CINCINNATI - The University of Cincinnati volleyball team opens its Big 12 Conference slate with a twomatch series against UCF, beginning Thursday at 6 p.m. inside Fifth Third Arena.

The Bearcats will also face the Knights at 6 p.m. on Friday night. UCF is currently receiving votes in the American Volleyball Coach Association's (AVCA)/Taraflex Division I Coaches Poll.

Cincinnati's matches will be broadcast nationally on ESPN+ and all matches can be followed at StatBroadcast.

SERIES HISTORY

- Cincinnati holds an 8-16 all-time record against UCF, with the first matchup coming in 1978. Cincinnati has dropped seven straight to UCF, dating back to 2019.
- This will be the first time the two teams face off as members of the Big 12 Conference. The former American Athletic Conference foes met 22 times from 2013-22. UCF held a 15-7 record over Cincinnati during that
- UC is 9-2 in conference openers under head coach Molly Alvey. The Bearcats have won their last seven conference openers, including a 3-1 decision at Tulane a season ago.

- Cincinnati went 1-1 at the Tru by Hilton Dayton Beavercreek Invitational, hosted by Wright State, last weekend. The Bearcats fell in five sets to Butler on Friday before picking up a four-set win over Wright State
- on Saturday.

 Junior Abby Walker was named All-Tournament after averaging 2.44 kills, 1.44 digs and 1.00 blocks per set on the right side. She recorded a match-high 12 kills at a .393 clip vs. Wright State and posted a seasonhigh seven blocks vs. Butler.
- Cincinnati concluded its non-conference slate with a 7-3 record. It marked the most non-conference wins since the Bearcats went 8-4 against out-of-conference opponents in 2019.

// DIGGIN' THE DEFENSE

- Five Bearcats are averaging more than 2.00 digs per set, with Skrabak owning a team-best 4.11 average. The Bearcats have out-dug their opponents in eight of 10 matches this season.
- UC ranks second in the Big 12 and 32nd nationally in digs per set (15.97).
 Cincinnati posted a season-high 91 digs against South Carolina on Sept. 9. It marked the most digs in a match since October 15, 2021 when the Bearcats had 93 against Tulsa.

- Transfers Jadyn Bauss, Carly Skrabak and Katelyn Lefler have started and played in every set this season. Bauss has led the Bearcats in kills in all but two matches. She has finished with double-digit kills in all 10 matches, including 20-plus kills on three occasions. She sits 22nd in the nation in points per set (4.93) and 36th in kills per set (4.11).
- Skrabak is averaging 4.11 digs per set as the team's starting libero. She's currently 17th among active career DI leaders with 1,643 career digs.
- Lefler has recorded seven double-doubles in 10 matches this season. She ranks third in the Big 12 and 23rd nationally with 10.67 assists per set. She has recorded 40-plus assists four times this season. The Bearcats rank second in the Big 12 and 19th in the nation in assists per set (12.97).

// THIS IS VOLLEYBALL COUNTRY

- Six Big 12 schools are ranked in the AVCA/Taraflex Division I Coaches Poll. Texas is ranked No. 9, BYU is No. 10, Kansas is No. 17, Baylor is No. 18, Houston is No. 20 and Iowa State is No. 25. UCF and TCU received votes.
- For the second consecutive week the Conference is one of two leagues with six teams ranked. The 46% of the league ranked is the highest percentage of any conference.
- The Big 12 is one of only two leagues to have a team advance to the National Semifinals in three of the last four seasons (Baylor -2019, Texas -2020 & 2022).
- The conference joined the Big Ten as the only leagues last year to have five or more teams in the NCAA tournament and go undefeated in the opening round (5-0). The Big 12 finished the regular season with the highest RPI of any league.

// GO OFF ROOK

- Freshman middle blocker Zeta Washington was named Big 12 Rookie of the Week, the league announced on Tuesday, Sept. 5. She averaged 5.00 kills and 1.00 blocks per set while hitting .492 in a 3-0 weekend
- She finished the week leading Conference players in both points per set (5.86) and kills per set (5.00) while ranking third in hitting percentage (.492). She is the first Bearcat to procure a weekly Big 12 volleyball
- Washington dropped a 25-piece in her collegiate debut against Kennesaw State on Sept. 1. She hit .524 with 25 kills and only three attacking errors on 42 swings. She added three blocks and a service ace in the four-set win. The 25 kills are the 19th-most nationally for a four-set match this season, and the most by a
- She added 10 kills at a .412 clip and four blocks (two solo) in a sweep of Tennessee Tech on Sept. 2. She was named to the Golden Eagle Invite All-Tournament Team for her performance.

// GOLDEN EAGLE TOURNEY CHAMPS

- Cincinnati won the Golden Eagle Tournament (Sept. 1-2), picking up wins over Kennesaw State, ETSU and Tennessee Tech. It marked Cincinnati's first non-conference tournament title since 2021 when the Bearcats won the NKU Invitational.
- Jadyn Bauss was named Most Valuable Player while Abby Walker and Zeta Washington were selected to the All-Tournament Team.
- to the All-lournament learn.
 Bauss averaged 4.63 points, 3.82 kills and 2.55 digs per set. She led the Bearcats in kills twice, including a 17-kill performance in a four-set win over ETSU. Walker averaged 2.82 kills and 0.67 blocks per set while hitting .491. She registered a season-high 15 kills at a .519 clip (15-1-27) in a four-set win over Kennesaw State.

// RECORD CROWDS FILL FIFTH THIRD ARENA

- Cincinnati broke its volleyball attendance record on August 26 with 3,358 fans packed inside Fifth Third Arena. It shattered the previous record of 2,057 set on Nov. 2, 2018.
- In addition, Aug. 25's attendance of 1,513 was the fifth-most in program history.

// ACES UP OUR SLEEVES

- The Bearcats totaled 18 service aces against Xavier on Aug. 26, breaking the program and Big 12 records for service aces in a four-set match. The 18 service aces surpassed the program and Big 12 records of 17, set in 2004 and 2005, respectively. The mark ranks second in the country for a four-set
- Shaye Eggleston had a career-high seven aces while Bauss tied her career high with five. Eggleston tied the individual program record for aces in a four-set match. The mark is tied for second nationally in the category.
- The Bearcats rank second in the Big 12 in service aces per set (2.10) while Bauss sits second in the league as an individual (0.62).

// STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- · This season marks the first year that Cincinnati will compete in the Big 12.
 The Bearcats will face 11 teams that saw action
- in the 2022 postseason: nine NCAA Tournament teams and two National Invitational Volleyball Championship teams.
- · Of the 21 opponents on the schedule, 14 finished inside the top-100 in the 2022 RPI rankings.

// ALL EYES ON THE 'CATS

- Cincinnati volleyball will be showcased on ESPNU during the 2023 season as part of the Big 12's national television schedule. Cincinnati is set to host Houston for the nationally-televised contest on Sunday, Oct. 29. First serve is scheduled for 1 p.m. ET inside Fifth Third Arena.
- The league's national television schedule includes 12 volleyball matches across its television partners ESPN and FOX Sports.

// RETURNING TALENT

- The Bearcats return nine letterwinners, including four starters, from a season ago.
- The roster features the return of all-conference
- selections Abby Walker and Carly Glendinning. Walker, a 6-foot-1 middle blocker, garnered her second consecutive Second Team All-Conference nod after averaging 2.51 kills and 0.82 blocks per set as a sophomore. The 2021 AAC Freshman of the Year started and played in every match (30)
- the Year started and played in every maker (65, and set (112) last season.
 Glendinning, a 6-foot-2 outside hitter, averaged a team-best 2.97 kills per set to go along with 1.26 digs and 0.30 blocks per set in 2022. She registered 16 double-digit kill performances, including a stretch of eight straight to open AAC play. She led the team in kills nine times last year.

// NEW KIDZ ON THE BLOCK

- Cincinnati welcomes eight newcomers to the 2023 roster, including five true freshmen and three transfers.
- UC's freshman class features Zeta Washington (Ponte Vedra, Fla.), Nina Horning (Lake Orion, Mich.), Lilian Entenmann (Columbus, Ohio), Vivian Campbell (Oswego, III.) and Kayla Hostetler (Hebron, Ky.).
- The Class of 2023 was ranked No. 21 by Prep Dig, marking the highest-rated recruiting class in
- program history. Transfers Carly Skrabak (Marquette), Jadyn Bauss (SMU) and Katelyn Lefler (Illinois State) also join the Bearcats.

- // FROM THE MUSIC CITY TO THE QUEEN CITY

 Former club teammates and high school competitors Carly Skrabak (Franklin, Tenn.) and Shaye Eggleston (Brentwood, Tenn.) will reunite to compete for the Bearcats this season.
- The duo grew up 15 minutes from each other and played club for Tennessee Performance Volleyball Club.

// FOREIGN TOUR PAYS DIVIDENDS

- · The Cincinnati volleyball program had the opportunity to take a 10-day foreign tour to Europe this summer with stops in Hungary, Slovenia, Croatia and Italy.
- The team trained and played local teams in each country along with sightseeing and experiencing the cultures of each location. The Bearcats competed against the Hungarian National Team, Nova KBM Branik (a Slovenian Club Team) and the Italian National Team.

// SUPER SENIORS

- The 2023 roster features a trio of super seniors: Elissa Alcantara, Jadyn Bauss and Carly Skrabak.
- Alcantara enters her second year as a Bearcat. She will look to play a larger role on the right side this season after averaging 1.46 kills per set in 12 matches in 2022. She spent her first two years at Colorado before transferring to Florida Southwestern Community College for the 2021 season.
- Bauss, a six-foot outside hitter, joins the Bearcats from a familiar foe in SMU. She appeared in 98 career matches across 334 sets. She totaled 752 kills, 899 digs, 80 aces, 66.5 blocks and 26 double-doubles in four years with the Mustangs. She was a two-time AAC weekly honor roll selection and finished fourth in the AAC in service aces (36) in 2022.
- Skrabak, a 5-foot-6 libero, will join the Bearcats as a graduate transfer in 2023. She spent the last three seasons at Marquette, playing in two straight NCAA Tournaments, including a Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2022. She has totaled 1,487 digs in her decorated career — good for 60th nationally amongst active career leaders in 2022.
- Last season, Skrabak was named BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week three times, tabbed to the NCAA's top liberos list and earned a spot on the All-BIG EAST Championship Team.

// THERE'S A NEW EGGLESTON IN TOWN

- Outside hitter Shaye Eggleston is back for the Bearcats after an impressive debut year in the Red & Black.
- Eggleston, who transferred from Alabama in spring 2022, averaged 2.12 kills, 2.45 digs and 0.31 aces per set in her first season with the Bearcats.
- She led the team in service aces (33) and doubledoubles (6) and was second in digs (269) in 2022.
- Her sister Logan Eggleston spent the last five years at Big 12 foe Texas. Logan was named Big 12 Conference Player of the Year for the last three seasons and is a five-time All-Big 12 First-Team honoree. She led Texas to its third NCAA Championship title and was named the NCAA Championship Most Outstanding Player in 2022.
