### CINCINNATI NOTES

**CINCINNATI** – The University of Cincinnati baseball team hosts Northern Kentucky on Tuesday afternoon in its first home game of the 2024 season. First pitch is set for 3 PM at UC Baseball Stadium.

The game will be broadcasted on ESPN+ and live stats will be available at BearcatStats.com.

Cincinnati is coming off an 0-2 weekend at Jacksonville to open the 2024 season. UC dropped both games of Friday's doubleheader before rain washed out any chances of finishing the series on Saturday or Sunday.

Game one was a back-and-forth affair. Jacksonville grabbed an early lead with a four-run first inning, but Cincinnati took the lead in the top of the fourth on a two-out RBI double from Josh Kross made it 5-4.

The Dolphins evened the score at 5-5 in the bottom half of the fourth before UC scored a run in the sixth to retake the lead at 6-5. Jacksonville tied the game once again on an RBI single in the bottom of the seventh and ended things with a two-run, walk-off homer in the bottom of the ninth.

Kerrington Cross opened game two with a three-run home run in the top of the first to give UC an early lead. The Bearcats could not push across another run, however, and surrendered 11 runs to wind up on the losing end of game two.

Cincinnati leads the all-time series vs. Northern Kentucky, 37-15, and had won the last five meetings. The last time these two teams faced off was May 11, 2022, a game that UC won 12-6.

The 2024 season will feature a couple important firsts for Bearcat Baseball; it will be the first baseball season as a member of the Big 12 Conference, and also the first under head coach Jordan Bischel.

Bischel comes to UC from Central Michigan, where he served as head coach for five seasons. He sports a 314-156 (.668) career record as a head coach at the NCAA level, a stretch that includes nine winning seasons, eight conference championships, and three NCAA Regional appearances. Bischel's CMU squad advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2019, 2021, and 2022.

Following Tuesday's game, Cincinnati will head to Conway, S.C. to play in a tournament hosted by Coastal Carolina. UC will face Ball State on Friday morning before playing Illinois on Saturday and the No. 25-ranked Chanticleers on Sunday.

## FIRSTS ON THE FIELD IN 2024

The 2024 season is underway, which means a few "firsts" have already taken place. Tommy O'Connor tallied the first Bearcat hit of the season last Friday, and in the very next at-bat Landyn Vidourek launched the first UC homer of the year.

Several players also appeared in their first career college baseball game or their first game as a Bearcat. Shawn Parnell, Nathan Taylor, Drew Erdmann, and Carson Marsh made their collegiate debuts on the mound at Jacksonville, while transfers Dalton Pearson, Josh Kross, Christian Mitchelle, Hunter Jessee, Seth Logue, Luke Sefcik, and Ryan Insco all made their first appearances since coming to Cincinnati.

## D1BASEBALL ACCOLADES

Five Bearcats were highlighted as top prospects and impact freshmen by D1Baseball in the organization's Big 12 preview.

Two Bearcats were represented in the Big 12 Conference prospect ranking for the upcoming 2024 MLB Draft, headlined by junior first basemen Tommy O'Connor coming in at No. 33. O'Connor batted .303 (23-for-76) with two doubles, two triples, eight home runs and 19 RBI in 2023.

Josh Kross, a transfer from Eastern Michigan, came in at No. 38 for the 2024 MLB Draft. He batted .376 (86-for-229) with 43 runs scored, 18 doubles, 15 home runs and 70 RBI. He was named MAC Freshman of the Year, First Team All-MAC and Freshman All-America by College Baseball Newspaper.

In addition, UC had a pair of two-way players recognized on the top prospect list for the 2025 MLB Draft. Christian Mitchelle came in at No. 19, followed by Griffin Hugus at No. 28.

Mitchelle is a transfer from Central Michigan, where he was named All-MAC Second Team after batting .307 (58-189) with 53 runs scored, 13 doubles, three home runs and 29 RBI as a freshman. He also served an important role as a relief pitcher in 2023, making 11 appearances with a 3.18 ERA.

Hugus, an AAC All-Freshman Team selection in 2023, batted .234 (29-for-124) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs and 20 RBI. He made 18 appearances on the mound with a 1-2 record and two saves.

Freshman right-handed pitcher Nathan Taylor was selected to D1Baseball's impact freshmen list at No. 23. He was named West Clermont's Most Valuable Pitcher three years in a row and struck out 53 batters in 36 innings as a senior.

## BISCHEL ERA BEGINS

Jordan Bishel became the 33rd head coach in Bearcat Baseball history on June 21, 2023.

Bishel comes to UC from Central Michigan, where he served as head coach for five

seasons. He also spent four seasons as head coach of Northwood, an NCAA Division II program in Midland, Mich., and two seasons at the helm of NAIA program Midland University in Fremont, Neb.

He sports a 314-156 (.668) career record as a head coach at the NCAA level, a stretch that includes nine winning seasons, eight conference championships, and three NCAA Regional appearances. Bishel's CMU squad advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2019, 2021, and 2022.

## BISCHEL BALL COMING TO UC

When asked what fans can expect from Cincinnati Baseball in 2024, Coach Bishel said that his team will play fast and play aggressive, which tracks with how his Central Michigan teams approached the game during his tenure there.

Last season, Bishel's Central Michigan squad ranked eighth in the country in stolen bases (133) and had three players with at least 20 stolen bases, including Christian Mitchelle, who transferred to UC this season.

## 2024 SCHEDULE

Cincinnati opens the 2024 campaign and the Jordan Bishel era when the Bearcats travel to Jacksonville for a three-game series on Feb. 16-18. The Bearcats will return home for Opening Day in Cincinnati on Feb. 20 versus Northern Kentucky. First pitch is scheduled for 3 p.m. at UC Baseball Stadium.

The 56-game slate includes 30 contests against Big 12 opponents and 10 opponents that made an NCAA Regional appearance last season. UC will play 10 of 12 possible Big 12 opponents for a total of 30 Conference games. The Conference season will begin the weekend of March 8 and culminate on the weekend of May 18.

## STADIUM UPGRADES

Cincinnati baseball has made several improvements to UC Baseball Stadium since the end of the 2023 season. Those additions and improvements include:

- New videoboard and turf surface.
- Upgraded stadium speakers and lighting.
- Renovated outfield fence that includes new padding and graphics featuring retired numbers, NCAA Regional appearances, and conference championships.
- Updated indoor graphics featuring MLB alumni, current players, and Big 12 logos.
- Installation of new batting cages and pitching machine.

## NEW FACES

Cincinnati's 2024 roster features 21 new players, including 12 transfers and nine true freshmen.

Gavin Ehrhardt (Avon, Ohio), Nathan Taylor (Amelia, Ohio), Noah Wicks (Arvada, Colo.), Charlie Niehaus (West Chester, Ohio), Joey Canzoni (Walton Hills, Ohio), Carson Marsh (West Chester, Ohio), Bradley Coulter (Taylorsville, Ky.), Drew Erdmann (Hudson, Ohio), and Carson French (West Chester, Ohio) are UC's true freshman.

NATE TAYLOR GETS THE NOD

Freshman Nate Taylor is schedule to make his first collegiate start on Saturday. The 6-4 hurler from Amelia, Ohio was a four-year letterwinner at West Clermont, where he was named the team's Most Valuable Player three years in a row. He led his team to a conference championship and a regional title as a senior while posting a sub-2.00 ERA en route to honorable mention all-state accolades.

KERRINGTON CROSS RETURNS

A second-team all-conference honoree last year, Kerrington Cross figures to be a fixture in the Bearcats' lineup in 2024. The Brownsburg, Ind. native hit .262 last season while tallying nine home runs, 37 RBI, 49 runs scored, and 10 doubles. He led the team in runs, stolen bases (14), and walks (30) last season and ranked second in doubles and third in homers and RBI.

ALEC JONES BRINGS WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE

Alec Jones started 39 games behind the plate last season and has appeared in 125 games at the Division I level between his time at UC and Oral Roberts. Jones was one of Cincinnati's top run producers last season, tallying 30 RBI while slugging seven home runs and seven doubles.

TOMMY O'CONNOR ENDED 2023 ON HOT STREAK

One of UC's top returning sluggers, Tommy O'Connor will be looking to build off his strong finish to 2023. O'Connor ended the 2023 season reaching base in 15 straight games, the longest such streak by a Bearcat last year. He hit .333 while slugging five home runs down the stretch and led UC with a .846 slugging percentage in the final 15 contests.

WELCOME TO THE BIG 12

This will be Cincinnati's first baseball season in the Big 12, one of the premier baseball conferences in the country.

Four Big 12 baseball teams, No. 5 TCU, No. 16 Texas, No. 21 Texas Tech and No. 24 Kansas State, start the 2024 season in the D1Baseball Top 25. Six Big 12 programs were selected to the 2023 NCAA Division I Baseball Championship, with a Big 12 team reaching the Men's College World Series for the ninth consecutive tournament.

## HEAD COACH JORDAN BISCHEL



## JORDAN BISCHEL • HEAD COACH • FIRST SEASON • ST. NORBERT '03

UC Director of Athletics John Cunningham announced on June 18, 2023 the hire of Jordan Bischel as the 33rd head coach in program history.

The Green Bay, Wis., native comes to UC from Central Michigan, where he served as head coach for five seasons. He also spent four seasons as head coach of Northwood, an NCAA Division II program in Midland, Mich., and two seasons at the helm of NAIA program Midland University in Fremont, Neb.

Overall, he has a 314-158 record (.665) as an NCAA coach, including nine winning seasons and eight conference championships (four at Central Michigan, four at Northwood).

Bischel led the Chippewas to four Mid-American Conference (MAC) championships -- two regular season and two tournament -- and three NCAA Regionals. The Chippewas went 177-80 (.689) during Bischel's tenure.

In five seasons as head coach at CMU, Bischel had a 102-32 MAC record and posted three consecutive 40-win full seasons for the first time since 1986-88. Bischel's teams won a combined 132 games in 2019, '21 and '22, marking the winningest three-year stretch in program history.

Bischel's CMU teams went a combined 31-8 against the five other Michigan Division I programs, Michigan, Michigan State, Eastern Michigan, Western Michigan and Oakland, and Bischel led his Chippewas to 12 victories over opponents from Power 5 conferences.

In 2022, the Chippewas finished 43-19, including 30-7 and in second place in the MAC. They made a remarkable run to the league tournament crown, starting 1-1 and then winning three consecutive elimination games, the final two against host and regular season champion Ball State.

That put the Chippewas in the NCAA Tournament for the third straight season, where they went 1-2 and bowed to No. 13-ranked Florida in the Gators' home stadium in Gainesville.

The Chippewas posted a 42-18 ledger in 2021, capped by a 2-2 finish in the NCAA Regional in South Bend, Ind. The Chippewas were the No. 4 seed in the four-team tournament and posted victories over No. 2 Michigan and No. 3 UConn.

Bischel electrified CMU baseball from the word go in 2019, leading it to its first MAC Tournament championship and its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1995. The 2019 squad posted a 47-14 mark -- an 18-win improvement over the 2018 squad -- and a dramatic 6-5 victory over Miami (Fla.) in an NCAA Regional game in Starkville, Miss. It was CMU's first NCAA Tournament victory since 1988.

The Chippewas earned their first MAC regular season title since 2015, tied the program record for victories in a season (47), and its .770-win percentage was fifth best in the nation.

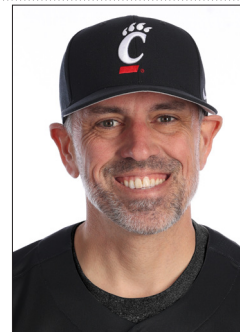
Prior to his time at CMU, Bischel was the head coach of Northwood from 2014 to 2018. The Timberwolves posted a combined 137-76 record and won two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Championships as well as two GLIAC Tournament titles. Over his last two seasons, Northwood won 84 games -- the best two-year stretch prior to Bischel's arrival featured 55 wins (1989-90).

Before Northwood, Bischel coached at Midland University in Fremont, Neb., for two seasons, leading the Warriors to a combined 74-45 record. In his first year at Midland, the Warriors won 31 games.

Bischel also coached in the Northwoods League for five seasons, four with the Green Bay Bullfrogs and one with the Wisconsin Woodchucks. He also served as the pitching coach for three seasons at Northwest Missouri State and was an assistant coach at John Carroll and at St. Norbert College in Wisconsin.

Bischel was an academic all-conference first baseman and pitcher at St. Norbert from 2000 to 2003. He earned all-conference honors and served as the team captain as a senior.

Bischel and his wife Katie have three sons, twins Luke and Parker, and Chase.

**JOSH REYNOLDS**

PITCHING COACH / ASSISTANT COACH

University of Cincinnati head baseball coach Jordan Bischel announced on July 11, 2023 the hire of Josh Reynolds as assistant coach and pitching coach.

With more than 20 years of college and professional baseball experience as a player and coach, Reynolds will oversee the pitching efforts of Bearcats baseball. He recently served as Colorado Scouting Director for Prep Baseball Report from 2022 to 2023.

Prior to that, Reynolds coached at Northwestern where he oversaw the Wildcats' pitching staff and took a lead role in Northwestern's recruiting efforts (2016-22). He was named interim head coach in May of 2021.

Reynolds came to Northwestern after serving as an assistant coach at Kansas State from 2011 to 2015. He helped the Wildcats reach the NCAA Tournament twice in five years, while also securing the 2013 Big 12 Championship.

Prior to joining the coaching staff in Manhattan, Reynolds worked as an assistant coach at Evansville for the 2009 and 2010 seasons. He also had successful stints as a graduate manager and a volunteer at KSU, and as an assistant at Northeast Texas Community College.

Reynolds pitched for a Division II powerhouse Central Missouri from 1998 to 2000. He set the UCM record for career wins with 34 in three seasons, while helping Mules to Division II College World Series appearances in 1998 and 2000.

Reynolds was selected in the third round of the Major League Baseball Draft by the New York Mets in 2000. He also spent time in the Boston Red Sox and San Diego Padres organizations before transitioning to coaching in 2004.

**KYLE PETTORUTO**

ASSISTANT COACH / RECRUITING COORDINATOR

University of Cincinnati head baseball coach Jordan Bischel announced on July 11, 2023 the hire of Kyle Pettoruto as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator.

Pettoruto comes to UC following a four-year stint as the hitting coach/assistant coach for Rutgers University (2020-23). He will oversee the recruiting efforts of Bearcats baseball and will instruct infield play and assist in all areas of the offense.

Pettoruto recently led Rutgers to back-to-back top-5 league finishes, rebuilding a program that had not finished better than 10th in its entire Big Ten history prior to his arrival. The Scarlet Knights went 77-38 (.670) overall and 31-17 (.646) in the Big Ten over the previous two seasons.

Under Pettoruto's guidance in 2022, Rutgers had one of the most prolific lineups in all of college baseball. The Scarlet Knights led the country with 9.6 runs per game and were top-5 nationally in runs (565) and doubles (147). In addition, the 2022 recruiting class was ranked No. 25 by D1Baseball.com and Top 35 by Baseball America.

Prior to his time at Rutgers, Pettoruto spent six seasons at Bryant and was a part of six straight Northeast Conference regular season championships and two NCAA Tournament appearances.

He played a role in producing 40 All-NEC selections, 46 All-New England selections, six ABCA All-Northeast selections, two NEC and New England Players of the Year, four NEC Rookies of the Year, two New England Rookies of the Year, one Collegiate Baseball Freshman Player of the Year and four Freshman All-Americans in his six seasons at Bryant.

Prior to Bryant, Pettoruto worked as an assistant coach with the North Shore Navigators in the Futures Collegiate Baseball League in the summer of the 2012. Following the summer, Pettoruto was hired as an assistant coach at Merrimack. He worked with the outfielders and the hitters, helping the Warriors set a school record for wins in the spring of 2013.

Pettoruto was a four-year letterwinner at the University of New Haven and helped the Chargers earn a spot in the 2010 NCAA Tournament. He also played for the Joplin Outlaws of the MINK League and the Rome Thunderbolts during the summer.

**TOM WISKE**

ASSISTANT COACH

University of Cincinnati head baseball coach Jordan Bischel announced on July 11, 2023 the hire of Tom Winske as assistant coach.

Winske resumes his longtime affiliation with Bischel when the latter was named to lead the Cincinnati baseball program. He will work with the Bearcat catchers and outfielders as well as oversee bunting and baserunning.

Winske comes to Cincinnati from Central Michigan, where he served as a volunteer assistant coach from 2019 to 2023. He combined with Bischel to lead the Chippewas to four Mid-American Conference (MAC) championships -- two regular season and two tournament -- and three NCAA Tournament berths.

With Winske on the coaching staff, the Chippewas compiled an 102-32 MAC record and posted three consecutive 40-win full seasons for the first time since 1986-88. They won a combined 132 games in 2019, '21 and '22, marking the winningest three-year stretch in program history.

Winske came to CMU after a highly successful two-decade run as the head coach at NCAA Division III St. Norbert College in De Pere, Wis. He amassed a 444-287-1 career mark from 1999 to 2018 and is the Midwest Conference's all-time leader in both conference and overall wins.

Winske was named the Midwest Conference North Division Coach of the Year nine times in his 20 years at St. Norbert and led the Green Knights to four conference championships and five NCAA Tournament berths. His 2017 team won 30 games, the most victories in a season by any men's athletics team in St. Norbert history.

Bischel, a pitcher, played for Winske at St. Norbert from 2000 to 2003 and served as an assistant under his mentor from 2007-09.

Sheriff comes to UC from Western Illinois where he served as interim head coach of the baseball program for the 2023 season. He was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2022 season, which was his first with the program.

In his first season, the Leathernecks saw an improvement in overall wins, Summit League victories and conference finish. Western Illinois also had improvements in nearly every major statistical category.

Prior to joining Western Illinois, Sheriff spent three years working for the baseball program at Spalding University as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator. He oversaw three pitchers who were named All-SLIAC in 2019.

In 2017-18, Sheriff contributed as a volunteer assistant coach at Indiana University of Pennsylvania. Prior to that, he worked nearby at Penn State - New Kensington as an assistant coach.

Since 2014, Sheriff has spent his summer days functioning as a general manager and head coach for Paul Carpenter Capital Advisors AAABA Baseball in his home state of Pennsylvania. He started his coaching career in 2015 with United High School in Armagh, Pa

Schroeder rejoins Bischel as the Bearcats director of program development. He comes to UC following a four-year stint as assistant coach at Central Michigan.

Schroeder played a major role in helping lead CMU to four Mid-American Conference championships -- two regular season and two tournament -- and three NCAA Tournament berths.

He previously served under Bischel for four years at Northwood University, where they combined to lead the program to unprecedented success, capped by back-to-back Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular season and tournament championships in 2017 and 2018.

Prior to his four years at Northwood, Schroeder served as an assistant under Bischel at Midland University in 2013-14. Together, they led Midland to a league championship and an appearance in the NAIA National Tournament.

Schroeder began his coaching career as an assistant in 2008 at Luther College, worked as a graduate assistant at Northwest Missouri State and served as an assistant with the Green Bay Bullfrogs of the Northwoods League.

As a player at Luther from 2004 to 2007, Schroeder led the Norse to Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular season and tournament championships during his senior year. He was named the 2007 IIAC Most Valuable Player and remains the program leader in several offensive categories, including career home runs (30) and career RBI (172).

Schroeder earned a bachelor's degree from Luther and a master's from Northwest Missouri State.

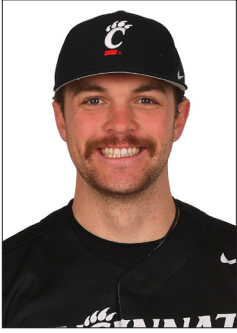
