GAME PREVIEW

CINCINNATI — After playing its last eight games on the road, the University of Cincinnati baseball team returns home this weekend to host TCU for three games at UC Baseball Stadium.

The series opener is set for Friday at 5 PM and will be followed by a 2 PM contest on Saturday. The Bearcats and the Horned Frogs will wrap up their weekend on Sunday at noon. All three games will be broadcast on ESPN+.

Cincinnati will be playing its first home game since March 17 vs. Kansas. Since that game, UC has played road games at Miami, Saint Louis, Louisville, and Baylor. Most recently, UC is coming off a weekend series in Waco where it dropped two out of three games to the Bears.

TCU and Cincinnati have met 12 times before, with all meetings coming in three-game series from 2002-05 when they overlapped as members of Conference USA. The last series between these two teams was May 6-8, 2005 at UC Baseball Stadium and the Horned Frogs won two out of three games.

Following play this weekend, Cincinnati will face Xavier at Prasco Park in Mason as part of the Joe Nuxhall Classic on Tuesday, April 9. First pitch for that game is set for 6 PM.

Last Time Out

The Bearcats resumed Big 12 play this past weekend at Baylor, dropping two out of three games.

UC started off the weekend strong with an 8-3 win in the series opener last Thursday. Tommy O'Connor and Seth Logue helped lead Cincinnati to the win with a pair of stellar performances. O'Connor hit two home runs, his first career multi-homer game, and Logue struck out eight in 6.1 innings out of the bullpen.

Following that game, however, Baylor took games on Friday and Saturday to win the series. An 8-6 decision evened the series on Friday and UC lost, 9-2, on Saturday to drop the series.

RUN FACTORY

Helping UC's offense all season long has been its ability to manufacture runs. The Bearcats rank eighth in the nation in stolen bases (68) and are among the leaders in the Big 12 in walks (170), HBP (47), and sacrifice flies (17). Their ability to get on base, take extra bases, and bring those runners home has them averaging 8.1 runs per game which ranks third in the Big 12.

Cincinnati has reached double-digits in runs scored 12 times this season.

HOME COOKIN'

UC boasts a 9-3 record in 12 home games this year. They're hitting .317 at home and outscoring opponents 109-63 on their home turf. The Bearcats have played their last eight games on the road and haven't played at home since March 17 vs. Kansas.

JOSH KROSS SLUGGING HIS WAY TO THE TOP

There aren't many hitters seeing the ball as well as Josh Kross right now.

The junior slugger leads the Big 12 and ranks fourth in the nation in RBI (44) and is tied for the Big 12 lead with 11 home runs. He has reached base in 23 straight games entering this weekend and has six home runs in his last seven games. His three-home run performance at Saint Louis on March 22 tied UC's singlegame school record are tied for the most by a Big 12 player in a game this season.

KERRINGTON CROSS ANCHORING THE

Kerrington Cross has been a great middle-ofthe-order bat for Cincinnati in the early going, slashing .333/.482/.509 in 29 games. He ranks third in the Big 12 in walks (26), third in stolen bases (11), tied for fifth in runs scored (33), and ninth in on-base percentage (.482). He is also the only Bearcat to start at the same position in all 29 games this year.

Cross has reached base at least twice in 22 of Cincinnati's 29 games this season.

LAUDEN BROOKS FLOURISHING

Lauden Brooks has been seeing the ball really well as of late, hitting .420 during his current 12-game hitting streak. He has a team-best 19 runs scored during that stretch and seven extrabase hits (six doubles, one triple). Brooks is tied for the Big 12 lead in triples (three) and ranks seventh in batting average (.376).

CHRISTIAN MITCHELLE: DUAL THREAT

Christian Mitchelle has been an asset for the Bearcats early on, starting the majority of games at shortstop while also being a weapon out of the bullpen.

Mitchelle has started 20 games at shortstop and has appeared in 10 games on the mound. He boasts a 2.00 ERA as a reliever with 11 strikeouts in 18.0 frames. Mitchelle has two saves this year, Feb. 29 vs. Oakland and March 16 vs. Kansas.

NATHAN TAYLOR OFF TO GREAT START

Freshman Nathan Taylor has made eight starts this year and has been one of the best pitchers

on UC's staff. He ranks second in the Big 12 lead with five wins and has a team-best 35 punchouts. He struck out a season-high 10 in 5.1 innings vs. Illinois on Feb. 24 and his last start against Kansas may have been his best one yet. Taylor struck out five in 6.0 scoreless frames vs. the Jayhawks on March 17.

The 6-4 hurler from Amelia, Ohio was a fouryear letterwinner at West Clermont, where he was named the team's Most Valuable Player three years in a row. He led his team to a conference championship and a regional title as a senior while posting a sub-2.00 ERA en route to honorable mention all-state accolades.

TOMMY BOBA: LIGHTS OUT

Over his last three outings, which includes a couple starts and one relief appearance, Tommy Boba owns a 1.17 ERA over 15.1 innings pitched. Of course, that stretch includes his near no-hitter against Kansas on March 16, but also includes a solid start at Saint Louis last Saturday (6.0 IP, three strikeouts) and 1.1 scoreless innings out of the bullpen against Western Illinois on March 13.

TOMMY O'CONNOR HEATING UP

During UC's recent eight-game road swing, Tommy O'Connor tied for the team lead in runs scored (11) and ranked second on the team in hits (11), home runs (4), and RBI (9). He had four multi-hit efforts during that stretch.

Operating out of the two-hole in the lineup for much of the season, O'Connor is batting .318 with a .438 on-base percentage and has walked 26 times. A fearsome slugger, he also has eight home runs and 26 RBI.

KAMERON **GUIDRY'S SLUGGING** STRETCH

For a three-game stretch earlier this season, nobody was hitting the ball better than Kameron Guidry.

He homered in three straight games (March 10 at Kansas State, March 12-13 vs. Western Illinois), hitting .462 with five home runs, 12 RBI, and seven runs scored over that stretch. The senior infielder hit two home runs at Kansas State in the series finale, two more against Western Illinois in the first game of that midweek series, and added another the next day vs. WIU.

He has two of UC's four multi-homer games this year.

SINGLE-GAME SUPERLATIVES

- Cincinnati tied two major single-game program records during the SLU series. They slugged eight home runs in the series opener to tie the single-game school record, and they stole a record-tying 10 bases the next day.
- · UC has drawn double-digit walks four times this season, including a high of 12 walks in games against Northern Illinois (March 2) and Western Illinois (March 12).
- The 20 hits against Kansas State on March 10 were the most for the Bearcats since tallying 20 hits against Xavier on March 21, 2021.
- · Earlier this year, UC allowed one run combined in its final two games against Kansas. The last time they had allowed just one run combined over a two-game stretch was April 19-20,

2013 when they posted 5-1 and 4-0 victories, respectively, against Villanova.

WALK-OFF BRUISE

In game one of Cincinnati's doubleheader vs. Northern Illinois, Josh Hegemann was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to bring in the game-winning run. It marked the first time since Feb. 24, 2013 that the Bearcats won a game in walk-off fashion with the RBI coming from something other than a hit or home run. UC won that game, 7-6, against Western Carolina when Colin Hawk was also hit by a pitch with the bases loaded.

TOMMY BOBA EARNS WEEKLY AWARDS FROM BIG 12 AND PERFECT GAME (MARCH 18-19)

Tommy Boba was named the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week on March 18 and the Perfect Game National Pitcher of the Week on March 19.

Boba was magnificent last week across two outings, one of which was a near no-hitter on Saturday vs. Kansas. Boba held the Jayhawks hitless through eight innings, finally surrendering his first hit of the day to the leadoff hitter in the top of the ninth. He struck out a career-best eight and retired 11 straight batters at one point from the end of the fourth inning to the beginning of the eighth. His start vs. KU is tied for the longest start by a Big 12 pitcher this season.

D1Baseball ranked the Top 100 pitching performances from this past weekend by game score, and Boba's mark of 86 was the highest in the country for this weekend's slate of games.

Earlier in the week, Boba struck out two in 1.1 innings against Western Illinois in midweek action.

JOSH KROSS - BIG 12 CO-NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK (MARCH 4)

Cincinnati has its first weekly award winner as a member of the Big 12 Conference. Josh Kross was named Co-Newcomer of the Week on Monday, March 4 thanks to his outstanding performances against Xavier, Oakland, and Northern Illinois.

The Brunswick, Ohio native was outstanding last week, hitting .455 and slugging .909 in six games while tallying three home runs and 11 RBI. He led Cincinnati in RBI and hits (11) and was tied for the team lead in home runs and runs scored (nine) last week. He also reached base at least twice in five of six contests.

Kross opened the week by hitting his first home run as a Bearcat at Xavier on Feb. 27 and homered again in the next game vs. Oakland on Feb. 29. He saved his best performance for last, going 3-for-4 with a home run and careerhigh six RBI in the finale vs. Northern Illinois.

RETURN OF THE MAC

UC is 6-1 against Mid-American Conference teams this year. They defeated Ball State earlier this year in Conway, S.C., won three out of four games against Northern Illinois, and defeated Akron and Miami in midweek action.

Of course, head coach Jordan Bischel has ties

for the MAC coming from Central Michigan, and six players on the roster transferred to UC after spending time in the MAC.

D1BASEBALL ACCOLADES

Five Bearcats were highlighted as top prospects and impact freshmen by D1Baseball in the organization's Big 12 preview.

Two Bearcats were represented in the Big 12 Conference prospect ranking for the upcoming 2024 MLB Draft, headlined by junior first basemen Tommy O'Connor coming in at No. 33. O'Connor batted .303 (23-for-76) with two doubles, two triples, eight home runs and 19 RBI in 2023.

Josh Kross, a transfer from Eastern Michigan, came in at No. 38 for the 2024 MLB Draft. He batted .376 (86-for-229) with 43 runs scored, 18 doubles, 15 home runs and 70 RBI. He was named MAC Freshman of the Year, First Team All-MAC and Freshman All-America by College Baseball Newspaper.

In addition, UC had a pair of two-way players recognized on the top prospect list for the 2025 MLB Draft. Christian Mitchelle came in at No. 19, followed by Griffin Hugus at No. 28.

Mitchelle is a transfer from Central Michigan, where he was named All-MAC Second Team after batting .307 (58-189) with 53 runs scored, 13 doubles, three home runs and 29 RBI as a freshman. He also served an important role as a relief pitcher in 2023, making 11 appearances with a 3.18 ERA.

Hugus, an AAC All-Freshman Team selection in 2023, batted .234 (29-for-124) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs and 20 RBI. He made 18 appearances on the mound with a 1-2 record and two sayes.

Freshman right-handed pitcher Nathan Taylor was selected to D1Baseball's impact freshmen list at No. 23. He was named West Clermont's Most Valuable Pitcher three years in a row and struck out 53 batters in 36 innings as a senior.

BISCHEL ERA BEGINS

Jordan Bischel became the 33rd head coach in Bearcat Baseball history on June 21, 2023.

Bischel comes to UC from Central Michigan, where he served as head coach for five seasons. He also spent four seasons as head coach of Northwood, an NCAA Division II program in Midland, Mich., and two seasons at the helm of NAIA program Midland University in Fremont, Neb.

As a head coach at the NCAA level he has nine winning seasons, eight conference championships, and three NCAA Regional appearances. Bischel's CMU squad advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2019, 2021, and 2022.

BISCHEL BALL COMING TO UC

When asked what fans can expect from Cincinnati Baseball in 2024, Coach Bischel said that his team will play fast and play aggressive, which tracks with how his Central Michigan teams approached the game during his tenure there.

Last season, Bischel's Central Michigan squad ranked eighth in the country in stolen bases (133) and had three players with at least 20 stolen bases, including Christian Mitchelle, who transferred to UC this season.

STADIUM UPGRADES

Cincinnati baseball has made several improvements to UC Baseball Stadium since the end of the 2023 season. Those additions and improvements include:

- New videoboard and turf surface.
- Upgraded stadium speakers and lighting.
- Renovated outfield fence that includes new padding and graphics featuring retired numbers, NCAA Regional appearances, and conference championships.
- Updated indoor graphics featuring MLB alumni, current players, and Big 12 logos.
- Installation of new batting cages and pitching machine.

NEW FACES

Cincinnati's 2024 roster features 21 new players, including 12 transfers and nine true freshmen.

Christian Mitchelle (Central Michigan), Hunter Jessee (Indiana), Michael Conte (Central Michigan), Ryan Insco (Central Michigan), Keegan Allen (West Virginia), Seth Logue (Kentucky), Joey Hurth (Indiana State), Luke Sefcik (Central Michigan), Will Murphy (DePauw), Josh Kross (Eastern Michigan), Dalton Pearson (Georgia State), and Marc Carney (Central Michigan) all join the Bearcats from previous institutions.

Gavin Ehrhardt (Avon, Ohio), Nathan Taylor (Amelia, Ohio), Noah Wicks (Arvada, Colo.), Charlie Niehaus (West Chester, Ohio), Joey Canzoni (Walton Hills, Ohio), Carson Marsh (West Chester, Ohio), Bradley Coulter (Taylorsville, Ky.), Drew Erdmann (Hudson, Ohio), and Carson French (West Chester, Ohio) are UC's true freshman.

WELCOME TO THE BIG 12

This will be Cincinnati's first baseball season in the Big 12, one of the premier baseball conferences in the country.

Four Big 12 baseball teams, No. 5 TCU, No. 16 Texas, No. 21 Texas Tech and No. 24 Kansas State, start the 2024 season in the D1Baseball Top 25. Six Big 12 programs were selected to the 2023 NCAA Division I Baseball Championship, with a Big 12 team reaching the Men's College World Series for the ninth consecutive tournament.

UC Director of Athletics John Cunningham announced on June 18, 2023 the hire of Jordan Bischel as the 33rd head coach in program history.

The Green Bay, Wis., native comes to UC from Central Michigan, where he served as head coach for five seasons. He also spent four seasons as head coach of Northwood, an NCAA Division II program in Midland, Mich., and two seasons at the helm of NAIA program Midland University in Fremont, Neb.

Overall, he has a 330-169 record (.661) as an NCAA coach, including nine winning seasons and eight conference championships (four at Central Michigan, four at Northwood).

Bischel led the Chippewas to four Mid-American Conference (MAC) championships -- two regular season and two tournament -- and three NCAA Regionals. The Chippewas went 177-80 (.689) during Bischel's tenure.

In five seasons as head coach at CMU, Bischel had a 102-32 MAC record and posted three consecutive 40-win full seasons for the first time since 1986-88. Bischel's teams won a combined 132 games in 2019, '21 and '22, marking the winningest three-year stretch in program history.

Bischel's CMU teams went a combined 31-8 against the five other Michigan Division I programs, Michigan, Michigan State, Eastern Michigan, Western Michigan and Oakland, and Bischel led his Chippewas to 12 victories over opponents from Power 5 conferences.

In 2022, the Chippewas finished 43-19, including 30-7 and in second place in the MAC. They made a remarkable run to the league tournament crown, starting 1-1 and then winning three consecutive elimination games, the final two against host and regular season champion Ball State.

That put the Chippewas in the NCAA Tournament for the third straight season, where they went 1-2 and bowed to No. 13-ranked Florida in the Gators' home stadium in Gainesville.

The Chippewas posted a 42-18 ledger in 2021, capped by a 2-2 finish in the NCAA Regional in South Bend, Ind. The Chippewas were the No. 4 seed in the four-team tournament and posted victories over No. 2 Michigan and No. 3 UConn.

Bischel electrified CMU baseball from the word go in 2019, leading it to its first MAC Tournament championship and its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1995. The 2019 squad posted a 47-14 mark — an 18-win improvement over the 2018 squad — and a dramatic 6-5 victory over Miami (Fla.) in an NCAA Regional game in Starkville, Miss. It was CMU's first NCAA Tournament victory since 1988.

The Chippewas earned their first MAC regular season title since 2015, tied the program record for victories in a season (47), and its .770-win percentage was fifth best in the nation.

Prior to his time at CMU, Bischel was the head coach of Northwood from 2014 to 2018. The Timberwolves posted a combined 137-76 record and won two Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Championships as well as two GLIAC Tournament titles. Over his last two seasons, Northwood won 84 games — the best two-year stretch prior to Bischel's arrival featured 55 wins (1989-90).

Before Northwood, Bischel coached at Midland University in Fremont, Neb., for two seasons, leading the Warriors to a combined 74-45 record. In his first year at Midland, the Warriors won 31 games.

Bischel also coached in the Northwoods League for five seasons, four with the Green Bay Bullfrogs and one with the Wisconsin Woodchucks. He also served as the pitching coach for three seasons at Northwest Missouri State and was an assistant coach at John Carroll and at St. Norbert College in Wisconsin.

Bischel was an academic all-conference first baseman and pitcher at St. Norbert from 2000 to 2003. He earned all-conference honors and served as the team captain as a senior.

Bischel and his wife Katie have three sons, twins Luke and Parker, and Chase.

University of Cincinnati head baseball coach Jordan Bischel announced on July 11, 2023 the hire of Josh Reynolds as assistant coach and pitching coach.

With more than 20 years of college and professional baseball experience as a player and coach, Reynolds will oversee the pitching efforts of Bearcats baseball. He recently served as Colorado Scouting Director for Prep Baseball Report from 2022 to 2023.

Prior to that, Reynolds coached at Northwestern where he oversaw the Wildcats' pitching staff and took a lead role in Northwestern's recruiting efforts (2016-22). He was named interim head coach in May of 2021.

Reynolds came to Northwestern after serving as an assistant coach at Kansas State from 2011 to 2015. He helped the Wildcats reach the NCAA Tournament twice in five years, while also securing the 2013 Big 12 Championship.

Prior to joining the coaching staff in Manhattan, Reynolds worked as an assistant coach at Evansville for the 2009 and 2010 seasons. He also had successful stints as a graduate manager and a volunteer at KSU, and as an assistant at Northeast Texas Community College.

Reynolds pitched for a Division II powerhouse Central Missouri from 1998 to 2000. He set the UCM record for career wins with 34 in three seasons, while helping Mules to Division II College World Series appearances in 1998 and 2000.

Reynolds was selected in the third round of the Major League Baseball Draft by the New York Mets in 2000. He also spent time in the Boston Red Sox and San Diego Padres organizations before transitioning to coaching in 2004



University of Cincinnati head baseball coach Jordan Bischel announced on July 11, 2023 the hire of Kyle Pettoruto as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator.

Pettoruto comes to UC following a four-year stint as the hitting coach/assistant coach for Rutgers University (2020-23). He will oversee the recruiting efforts of Bearcats baseball and will instruct infield play and assist in all areas of the offense.

Pettoruto recently led Rutgers to back-to-back top-5 league finishes, rebuilding a program that had not finished better than 10th in its entire Big Ten history prior to his arrival. The Scarlet Knights went 77-38 (.670) overall and 31-17 (.646) in the Big Ten over the previous two seasons.

Under Pettoruto's guidance in 2022, Rutgers had one of the most prolific lineups in all of college baseball. The Scarlet Knights led the country with 9.6 runs per game and were top-5 nationally in runs (565) and doubles (147). In addition, the 2022 recruiting class was ranked No. 25 by D1Baseball.com and Top 35 by Baseball America.

Prior to his time at Rutgers, Pettoruto spent six seasons at Bryant and was a part of six straight Northeast Conference regular season championships and two NCAA Tournament appearances.

He played a role in producing 40 All-NEC selections, 46 All-New England selections, six ABCA All-Northeast selections, two NEC and New England Players of the Year, four NEC Rookies of the Year, two New England Rookies of the Year, one Collegiate Baseball Freshman Player of the Year and four Freshman All-Americans in his six seasons at Bryant.

Prior to Bryant, Pettoruto worked as an assistant coach with the North Shore Navigators in the Futures Collegiate Baseball League in the summer of the 2012. Following the summer, Pettoruto was hired as an assistant coach at Merrimack. He worked with the outfielders and the hitters, helping the Warriors set a school record for wins in the spring of 2013.

Pettoruto was a four-year letterwinner at the University of New Haven and helped the Chargers earn a spot in the 2010 NCAA Tournament. He also played for the Joplin Outlaws of the MINK League and the Rome Thunderbolts during the summer.



University of Cincinnati head baseball coach Jordan Bischel announced on July 11, 2023 the hire of Tom Winske as assistant coach.

Winske resumes his longtime affiliation with Bischel when the latter was named to lead the Cincinnati baseball program. He will work with the Bearcat catchers and outfielders as well as oversee bunting and baserunning.

Winske comes to Cincinnati from Central Michigan, where he served as a volunteer assistant coach from 2019 to 2023. He combined with Bischel to lead the Chippewas to four Mid-American Conference (MAC) championships—two regular season and two tournament—and three NCAA Tournament berths.

With Winske on the coaching staff, the Chippewas compiled an 102-32 MAC record and posted three consecutive 40-win full seasons for the first time since 1986-88. They won a combined 132 games in 2019, '21 and '22, marking the winningest three-year stretch in program history.

Winske came to CMU after a highly successful two-decade run as the head coach at NCAA Division III St. Norbert College in De Pere, Wis. He amassed a 444-287-1 career mark from 1999 to 2018 and is the Midwest Conference's all-time leader in both conference and overall wins

Winske was named the Midwest Conference North Division Coach of the Year nine times in his 20 years at St. Norbert and led the Green Knights to four conference championships and five NCAA Tournament berths. His 2017 team won 30 games, the most victories in a season by any men's athletics team in St. Norbert history.

Bischel, a pitcher, played for Winske at St. Norbert from 2000 to 2003 and served as an assistant under his mentor from 2007-09.



Sheriff comes to UC from Western Illinois where he served as interim head coach of the baseball program for the 2023 season. He was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator during the 2022 season, which was his first with the program.

In his first season, the Leathernecks saw an improvement in overall wins. Summit League victories and conference finish. Western Illinois also had improvements in nearly every major statistical category.

Prior to joining Western Illinois, Sheriff spent three years working for the baseball program at Spalding University as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator. He oversaw three pitchers who were named All-SLIAC in 2019.

In 2017-18. Sheriff contributed as a volunteer assistant coach at Indiana University of Pennsylvania. Prior to that, he worked nearby at Penn State - New Kensington as an assistant coach

Since 2014, Sheriff has spent his summer days functioning as a general manager and head coach for Paul Carpenter Capital Advisors AAABA Baseball in his home state of Pennsylvania. He started his coaching career in 2015 with United High School in Armagh, Pa



Schroeder rejoins Bischel as the Bearcats director of program development. He comes to UC following a four-year stint as assistant coach at Central Michigan.

Schroeder played a major role in helping lead CMU to four Mid-American Conference championships -- two regular season and two tournament -- and three NCAA Tournament

He previously served under Bischel for four years at Northwood University, where they combined to lead the program to unprecedented success, capped by back-toback Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular season and tournament championships in 2017 and 2018.

Prior to his four years at Northwood, Schroeder served as an assistant under Bischel at Midland University in 2013-14. Together, they led Midland to a league championship and an appearance in the NAIA National Tournament.

Schroeder began his coaching career as an assistant in 2008 at Luther College, worked as a graduate assistant at Northwest Missouri State and served as an assistant with the Green Bay Bullfrogs of the Northwoods League.

As a player at Luther from 2004 to 2007, Schroeder led the Norse to Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular season and tournament championships during his senior year. He was named the 2007 IIAC Most Valuable Player and remains the program leader in several offensive categories, including career home runs (30) and career RBI (172).

Schroeder earned a bachelor's degree from Luther and a master's from Northwest Missouri State.


