totaled 1,139 rebounds in 2023-24. The Bearcats would need 215 more rebounds to break the single season program record (1,354).
- The Bearcats boast a +5.4 rebounding margin and 40.7 rebounding average this season. Both marks would rank fifth for a single season in program history.
- Cincinnati came in at No. 92 in the Feb. 27 NET rankings. The Big 12 is the only conference with all of its members inside the Top 100 of the NET.

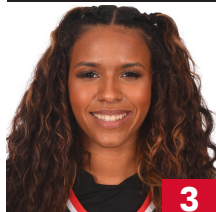

MILESTONE WATCH

- Hayes moved into third all-time at UC in career blocks with 124. She is seven blocks away from a second-place tie with Il'mar'l Thomas (2018-21) with 131.
- Hayes became just the fifth player in program history to reach 800 career rebounds. She is 46 rebounds away from a fourth-place tie with Doris Scott (1996-99) with 861.
- Hayes cracked inside the top-5 in UC history in free throws made with 379. She is the only player in UC women's basketball history to record over 1,000 points, 800 rebounds, 300 free throws, 170 steals and 120 blocks in their career.
- Senior Malea Williams moved into sole possession of sixth all-time at UC in blocks with 95 in three seasons with the Bearcats. She is five blocks away from a fifth-place tie with Jeanise Randolph (2011-14) with 100.
- Williams has totaled 97 blocks in her collegiate career after blocking two shots during her freshman season at Louisville.

WRECKED 'EM, AGAIN

- Cincinnati snapped a four-game losing skid with a 68-56 road win over Texas Tech on Feb. 24 in Lubbock. A big second quarter (22-10) fueled the Bearcats to a win in which they led by as many as 22. The Bearcats picked up their second season sweep of a conference opponent this season.
- Cincinnati improved to 8-1 when holding an opponent to 59 points or less. The Bearcats held the Lady Raiders to 33% from the floor and 24% from behind the arc.
- UC won the rebounding battle for the 13th time in Big 12 play, owning a plus-14 advantage on the glass (45-31) which resulted in 17 second-chance points.
- Four Bearcats finished in double figures, led by Texas native Reagan Jackson's 16 points and career-high four three-pointers. Senior Jillian Hayes poured in her ninth double-double of the season with 15 points and a team-high 10 rebounds.
- Sophomore Ariel Jackson recorded 14 points and a career-high seven rebounds while redshirt junior Ta'Ziah Jenks had 12 and six.

CRASH THE BOARDS

- Cincinnati has outrebounded its opponent in 19 games this season and has either won or matched the rebounding battle in 13 of its 17 Big 12 contests (+3.6 margin).
- UC sits first in the league and 17th in the country in offensive rebounds per game (15.1).
- The Bearcats also pace the league with 14.3 offensive boards/contest in Big 12 play. Cincinnati has recorded 20-plus offensive rebounds in four Big 12 games.
- The Bearcats boast a +5.4 rebounding margin and 40.7 rebounding average this season. Both marks would rank fifth for a single season in program history.
- Cincinnati has totaled 1,139 rebounds in 2023-24. The Bearcats would need 215 more rebounds to break the single season program record (1,354).

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED

- Following UC's loss to Houston on Jan. 30, head coach Katrina Merriweather challenged senior Jillian Hayes to take her game to another level.
- "The way she practiced the last couple of days, especially yesterday, is exactly why she had 18 and 12 (against Texas Tech)," said Merriweather in the postgame presser. "That wasn't anyboy but her, stepping up and responding. When she did that, the team followed... the tenacity she brought to practice translated to everyone else and the game."
- Since the Texas road trip, Hayes has averaged 15.5 points, 9.8 rebounds, 1.1 blocks and 1.3 steals over eight games. She has turned in four double-doubles during the stretch, and helped UC grab three conference wins.

SEASON SWEEP 'EM

- Cincinnati outlasted UCF, 67-61, in a back-and-forth battle on Feb. 7 in Orlando, Fla. The Bearcats snapped a six-game losing streak in Orlando for their first season sweep of the Knights since 2014.
- The Bearcats earned their first road win in Big 12 action as well as their 12th overall win -- their most wins in a season since 2019-20.
- Senior Jillian Hayes finished with her second straight double-double with team highs in points (13) and rebounds (11) vs. UCF. It was her seventh double-double of the season, and 20th of her career. She also made her 100th consecutive start in the win.
- Redshirt junior Ta'Ziah Jenks scored 10 points (4-8 FG) vs. UCF, including the turnaround jumper with 50 seconds to go to seal the victory.
- Junior Clarissa Craig went a perfect 4-for-4 from the floor (12 points) vs. UCF.
- Cincinnati shot 41.8% from the floor (23-55 FG). The Bearcats' defense held UCF to 32.2% from the field (19-59 FG) and 15.8% from 3-point range (3-19 3FG).

A TOTAL TEAM TAKEDOWN

- Cincinnati outscored Texas Tech 24-7 in the fourth quarter to run away with a 74-56 win on Feb. 3 in Fifth Third Arena. UC earned its third Big 12 victory and eighth overall home win.
- The Bearcats owned a commanding plus-17 advantage on the glass vs. TTU (43-26) and pulled down 21 offensive boards which resulted in 23 second-chance points and 44 points in the paint.
- Cincinnati had a season-high 13 steals and scored 23 points off Texas Tech's 19 turnovers.
- Senior Jillian Hayes led the Bearcats vs. TTU with her sixth double-double of the season, 19th of her career. She finished with team highs in points (18) and rebounds (12) and added season highs in blocks (3) and steals (3) in the all-around performance.
- Ariel Jackson posted 13 points (6-12 FG) to go along with four rebounds and four assists while junior Ta'Ziah Jenks recorded a season-high 13 points on 6-of-10 shooting. Six Bearcats finished with six-or-more points in the win.
- Cincinnati women's basketball beat Texas Tech in Cincinnati and just a few hours later the men's team got the win over Texas Tech, 75-72, in Lubbock.

NUMBERS TO KNOW**15.7**

The Bearcats lead the Big 12 and rank 15th nationally in free throws made per game (15.7). Cincinnati has made 613 trips to the free throw line this season, making 440 of its attempts (.718).

BUZZER-BEATING BEARCATS STRIKE AGAIN!

- Senior Malea Williams notched the game-winning steal and score as Cincinnati defeated Oklahoma State, 58-56, on Jan. 24 in Fifth Third Arena. Williams broke up OSU's hand-off to lead her to the game-winning fastbreak layup with 2.7 seconds left.
- The back-and-forth battle featured nine ties and six lead changes, including four of each in the final quarter. UC improved to 3-0 in games decided by five points or fewer.
- Cincinnati received valuable contributions from its bench, owning a plus-19 advantage in the category (23-4). The Bearcats committed just 11 turnovers vs. OSU — its second lowest total of the season and fewest of Big 12 play.
- Jillian Hayes played in her 100th career game and finished with 10 points and six rebounds. Ta'Ziah Jenks and Reagan Jackson each finished with nine points and six boards, as well.

IN JILLIAN WE TRUST

- Cincinnati native Jillian Hayes is averaging nearly a double-double with 12.9 points and 8.6 rebounds and is shooting 42.3% from the field this season. She sits third in the Big 12 and 71st nationally in rebounding (8.6).
- She has recorded nine double-doubles in 2023-24, including back-to-back in wins against Texas Tech (18 points, 12 rebounds) and UCF (13 points, 11 rebounds).
- She has recorded 22 double-digit scoring performances, including a trio of 20-point outings.
- She currently ranks third in blocks (124), fifth in rebounds (815) and free throws made (379) and eighth in steals (176) in program history.
- She has led the team in a variety of categories during the course of the season: scoring (16), rebounding (19), steals (11) and blocks (13).
- She played in her 100th career game in UC's 58-56 win over Oklahoma State on Jan. 24. She has made 106 career starts - all consecutive, dating back to Dec. 20, 2020.
- She turned in her eighth double-double of the season, 21st of her career, vs. Kansas on Feb. 14. She posted 15 points and a career-high 17 rebounds, with eight and 10 coming in the fourth quarter. The 17 rebounds are tied for the eighth-most in a Big 12 game this season.

BUZZER-BEATING BEARCATS

- Behind sophomore Ariel Jackson's late-game heroics, Cincinnati (9-6, 1-3 Big 12) pulled out a thrilling 64-63 win over UCF on Wednesday night inside Fifth Third Arena. Down by one with 14 seconds remaining (63-62), Ariel Jackson drove to the lane, missing her initial shot, and grabbed the offensive board for the game-winning putback with five tenths of a second on the clock.
- With the win, the Bearcats earned their first-ever Big 12 Conference victory. Cincinnati also matched its win total from a season ago under first year head coach Katrina Merriweather, who earned her 160th career win in the game.
- Senior Malea Williams recorded her third career double-double with 17 points to go along with 11 rebounds vs. UCF. She made a career-high seven field goals (7-11 FG) and added three assists and two blocks in a season-high 33 minutes of action.
- Sophomore Braylyn Milton finished with 12 points vs. UCF. She drained four three-pointers, with three coming in the first quarter.

INJURY BUG BITES THE BEARCATS

- Six Bearcats have missed at least one game this season due to injury. The Bearcats have not had their complete lineup since Nov. 24 vs. #10 NC State.
- Cincinnati was without three of its starters - Mya Jackson, Destiny Thomas and Braylyn Milton - in its Big 12 opener vs. #11 Kansas State on Dec. 30.
- Clarissa Craig missed the first 10 games of the season and made her debut in UC's 71-51 win over Siena on Dec. 21. She had 11 points (4-4 FG) and six rebounds in the victory.
- Sophomore Destiny Thomas made her return to the court vs. West Virginia on Jan. 20 after missing six games due to injury.
- The Bearcats have yet to play a game with Mya Jackson, Destiny Thomas and Clarissa Craig all available.

BIG BOARDS

- Seniors Jillian Hayes and Malea Williams each pulled down a career high in rebounds in Cincinnati's 58-56 win over Southern Indiana on Dec. 17 in Evansville, Ind. Hayes turned in her 17th career double-double with a then-career-high 16 rebounds to go along with 16 points (5-7 FG, 6-6 FT). Williams was two points shy of a double-double with career-high 14 rebounds and eight points.
- UC pulled down 52 rebounds (52-34) which resulted in 24 second-chance points in the win. In a critical fourth quarter, the Bearcats were plus-eight in rebounds (13-5) and grabbed six offensive boards.

1K FOR HAYES

- Senior Jillian Hayes surpassed 1,000 career points on December 13 as Cincinnati earned its fourth straight win, defeating Howard 87-62. She led four Bearcats in double figures with her ninth career 20-point effort. Entering the game, she needed 19 points to eclipse 1,000 points for her career. She hit the milestone in the third quarter and became the 30th player in program history to surpass 1,000 career points.
- The Bearcats earned their largest margin of victory vs. Howard on Dec. 13 (+25), for their fourth 21-plus point victory this season. The four wins by 21 points or more are the most in a single season since the Bearcats had seven in 2019-20.

QUEENS OF THE CITY

- Cincinnati earned its third straight victory on Dec. 10, defeating rival Xavier, 69-47, in the 45th Women's Skyline Chili Crosstown Shootout. It was UC's highest attended Crosstown Shootout in over a decade with 5,013 fans in attendance.
- Reagan Jackson led three Bearcats in double figures, finishing with a game-high 14 points. It marked her fourth straight game in double figures and third time leading the team in scoring.
- Head coach Katrina Merriweather improved to 6-0 in the Crosstown Shootout — four as a player (1997-01), one as a graduate assistant (2001-02) and one as head coach (2023-24).

NEW HEIGHTS

- Cincinnati debuted at No. 98 out of 360 NCAA DI teams in the initial NCAA Women's Basketball NET rankings of the 2023-24 season, released on Monday, Dec. 4. It marked Cincinnati's then highest-ever ranking in the NET era.
- The Big 12 was the only women's basketball conference with all of its members in the top 100 of the initial NET rankings. NET rankings -- which have been used since the 2020-21 season in women's college basketball, replacing the RPI metric -- are part of the criteria used by the Division I women's basketball committee to determine selection and seeding into the NCAA tournament.

PARADISE 'CATS

- Cincinnati earned a 65-41 win over SEC foe Kentucky in its final game of the Paradise Jam on Nov. 25 in the U.S. Virgin Islands. It marked Cincinnati's first win over an SEC opponent since Jan. 2, 2004, when the Bearcats defeated Kentucky, 60-52. It snapped a nine-game losing streak to SEC opponents.
- Hayes was named to the 2023 Paradise Jam All-Tournament Team. She averaged 10.7 points and 7.0 rebounds and shot 47.8% from the field over three games in the U.S. Virgin Islands.
- Sophomore Destiny Thomas tied her career-high 13 points on 6-of-8 shooting to go along with five rebounds vs. Kentucky.

ROCKET (THREE-POINT) POWER

- Cincinnati made 10 three-pointers during a 71-60 triumph over Toledo on Dec. 19. After not making a three-pointer vs. Lindenwood, Cincinnati bounced back with a much-improved 41.7 percent (10-24) in the victory. The 10 three-pointers fueled the Bearcats to a win in which they led by as many as 19 (57-38).
- Graduate student Mya Jackson led the way for the Bearcats, posting her ninth career 20-plus point effort with a team-high 22 points. She shot a sizzling 6-of-7 from behind the arc.
- Cincinnati limited the Rockets to 35.4 percent shooting (23-65), including a 11.8 percent mark (2-17) from behind the arc.
- Toledo was picked to finish first in the MAC preseason coaches poll. The Rockets won the 2023 MAC Tournament and advanced to the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament.

FIRST WIN OF THE KATRINA MERRIWEATHER ERA

- Cincinnati earned its first win of the 2023-24 season and Katrina Merriweather era on Nov. 15, defeating Lindenwood, 81-62. The Bearcats set a new program Education Day attendance record with 4,673 fans packed inside Fifth Third Arena.
- The Bearcats shot 47.1 percent from the field (32-68 FG) despite not making a three-point field goal (0-10 3FG). Cincinnati owned a +19 advantage on the glass (48-29) which resulted in 23 second-chance points. UC also owned a plus-36 advantage in points in the paint (60-24).
- Four Bearcats finished in double figures: Destiny Thomas (13), Jillian Hayes (13), Malea Williams (11) and Ariel Jackson (10). Hayes and Thomas pulled down 14 and 12 rebounds, respectively.

DOUBLE THE TROUBLE

- Sophomore Destiny Thomas recorded her first career double-double versus Lindenwood (Nov. 15), finishing with personal bests in points (13) and rebounds (12). She went a perfect 6-of-6 from the field and pulled down six offensive boards. She also led the team in assists with three.
- Senior Jillian Hayes recorded her first double-double of the season, 14th of her career, with 13 points and 14 rebounds.
- It marked the first time Cincinnati had two players post double-doubles in the same game since Ilmar'i Thomas and Angel Rizer did so against Houston on Feb. 18, 2020. Ilmar'i Thomas and Rizer recorded double-doubles in the same game three times during the 2019-20 season.

YOU'VE BEEN BLOCKED

- Cincinnati returned its top six shot blockers and 90 percent of its block production from 2022-23. Senior forward Jillian Hayes and senior forward Malea Williams are both back after combining for 88 blocks last season.
- Hayes moved into third all-time at UC in career blocks with 124. She is seven blocks away from a second-place tie with Ilmar'i Thomas (2018-21) with 131.
- Senior Malea Williams moved into sole possession of sixth all-time at UC in blocks with 95 in three seasons. She is five blocks away from a fifth-place tie with Jeanise Randolph (2011-14) with 100.
- Williams has 97 total blocks in her career after recording two blocks during her freshman season at Louisville. Her 49 blocks in 2022-23 rank second in UC history for a single season.

NEW ERA(S) BEGIN - MERRIWEATHER, BIG 12, JORDAN

- Head coach Katrina Merriweather was hired as the 10th women's basketball head coach at Cincinnati, her alma mater, on March 25, 2023. A four-year letterwinner for Hall of Fame head coach Laurie Pirtle from 1997-01, Merriweather was the program's first women's basketball player to make four consecutive postseason tournaments and posted an 83-41 record as a player. Additionally, she helped lead the program to its first-ever NCAA Tournament win as a graduate assistant in 2001-02.
- Merriweather returns to her alma mater with a 151-70 overall record in seven seasons as the head coach of Memphis (38-23) and Wright State (113-47). Most recently, Merriweather led Memphis to a 22-11 season in 2022-23, the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13, and an appearance in the WNIT Sweet 16.
- Cincinnati was one of four programs to become a member of the Big 12 on July 1. The Bearcats will also be a Jordan Brand program for the first time.

A LOT OF RETURNING PRODUCTION

- Cincinnati returns seven players from 2022-23. All seven averaged double-digit minutes and played in at least 25 of 30 games last season. The Bearcats return six of their top seven scorers from last season, including double-digit scorers in Jillian Hayes (12.8) and Mya Jackson (11.0).
- In terms of returning percentages from 2022-23, Cincinnati returns 75.5 percent of its points (1354/1794), 77.7 percent of its rebounds (749/966), 82.3 percent of its assists (293/356) and 72.6 percent of minutes played (4412/6075).
- The seven returners combine for 441 career games played and 245 starts. Five of the seven returners started double-digit games in 2022-23.

MORE ON MERRIWEATHER

- Merriweather spent five seasons at Wright State, where she led the Raiders to a 113-47 record, four postseason berths (2 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and was named Horizon League Coach of the Year three times. She led Wright State to the program's third appearance and first NCAA Tournament win with an upset over four-seed Arkansas in 2021.
- Katrina Merriweather was a team captain in 2000-01 and made 27 starts in 107 games played with 22 starts as a senior. She was a part of four postseason tournament appearances in her four seasons as a player and five postseason berths in her five years with the Bearcats. (Player - WNIT 1998, 2000, 2001, NCAA - 1999; GA NCAA - 2002).
- With Wright State, she was a three-time Horizon League Regular Season champion (2017, 2019, 2021) and two time Horizon League Regular Season champion (2019, 2021).
- As a head coach, she has made the postseason five times - four at Wright State and one at Memphis. She has coached 19 All-Conference honorees (16 - Wright State - Horizon League; 3 - Memphis - AAC).

JILLIAN HAYES IS BACK

- Senior forward Jillian Hayes remained home with her hometown Cincinnati Bearcats (Loveland High School) despite the coaching change after posting 12.8 points, 8.6 rebounds, 2.1 assists, 1.6 steals and 1.3 blocks in 31.6 minutes per game in 2022-23.
- Hayes led the team in multiple categories - starts, minutes, points, rebounds, steals - in 2022-23. It is the second straight season that she has led the team in starts, minutes, points, rebounds and steals.
- Hayes recorded 10 double-doubles in 2022-23, the most of any Bearcat since Shanice Johnson in 2016-17. She scored 10-plus points in 23 games in 2022-23.
- She led the team in rebounds in 23 games and had 11 games of 10-plus rebounds last season.
- Her points and rebound average has increased each season. Her rebound average has increased from 5.3 in 2020-21 to 6.8 to 2021-22 to 8.6 in 2022-23, while her point average has increased

from 7.6 in 2020-21 to 11.5 to 2021-22 to 12.8 in 2022-23.

- Hayes gets to the line at a high level - she has made 90-plus free throws each of the last two seasons.
- She is also an elite defensive presence, averaging 1.3 blocks and 1.6 steals per game in 2022-23. Hayes was responsible for 27 percent of the team's blocks and 21 percent of the steals.

MORE OF MYA (JACKSON) TO COME

- Graduate student Mya Jackson averaged 11.0 points, 2.7 rebounds, 2.6 assists in 32.4 minutes per game last season. She set career-high averages in points (11.0), assists (2.6) and minutes (32.4) in 2022-23. She posted 17 10-plus point games in 2022-23 and led the team in assists in 11 games and points in eight games. She recorded a career-high six assists with only one turnover at North Carolina A&T on Dec. 1, 2022.
- Jackson played all 45 minutes in the 71-74 (OT) loss to Toledo on Nov. 16, 2022. The 45 minutes played are the most by a Bearcat since Akira Levy totaled 48 minutes in an 87-77 (2OT) win over North Carolina A&T on Dec. 19, 2021. She was also the first Bearcat to play every minute of the game since Ilmar'i Thomas played all 40 minutes vs. South Florida on Dec. 22, 2020.
- She surpassed 1,000 career points after scoring 18 points versus Merriweather and Memphis on Jan. 14.

MORE OF (BRAYLYN) MILTON TO COME

- Junior guard Braylyn Milton looks to take the next steps after she averaged 4.2 points, 2.2 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.0 steals in 23.1 minutes per game in 2022-23.
- Milton led the team in assists in 10 games, including seven conference contests, in 2022-23. Her assist average increased from 1.3 as a freshman to 2.3 as a sophomore. She recorded a career-high eight assists at East Carolina on Jan. 18, 2023.
- She erupted for a career-high, game-high and individual Cincinnati season-high 28 points on 9-12 from the field, 5-5 from three in the 2022-23 season opener against No. 7 Louisville on Nov. 7, 2022. It was the most points scored by a Bearcat since Ilmar'i Thomas totaled 30 in the American Athletic Conference First Round against Memphis on Mar. 8, 2021 and the most points in an opener since Thomas had 34 against NKU on Nov. 25, 2020.

BIG 12 THINGS TO COME

- Cincinnati was one of four schools - BYU, Houston UCF - to join the Big 12 Conference on July 1.
- The Big 12 is one of the premier basketball conferences in the nation. 90 percent of Big 12 teams finished with a winning record in 2022-23, a feat that no other conference has accomplished since the formation of the Big 12 in 1994.
- A nation-leading - for the second straight year - 60 percent (six teams) were selected to the 2023 NCAA Tournament and 90 percent (nine teams) reached a postseason tournament - including 2023 WNIT Champion Kansas.
- Within the Bearcats' 18-game conference slate are nine home contests inside Fifth Third Arena and eight game versus teams that advanced to the 2023 NCAA Tournament. Cincinnati will face Kansas, Kansas State, Oklahoma and Texas Tech for the first time in program history.

THE FAB FIVE FRESHMEN

- Cincinnati added five freshmen in Katrina Merriweather's first recruiting class - guard Reagan Jackson (Kennedale, Texas), guard Abby Holtman (Florence, Ky.), forward Brianna Byars (Paris, Ky.), forward Ramiyah Byrd (Colorado Springs, Colo.) and center Delaney Snyder (Richmond, Va.).

CINCINNATI ADDS TALENT IN THE PORTAL

- Cincinnati added graduate student guard Nia Clarke, sophomore center Destiny Thomas and sophomore guard Aicha Dia.
- Thomas follows the staff from Memphis where she was named to the 2022-23 American Athletic Conference All-Freshman Team. She made 18 starts in 33 games - all 18 of her starts came straight starting versus SMU on Jan. 6, 2023. Thomas averaged 4.7 points and 5.8 rebounds on a team-high 55.0 percent from the field in 19.3 minutes per game for the Tigers last season.
- Clark, comes from Marquette where she started 13 games and played in 27 for the Golden Eagles, who advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- Clark is playing her fifth year of collegiate basketball and has been at the collegiate level for six seasons - sat out 2019-20 due to NCAA Transfer rules. Clark also played for Miami (OH) from 2018-19 and Xavier from 2020-22. The staff ties to Indianapolis, Ind. (hometown of head coach Katrina Merriweather; assistants Kabrina Merriweather and Ashley Barlow) helped land Clark (Ben Davis High School).
- Dia, joins the team from Penn State, where she played her freshman season in 2022-23. She is a long athletic forward/guard hybrid who has shined on the international stage, playing for Team Canada and most recently BAL Select at the GLOBL Jam.

UC TAKES CENTER STAGE AT BIG 12 TIPOFF

- Head coach Katrina Merriweather, senior forward Jillian Hayes, graduate student guard Mya Jackson and junior guard Braylyn Milton represented Cincinnati at the Big 12 Basketball Tipoff, presented by Old Trapper Beef Jerky, at the T-Mobile Center in Kansas City, Mo.
- Coach Merriweather and players met with ESPN, appeared on Sirius XM and participated in a roundtable discussion with six-time WNBA All-Star Sheryl Swoops and ESPN reporter Kris Budden. Sandwiched in between these on-camera appearances were a series of breakout stations with Big 12 social, T-Mobile Digital, BYU.TV. and ESPN.

MERRIWEATHER, USA EARN SILVER MEDAL AT 2023 FIBA WOMEN'S AMERICUP

- Head coach Katrina Merriweather and USA Basketball earned a silver medal podium finish at the 2023 FIBA Women's AmeriCup, held from July 1-9, 2023 in León, Mexico.
- Merriweather was elevated to her first bench coach assignment for the event, serving as an assistant coach alongside South Dakota State head coach Aaron Johnston under Washington State head coach Kamie Ethridge, after previously serving as a court coach for the 2021 USA Women's U19 National Team Trails.

IT'S A FAMILY THING

- Senior forward Jillian Hayes comes from athletic bloodlines. Her father, Jonathan, was a former NFL player with the Kansas City Chiefs (1985-1993) and Pittsburgh Steelers (1994-1996), assistant coach with the Cincinnati Bengals (2003-18), head coach/GM of the XFL's St. Louis BattleHawks (2020) and most recent a co-offensive coordinator of the XFL's Arlington Renegades (2023-). He was recently named Athletic Director of nearby Moeller High School in Cincinnati.
- Her mother, Kristi, was the 1995 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Year at Drake, and her brother, Jaxson, played at Texas, was the eighth overall pick in the 2019 NBA Draft by the Atlanta Hawks, played for the New Orleans Pelicans and currently plays for the Los Angeles Lakers. She also has two brothers who play high school sports in the Cincinnati area.

THE SISTERHOOD STARTS WITH STAFF

- Prior to returning to Cincinnati, Katrina Merriweather was the head coach for Memphis where a familiar coaching staff started to take shape.
- Katrina Merriweather hired her younger sister Kabrina to help lead the Tigers to a 38-23 record and a postseason appearance in the WNIT Sweet 16 in 2023. Prior to Memphis, Kabrina worked as the Director of Operations for New Mexico Lobos where she made the jump to assistant coach in the 2021-22 season. She was also a forward for Florida A&M and Georgia Southwestern State from 2011-15.
- Both Merriweathers have been on the sidelines together since 2021, and have continued that sisterhood bond in Clifton.

HEAD COACH KATRINA MERRIWEATHER



Director of Athletics John Cunningham announced the hire of former Bearcats' captain Katrina Merriweather as the 10th women's basketball head coach at the University of Cincinnati on March 25, 2023.

A four-year letterwinner for the Bearcats' Hall of Fame head coach Laurie Pirtle from 1997-01, Merriweather became the program's first women's basketball player to advance to four consecutive postseason tournaments. Additionally, she helped lead the program to its first-ever NCAA Tournament win as a graduate assistant coach in 2001-02.

Merriweather quickly has become a rising star in the coaching profession, elevating two programs and taking both to the postseason a total of five times, including a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances.

Merriweather returns to her alma mater with a 151-70 overall record in seven seasons as the head coach of Memphis and Wright State. Most recently, Merriweather led Memphis to a 22-11 season in 2022-23, the program's first 20-win season in more than a decade, and an appearance in the 2023 WNIT Sweet 16.

Merriweather took over a four-win Memphis team and immediately produced 16 wins in 2021-22 before the 22-win campaign this season in which the Tigers clinched the two seed in the 2022 AAC Championships, the program's highest-ever AAC regular season finish, and advanced to a postseason tournament for the first time since 2015-16.

In her two seasons at the helm, the Tigers compiled a 38-23 record and earned three All-Conference selections.

The search was led by Maggie McKinley, Deputy Athletic Director and Senior Woman Administrator, who worked with Cunningham to bring Merriweather back home.

Prior to her tenure at Memphis, Merriweather spent five seasons as the head coach at Wright State, where she took the Raiders to two NCAA Tournaments and was named Horizon League Coach of the Year three times. Merriweather led Wright State to the program's third appearance and first NCAA Tournament win with an upset over four-seed Arkansas in 2021.

In 2018-19, she guided the Raiders to a school-record 27 wins and its first-ever outright Horizon League regular season championship, securing the conference tournament title and reaching the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history.

While at the helm, Merriweather led the Raiders to a 113-47 (.706) record, finishing with the best winning percentage in program history. She was a part of all three of the program's Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances, twice as a head coach in 2019 and 2021 and once as an assistant in 2014. The Raiders also earned 16 All-Conference selections in her tenure.

Merriweather was an assistant under Mike Bradbury for six seasons at Wright State from 2010-16 before becoming head coach.

Prior to Wright State, she was an assistant at Purdue from 2003-06, and at UIC for the 2002-03 season.

With the Bearcats, Merriweather made 27 career starts, including 22 in her senior season, and played in 107 games. She helped lead the program to an 83-41 record in her four seasons.

The Indianapolis native graduated from Cincinnati in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in English literature and earned a second bachelor in secondary education in 2002.
