THE RUNDOWN

- The Bearcats will compete in the inaugural Atlantic Slam W from November 22-24 in Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, Canada, where they will face Georgetown and FGCU.
- This event marks a special homecoming for Canadian players Tineya Hylton (Toronto, Ontario) and Aicha Dia (Montreal, Quebec). Both have represented Canada on the international stage: Hylton showcased her skills with the U23 National Team, while Dia competed at the 2021 U19 FIBA World Cup in Hungary.
- Cincinnati will look to bounce back after suffering a 69-68 loss to Seton Hall on Monday night at home. The Bearcats led by as many as 10 before the Pirates ended the game on a 13-3 run over the final 3:36 minutes.
- Four Bearcats finished in double figures behind a team-high 16 points from fifth year forward Jillian Hayes. She added a team-high 10 rebounds for her third double-double of the season, 26th of her career.
- Reagan Jackson (11), Chloe Mann (11) and Tineya Hylton (10) also were in double figures. It marked the first double-digit scoring performance of Mann's career.
- Hayes is averaging nearly a double-double with 19.3 points and 9.8 rebounds and is shooting 57.7% from the field this season. She sits second in the Big 12 in rebounding, sixth in scoring and eighth in field goal percentage.
- Hayes has recorded three double-doubles in her first four games, which currently leads the Big 12 and ranks fourth nationally. She is one of six Big 12 athletes to score 30-or-more points in a game this season.
- Hayes is now tied for second all-time in program history in blocked shots (131) and is third in rebounds (883).
- Redshirt junior Alliance Ndiba opened her Bearcat career with three consecutive games of 10+ rebounds. She is the first Bearcat to start a season with 10+ boards in three straight games since Loyre Harper in 1997.
- Ndiba ranks eighth in the conference and inside the top-100 nationally in rebounding (8.8). She also sits 16th in the league in blocks per game (1.75).
- Hayes and Hylton combined for 40 points vs. Davidson. It marked the first time Cincinnati had two 20-point scorers in a game since Hayes (21 points) and Mya Jackson (24 points) vs. Toledo on Nov. 16, 2022.
- Hylton set and matched her career high of 20 points in two of the first three games. She is averaging 14.5 points to go along with a team-best 5.0 assists per game this season.
- Among active career leaders in Division I, Hayes is fifth in FT made (420), 17th in rebounds (883) and 28th in doubles-doubles (26).
- Hayes and Ndiba are two of six Big 12 players to have posted three games with 10-or-more boards.
- Cincinnati ranks third in the Big 12 in free throw percentage, shooting 74% from the charity stripe.
- Cincinnati pulled down 50 rebounds vs. Delaware State. It marked the fourth game in the Merriweather era at Cincinnati with 50 rebounds or more. Across her career, Merriweather's teams have achieved this feat in 46 games.
- Head coach Katrina Merriweather announced the signing of five players on National Signing Day. The class is currently ranked No. 7 by ASGR Hoops, marking the highest-ranked class in program history.

Dee Alexander, Caliyah DeVillasee, Kali Barrett, Joya Crawford and Paige Whitted will suit up for the Bearcats as freshmen beginning in the 2025-26 campaign.
- Dee Alexander | G | Cincinnati, Ohio (Purcell Marian):** The highest-ranked recruit in program history, coming in at No. 10 in the latest ESPN rankings... Five-star recruit by ESPNW — 96 Scouts Grade... Ranked the No. 1 player in Ohio by Prep Hoops ... Named to Naismith Girls' High School Player of the Year Watch List.
- Caliyah DeVillasee | PG | Owings Mills, Md. (Our Lady of Good Counsel):** Ranked the No. 1 player overall in Maryland according to Prep Hoops... Comes in at No. 55 in the 2025 class rankings by ESPN... Four-star recruit by ESPNW — 93 Scouts Grade.
- Kali Barrett | F | Bradenton, Fla. (Cardinal Mooney):** Ranked No. 4 player in Florida according to Prep Hoops... Three-star recruit by ESPNW... Second all-time leading scorer and rebounder at Cardinal Mooney High School.
- Joya Crawford | G | Dyersburg, Tenn. (Dyersburg):** Has scored 1,700+ points at Dyersburg High School, playing for Tim Strayhorn... Holds the Dyersburg record for most points in a game with 44.

HAYES TAKES CENTER STAGE WITH WEEKLY HONORS

- Star forward Jillian Hayes was named Big 12 Player of the Week for the first week of the season, the conference announced on Monday, Nov. 11. She became the first Bearcat to win a weekly Big 12 women's basketball honor in program history.
- Hayes averaged a double-double across two wins, recording 20.5 points and 11.0 rebounds per game while shooting 61.5% from the field. She was one of two Big 12 players to record multiple double-doubles during the first week of the season, tied for the most among all players nationally.
- The Cincinnati native posted her 25th career double-double vs. Delaware State on Sunday. She dropped a career-high 30 points to go along with 11 rebounds while shooting 70.6% from the field (12-17 FG). She became the first Bearcat to post a 30-point game since Ilmarl Thomas did so on March 8, 2021, and is one of four Big 12 players to reach the 30-point mark this season.
- She added an 11-point, 11-rebound double-double in UC's season opener at UIC.

FOUNDATION SET

- Merriweather made an immediate impact last season, leading the Bearcats to a 14-18 overall record and a 5-13 mark in their debut Big 12 season. The 14 wins were the team's most since 2019 and marked a five-win improvement from the prior season.
- Merriweather also returned her alma mater to postseason play for the first time since 2019, adding to her career total of six postseason qualifications in seven eligible seasons (excluding 2020 due to COVID).
- The Bearcats went 9-3 in non-conference play in 2023-24, achieving their best non-conference win percentage (72.7%) in 15 years. They also had a six-game winning streak, the longest since 2019-20.
- Cincinnati pulled down 1,269 rebounds — the program's third-highest single-season total and its most since 2017-18. They finished the season with a positive rebounding margin (+5.0) for the first time since 2018-19 and the best margin since 2006-07. The Bearcats led the Big 12 and ranked 23rd nationally in offensive rebounds per game (14.5).
- Cincinnati led the Big 12 and ranked 15th nationally in free throws made per game (15.9) in 2023-24. Hayes reached the line frequently, ranking inside the top 15 nationally in free throws made (159) and attempts (217), both third-best for a single season in UC history.

LEADER OF THE PACK

- Forward Jillian Hayes has chosen to use her fifth year of eligibility to finish her career at Cincinnati. Hayes has led the team in starts, minutes, points, rebounds, and steals for three consecutive seasons.
- She averaged nearly a double-double with 12.9 points and 8.4 rebounds while shooting 42.0% from the field last season. She ranked fourth in the Big 12 and 78th nationally in rebounding (8.4). She recorded 26 double-digit scoring performances, including a trio of 20-point outings.
- She posted 10 double-doubles last season, becoming the first Bearcat since Doris Scott (1997-99) to record back-to-back double-digit double-double seasons.
- Over the course of the season, she led the team in numerous categories: scoring (18 games), rebounding (21 games), steals (13 games) and blocks (14 games).
- Hayes has seen her scoring average rise from 7.6 points per game in 2020-21 to 12.9 points in 2023-24, with her shooting percentage increasing from .311 to .420 over the same span.
- Hayes has led Cincinnati in scoring, rebounding and steals for three straight seasons — a first in program history. She has made 90-plus free throws each of the last three seasons.

MORE OF (ARIEL) JACKSON TO COME

- Junior Ariel Jackson returns as the team's second-leading scorer from last season, averaging 9.4 points per game. Her scoring rose from 4.1 in 2022-23, and she averaged 10.7 points in league games. Jackson also led the team in assists (49) and showed across-the-board improvements in her shooting: field goal (.313 to .330), three-point field goal (.250 to .286) and free throw (.686 to .796). She led the Bearcats in scoring in five games, steals in nine, and assists in 15.

NUMBERS TO KNOW

MORE OF (REAGAN) JACKSON TO COME

- Reagan Jackson is primed to take her game to new heights after averaging 8.2 points, 2.6 rebounds, 0.8 assists, and 1.1 three-pointers per game in 2023-24. Jackson posted 12 double-digit scoring games, including seven in Big 12 play, with a season-high 18 points against Tennessee State on December 1, 2023. She led the team in three-pointers made (36) and was fourth in scoring. Jackson started 26 of her 32 games last season.

RETURNING PRODUCTION

- Cincinnati returns nine players from 2023-24, including four starters. The Bearcats bring back three of their top four scorers from last season, including double-digit scorer in Jillian Hayes (12.9). In terms of returning percentages from 2023-24, Cincinnati returns 63.0 percent of its points (1259/1997), 61.9 percent of its rebounds (700/1131) and 50.2 percent of its assists (148/295).

NEWCOMERS TO NOTE

- The Bearcats welcome four newcomers to the 2024-25 roster: Tineya Hylton (senior, transfer from Texas A&M), Daylee Dunn (fifth-year, transfer from Loyola Marymount), Alliance Ndiba (redshirt junior, transfer from Arizona Western), and freshman Chloe Mann from Fort Worth, Texas.

TSTAR. POINT GUARD.

- Tineya Hylton, a 5-foot-7 guard, joins Cincinnati from Texas A&M, where she contributed to the Aggies' 2024 NCAA Tournament appearance. This season, she'll step into the point guard role, allowing Reagan Jackson and Ariel Jackson to play their natural positions.
- Merriweather emphasized the impact of Hylton's addition at Big 12 Media Days, "We are thrilled to have Tineya. Last year, we had a point guard. She was just injured; she played seven games. It was hard because it took a committee to break presses, to bring the ball up the floor. Now we have someone who wants that pressure; she wants to facilitate. I love the way she's committed to playing defense."
- During her junior season in 2023-24, Hylton led Texas A&M in assists in five games and achieved three double-digit scoring performances. She played the first semester of her college career at the University of Georgia after reclassifying due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

THE BELIEVER

- Freshman Chloe Mann holds a special place in Cincinnati's new era under head coach Katrina Merriweather as her very first recruit to join the program.
- Mann made her mark at Duncanville High School, where she was a dual-sport standout, winning state championships in both basketball and track and field. A skilled playmaker, she'll join senior Tineya Hylton in handling the ball this season.
- In her senior year, Mann averaged an impressive 13.2 points, 3.6 assists, 3.8 rebounds and 2.2 steals per game. She was also nominated for the prestigious 47th annual McDonald's All-American Games, one of only 40 players recognized from Texas. Prior to her time at Duncanville, she played two standout seasons at Boswell High School, where she earned Newcomer of the Year honors in 2020-21.

ALLIANCE IS A JUCO ALL-AMERICAN

- Redshirt junior Alliance Ndiba, a 6-foot-3 standout from Arizona Western College, joins Cincinnati as a two-time NJCAA All-American. Averaging a double-double with 14.0 points and 11.8 rebounds across 57 games, she earned First Team All-ACCAC and All-Region honors. She earned both ACCAC Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year honors in 2021-22.
- A native of Lubumbashi, Congo, Ndiba has formed a close bond with teammate Aïcha Dia, who is also fluent in French and has helped her adjust to life in Cincinnati.

OH, CANADA!

- The Bearcats will compete in the inaugural Atlantic Slam W in Charlottetown, Canada, from November 22-24, where they will face Georgetown and FGCU. The Hoyas went 23-12 last season and advanced the WBIT Second Round. FGCU, who went 29-5, won its seventh straight ASUN Tournament to earn a berth to the 2024 NCAA Tournament.
- This event marks a special homecoming for Canadian players Tineya Hylton (Toronto, Ontario) and Aicha Dia (Montreal, Quebec). Both have represented Canada on the international stage: Hylton showcased her skills with the U23 National Team, while Dia competed at the 2021 U19 FIBA World Cup in Hungary.

MS. TWO SPORTS

- Fifth-year transfer Daylee Dunn will bring her athletic talents to both the Bearcats' basketball team and outdoor track and field team in 2024-25. Dunn comes to Cincinnati following previous stops at Loyola Marymount (2023-24) and Fresno State (2020-23).
- Dunn appeared in 64 games in three seasons at Fresno State, which included a 2021 WNIT appearance. She was also a member of the Bulldogs track and field team where she scored in the 400m hurdles at the 2022 Mountain West Championship.

FROM COURT TO COVER

- Star forward Jillian Hayes made headlines by appearing in the 2024 Sports Illustrated Swimsuit 60th Anniversary Issue, joining UCF's Jas Williams and Houston's Alexa Massari as the Big 12's representatives.
- Last season, Hayes traveled to Belize for the Sports Illustrated Swimsuit shoot, then flew directly to Lawrence, Kansas, to rejoin her team on the eve of their game. Despite the whirlwind travel, she delivered a double-double performance against Kansas, scoring 15 points and pulling down a career-high 17 rebounds.
- She also attended the SI Swimsuit Launch Weekend, meeting icons such as Tyra Banks, Christie Brinkley, and many more.

HOLTMAN'S JOURNEY OF RESILIENCE

- Sophomore Abby Holtman's journey in sports has been defined by resilience. Diagnosed with hearing loss at age four, she received her first hearing aids the same year. "The best way I can describe it now is like noise cancelation," Holtman explained. "With noise-canceling headphones, you can't block out everything."
- Holtman shares her hearing loss journey with her younger sister, Paisley, who also has the condition. Though Paisley is passionate about volleyball, the two sisters share an unbreakable bond as they navigate both sports and life's challenges together. In honor of Paisley, Holtman donates 50% of her NIL proceeds from Rally House to the audiology department at Cincinnati Children's Hospital.

DUNN AN ENTREPRENEUR

- Off the court, Daylee Dunn is a motivated entrepreneur with a purpose. As a freshman at Fresno State, she launched Baby Daylee LLC, a baby doll line featuring affirmation cards to inspire children.
- Dunn drew inspiration from her mother's and grandmother's words of encouragement, aiming to create something that would uplift and empower young girls everywhere.

- Jillian Hayes comes from athletic bloodlines. Her father, Jonathan, was a former NFL player with the Kansas City Chiefs (1985-1993) and Pittsburgh Steelers (1994-1996), assistant coach with the Cincinnati Bengals (2003-18), head coach/GM of the XFL's St. Louis BattleHawks (2020) and most recent a co-offensive coordinator of the XFL's Arlington Renegades (2023-). He was recently named Athletic Director of nearby Moeller High School in Cincinnati.
- Her mother, Kristi, was the 1995 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Year at Drake, and her brother, Jaxson, played at Texas, was the eighth overall pick in the 2019 NBA Draft by the Atlanta Hawks, played for the New Orleans Pelicans and currently plays for the Los Angeles Lakers.

LIKE MOTHER, LIKE DAUGHTER

- Junior guard Ariel Jackson follows in the footsteps of her mother, Kym Hampton, who was the No. 4 pick in the inaugural 1997 WNBA Draft. Hampton played three seasons with the New York Liberty, serving as the starting center in the first WNBA All-Star Game and enjoying a 15-year professional career. Jackson, a Brooklyn native and lifelong Liberty fan, will have the opportunity to play against her mother's alma mater, Arizona State, when UC visits Tempe on January 25.

THE SISTERHOOD STARTS WITH STAFF

- Prior to returning to Cincinnati, Katrina Merriweather was the head coach for Memphis where a familiar coaching staff started to take shape. Katrina Merriweather hired her younger sister Kabrina to help lead the Tigers to a 38-23 record and a postseason appearance in the WNIT Sweet 16 in 2023.
- Prior to Memphis, Kabrina worked as the Director of Operations for New Mexico Lobos where she made the jump to assistant coach in the 2021-22 season. She was also a forward for Florida A&M and Georgia Southwestern State from 2011-15.
- Both Merriweathers have been on the sidelines together since 2021, and have continued that sisterhood bond in Clifton.

#THESISTERHOOD

- Cincinnati is one of only nine programs in the Power Four, and the only program in the Big 12, with an all-female coaching staff.
- Every year, Merriweather has had a former player on staff. Seven total. At least one from every head coaching stop.
- Merriweather has had a staff member selected to the WBCA Thirty Under 30 List for seven straight years.

MORE ON MERRIWEATHER

- Head coach Katrina Merriweather made an immediate impact last season, leading the Bearcats to a 14-18 overall record and a 5-13 mark in their debut Big 12 season. The 14 wins were the team's most since 2019 and marked a five-win improvement from the prior season.
- Merriweather also returned her alma mater to postseason play for the first time since 2019, adding to her career total of six postseason qualifications in seven eligible seasons (excluding 2020 due to COVID).
- Merriweather was hired as the 10th women's basketball head coach at Cincinnati, her alma mater, on March 25, 2023. A four-year letterwinner for Hall of Fame head coach Laurie Pirtle from 1997-01, Merriweather was the program's first women's basketball player to make four consecutive postseason tournaments and posted an 83-41 record as a player.
- Additionally, she helped lead the program to its first-ever NCAA Tournament win as a graduate assistant in 2001-02.
- Merriweather spent five seasons at Wright State, where she led the Raiders to a 113-47 record, four postseason berths (2 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and was named Horizon League Coach of the Year three times. She led Wright State to the program's third appearance and first NCAA Tournament win with an upset over four-seed Arkansas in 2021.
- Katrina Merriweather was a team captain in 2000-01 and made 27 starts in 107 games played with 22 starts as a senior. She was a part of four postseason tournament appearances in her four seasons as a player and five postseason berths in her five years with the Bearcats. (Player - WNIT 1998, 2000, 2001, NCAA - 1999; GA NCAA - 2002).
- With Wright State, she was a three-time Horizon League Regular Season champion (2017, 2019, 2021) and two time Horizon League Regular Season champion (2019, 2021).

POSTSEASON HISTORY

- Cincinnati has made the NCAA Tournament four times in its history (1988-89, 1998-99, 2001-02, 2002-03), earning three at-large bids.
- Cincinnati has won four conference titles in its history. The Bearcats won the 2002 C-USA Championships to advance to the NCAA Tournament where the program earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament win. Merriweather was on the staff as a graduate assistant that year.
- The 1988-89 Bearcats compiled a 21-9 ledger under Laurie Pirtle and made the school's first appearance in the NCAA tournament.
- A four-year letterwinner for the Bearcats from 1997-01, Merriweather became the program's first women's basketball player to advance to four consecutive postseason tournaments.
- Cincinnati has made 14 postseason appearances.

LAST TIME OUT

CINCINNATI — A fourth quarter rally by Seton Hall proved to be the deciding factor as the University of Cincinnati women's basketball team fell to the Pirates 69-68 on Monday night inside Fifth Third Arena.

Cincinnati led by as many as 10 before Seton Hall went on a 13-3 run over the final three minutes of the game. The Bearcats' final two looks were unsuccessful as the Pirates held on for the 69-68 win. UC committed 23 turnovers in the loss, including 11 in the decisive fourth quarter.

Four Bearcats finished in double figures behind a team-high 16 points from fifth year forward Jillian Hayes. She added a team-high 10 rebounds for her third double-double of the season, 26th of her career. Reagan Jackson (11), Chloe Mann (11) and Tinaya Hylton (10) also were in double figures. It marked the first double-digit scoring performance of Mann's career.

Seton Hall hit a pair of three-pointers to lead 12-6 with under five minutes remaining in the first quarter. Hayes had all six of UC's points to start. The Bearcats pulled within two to end the quarter after a tough bucket by Hayes (19-17).

UC tied up the game after back-to-back buckets from Mann and Delaney Snyder (23-23). The Pirates then rattled off eight straight before a Reagan Jackson 3-pointer ended the spurt (31-26). The stretch featured four points from Brianna Byars. The two teams were tied at 35-all heading into the locker room.

Reagan Jackson and Mann knocked down back-to-back three-pointers to give UC a four-point lead with 4:37 in the third quarter (46-42). In total, the Bearcats went on an 11-0 run over four minutes (51-42). Cincinnati outscored Seton Hall 18-9 to own a nine-point advantage with one quarter remaining (53-44).

Seton Hall scored the first six points of the final period to cut UC's deficit to three (53-50). Hylton ended the drought for the Bearcats with under seven minutes remaining. Abby Holtman drained a pair of three-pointers to give UC its largest lead of the game with 4:02 on the clock (65-55).

The Pirates then went on an 11-0 over three minutes to reclaim the lead with 35 seconds remaining (67-65). Hayes completed an and-one play before Seton Hall went back in front with 19 seconds on the clock (69-68). The Bearcats' final two looks were unsuccessful as the Pirates held on for the 69-68 win.

HEAD COACH KATRINA MERRIWEATHER



Director of Athletics John Cunningham announced the hire of former Bearcats' captain Katrina Merriweather as the 10th women's basketball head coach at the University of Cincinnati on March 25, 2023.

Merriweather quickly has become a rising star in the coaching profession, taking three programs to the postseason a total of six times, including a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. She has totaled 165 wins in eight seasons as bench boss.

Merriweather guided the Bearcats' transition from the American Athletic Conference to the Big 12 Conference in her first season at UC in 2023-24. The Bearcats saw a five-win improvement and their 14 wins were the most in a single season since 2019-20. The squad posted its best non-conference winning percentage (.727%) in 15 years and won six consecutive games during the stretch for its longest win streak since 2019-20. The non-conference slate also featured UC's first win over an SEC opponent since 2004.

Merriweather led her third school to the postseason, having done so at previous stops Memphis and Wright State. Cincinnati qualified for the WNIT for its 14th postseason appearance and first since 2019.

Senior Jillian Hayes became the first player in program history to earn All-Big 12 honors. She ranked inside the top-5 in the league in free throws made, free throws attempts and rebounds per game. She announced she would return to the Bearcats for her final season of eligibility in 2024-25.

"I'm excited to announce Katrina Merriweather as the next head coach for our women's basketball program," Cunningham said. "Her track record of success at both Wright State and Memphis speaks for itself. She's been an outstanding recruiter, program builder and developer of talent. As an alumna of Cincinnati and one of the winningest players in school history, she knows the potential this program has and understands what it will take for us to compete at the top of the Big 12. She's the perfect fit and I'm thrilled to welcome her back to the program."

"My time as a student-athlete and as a Bearcat were some of the greatest years of my life, and I'm excited to give back with everything I have to our current players like so many did for me. This is home for me, and I'm honored to wear the C-Paw once again. I'm thankful to John Cunningham and Maggie McKinley for this opportunity and I'm looking forward to working closely with our entire athletics department to compete for championships in the Big 12."

Merriweather and USA Basketball earned a silver medal podium finish at the 2023 FIBA Women's AmeriCup in Leon, Mexico. She was elevated to her first bench coach assignment for the event after previously serving as a court coach for the 2021 USA Women's U19 National Team Trials.

Merriweather led Memphis to a 22-11 season in 2022-23, the program's first 20-win season in more than a decade, and an appearance in the 2023 WNIT Sweet 16.

Merriweather took over a four-win Memphis team and immediately produced 16 wins in 2021-22 before the 22-win campaign this season in which the Tigers clinched the two seed in the 2022 AAC Championships, the program's highest-ever AAC regular season finish, and advanced to a postseason tournament for the first time since 2015-16.

In her two seasons at the helm, the Tigers compiled a 38-23 record and earned three All-Conference selections.

The search was led by Maggie McKinley, Deputy Athletic Director and Senior Woman Administrator, who worked with Cunningham to bring Merriweather back home.

Prior to her tenure at Memphis, Merriweather spent five seasons as the head coach at Wright State, where she took the Raiders to two NCAA Tournaments and was named Horizon League Coach of the Year three times. Merriweather led Wright State to the program's third appearance and first NCAA Tournament win with an upset over four-seed Arkansas in 2021.

In 2018-19, she guided the Raiders to a school-record 27 wins and its first-ever outright Horizon League regular season championship, securing the conference tournament title and reaching the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history.

While at the helm, Merriweather led the Raiders to a 113-47 (.706) record, finishing with the best winning percentage in program history. She was a part of all three of the program's Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances, twice as a head coach in 2019 and 2021 and once as an assistant in 2014. The Raiders also earned 16 All-Conference selections in her tenure.

Merriweather was an assistant under Mike Bradbury for six seasons at Wright State from 2010-16 before becoming head coach.

Prior to Wright State, she was an assistant at Purdue from 2003-06, and at UIC for the 2002-03 season.

With the Bearcats, Merriweather made 27 career starts, including 22 in her senior season, and played in 107 games. She helped lead the program to an 83-41 record in her four seasons.

The Indianapolis native graduated from Cincinnati in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in English literature and earned a second bachelor in secondary education in 2002.

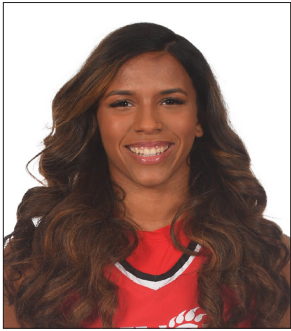

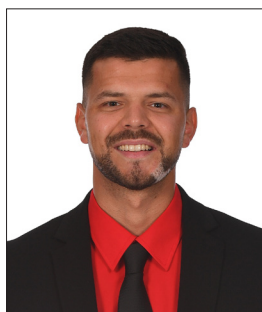

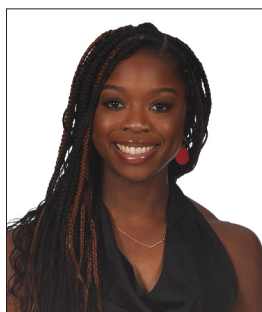
