## SERIES HISTORY

- This will be the third overall meeting between the two programs with Colorado leading the series, 2-1. The last meeting was in 2016 where Cincinnati claimed a 2-0 win.

## YOU GET A GOAL, YOU GET A GOAL!

- Against Houston, Cincinnati boasted four different goal-scorers for the first time this season, while also surpassing their previous total team goals of 17 from last season.
- A total of nine different players have recorded at least one goal this season with freshman Rylee Felton (6) and fifth year Ellie Flower (5) leading the way.
- The Bearcats' four goal performance marked the most in a single game since the 2022 season.

## A SPECIAL GOAL ON A SPECIAL DAY

- Junior Coley Sidloski secured Cincinnati's victory over Kansas State by scoring her lone goal in the honorary "We Play For 3" game, named after her sister, and former Bearcat, Ally.

## GOALKEEPIN' IT REAL

- Fifth-year goalkeeper Anna Rexford has been instrumental in the last 15 matches, playing every minute.
- Thursday's match will mark Rexford's 80th consecutive start as a Bearcat. She currently is ranked eighth in the nation for minutes played by a goalie (7,142.33) in their career.
- With the 0-0 draw against Iowa State, Rexford earned her 17th career shutout, second of the season, and moved into the fourth spot in program history.
- Against the Cyclones, Rexford earned her first career penalty kick save.
- She recorded a career-high eight saves vs. Butler.
- Against Xavier, Rexford finished with five total saves. This marked the 21st game of her career with five or more saves.
- She has 41 saves on the year and 246 in her career, the fifth-most in program history.

## A WIN WOULD...

- Tie up the overall series.
- Be Cincinnati's second-straight win against Colorado.
- Be Cincinnati's first win over a newly added Big 12 program.

## LAST TIME OUT

- Cincinnati fell to Oklahoma State, 1-0 on Sunday inside Neal Patterson Stadium.
- Oklahoma State opened scoring in the 26th minute with a goal from Alex Morris. Fifth year goalkeeper Anna Rexford notched four saves in the first half and remained in goal for the full match.
- Junior Claire Rea and fifth year Lauren Bastian led the offense with two shots apiece. Each earned their third-straight game recording one or more shots.
- UC had a late surge of energy when Bastian fired a shot aimed for the top right corner of the goal, but it was saved by OSU's Grace Gordan.

# 2024 CINCINNATI SOCCER MATCH NOTES

## // A CONFERENCE CHANGE IS NOTHING NEW

With UC joining the Big 12, it will mark the sixth new conference the Bearcats have joined since the programs formation in 1980 (note team was independent from 1984-93.) The Bearcats have reached double-digit wins in there previous conference inaugural seasons, including going 15-5-2 as part of the GMC in 1994.

## // NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

The Bearcats 2024 roster features eight freshman and three transfers. Coley Sidloski (Ohio State), Ashlyn Basinger (Maryland) and Jenna Daveler (Old Dominion) all come with previous collegiate experience.

## // WELCOMING THE WEST

The Big 12 Conference welcomed four new members ahead of the 2024-25 season. The Bearcats will face three of the four new conference members this upcoming season. UC will host Colorado on Oct. 17 for the first match between the two programs since 2015.

## // CLIFTON CONFIDENCE

Head coach Erica Demers and her staff adopted a saying at the beginning of the season to help the team adapt to the changes at hand and embody the team's mindset and playing style, which is to play with "Clifton Confidence." The effect of Clifton Confidence became a reality during the match against then-ranked No. 6 BYU, where the team went and shocked the Cougars and 5,000 fans in attendance, walking away with a 1-1 draw against one best scoring teams in the nation, and a team that advanced all the way to the 2023 College Cup Final Four.

## // SUPER SENIORS

In December, the program announced the return of four key fifth year players. Vyviene Spaulding (F), Lauren Bastian (M), Ellie Flower (F/M) and Anna Rexford (GK) will suit up in the red and black for one more season.

## // RETURNING STRENGTH

Cincinnati returns great numbers from last year's roster including five leading scorers and team leader in assists, Fran Stables.

## // WE PLAY FOR 3

Junior transfer Coley Sidloski will rep the number 3 this year in honor of her sister and former UC student athlete, Ally Sidloski, who passed away in 2021. This will be the first time since 2022 that #3 is worn, last done so by Vanessa DiNardo, also in honor of Ally. DiNardo proceeded to score the team's first goal of the 2022 season in the win at NKU. After the Kansas State game, the Sidloski family presented their memorial scholarship to junior Maddie Swingle for embodying the true qualities of "Playing for 3".

## // BEARCATS WORLD-WIDE

Cincinnati's 2024 roster features four international students from three different countries. Claire Rea and Jada Arthurs represent Ontario. Fran Stables reps England and Laura Zembryova comes to UC from Slovakia.

## // FELTON-FLOWER CONNECTION

Freshman Rylee Felton and Fifth year Ellie Flower emerge as a strong duo for the Bearcats' offense. The pair recorded assists for each other's goals in three-straight games.

## // FELTON'S ON FIRE

Freshman Rylee Felton was named Co-Freshman of the Week by the Big 12 for the week of 9/4, marking her first weekly accolade and Cincinnati's first of the season. The Milford, Mich. native has been outstanding in her debut season, scoring in four consecutive matches, including the equalizer against Louisville and a pair of goals against Eastern Michigan. She leads the team with six goals, 13 points, and a .647 SOG%.

HEAD COACH ERICA DEMERS | SECOND SEASON



University of Cincinnati Director of Athletics John Cunningham announced the hiring of Erica Demers as the sixth women’s soccer head coach in program history on December 7, 2022.

In her first year as head coach of the Bearcats, Demers led UC to the program's first Big 12 Championship Tournament victory, defeating Baylor 3-2 in the first round of the tournament in the team's first year in the conference.

Demers ushers in the new era after elevating the University of Alabama at Birmingham to unrivaled success during six seasons as head coach.

Demers was honored as the 2022 Conference USA Coach of the Year following a 9-4-5 overall and 6-1-3 Conference USA record that featured a program-best 10-match unbeaten streak. The Blazers had a league-best six student-athletes named to All-Conference teams and the conference’s Defensive Player of the Year in Asha Zuniga.

During her time in Birmingham, Demers coached the Blazers to 23 All-Conference selections, 16 conference All-Academic honorees and an overall record of 50-38-19.

Hired on May 22, 2017, Demers orchestrated one of the best turnarounds in the NCAA in her first season at the helm by increasing the team’s win total by nine games and leading the Blazers to their most wins since 2004.

Prior to her tenure with the Blazers, Demers spent 12 seasons on Dave Dilanni’s staff at Iowa and Grand Valley State. She helped lead Iowa to 29 victories, coached three All-Big Ten performers and 31 Big Ten All-Academic selections in three seasons.

At Grand Valley State, she helped guide the Lakers to three NCAA Division II national titles, nine GLIAC championships and nine NCAA regional championships. She spent her final two seasons as associate head coach of the program.

In addition to her coaching duties, Demers served as the school’s recruiting coordinator, camps coordinator and instructor, strength and conditioning coach and fundraising director. She also was instrumental in the team’s academic success, as she coached two Academic All-American of the Year honorees, eight Academic All-Americans, one Elite 88 Award winner and more than 40 athletes to GLIAC All-Academic honors during her tenure.

Demers started her coaching career at The Citadel, where she served one season as a graduate assistant.

As a student-athlete, Demers led Oakland to four-straight Mid-Continent Conference titles and three-straight NCAA Tournament appearances. She was a two-time First Team All-Conference selection and was named Conference Player of the Year in 2002.

Demers competed for the Canadian U-21 National Team and was part of the 2000 Canadian National Championship Team. In 1997-98, she played for the National Training Centre team and was a member of the Ontario Provincial Team for five seasons.

The Welland, Ontario, Canada native graduated from Oakland with a Bachelor of Health Science in 2004 and earned her Master’s in Education while at Grand Valley State in 2009.

## PAUL BABBA ASSOCIATE COACH

FIRST SEASON • BELHAVEN UNIVERSITY, 2017

- Paul Babba joined the Cincinnati women's soccer staff in March of 2024 and enters his first season at UC as an associate head coach.
- Babba spent the last two seasons as the head coach of Bellarmine's women's soccer program. He has more than 16 years of collegiate soccer coaching experience, including other head coaching roles at Delta State, Bryan College and Kentucky.
- During his two-year stint at Bellarmine, he led one of the top defensive units in the ASUN.
- Prior to joining Bellarmine, he spent two seasons as an assistant coach/recruiting coordinator at Kentucky, where he also assumed the role of interim head coach for the final three games of the fall 2021 campaign.
- Before heading to Lexington, Babba served as an assistant coach/recruiting coordinator at Elon and helped lead the Phoenix to a 12-6-2 season and the program's first-ever berth in the Colonial Athletic Association tournament.
- In 2017 he was recognized as the Appalachian Athletic Conference Coach of the Year as he led Bryan College to its first-ever AAC regular-season championship and berth in the NAIA National Tournament while posting the winningest season in program history at 12-7 overall and 9-2 in conference play.
- Under his guidance that season, the Lions also garnered AAC acknowledgments for Offensive Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year. In his two seasons at Bryan College, the program accumulated nine All-AAC and 13 All-Academic Team honors.
- Babba's first head-coaching job at the collegiate level came at Delta State University, a Division II program in Mississippi, and led the program for five years (2011-15).
- He played collegiately from 2003-06 at Belhaven University, where he was a team captain his last two seasons and ranked third all-time at the school in points (92) and tied for third in goals (37). After college, he played two summers for Mississippi Brilla FC.



## RACHAEL COLLINS ASSISTANT COACH

SECOND SEASON • PEPPERDINE UNIVERSITY 2017

- Collins joined the staff after spending the last two seasons in the same role with Erica Demers at the University of Alabama Birmingham from 2021-22. In her stint with the Blazers, the pair compiled a 16-13-8 record and earned 11 All-Conference selections.
- Prior to UAB, Collins served as a volunteer assistant coach for two seasons at Alabama from 2019-20. With the Crimson Tide, she helped develop five All-SEC performers, including midfielder Reyna Reyes who played on the Mexican Senior National Team and was named to the United Soccer Coaches' All-Southeast Region Third Team.
- Collins spent two seasons as an assistant coach at UC Davis from 2017-18. In her time with the Aggies, she coached four All-Big West honorees. Collins was instrumental in the development of goalkeeper Alexis Smith, who finished as UC Davis' all-time leader in shutouts and saves.



## OLIVIA SILVERMAN ASSISTANT COACH

FIRST SEASON • SAINT LOUIS, 2020

- Olivia Silverman joined the Cincinnati women's soccer coaching staff in March of 2024 and enters her first season as an assistant coach.
- The Cincinnati native, Silverman returns to her hometown after spending the last five years coaching at her alma mater, Saint Louis, working primarily with the goalkeepers.
- Following two seasons as a volunteer assistant for the Billikens, the SLU graduate and former Billiken goalkeeper was elevated to assistant coach in 2021.
- During her time as a coach, she has helped lead Saint Louis to five straight Atlantic 10 Tournament Championships and five straight NCAA tournament appearances as the Billikens advanced all the way to the Sweet Sixteen in 2023.
- In 2022, Silverman's work as a goalkeeper coach played a key role in the team breaking the program record for wins in a single season. SLU finished the year with a record of 20-2 and 10-0 in conference play as SLU allowed only 10 goals all season long.
- Silverman played three seasons (2016-18) at Saint Louis and concluded her career sixth in shutouts (11), seventh in wins (17), ninth in minutes (2,106) and 10th in saves (50) on SLU's career lists.
- A two-year team captain for Seven Hills School in Cincinnati. She was a four-time All-Conference selection and a two-time All-City choice and she garnered All-America and All-State honors as a senior.
- She is a 2020 graduate of Saint Louis University and earned a bachelor's degree in public health.

- Named to the CSC Academic All-District team and named TopDrawer Soccer Midfielder of the Week (Oct. 29)
- Appeared in all 19 matches, starting in 17
- Led the team with a career-high six assists and added two goals, finishing the season as the only Bearcat with double-digit points (10)
- Played a career-high 1,325 minutes and took 21 shots, with 16 being on goal
- Scored the game's opening goal and tied a career-high with two assists, helping lead UC to its first-ever Big 12 Tournament victory over Baylor (3-2) in the opening round
