Lacrosse Faces Central Michigan Friday At Gettler

Bearcats look to continue three-game winning streak

// THE OPENING DRAW

The University of Cincinnati lacrosse team continues a four-game homestand Friday, facing Central Michigan inside Gettler Stadium at 3 p.m. ET. A free live stream and live statistics are available at GoBEARCATS.com. Cincinnati (3-1) enters on a three-game winning streak and knocked off Ohio State by a 17-12 margin on Monday. Central Michigan (2-2) beat Butler, 19-9, in their home opener on Wednesday in Mount Pleasant, Michigan.

// WEEKLY HARDWARE

One day after defeating its intrastate rival for the first time in program history, two members of the University of Cincinnati lacrosse team were selected for weekly awards from the BIG EAST Conference as Monica Borzillo was named the Attacker of the Week and McKenna Rushford was named the Midfielder of the Week. This week's award is the second in a row for Borzillo and her seventh career honor from the BIG EAST after being named the freshman of the week five times last year.

// DYNAMIC DUO

Monica Borzillo had a strong outing against Ohio State as she netted five goals and added a trio of assists while McKenna Rushford scored six goals for the second game in a row to help the Bearcats move to 3-1, the best start in program history. The duo combined for 14 points, including 11 goals, as the Bearcats defeated Ohio State, 17-12, Monday night at home.

// FOUR IN A ROW

Friday's game with CMU is the second of four in a row at home. UC knocked off Ohio State, 17-12, on Feb. 26, plays host to the Chippewas Friday, welcomes Detroit to town on Monday, March 5 and play Campbell on Thursday, March 8. The four-game homestand will also mark four of the final five non-conference games remaining on the schedule as UC jumps into BIG EAST play on Sunday, March 18 at Marquette.

// THAT'S A FIRST

Heading into the game, Ohio State had won the previous six meetings in the series, including last year's 17-8 decision in Columbus that opened the season for both teams. The win tonight was the first for the Bearcats against the Buckeyes.

// OFF TO THE BEST START
In their 11th varsity season, the Bearcats are now off to a 3-1 start, which ties the program record for the best start. The last time UC had a 3-1 start to their season came in 2009 when the Bearcats began the year at 3-0 before falling on the road at Johns Hopkins.

// HOW IT HAPPENED: OHIO STATE
After Ohio State took a 1-0 lead, Taylor Gysin struck back for the Bearcats less than one minute later to tie the game before Rushford scored her first for a 2-1 lead. The Buckeyes tied the game at 2-2, but Rushford put the Bearcats on top for good with her second of the night before UC stretched the lead to four goals at 6-2. Following a two-goal run from the visitors, UC would close out the half by scoring three of the final four goals to take a 9-5 lead at halftime. In the second half, OSU scored first, but the Bearcats responded once again with another four-goal run as Amanda Donovan, Rushford, Borzillo and Alyssa Adams each scored. After two from the Buckeyes, UC scored three in row for a 16-8 lead, its largest of the night, before OSU scored four of the final five goals of the contest for the 17-12 score line.

// BORZILLO HAS BIG NIGHT
Borzillo collected a team and game-high eight points on the night as she scored five goals while adding three assists as well. Going 2-of-3 in free-position shot attempts, Borzillo added a pair of ground balls in the game. Her final goal of the contest came at 2:08 remaining and helped halt an OSU run that saw the Buckeyes score twice in a row and gut the lead to 16-10.

// RUSHFORD'S HOT STREAK CONTINUES
Rushford had another huge game offensively for the Bearcats as she netted six goals for the second game in a row to lead the way. Her first goal of the night put the Bearcats on top, 2-1, before her second made it 3-2 for the hosts, giving UC a lead it would not surrender. In fact, her second score started a 4-0 run for the Bearcats to take a 6-2 lead. Overall, she finished the first half of play with four goals to her credit before adding two more in the second half for her final total.

Last week at Winthrop, Rushford netted six goals, which then surpassed her previous career-high goal total of four goals in a single game. She now has two entries into the UC single game record book as her six goals tie for the second-most in a game in Bearcats history. But, her offense wasn't the only factor she played on the night as she led the team with six caused turnovers while also leading in ground balls (four) and added a pair of draw controls.

// DURSO, DEFENSE STAND TALL
Giuliana Durso had another outstanding day in the cage as she recorded 11 saves to help anchor the defense in the big victory. Defensively, UC forced OSU into 20 turnovers, collecting 13 caused turnovers while the Buckeyes caused just seven on the Bearcats.

// QUICK ON THE DRAW
The UC offense was sparked by a 17-14 advantage in draw controls in the game. Schuyler Nissen led the way with seven controls while Amanda Donovan added five as well.

// RECAP: ROAD TRIPPING
Last week, the Bearcats went 2-0 on the road with wins of 20-9 at Gardner-Webb and 12-10 at Winthrop to improve to 2-1 overall in 2018. In the opening game, Borzillo led the way as she netted five goals, the eighth-most in a single game in program history, while chipping in a pair of assists as well. In the trip finale, she added another two goals and three assists to five her seven goals, five assists and 12 points on the weekend as UC got off to its second-best start in program history.

// FEELING HONORED
The BIG EAST Conference has announced its weekly award winners for women's lacrosse with Monica Borzillo being named the Attacker of the Week following the Bearcats' 2-0 road trip through the Carolinas last weekend. Borzillo is the first Bearcats player to be named the conference's attacker of the week since the award began in 2015 and is the third different player in program history to be selected for the league's top weekly offensive honor after Meg Bell (2/25/14) and Laura Simanski (2/23/09) were honored. A five-time freshman of the week honoree last year, Borzillo's award this week is her first non-rookie honor in her career and the first earned by a UC player this season.

// WHAT A RUSH(FORD)
McKenna Rushford's day against Winthrop, which also was her birthday, saw her open the scoring just 10 seconds into the contest before adding her second of the game with 3:21 remaining in the first half. The only player on either team to score more than once in the first half, Rushford went back to work immediately after the intermission and netted her third of the contest with just 36 seconds removed from the second half clock. With UC trailing for the first time, 8-7, at the 18:06 mark, Rushford would lead the way with three of UC's final five goals to put the game away and give the visitors the win. Overall, Rushford surpassed her previous career marks with her offensive performance today, which also included four draw controls won. Entering the game, her four points and four goals scored against Butler (April 1, 2017) and four points and two assists against Louisville in this year's season opener (February 9) were her career highs. Not only did she better all of those categories, she also added her name to a trio of individual game record lists as her nine points and six goals both are tied for the second-most in a single UC game. Monica Borzillo holds the points record with 10 (vs. Butler, 4/1/17) while Kylie Ramsland holds the goals record at seven (at Villanova, 4/30/10). Rushford also was 3-for-3 on free-position goals, which ties the record with five other players, most recently Courtney Curtis (3/15/15).

// DURSO MAKES SAVES
Giuliana Durso had a big day in goal at Winthrop as she faced 21 shots and turned away 11 to pick up the victory, her second in a row. Her save total is a career high and marks the second time she has done so this year after recording a then-career-high eight saves against Louisville in the opener. For her career, Durso entered the contest with 18 career saves and nearly reached that in today's contest alone.

// RECORD DAY AGAINST GWU
As a team, the Bearcats recorded five entries into the single-game Top 10 charts, including 42 shots that tied the school record (at Campbell, 2/26/17). The 20 goals scored ties for the fourth-most in a single game while the 10 assists rank as the sixth-most in a game. Combined, the 30 points tallied ranks tied for third all-time. Defensively, the 18 caused turnovers ranks as the second-best total in a game behind only the 20 forced on Robert Morris in 2009 (2/22).

// CARNEY COLLECTING DIMES
Carney, a freshman, finished her second collegiate game with one goal and four assists, giving her career-highs for both assists and points (five). Not only was tonight the second game in a row she has scored a goal, it also saw her record the eighth-most assists in a game in program history (sixth time).
