STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

» **THE GAME:** FOLLOWING A FIRST-ROUND BYE, No. 3 SEED UNIVERSITY OF CINCINNATI WOMEN'S BASKETBALL WILL FACE THE WINNER OF FRIDAY'S No. 6 SEED TEMPLE OWLS - No. 11 SEED MEMPHIS TIGERS MATCHUP IN THE 2019 AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP QUARTERFINALS ON SATURDAY, MARCH 9 AT 8 P.M. ET AT MOHEGAN SUN ARENA.

» **THE SERIES:** THE BEARCATS TRAIL THE OWLS IN THE ALL-TIME SERIES, 4-7, BUT HAVE WON THREE OF THE LAST FOUR MEETINGS. THE TWO TEAMS SPLIT THEIR MATCHUPS THIS SEASON WITH BOTH WINNING AT HOME. JUNIOR GUARD ANTOINETTE MILLER AND SOPHOMORE FORWARD IIMAR'I THOMAS EACH RECORDED DOUBLE-DOUBLES IN A 72-52 HOME VICTORY ON JAN. 16. AT TEMPLE ON FEB. 17, MILLER SCORED A TEAM-BEST 16 POINTS IN A 78-70 SETBACK. THEY HAVE NEVER SQUARED OFF ON A NEUTRAL FLOOR.

» UC TRAILS U OF M ON THE ALL-TIME SERIES, 19-35, AND ARE ALSO BEHIND IN GAMES PLAYED ON A NEUTRAL FLOOR, 1-5. HOWEVER, THE BEARCATS HAVE WON THE LAST FIVE OVERALL MEETINGS, INCLUDING BOTH THIS SEASON. IN AN 80-56 HOME IN ON JAN. 26, THE RED & BLACK WAS LED BY THOMAS' 19 POINTS ON 9-OF-9 SHOOTING FROM THE FIELD. FOLLOWING, UC TOPPED THE TIGERS, 89-69, ON FEB. 13 IN MEMPHIS WITH JUNIOR GUARD NIKIRA GOINGS PACING THE TEAM WITH 19 POINTS, INCLUDING FIVE MADE 3-POINTERS. THE TWO TEAMS HAVE NEVER FACED OFF IN THE AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP.

» **LAST TIME OUT:** UC WRAPPED THE REGULAR SEASON MONDAY WITH AN 80-

65 VICTORY AT TULANE. WITH THE WIN, THE BEARCATS TALLIED 20 VICTORIES FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 2003 AND 12 LEAGUE TRIUMPHS FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 1999. UC LED THE ENTIRE GAME, BUT A 21-12 ADVANTAGE AFTER ONE QUARTER SET THE TONE FOR THE REST OF THE CONTEST AS THE BEARCATS DEALT THE GREEN WAVE ITS FIFTH-CONSECUTIVE DEFEAT. THE TRIUMPH WAS ALSO THE RED & BLACK'S FIRST IN NEW ORLEANS SINCE 2002. SOPHOMORE FORWARD IIMAR'I THOMAS NOTCHED HER SIXTH DOUBLE-DOUBLE OF THE SEASON WITH GAME HIGHS OF 18 POINTS AND 12 REBOUNDS. JUNIOR GUARD ANTOINETTE MILLER ADDED 16 POINTS, SIX ASSISTS, AND A CAREER-HIGH SIX STEALS. JUNIOR FORWARD ANGEL RIZOR STUFFED THE STAT SHEET WITH 15 POINTS, EIGHT REBOUNDS, FOUR ASSISTS.

» **BEARCATS BYTES:** THE TRIO OF THOMAS, MILLER, AND JUNIOR GUARD FLORENCE SIFA WERE EACH RECOGNIZED ON FRIDAY WITH AAC REGULAR SEASON HONORS. THOMAS WAS SELECTED FIRST TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE, MILLER SECOND TEAM, AND SIFA NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR. THE RECOGNITION MARKS BACK-TO-BACK YEARS UC HAS HAD MULTIPLE AAC REGULAR SEASON HONOREES AFTER THOMAS WON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR AND ANA OWENS WAS CHOSEN FOR THE THIRD TEAM IN 2018. IN ADDITION, THOMAS' SELECTION IS THE BEARCATS' FIRST FIRST TEAM SELECTION IN ITS SIX YEARS IN THE AAC.

» WITH THE WIN OVER USF ON MARCH 2, UC CLINCHED THE No. 3 SEED IN THE AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP. A TOP-THREE SEED IS THE BEARCATS' BEST-EVER REGULAR-SEASON FINISH IN ITS SIX YEARS IN THE AAC.

FIFTH THIRD ARENA REOPENS



After a 20-month, privately-funded \$87-million renovation, Fifth Third Arena reopens in 2018-19 as the latest marker in the continued growth of University of Cincinnati basketball.

A program rich in tradition, UC women's basketball now calls this amazing on-campus facility home.

Improvements to the new-look, 12,012-seat, arena include two 360-degree concourses with court-centric seating, new club seats, loge boxes and premium suites. The Arena Club, Champions Club and the Mercedes-Benz Courtside Club provide entertainment options for fans. State-of-the-art videoboard and ribbon boards raise the gameday experience to a new level while increased points-of-sale for concessions feature food options from some of Cincinnati's most famous restaurants.

New student-athlete amenities include new locker rooms, a film room, a hydrotherapy room and the Margaret K. Valentine Classroom creates more learning environments for the University.

What isn't expected to change though is the thrilling environment on game day featuring loud and intimidating student sections along both baselines and passionate, determined play on the court.

Originally tabbed the Myrl H. Shoemaker Center, it was named after the former Ohio lieutenant governor who was instrumental in securing state funding for the building while he was chairman of the Ohio House Finance Appropriations Committee. Shoemaker died in 1985.

Affectionately known as "The Shoe," the arena was renamed Fifth Third Arena at Myrl H. Shoemaker Center in 2004 in recognition of Fifth Third Bank's support of the Varsity Village facilities enhancement project. Fifth Third Bank remains a valued long-term campus-wide partner on numerous initiatives.

In 2002, the floor was named Ed Jucker Court in honor of the men's head coach who led Cincinnati to its two national titles in 1961 and 1962.

- » Renovation of the building facade, entries and plazas, including the addition of an outdoor videoboard
- » Two 360-degree concourses and permanent lower bowl with court-centric seating and new chairback seating
- » New hospitality areas, including main and upper level concourse bars available to all fans and the addition of three exclusive clubs - the Arena Club, the Champions Club and the Mercedes-Benz Courtside Club
- » New upper-level concourse with its own fan amenities, including new restrooms, concessions and a specialty drink bar
- » Additional bars at the north end of the main and upper concourses - the Armory Bar and the Queen City Bar - that highlight UC Athletics' partnerships with Braxton, MadTree and Rhinegeist
- » New center-hung videoboard, ribbon boards, sound system and LED lighting to enhance game atmosphere
- » Increased points and sale for concessions including some of Cincinnati's favorite food options - Buffalo Wings & Rings, Frisch's, Skyline Chili and Taste of Belgium
- » Open entrance plaza with centralized ticketing and guest services along with the new Fan First Center

// MILLER STEPS UP

- » MILLER IS BEING LEANED ON TO STEP UP THIS YEAR AFTER THE GRADUATION OF POINT GUARD ANA OWENS WHO SCORED 1,469 POINTS AND DISHED OUT 404 ASSISTS IN HER UC CAREER. SHE HAS RESPONDED BY IMPACTING THE GAME IN A VARIETY OF WAYS WITH 12.8 POINTS, 5.4 ASSISTS, 4.7 REBOUNDS, AND 2.0 STEALS PER GAME SO FAR IN 2018-19. HER ASSISTS PER GAME MARK (5.4) RANKS SECOND IN THE AAC AND 27TH IN THE COUNTRY AND HER CURRENT 156 TOTAL ASSISTS RANKS AS FOURTH-BEST IN A SEASON IN PROGRAM HISTORY. ADDITIONALLY, HER ASSIST-TO-TURNOVER RATIO (2.1) IS 61ST-BEST IN NCAA DIVISION I. MILLER HAS BEEN NAMED TO THE AAC WEEKLY HONOR ROLL TWICE THIS SEASON, MOST RECENTLY ON FEB. 11 FOLLOWING HER CAREER DAY OF 23 POINTS AGAINST WICHITA STATE.

// GOINGS' PROGRESSION

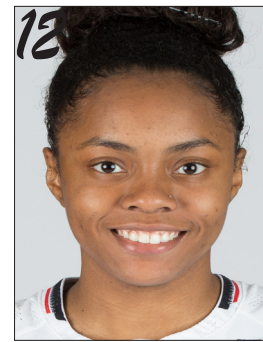

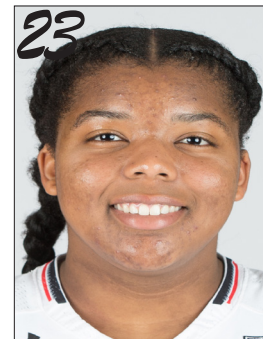

HEAD COACH MICHELLE CLARK-HEARD



Michelle Clark-Heard was named the ninth University of Cincinnati women's basketball coach in March 2018.

Clark-Heard, who was an assistant at UC from 2002-05, spent the previous six seasons as the head coach at Western Kentucky University.

In six seasons at WKU, Clark-Heard reached four NCAA Tournaments, won four conference tournament championships and two regular season conference titles while posting 154 wins, becoming the second-fastest Lady Topper coach to reach 100 victories with the program.

Clark-Heard took over a program with a 9-21 record in 2011-12 and she led the Hilltoppers to a 22-11 mark in her first season (2012-13), a 13-win improvement, which was the largest in Sun Belt Conference history.

WKU finished the 2017-18 campaign with a 24-9 record and captured the 2018 Conference USA Tournament championship and qualified for its third NCAA Tournament in four years. Tashia Brown was tabbed as an Associated Press Honorable Mention All-American and the C-USA Player of the Year.

Clark-Heard amassed a 154-47 (.766) record at WKU and a 178-79 (.693) career mark. Clark-Heard has led her teams to six consecutive 20-win seasons and six-straight appearances in the postseason (four NCAA, two WNIT).

The 2016-17 campaign saw WKU claim its second sweep of the C-USA regular season and tournament championships in just three seasons as a member of the league. The Lady Toppers put together a 27-7 record and a 16-2 mark in C-USA play; the team also pieced together a 12-game winning streak entering the NCAA Tournament, culminating in a 67-56 win over Southern Miss in the C-USA championship game on March 11.

Following the season, Clark-Heard was invited to serve as an assistant coach for the United States U-23 National Team in the inaugural Four Nations Tournament in Tokyo, Japan. During her second stint with the red, white and blue, Clark-Heard helped to push the Americans to an undefeated record and the championship in the event, defeating their opponents by an average of 32 points along the way.

Following the 2014-15 season, Clark-Heard was recognized for her outstanding accomplishments, earning Conference USA Coach of the Year and 2015 United States Marine Corps/WBCA NCAA Division I Regional Coach of the Year honors. Her selection as a WBCA Regional Coach of the Year also made her a finalist for the Pat Summitt Trophy, awarded annually to the 2015 United States Marine Corps/WBCA NCAA Division I National Coach of the Year.

Clark-Heard was named an assistant coach for the 2015 U.S. Pan American Women's Basketball Team, joining head coach Lisa Bluder of the University of Iowa and fellow assistant coach Scott Rueck of Oregon State University on the 2015 staff. In Toronto, Clark-Heard helped lead the United States to a silver medal in her international assistant coaching debut, falling just short in the gold medal game against the host Canadians.

MICHELLE CLARK-HEARD

HEAD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH | 1ST SEASON

In 2013-14, Clark-Heard helped WKU win its final seven regular season games before reeling off three straight in New Orleans, La. in March 2014 to win the Sun Belt Conference Championships with a 61-60 win over Arkansas State after WKU faced a 14-point deficit in the second half. The season also saw WKU defeat Georgetown in the Puerto Rico Classic after facing a 16-point deficit in the second half.

The season was capped by a 87-74 loss to fifth-ranked Baylor in Waco, Texas in the opening round of the 2014 NCAA Tournament, ending the longest NCAA Tournament appearance drought in program history.

The run to the tournament helped WKU secure a 24-9 record and finish with 20-wins for the second straight season. Her consecutive 20-win seasons to begin her time at WKU marked the first time in Sun Belt Conference history that a team had won 20 games in back-to-back years following a season in which it had won less than 10 games.

Her success in 2013-14 followed a massive improvement on the floor in 2012-13.

In her first year as a Division One coach in 2012-13, Clark-Heard helped WKU to a 13-win improvement over the 2011-12 season output. It was the largest in Sun Belt Conference history as WKU turned a 9-21 mark into a 22-11 record. WKU's eight win improvement in conference play from five wins to 13 wins was tied for the largest in league history. The Lady Toppers also became the first team in Sun Belt Conference history to win 20 games in the season following a year in which the team won less than 10 games earlier this season.

Her first season at WKU also showcased her ability to develop players. The duo of Chastity Gooch and Alexis Govan averaged a combined 12.7 ppg in 2011-12 but posted 36.5 per outing in 2012-13. The duo combined for 1,203 points after posting 381 last season. The team also saw major improvement in nearly all statistical categories, including improving free throw shooting by over 11 percent to .739, the third highest mark in school history.

Clark-Heard spent five years as an assistant coach to Jeff Walz at Louisville from 2007-12. During her time with the program, the Cardinals made three Sweet 16 appearances and their first Final Four appearance, finishing as the National Runner-Up in 2009.

Showing her prowess as a recruiter, she was instrumental in bringing in the No. 12 recruiting class to UofL in 2008, then followed with three consecutive Top 10 classes in 2009, 2010 and 2011. The 2010 recruiting class was the highest ranked class in school history, No. 5 nationally.

Among the most notable players Clark-Heard coached at Louisville was overall number one pick in the 2009 WNBA Draft, Angel McCoughtry and overall number eight pick in the 2013 WNBA Draft, Shoni Shimmel. Overall, she coached five players at Louisville that went on to be drafted in the WNBA Draft.

Prior to her time at Louisville, Clark-Heard spent two seasons as the head coach at Kentucky State, taking the reigns of the program in June 2005. She took over a program that had won just one game during the 2004-05 season. In her first season she led the Thorobrettes to a 5-23 record, four of the wins



were against Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference opponents. Her team was picked to finish 11th in the SIAC but ended the season in ninth place. In her second season at KSU, she guided the Thorobrettes to an impressive 19-9 record, finishing tied for fourth place in the SIAC. Clark-Heard earned SIAC Coach-of-the-Year honors after the impressive turnaround. Her 2006-07 Thorobrettes were the second most improved team in NCAA Division II women's basketball during the 2006-07 season.

Before being named head coach at Kentucky State, Clark-Heard spent three seasons at Cincinnati as an assistant and four years at Nebraska in the same role. The Bearcats advanced to postseason play in two of her three seasons there while she helped Nebraska reach the NCAA Tournament twice during her time with the team. She was also responsible for helping sign McDonald's All-American Janice Bright for the Cornhuskers in 2001 while coaching alongside current Louisville coach Jeff Walz and under former WKU coach Paul Sanderford.

A four-year letterwinner on the Hill (1987-90), Clark-Heard was part of four NCAA Tournament teams during her Lady Topper career. She also helped guide the Lady Toppers to a pair of Sun Belt Conference Tournament championships (1988 and 1989) and two conference regular-season titles (1989 and 1990). She played in 118 games during her four years in the Hill, scoring 790 points and pulling down 615 rebounds. WKU amassed 89 victories during her four years in uniform, winning 70 percent of the games over that span and putting together three 20-win seasons.

Upon graduation from WKU, she spent eight years working within a recreational setting in Kentucky, including five years in Bowling Green and three with the Louisville Metro Parks Department.

While in Louisville, she served as head junior varsity coach and assistant varsity coach at DuPont Manual High School for the 1994-95 season. Additionally, she played professionally with the Kentucky Marauders of the Women's Basketball Association in 1994-95.

The Louisville native earned Kentucky High School State Player of the Year honors in 1986 while playing at Atherton High School and was inducted into the Atherton Hall of Fame in 2003.

She married Luther Heard on August 16, 2003.

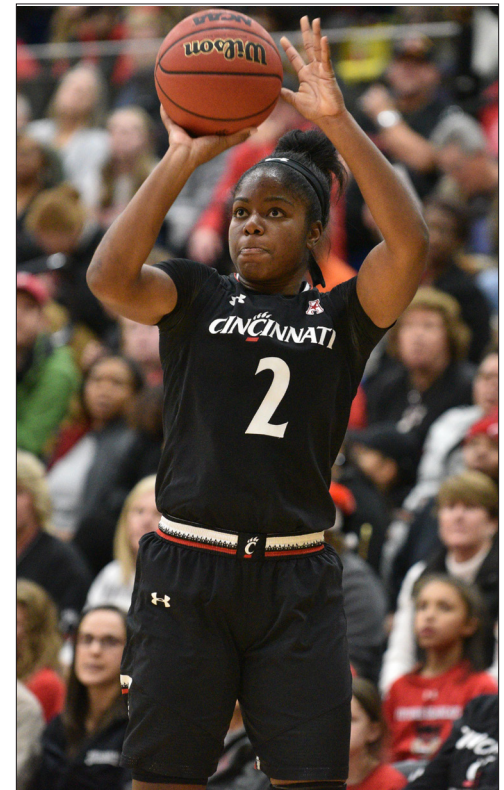

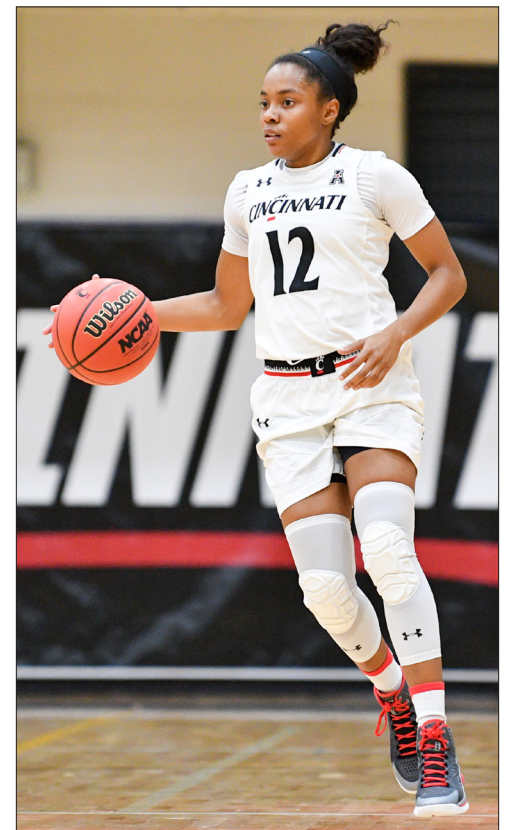
