CINCINNATI CLOSES OUT EARLY SEASON HOMESTAND WITH TOLEDO

- Cincinnati closes out an early season homestand when the Bearcats face Toledo inside Fifth Third Arena at 11 a.m. ET on Wednesday. The Bearcats will look to remain undefeated at home after securing a 62-53 win over Radford last Sunday.
- Cincinnati led for 38:06 and never trailed in the game. The last time that the Bearcats never trailed in a game was a 71-58 win over Memphis on Feb. 23, 2022.
- Caitlyn Wilson finished with a game-high 15 points on 5-7 from behind the arc, in addition to three rebounds, a block, and a steal. Wilson was one of four Bearcats who finished in double figures, the first time that four Bearcats scored in double figures since a 57-68 loss to East Carolina on Feb. 19, 2022.
- Jillian Hayes recorded her fourth career double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds. Clarissa Craig turned in a career-high 11 points and tied a career-high with five rebounds, while Jada Scott tied a career-high with eight points and seven rebounds off the bench.
- The Bearcats forced 22 Highlander turnovers, converting them into a 24-11 advantage in points off turnovers. Cincinnati received a season-high 24 points off its bench.
- Wednesday will be the 12th-ever meeting between Cincinnati and Toledo. The Bearcats lead the all-time series 8-3 and are 5-0 in Cincinnati. The last time these two programs played was Mar. 19, 2012, where Cincinnati suffered a 72-51 loss in Toledo.
- The Bearcats are 27-18 in regular season non-conference games and 43-22 at home in four seasons under head coach Michelle Clark-Heard.






EARLY SEASON CONTRIBUTIONS

- Cincinnati has three players - Mya Jackson (13.7), Jillian Hayes (11.0), and Braylyn Milton (10.7) - who are averaging double figures scoring through the first three games. Mya Jackson is the only Bearcat to finish in double figures in her first three games as a Bearcat (Seton Hall transfer).
- Cincinnati is converting on 21-44 for 47.7 percent from three point range through the first three games, which ranks sixth in the nation and second in the AAC. Caitlyn Wilson, one of three Bearcats shooting at or above 50.0 percent from three, ranks third in the conference with a team-high 61.5 three-point percentage (8-13).
- Mya Jackson has logged 37.0 minutes per game through the first three contests, which ranks first in the AAC.

NOTING TOLEDO

- In the 15th season under head coach Tricia Cullop, Toledo is off to a 2-0 start with wins over Wright State and Canisius.
- The Rockets are led by senior guard Quinesha Lockett, who is averaging 18.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game. Lockett was named to the preseason watch list for the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award, while her and fellow guard Sophia Wiard were both named Preseason First-Team All-MAC.
- Toledo was selected to win the Mid-American Conference, receiving 11 of 12 first-place votes in the preseason poll. Last season, Toledo finished 29-6 overall, 19-1 in conference play to win the program's 10th MAC Regular Season Championship. Toledo's 29 wins tied a school record, matching the 2010-11 and 2012-13 teams.
- Toledo was one of just 10 teams to win at least 29 games last season.
- Overall, Toledo returns 97.6 percent of its minutes played and 98.7 percent of its offensive production from a year ago.

DANGEROUS FROM BEHIND THE ARC

- Cincinnati is converting on 21-44 for 47.7 percent from three point range through the first three games, which ranks sixth in the nation and second in the AAC. Caitlyn Wilson is leading the team with a 61.5 three-point percentage [8-13].
- Wilson is one of three Bearcats who are shooting at or above 50.0 percent from three through the first three games (min. 3 made). [Mya Jackson and Braylyn Milton - 50.0]
- Cincinnati shot 9-13 (69.2 percent) from three in the season opener at Louisville, the best mark under Michelle Clark-Heard. Cincinnati improved to 13-2 when shooting above 50.0 percent from three under Clark-Heard.
- Caitlyn Wilson finished second in the AAC with 2.1 three-point field goals per game and third in total three-point field goals made at 58 on 30.9 percent from behind the arc last season, while Braylyn Milton converted on a team-high 38.2 percent from three.
- The Bearcats added Mya Jackson, who ranked eighth in the BIG EAST with a .373 three-point percentage last season, her third straight season converting on at least .370 percent from behind the arc.
- The Bearcats have four players on their roster with at least a 31.0 career three-point percentage (min. one season played) [Milton - 40.0, Jackson - 39.6, Jenks - 33.3, Wilson - 32.6].

BOUNCE BACK FOR JILLIAN HAYES

- The junior guard Jillian Hayes is averaging 11.0 points, a team-high 7.3 rebounds, and 2.0 assists in 22.9 minutes per game through the first three contests.
- After an 0-9 performance in 19 minutes at Louisville, Hayes posted back-to-back impressive performances against Radford and Tennessee Tech. Hayes finished with her fourth career double-double, recording 11 points and 10 rebounds, in addition three assists, three blocks and two steals in 25 minutes last Sunday vs. Radford. She finished with a game-high 19 points on 8-15 from the field, 15 of which came in the first half, in addition to nine rebounds, three assists, a block and steal vs. Tennessee Tech.
- "We were really pleased with her ability to be aggressive early tonight," said head coach Michelle Clark-Heard on Hayes following Tennessee Tech. "That was something myself and Coach Gordon talked about with her. We told her that she has been in a lot of big-time situations for us and tonight was her growing as a player and that's what we need from her."

MYA JACKSON LEADING AT POINT

- Senior Mya Jackson (Seton Hall transfer) has finished in double figures (18 vs. Tennessee Tech; 12 at Louisville;) in her first three contests as a Bearcat.
- Jackson is tied for first in the conference, ranks 43rd nationally with 14 assists.
- She has played a conference-high 37.1 minutes per game, ranking first on the team with 13.7 points and 4.7 assists per game.

BIG OPENING NIGHT FOR BRAYLYN MILTON

- Sophomore guard Braylyn Milton erupted for a career-high and game-high 28 points on 9-12 from the field, 5-5 from behind the arc in the season opener against No.7/5 Louisville.
- The 28 points by Milton ties the most individual points against Louisville since Notre Dame's Jessica Shepard had 30 against the ACC Women's Tournament Final on Mar. 10, 2019.
- It is the most points scored by a Bearcat since Ilmar'I Thomas totaled 30 in the American Athletic Conference First Round against Memphis on Mar. 8, 2021. It is also the most points in a season opener since Thomas had 34 against Northern Kentucky on Nov. 25, 2020.

A LOT OF PRODUCTION BACK

- Despite losing five players from last year's roster, the Bearcats return a lot of production.

- Cincinnati welcomes back 38.3 points, 26.1 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game.
- The Bearcats return four players that started double-digit games in 2021-22. [Jillian Hayes - 28, Caitlyn Wilson - 21, Braylyn Milton - 14, Jadyn Scott - 12]. The four players have made a combined 111 starts at Cincinnati. [Jillian Hayes - 48, Caitlyn Wilson - 32, Jadyn Scott - 17, Braylyn Milton - 14].
- Cincinnati welcomes in the addition of Mya Jackson, who started 33 of 34 games last season at Seton Hall and made 59 career starts over three seasons with the Pirates.
- Nine of the 10 returners have made a start and combine to have made 137 starts at Cincinnati. [Jillian Hayes - 48, Caitlyn Wilson - 32, Jadyn Scott - 17, Braylyn Milton - 14, Jada Scott - 13, Sofia Gritzali - 7, Malea Williams - 3, Taziah Jenks - 2, Clarissa Craig - 1].

HAYES NAMED TO PRESEASON SECOND-TEAM; CINCINNATI PREDICTED NINTH IN THE AMERICAN

- Junior guard Jillian Hayes was named to the American Athletic Conference Preseason All-Conference Second Team on Oct. 12.
- The Cincinnati native was the only Bearcat to start all 28 games last season, averaging 11.5 points, 6.8 rebounds and 2.8 assists in 31.2 minutes per game. Hayes led the team in points, rebounds, steals and blocks, ranking second in the conference with 2.2 steals, seventh with 1.4 blocks and tenth in rebounds per game. She finished in double figures in 16 games, including 10 conference contests, and recorded a career-high 23 points on 9-15 from the field against Central Michigan on Dec. 1.
- Hayes' averages increased to 7.0 rebounds and 12.1 points per game in AAC play, first and second compared to conference sophomores, respectively.
- Cincinnati was selected to finish ninth in conference, while South Florida was chosen as the predicted favorite for the second straight season with nine first place votes.

NEW FACES IN THE MIX

- Cincinnati welcomes in the addition of three newcomers, transfers Mya Jackson and Dais'Ja Trotter and freshman A'riel Jackson.

DAIS'JA TROTTER

- Trotter comes to Cincinnati from Rend Lake College, where she was named the Great Rivers Athletic Conference and NJCAA Region XXIV Player of the Year after leading the NJCAA in points per game, total points and field goals made. She finished as Rend Lake College's all-time leading scorer with 1,474 points, breaking a nearly four-decade record established in 1983. She was also named a Second-Team NJCAA All-American, in addition to earning All-Region and All-Conference honors after starting 29 of 30 games and averaging 24.4 points, 10.3 rebounds, and 2.3 assists per game in 2021-22. She was named an honorable mention NJCAA All-American in 2020-21. Her #10 Rend Lake jersey is on display at the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Ring of Honor in Knoxville, Tenn.

MYA JACKSON

- Jackson comes to Cincinnati after three seasons at Seton Hall. In 2021-22, she started 33 of 34 games averaging 9.0 points, 2.9 rebounds and 1.3 assists in 32.0 minutes per game. She ranked eighth in the BIG EAST with a .373 three-point percentage, her third straight season converting on at least .370 percent from behind the arc. She was heavily recruited by Clark-Heard coming out of high school before choosing Seton Hall.

A'RIEL JACKSON

- Jackson comes to Cincinnati from Bishop Loughlin Memorial High School, where she named to the McDonald's All-American East Nominee List and was 1,000-point scorer. Jackson was ranked 79th nationally, 16th-ranked shooting guard by Preferred Athlete Scouting Service and 108th nationally by the All-Star Girls Report. Her Mother, Kym Hampton, was the number four overall pick in the inaugural 1997 WNBA Draft and played three seasons for the New York Liberty as part of a 15-year professional career, where she was voted the starting center in the inaugural WNBA All-Star Game.

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE AHEAD

- Cincinnati is set to face three opponents who were ranked or receiving votes in the Associated Press' preseason top 25 poll, opening the season at No. 7 Louisville before facing UCF (RV) twice and South Florida (RV) once in conference action.
- Cincinnati plays five opponents - Louisville, USF, UCF, UT Arlington and Charlotte - who made the NCAA Tournament last season.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

- Cincinnati has a set of twins - Jada and Jadyn Scott - who are one of 15 sets of twins on a Division I women's basketball roster.
- Jadyn Scott played in 27 of 28 games with 12 starts last season. She averaged 4.4 points, 2.7 rebounds in 14.9 minutes per game and finished second on the team with a 49.4 percent field goal percentage.
- Jada Scott played in 24 of 28 games with three starts, averaging 1.4 points and 1.4 rebounds in 8.5 minutes per game.

ADDING JENKS BACK TO THE FOLD

- After transferring from West Virginia, Taziah Jenks tore her ACL in a road game against Ohio State on Nov. 27, 2021. She was averaging 7.5 points, 3.2 rebounds and 1.3 assists per game in 19.7 minutes before the injury and started in her first game back at Louisville on Nov. 7.

APPROACHING MILESTONES

- Head coach Michelle Clark-Heard is 244-135 all-time as a head coach and is six wins shy of 250 for her career.
- Senior guard Mya Jackson stands at 830 career points and is only 170 points shy of 1,000.
- Senior guard Caitlyn Wilson is 12 three-point field goals made shy of entering top-10 in program history (currently at 112 124 - 10th).

FAMILY TIES**JILLIAN HAYES**

- Her father, Jonathan, was a former NFL player with the Kansas City Chiefs (1985-1993) and Pittsburgh Steelers (1994-1996), assistant coach with the Cincinnati Bengals (2003-18) and recent head coach for the XFL's St. Louis BattleHawks (2020); mother, Kristi, was the 1995 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Year at Drake; and brother, Jaxson, played at Texas and was the eighth overall pick in the 2019 NBA Draft by the Atlanta Hawks, currently playing for the New Orleans Pelicans.

A'RIEL JACKSON

- Her Mother, Kym Hampton, was the number four overall pick in the inaugural 1997 WNBA Draft and played three seasons for the New York Liberty as part of a 15-year professional career, where she was voted the starting center in the inaugural WNBA All-Star Game.

JADA/JADYN SCOTT

- One of 15 sets of twins on a Division I Women's Basketball roster, their brother, Tre Scott, played for Cincinnati men's basketball from 2016-20, earning 2020 AAC Defensive Player of the Year honors.

RECRUITING CLOSE TALENT

- The roster features six players within a 100-mile radius, including Jillian Hayes and Clarissa Craig from Cincinnati.

PROGRAM ADDS THREE NEW ASSISTANT COACHES

- Cincinnati welcomes in the addition of three new assistant coaches, Bridgette Gordon, Myia Johnson and Devrinn Paul.

BRIDGETTE GORDON

- Gordon comes to Cincinnati after stints at Kansas State, SMU, Tennessee, Wichita State, Georgia State, WNBA and Stetson. Gordon is a 2007 Women's Basketball Hall of Fame inductee, won a 1988 Olympic Gold Medal in Seoul, two-time NCAA National Champion under Pat Summit in 1987 and 1989, the first two national championships in program history. As a player at Tennessee, Gordon was named NCAA Final Four MVP, SEC Female Athlete of the Year, SEC Player of the Year (senior season) and a two-time All-American. She led the Lady Vols to their first two national championships and four straight Final Fours. Gordon finished her college career as the all-time leader in points (2,462) and steals (336) for the Lady Vols and remains second in both categories.

MYIA JOHNSON

- Johnson comes to Cincinnati after stints at Penn State, Wisconsin, Ohio State and South Florida.. Johnson was a four-year letter winner for Hall of Fame head coach C. Vivian Stringer at Rutgers from 2006-10, appearing in two Sweet 16s, an Elite Eight and the 2007 National Championship game and was the co-captain of 2009-10 team.

DEVRIINN PAUL

- Paul comes to Cincinnati after serving as a coaching consulting for the last six years and a three-year stint at Marshall. Prior to serving as an assistant coach at Marshall, Paul served as a video coordinator under Walz at Louisville for three seasons (2009-12.) He was part of the program's first NCAA Final Four appearance in 2009.

CAPTAINS FOR THE 2022-23 SEASON

HEAD COACH MICHELLE CLARK-HEARD

FIFTH SEASON

The University of Cincinnati women's basketball program continues to reach new heights under head coach Michelle Clark-Heard since her hiring in March 2018.

Clark-Heard is entering her fifth season at the helm in 2022-23 and her 13th overall season as a collegiate head coach. Under Clark-Heard, the Bearcats have posted superlatives including back-to-back 20 win seasons from 2018-2020 and the program's first appearance in a conference tournament final, both of which last occurred in 2002-03.

In 2021-22, the Bearcats continued to experience success as Braylyn Milton was named to the AAC All-Freshman Team to become the third player (Jillian Hayes, 2021 and Ilmar'I Thomas, 2018) to earn the distinction under Clark-Heard. Caitlyn Wilson finished second in the conference in three-point field goals made per game (2.1), while the Bearcats had two players ranked in the top-three in steals per game. In addition to the individual accolades, Bearcats were the only AAC program to defeat the conference champion UCF, taking down the Knights 61-57 inside Fifth Third Arena.

Clark-Heard, who was a UC assistant from 2002-05 and also spent six seasons as the head coach at Western Kentucky University before returning to UC, has amassed 46 wins in her first two years at the helm and is the only coach in program history to open a tenure with back-to-back 20 win seasons. Overall, her 10-year coaching career has seen her teams average more than 20 wins per campaign (22.4) with seven postseason appearances, including four NCAA Tournaments and three WNIT berths.

Her third season with the Bearcats (2020-21) was a season unlike any other due to COVID-19. Even with an 8-16 finish, Clark-Heard continued to showcase the talent on the court. Ilmar'I Thomas was tabbed as the AAC Player of the year, receiving all 50 voting points from the league's coaches to be the only conference player to earn unanimous First Team All-AAC honors for the second consecutive season. Thomas earned national player of the week honors from the United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) after she set the UC women's basketball record and the AAC record for most points in a game when she poured in 51 points to go with 12 rebounds at East Carolina on Feb. 24. The effort still stands as the most points in a Division I men's or women's basketball game this season. She joined Oscar Robertson as the only two player in UC history to score 50 or points in a game.

Jillian Hayes was tabbed as the AAC Freshman of the year and is the fourth UC player to be named to the AAC All-Freshmen Team, joining Ilmar'I Thomas (2018), Bianca Quisenberry (2014) and Anna Owens (2015).

Her second season with the Bearcats (2019-20) produced many big moments for the program. On a team level, UC posted a 22-10 record overall and went 11-5 in the American to finish tied for second, UC's best league finish in its seven-year membership in the AAC. Seeded third in the tournament, the Bearcats reached the final for the first time in the AAC as well as their first final appearance since the 2003 Conference USA Championship game. Additionally, the Bearcats finished the year 14-3 at home with a 12-game winning streak at Fifth Third Arena as well.

Individually, Clark-Heard's players enjoyed a great deal of success as well as a trio of players -- Ilmar'I Thomas, Antoinette Miller and Angel Rizer -- all joined the program's 1,000-point club during the season, the 27th, 28th and 29th members, respectively. When it came time for awards and honors, that trio also made a big splash as each was honored by the AAC as Thomas was a unanimous selection to the first team, Miller was a second-team honoree and Rizer was twice honored as she was named the AAC Most Improved Player of the Year while earning third-team all-conference accolades as well. The honors didn't end there, however, as Thomas and Miller both were voted Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) All-America Honorable Mention selections. The awards stand as just the second and third All-America honors earned in program history, joining Debbie Merrill, a 2003 WBCA All-America Honorable Mention.

In her first season at the helm at UC in 2018-19, Clark-Heard led the Bearcats to 24 wins -- the most victories in a head coach's first season in program history, and the most triumphs in 17 years (27 in 2001-02). The Red and Black's historic accomplishments also included the first time with consecutive postseason wins in program history (WNIT quarterfinals), its first 20-win season since 2003, first time with 12 conference wins since 1999, (at the time) highest-ever finish in the American (third place), and first time with three or more regular-season conference honorees since 2003 (Thomas - First Team All-AAC, Miller - Second Team All-AAC, Florence Sifa - Newcomer of the Year).

In six seasons at WKU, Clark-Heard reached four NCAA Tournaments, won four conference tournament championships and two regular season conference titles while posting 154 wins, becoming the second-fastest Lady Topper coach to reach 100 victories with the program. Clark-Heard took over a program with a 9-21 record in 2011-12 and she led the Hilltoppers to a 22-11 mark in her first season (2012-13), a 13-win improvement, which was the largest in Sun Belt Conference history.

Prior to taking the reigns at WKU, Clark-Heard spent five years as an assistant coach to Jeff Walz at Louisville (2007-12). During her time with the program, the Cardinals made three Sweet 16 appearances and their first Final Four appearance, finishing as the National Runner-Up in 2009.

Prior to her time at Louisville, Clark-Heard spent two seasons as the head coach at Kentucky State, taking the reigns of the program in June 2005. She took over a program that had won just one game during the 2004-05 season. In her first season, she led the Thorobrettes to a 5-23 record, four of the wins were against Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference opponents. Her team was picked to finish 11th in the SIAC but ended the season in ninth place. In her second season at KSU, she guided the Thorobrettes to an impressive 19-9 record, finishing tied for fourth place in the SIAC. Clark-Heard earned SIAC Coach of the Year honors after the impressive turnaround. Her 2006-07 Thorobrettes were the second most improved team in NCAA Division II women's basketball.

A four-year letter-winner on the Hill (1987-90), Clark-Heard was part of four NCAA Tournament teams during her Lady Topper career. She also helped guide the Lady Toppers to a pair of Sun Belt Conference Tournament championships (1988 and 1989) and two conference regular-season titles (1989 and 1990). She played in 118 games during her four years on the Hill, scoring 790 points and pulling down 615 rebounds. WKU amassed 89 victories during her four years in uniform, winning 70 percent of the games over that span and putting together three 20-win seasons.
