GAME PREVIEW

CINCINNATI — The University of Cincinnati baseball team has four road games scheduled for this week, a stretch that begins with a Tuesday evening contest at Indiana.

First pitch from Bloomington is set for 6 PM and the game will be broadcast on BTN+.

This will be the 38th all-time meeting between Cincinnati and Indiana. These two teams met last year on April 19 at UC Baseball Stadium and the Hoosiers won that game, 11-9.

The Bearcats are coming off a big series win vs. West Virginia, which leaves them in a tie for fifth place in the Big 12 standings and just two games out of second place. UC (13-11 Big 12) and Kansas (13-11) are both two games behind Oklahoma State (15-9), Texas (15-9), and West Virginia (15-9) in the conference standings with two weekends remaining.

Cincinnati has now won three-straight conference series for the first time since 2016 and has not lost a weekend home series this season.

Next up for the Bearcats will be a three-game Big 12 series at BYU this weekend. The first game of the series is set for 8 PM ET on Thursday, and game two will begin at 8 PM ET on Friday. The finale on Saturday is set for 1:30 PM ET.

Last Time Out

Cincinnati continued its stellar play at home this past weekend when it won its series vs. West Virginia. After dropping the first game, UC bounced back to win 10-4 on Saturday before winning the rubber match on Sunday, 8-2.

The Bearcats used the long ball to win on Saturday, hitting four home runs to power their way past WVU. Max Palmieri, Alec Jones, Kerrington Cross, and Josh Kross all homered in the game. In Sunday's win, UC was able to manufacture runs to build an early lead and Jones' three-run homer in the third inning blew the game open.

Cincinnati also benefited from outstanding starting pitching from Tommy Boba and Nathan Taylor. Boba tied a career-high with nine strikeouts on Saturday and did not allow a walk, while Taylor struck out seven in 6.1 innings and retired 10 straight batters at one point.

BEATING THE ODDS

Prior to the start of the season, Cincinnati was picked to finish last in the Big 12's preseason coaches poll. The Bearcats received 21 points in the poll, tied with BYU for the last spot.

Cincinnati enters the penultimate weekend tied for fifth with a 13-11 Big 12 record, tied with Kansas, and is just two games out of second place which is occupied by Texas (15-9), Oklahoma State (15-9), and West Virginia (15-9).

UC took two out of three games against West Virginia this past weekend and swept preseason favorite and 2023 College World Series participant TCU on April 5-7.

Cincinnati has won its last three conference series (vs. Houston, at UCF, and vs. West Virginia), the first time it has won three straight conference weekend series since 2016.

RUN FACTORY

Helping UC's offense all season long has been its ability to manufacture runs. The Bearcats rank 16th in the nation in walks (278) and 18th in stolen bases (96) and lead the Big 12 in HBP (80) and sacrifice flies (26). Their ability to get on base, take extra bases, and bring those runners home has helped UC reach doubledigits in runs scored 15 times this season and post three run-rule victories. Cincinnati is averaging 7.4 runs per game

At UCF April 26-28, Cincinnati was able to average 6.3 runs per game against the Big 12's top-ranked pitching staff, as the Knights had a 4.20 ERA entering the weekend which was first in the league at the time.

This past weekend, UC scored 18 runs over the final two games against West Virginia to win the series.

HOME COOKIN'

UC boasts a 17-6 record in 23 home games this year and outscoring opponents 186-104 on its home turf. All three of UC's run-rule wins have come at home and have come against Northern Illinois, TCU, and Eastern Kentucky.

Cincinnati has not lost a weekend home series this season.

JOSH KROSS: SELFLESS SLUGGER

Josh Kross leads the Big 12 with 56 RBI and ranks fourth in the Big 12 with 14 home runs. His three-home run performance at Saint Louis on March 22 tied UC's single-game school record are tied for the most by a Big 12 player in a game this season. Kross has a team-best 19 multi-hit efforts and has a season-high three hits in four games.

Kross also isn't afraid to give his team a free base and has been hit by a pitch 22 times this year, which ranks sixth in the nation. That is the most-ever in a season in school history, breaking the previous record held by Josh Harrison, who was plunked 21 times in 2006.

CHRISTIAN MITCHELLE NAMED TO JOHN OLERUD TWO-WAY PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD WATCH LIST

Christian Mitchelle of the University of Cincinnati baseball team has been named to the watch list for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award, the College Baseball Foundation announced Tuesday.

One of 23 players selected to the initial watch list, Mitchelle has made his mark on the diamond this year as an infielder and a relief pitcher.

Mitchelle has played in 34 games as a position player, making 33 starts primarily at shortstop, and is hitting .306 with 25 runs scored and 16 RBI. The Romeoville, III. native was outstanding vs. Houston, hitting .583 with a home run and four RBI across three games.

On the mound, Mitchelle has pitched in 19 games and sports a 3.37 ERA with a teambest five saves. He has been one of head coach Jordan Bischel's most-trusted weapons out of the bullpen, ranking third on the team in pitching appearances this season. He ranks fourth in the Big 12 in saves.

The John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award is presented annually by the College Baseball Foundation to honor the nation's top combo pitcher-position player. Recent winners include Caden Grice (Clemson, 2023), Paul Skenes (Air Force, 2022), and Spencer Schwellenbach (Nebraska, 2021).

TWO-SPOT TOMMY O'CONNOR

Tommy O'Connor has hit out of the two-hole for nearly the entire season and has done a great job setting the table for the hitters behind him and clearing the table with his prodigious power.

O'Connor ranks second on UC with 12 home runs and a .552 slugging percentage, and also ranks second in runs scored and in walks, ranking seventh in the Big 12 in the latter category. O'Connor has 14 multi-hit efforts this year and 13 multi-RBI performances, among the most on the team in both categories.

TOMMY BOBA EARNS WEEKLY AWARDS FROM BIG 12 AND PERFECT GAME (MARCH 18-19)

Tommy Boba was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week on March 18 and the Perfect Game National Pitcher of the Week on March 19.

Boba was magnificent last week across two outings, one of which was a near no-hitter on Saturday vs. Kansas. Boba held the Jayhawks hitless through eight innings, finally surrendering his first hit of the day to the leadoff hitter in the top of the ninth. He struck out a career-best eight and retired 11 straight batters at one point from the end of the fourth inning to the beginning of the eighth. His start vs. KU is tied for the longest start by a Big 12 pitcher this season.

D1Baseball ranked the Top 100 pitching performances from this past weekend by game score, and Boba's mark of 86 was the highest in the country for this weekend's slate of games.

JOSH KROSS - BIG 12 CO-NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK (MARCH 4)

Cincinnati earned its first weekly award as a member of the Big 12 Conference on March 4. Josh Kross was named Co-Newcomer of the Week thanks to his outstanding performances against Xavier, Oakland, and Northern Illinois.

The Brunswick, Ohio native was outstanding, hitting .455 and slugging .909 in six games while tallying three home runs and 11 RBI. He led Cincinnati in RBI and hits (11) and was tied for the team lead in home runs and runs scored (nine). He also reached base at least twice in five of six contests.

Kross opened the week by hitting his first home run as a Bearcat at Xavier on Feb. 27 and homered again in the next game vs. Oakland on Feb. 29. He saved his best performance for last, aoina 3-for-4 with a home run and career-high six RBI in the finale vs. Northern Illinois.

D1BASEBALL ACCOLADES

Five Bearcats were highlighted as top prospects and impact freshmen by D1Baseball in the organization's Big 12 preview.

Two Bearcats were represented in the Big 12 Conference prospect ranking for the upcoming 2024 MLB Draft, headlined by junior first basemen Tommy O'Connor coming in at No. 33. O'Connor batted .303 (23-for-76) with two doubles, two triples, eight home runs and 19 RBI in 2023.

Josh Kross, a transfer from Eastern Michigan, came in at No. 38 for the 2024 MLB Draft. He batted .376 (86-for-229) with 43 runs scored, 18 doubles, 15 home runs and 70 RBI. He was named MAC Freshman of the Year, First Team All-MAC and Freshman All-America by College Baseball Newspaper.

In addition, UC had a pair of two-way players recognized on the top prospect list for the 2025 MLB Draft. Christian Mitchelle came in at No. 19, followed by Griffin Hugus at No. 28.

Mitchelle is a transfer from Central Michigan, where he was named All-MAC Second Team after batting .307 (58-189) with 53 runs scored, 13 doubles, three home runs and 29 RBI as a freshman. He also served an important role as a relief pitcher in 2023, making 11 appearances with a 3.18 ERA.

Hugus, an AAC All-Freshman Team selection in 2023, batted .234 (29-for-124) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs and 20 RBI. He made 18 appearances on the mound with a Christian Mitchelle (Central Michigan), 1-2 record and two saves.

Freshman right-handed pitcher Nathan Taylor was selected to D1Baseball's impact freshmen list at No. 23. He was named West Clermont's Most Valuable Pitcher three years in a row and struck out 53 batters in 36 innings as a senior.

BISCHEL ERA BEGINS

Jordan Bischel became the 33rd head coach in Bearcat Baseball history on June 21, 2023.

Bischel comes to UC from Central Michigan, where he served as head coach for five seasons. He also spent four seasons as head coach of Northwood, an NCAA Division II program in Midland, Mich., and two seasons at the helm of NAIA program Midland University in Ohio) are UC's true freshman. Fremont, Neb.

As a head coach at the NCAA level he has nine winning seasons, eight conference championships, and three NCAA Regional appearances. Bischel's CMU squad advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2019, 2021, and 2022.

BISCHEL BALL COMING TO UC

When asked what fans can expect from Cincinnati Baseball in 2024, Coach Bischel said that his team will play fast and play aggressive, which tracks with how his Central Michigan teams approached the game during his tenure there.

Last season, Bischel's Central Michigan squad ranked eighth in the country in stolen bases (133) and had three players with at least 20 stolen bases, including Christian Mitchelle, who transferred to UC this season.

STADIUM UPGRADES

Cincinnati baseball has made several improvements to UC Baseball Stadium since the end of the 2023 season. Those additions and improvements include:

JORDAN BISCHEL • HEAD COACH • FIRST SEASON • ST. NORBERT '03

UC Director of Athletics John Cunningham announced on June 18, 2023 the hire of Jordan Bischel as the 33rd head coach in program history.

The Green Bay, Wis., native comes to UC from Central Michigan, where he served as head coach for five seasons. He also spent four seasons as head coach of Northwood, an NCAA Division II program in Midland, Mich., and two seasons at the helm of NAIA program Midland University in Fremont, Neb.

Overall, he has a 341-177 record (.660) as an NCAA coach, including nine winning seasons and eight conference championships (four at Central Michigan, four at Northwood).

Bischel led the Chippewas to four Mid-American Conference (MAC) championships -- two regular season and two tournament -- and three NCAA Regionals. The Chippewas went 177-80 (.689) during Bischel's tenure.

In five seasons as head coach at CMU, Bischel had a 102-32 MAC record and posted three consecutive 40-win full seasons for the first time since 1986-88. Bischel's teams won a combined 132 games in 2019, '21 and '22, marking the winningest three-year stretch in program history.

Bischel's CMU teams went a combined 31-8 against the five other Michigan Division I programs, Michigan, Michigan State, Eastern Michigan, Western Michigan and Oakland, and Bischel led his Chippewas to 12 victories over opponents from Power 5 conferences.

In 2022, the Chippewas finished 43-19, including 30-7 and in second place in the MAC. They made a remarkable run to the league tournament crown, starting 1-1 and then winning three consecutive elimination games, the final two against host and regular season champion Ball State.

That put the Chippewas in the NCAA Tournament for the third straight season, where they went 1-2 and bowed to No. 13-ranked Florida in the Gators' home stadium in Gainesville.

The Chippewas posted a 42-18 ledger in 2021, capped by a 2-2 finish in the NCAA Regional in South Bend, Ind. The Chippewas were the No. 4 seed in the four-team tournament and posted victories over No. 2 Michigan and No. 3 UConn.

Bischel electrified CMU baseball from the word go in 2019, leading it to its first MAC Tournament championship and its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1995. The 2019 squad posted a 47-14 mark — an 18-win improvement over the 2018 squad — and a dramatic 6-5 victory over Miami (Fla.) in an NCAA Regional game in Starkville, Miss. It was CMU's first NCAA Tournament victory since 1988.

The Chippewas earned their first MAC regular season title since 2015, tied the program record for victories in a season (47), and its .770-win percentage was fifth best in the nation.

Prior to his time at CMU, Bischel was the head coach of Northwood from 2014 to 2018. The Timberwolves posted a combined 137-76 record and won two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Championships as well as two GLIAC Tournament titles. Over his last two seasons, Northwood won 84 games — the best two-year stretch prior to Bischel's arrival featured 55 wins (1989-90).

Before Northwood, Bischel coached at Midland University in Fremont, Neb., for two seasons, leading the Warriors to a combined 74-45 record. In his first year at Midland, the Warriors won 31 games.

Bischel also coached in the Northwoods League for five seasons, four with the Green Bay Bullfrogs and one with the Wisconsin Woodchucks. He also served as the pitching coach for three seasons at Northwest Missouri State and was an assistant coach at John Carroll and at St. Norbert College in Wisconsin.

Bischel was an academic all-conference first baseman and pitcher at St. Norbert from 2000 to 2003. He earned all-conference honors and served as the team captain as a senior.

Bischel and his wife Katie have three sons, twins Luke and Parker, and Chase.

ASSISTANT COACHES



University of Cincinnati head baseball coach Jordan Bischel announced on July 11, 2023 the hire of Josh Reynolds as assistant coach and pitching coach.

With more than 20 years of college and professional baseball experience as a player and coach, Reynolds will oversee the pitching efforts of Bearcats baseball. He recently served as Colorado Scouting Director for Prep Baseball Report from 2022 to 2023.

Prior to that, Reynolds coached at Northwestern where he oversaw the Wildcats' pitching staff and took a lead role in Northwestern's recruiting efforts (2016-22). He was named interim head coach in May of 2021.

Reynolds came to Northwestern after serving as an assistant coach at Kansas State from 2011 to 2015. He helped the Wildcats reach the NCAA Tournament twice in five years, while also securing the 2013 Big 12 Championship.

Prior to joining the coaching staff in Manhattan, Reynolds worked as an assistant coach at Evansville for the 2009 and 2010 seasons. He also had successful stints as a graduate manager and a volunteer at KSU, and as an assistant at Northeast Texas Community College.

Reynolds pitched for a Division II powerhouse Central Missouri from 1998 to 2000. He set the UCM record for career wins with 34 in three seasons, while helping Mules to Division II College World Series appearances in 1998 and 2000.

Reynolds was selected in the third round of the Major League Baseball Draft by the New York Mets in 2000. He also spent time in the Boston Red Sox and San Diego Padres organizations before transitioning to coaching in 2004



University of Cincinnati head baseball coach Jordan Bischel announced on July 11, 2023 the hire of Kyle Pettoruto as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator.

Pettoruto comes to UC following a four-year stint as the hitting coach/assistant coach for Rutgers University (2020-23). He will oversee the recruiting efforts of Bearcats baseball and will instruct infield play and assist in all areas of the offense.

Pettoruto recently led Rutgers to back-to-back top-5 league finishes, rebuilding a program that had not finished better than 10th in its entire Big Ten history prior to his arrival. The Scarlet Knights went 77-38 (.670) overall and 31-17 (.646) in the Big Ten over the previous two seasons.

Under Pettoruto's guidance in 2022, Rutgers had one of the most prolific lineups in all of college baseball. The Scarlet Knights led the country with 9.6 runs per game and were top-5 nationally in runs (565) and doubles (147). In addition, the 2022 recruiting class was ranked No. 25 by D1Baseball.com and Top 35 by Baseball America.

Prior to his time at Rutgers, Pettoruto spent six seasons at Bryant and was a part of six straight Northeast Conference regular season championships and two NCAA Tournament appearances.

He played a role in producing 40 All-NEC selections, 46 All-New England selections, six ABCA All-Northeast selections, two NEC and New England Players of the Year, four NEC Rookies of the Year, two New England Rookies of the Year, one Collegiate Baseball Freshman Player of the Year and four Freshman All-Americans in his six seasons at Bryant.

Prior to Bryant, Pettoruto worked as an assistant coach with the North Shore Navigators in the Futures Collegiate Baseball League in the summer of the 2012. Following the summer. Pettoruto was hired as an assistant coach at Merrimack. He worked with the outfielders and the hitters. helping the Warriors set a school record for wins in the spring of 2013.

Pettoruto was a four-year letterwinner at the University of New Haven and helped the Chargers earn a spot in the 2010 NCAA Tournament. He also played for the Joplin Outlaws of the MINK League and the Rome Thunderbolts during the summer.



University of Cincinnati head baseball coach Jordan Bischel announced on July 11, 2023 the hire of Tom Winske as assistant coach.

Winske resumes his longtime affiliation with Bischel when the latter was named to lead the Cincinnati baseball program. He will work with the Bearcat catchers and outfielders as well as oversee bunting and baserunning.

Winske comes to Cincinnati from Central Michigan. where he served as a volunteer assistant coach from 2019 to 2023. He combined with Bischel to lead the Chippewas to four Mid-American Conference (MAC) championships -- two regular season and two tournament - and three NCAA Tournament berths.

With Winske on the coaching staff, the Chippewas compiled an 102-32 MAC record and posted three consecutive 40-win full seasons for the first time since 1986-88. They won a combined 132 games in 2019. '21 and '22, marking the winningest three-year stretch in program history.

Winske came to CMU after a highly successful twodecade run as the head coach at NCAA Division III St. Norbert College in De Pere, Wis, He amassed a 444-287-1 career mark from 1999 to 2018 and is the Midwest Conference's all-time leader in both conference and overall

Winske was named the Midwest Conference North Division Coach of the Year nine times in his 20 years at St. Norbert and led the Green Knights to four conference championships and five NCAA Tournament berths. His 2017 team won 30 games, the most victories in a season by any men's athletics team in St. Norbert history.

Bischel, a pitcher, played for Winske at St. Norbert from 2000 to 2003 and served as an assistant under his mentor from 2007-09.



Sheriff comes to UC from Western Illinois where he served as interim head coach of the baseball program for the 2023 season. He was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2022 season, which was his first with the program.

In his first season, the Leathernecks saw an improvement in overall wins. Summit League victories and conference finish. Western Illinois also had improvements in nearly every major statistical category.

Prior to joining Western Illinois, Sheriff spent three years working for the baseball program at Spalding University as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator. He oversaw three pitchers who were named All-SLIAC in 2019.

In 2017-18. Sheriff contributed as a volunteer assistant coach at Indiana University of Pennsylvania. Prior to that, he worked nearby at Penn State - New Kensington as an assistant coach

Since 2014, Sheriff has spent his summer days functioning as a general manager and head coach for Paul Carpenter Capital Advisors AAABA Baseball in his home state of Pennsylvania. He started his coaching career in 2015 with United High School in Armagh, Pa



Schroeder rejoins Bischel as the Bearcats director of program development. He comes to UC following a four-year stint as assistant coach at Central Michigan.

Schroeder played a major role in helping lead CMU to four Mid-American Conference championships -- two regular season and two tournament -- and three NCAA Tournament

He previously served under Bischel for four years at Northwood University, where they combined to lead the program to unprecedented success, capped by back-toback Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular season and tournament championships in 2017 and 2018.

Prior to his four years at Northwood, Schroeder served as an assistant under Bischel at Midland University in 2013-14. Together, they led Midland to a league championship and an appearance in the NAIA National Tournament.

Schroeder began his coaching career as an assistant in 2008 at Luther College, worked as a graduate assistant at Northwest Missouri State and served as an assistant with the Green Bay Bullfrogs of the Northwoods League.

As a player at Luther from 2004 to 2007, Schroeder led the Norse to Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular season and tournament championships during his senior year. He was named the 2007 IIAC Most Valuable Player and remains the program leader in several offensive categories, including career home runs (30) and career RBI (172).

Schroeder earned a bachelor's degree from Luther and a master's from Northwest Missouri State.
