STREAKS, STORYLINES & SIDEBARS

» **THE GAME:** UNIVERSITY OF CINCINNATI WOMEN'S BASKETBALL WILL LOOK TO SNAP A TWO-GAME ROAD SKID THURSDAY WHEN IT TRAVELS TO RICHMOND, VIRGINIA TO TAKE ON THE VCU RAMS AT 6 P.M. ET AT THE SIEGEL CENTER.

» **THE SERIES:** THE MATCHUP WILL BE THE SECOND ALL-TIME BETWEEN THE TWO TEAMS AFTER THE BEARCATS BESTED THE RAMS 66-54 LAST SEASON IN CINCINNATI. FORWARD IIMAR'I THOMAS LED ALL SCORERS AND REBOUNDERS WITH 20 POINTS, TO GO ALONG WITH NINE REBOUNDS, WHILE GUARD ANTOINETTE MILLER CHIPPED IN 11 POINTS.

» **LAST TIME OUT:** UC FELL 56-48 TO THE BUCKNELL BISON ON NOV. 28 AT COLISEO MARIO MORALES IN SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO IN ITS SECOND AND FINAL GAME IN THE PUERTO RICO CLASICO. SENIOR FORWARD ANGEL RIZOR SCORED A SEASON-HIGH 14 POINTS.

» **BEARCATS BYTES:** AFTER SCORING A CAREER-HIGH 29 POINTS AGAINST CHATTANOOGA ON NOV. 19, THOMAS WAS NAMED THE AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK. THOMAS IS THIRD IN THE AAC IN SCORING (18.6 PPG) AND REBOUNDING (9.7 RPG). SHE IS ALSO SECOND IN THE LEAGUE IN FIELD-GOAL PERCENTAGE (54.7%), SEVENTH IN FREE-THROW SHOOTING (76.5%), AND TOPS IN OFFENSIVE REBOUNDS (5.1 RPG). ON NOV. 12, THOMAS WAS PICKED FOR THE

AMERICAN WEEKLY HONOR ROLL AFTER AVERAGING 19.0 POINTS AND 10.5 REBOUNDS DURING WEEK TWO OF THE SEASON. SHE LAST EARNED CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK ON DEC. 17, 2018.

» MILLER HAS BEEN ON A TEAR, SCORING IN DOUBLE-FIGURES IN 13 OF HER LAST 14 GAMES DATING BACK TO LAST SEASON. THE SENIOR IS STUFFING THE STAT SHEET WITH 15.3 POINTS, 4.3 REBOUNDS, 3.9 ASSISTS, AND 1.6 STEALS PER GAME. FURTHERMORE, HER SCORING AND ASSIST AVERAGES RANK NINTH IN THE CONFERENCE, ASSIST-TO-TURNOVER RATIO (1.5) EIGHTH AND HER 36.4 MINUTES A CONTEST IS FOURTH-MOST IN THE AAC.

» SENIOR FORWARD ANGEL RIZOR HAS ALREADY SURPASSED HER DOUBLE-DOUBLE TOTAL FROM LAST SEASON WITH TWO IN SEVEN GAMES TO BEGIN THE YEAR. ON THE YEAR, SHE IS AVERAGING 8.0 POINTS AND 7.6 REBOUNDS (10TH IN THE AAC) A GAME. ADDITIONALLY, HER OFFENSIVE REBOUNDS AVERAGE (3.1 RPG) RANKS SIXTH.

» A PAIR OF BEARCATS ARE QUICKLY APPROACHING 1,000-CAREER POINTS. MILLER CURRENTLY BOASTS 869 POINTS, WHILE THOMAS IS AT 892. THE DUO WILL SOON BE THE 27TH AND 28TH MEMBERS OF THE PROGRAM'S 1,000-POINT CLUB. GUARD ANA OWENS WAS THE MOST RECENT BEARCAT TO SCORE 1,000 POINTS WHEN SHE JOINED THE CLUB IN 2017.

FIFTH THIRD ARENA



After a 20-month, privately-funded \$87-million renovation, Fifth Third Arena reopened prior to the 2018-19 season as the latest marker in the continued growth of University of Cincinnati basketball.

Improvements to the 12,012-seat arena include two 360-degree concourses with court-centric seating, club seats, loge boxes and premium suites. The Arena Club, Champions Club and the Mercedes-Benz Courtside Club provide entertainment options for fans. State-of-the-art videoboards and ribbon boards raise the gameday experience to the next level while increased points-of-sale for concessions feature food options from some of Cincinnati's most famous restaurants.

New student-athlete amenities include new locker rooms, a film room and a hydrotherapy room while the Margaret K. Valentine Classroom creates more learning environments for the University.

Originally tabbed the Myrl H. Shoemaker Center, it was named after the former Ohio lieutenant governor who was instrumental in securing state funding for the building while he was chairman of the Ohio House Finance Appropriations Committee. Shoemaker died in 1985.

Affectionately known as "The Shoe," the arena was renamed Fifth Third Arena at Myrl H. Shoemaker Center in 2004 in recognition of Fifth Third Bank's support of the Varsity Village facilities enhancement project. Fifth Third Bank remains a valued long-term campus-wide partner on numerous initiatives.

ARENA FEATURES

- » Renovation of the building facade, entries and plazas, including the addition of an outdoor videoboard
- » Two 360-degree concourses and permanent lower bowl with court-centric seating and new chairback seating
- » New hospitality areas, including main and upper level concourse bars available to all fans and the addition of three exclusive clubs - the Arena Club, the Champions Club and the Mercedes-Benz Courtside Club
- » New upper-level concourse with its own fan amenities, including new restrooms, concessions and a specialty drink bar
- » Additional bars at the north end of the main and upper concourses - the Armory Bar and the Queen City Bar - that highlight UC Athletics' partnerships with Braxton, MadTree and Rhinegeist
- » New center-hung videoboard, ribbon boards, sound system and LED lighting to enhance game atmosphere
- » Increased points and sale for concessions including some of Cincinnati's favorite food options - Buffalo Wings & Rings, Frisch's, Skyline Chili and Taste of Belgium
- » Open entrance plaza with centralized ticketing and guest services along with the new Fan First Center

// SCOUTING THE RAMS

» VCU DROPPED TO 3-4 ON THE SEASON WITH A 51-39 LOSS AT SOUTHERN MISS ON NOV. 30 AT THE LADY EAGLE THANKSGIVING CLASSIC. TERA REED SCORED A TEAM-HIGH 12 POINTS AND ADDED FOUR ASSISTS, WHILE MADISON HATTIX-COVINGTON HAD EIGHT POINTS AND THREE REBOUNDS. ON THE SEASON, REED LEADS THE RAMS WITH 11.8 POINTS PER GAME, WHILE SYDNEY ARCHIE AVERAGES 5.9 REBOUNDS A CONTEST. VCU HAS SPLIT A PAIR OF CONTESTS AGAINST AAC OPPONENTS THIS SEASON -- 77-55 LOSS AT USF, 53-40 WIN AGAINST ECU. IN THE PRESEASON, THE RAMS WERE TABBED AS THE A-10 FAVORITE WITH REED A FIRST TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTION, WHILE TAYIA ROBINSON AND DANIELLE HAMMOND WERE PICKED FOR THE THIRD TEAM.

// PRESEASON AAC HONORS

» ANNOUNCED AT AAC BASKETBALL MEDIA DAY ON OCT. 14, UC WAS SELECTED TO FINISH IN A TIE FOR THIRD IN THE 12-TEAM LEAGUE. ADDITIONALLY, MILLER AND THOMAS WERE BOTH TABBED FOR THE PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE SECOND TEAM. CHOSEN BY THE LEAGUE'S HEAD COACHES, THE PREDICTED FINISH IS THE HIGHEST THE BEARCATS HAVE EVER RECEIVED IN THEIR SEVEN YEARS IN THE AMERICAN, WHILE THE PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE ACCOLADES ARE THE FIRST SINCE ALYESHA LOVETT RECEIVED SECOND TEAM ALL-AAC HONORS IN 2014.

// CONTINUING MOMENTUM

» UC WILL AIM TO CONTINUE THE MOMENTUM FROM LAST YEAR'S HISTORIC SEASON WHICH INCLUDED CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON WINS FOR THE FIRST TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY (WNIT QUARTERFINALS), FIRST 20-WIN SEASON (24) SINCE 2003, FIRST TIME WITH 12 CONFERENCE WINS SINCE 1999, AND HIGHEST-EVER FINISH IN THE AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE (AAC) (THIRD PLACE).

// THEY'RE BACK

» WITH NINE NEWCOMERS TO THE PROGRAM IN 2019-20, THE RED & BLACK RETURNS FIVE STARTERS, AS WELL AS ILLINOIS TRANSFER ADDAYA MOORE. RETURNING SENIOR STARTERS INCLUDE 2019 SECOND TEAM ALL-AAC PICK MILLER, RIZOR, AND SAM RODGERS. IN ADDITION, FIRST TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE HONOREE THOMAS AND REIGNING LEAGUE NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR FLORENCE SIFA ARE ALSO BACK.

// HOME COOKIN'

» THE BEARCATS HAVE CREATED A FORMIDABLE HOME-COURT ADVANTAGE INSIDE NEWLY-RENOVATED FIFTH THIRD ARENA WITH AN 20-4 HOME RECORD GOING BACK TO LAST SEASON. IN TOTAL, THE RED & BLACK BOASTS A 73% (44-16) WINNING PERCENTAGE ON THEIR HOME FLOOR OVER THE LAST FOUR SEASONS.

// BEARCATS LIVE

» AFTER SHOOTING 60.4% FROM THE FIELD IN 2018-19, ILMAR'I THOMAS' CAREER FIELD-GOAL PERCENTAGE SITS AT 59.0% WHICH IS BEST IN PROGRAM HISTORY, TRAILED BY LINDA NORWELL WHO SHOT 53.4% FROM 1974-77. THOMAS WAS SECOND IN THE CONFERENCE AND TOP 15 NATIONALLY IN SHOOTING LAST SEASON.





HEAD COACH MICHELLE CLARK-HEARD



Michelle Clark-Heard was named the ninth University of Cincinnati women's basketball coach in March 2018.

Clark-Heard, who was an assistant at UC from 2002-05, spent the previous six seasons as the head coach at Western Kentucky University.

In her first season at the helm at UC in 2018-19, Clark-Heard led the Bearcats to 24 wins -- the most victories in a head coach's first season in program history, and the most triumphs in 17 years. The Red & Black's historic accomplishments also included the first time with consecutive postseason wins in program history (WNIT quarterfinals), its first 20-win season since 2003, first time with 12 conference wins since 1999, highest-ever finish in the American Athletic Conference (third place), and first time with three or more regular-season conference honorees since 2003 (Thomas - First Team All-AAC, Miller - Second Team All-AAC, Sifa - Newcomer of the Year).

In six seasons at WKU, Clark-Heard reached four NCAA Tournaments, won four conference tournament championships and two regular season conference titles while posting 154 wins, becoming the second-fastest Lady Topper coach to reach 100 victories with the program.

Clark-Heard took over a program with a 9-21 record in 2011-12 and she led the Hilltoppers to a 22-11 mark in her first season (2012-13), a 13-win improvement, which was the largest in Sun Belt Conference history.

WKU finished the 2017-18 campaign with a 24-9 record and captured the 2018 Conference USA Tournament championship and qualified for its third NCAA Tournament in four years. Tashia Brown was tabbed as an Associated Press Honorable Mention All-American and the C-USA Player of the Year.

Clark-Heard amassed a 154-47 (.766) record at WKU and a 178-79 (.693) career mark. Clark-Heard has led her teams to six consecutive 20-win seasons and six-straight appearances in the postseason (four NCAA, two WNIT).

The 2016-17 campaign saw WKU claim its second sweep of the C-USA regular season and tournament championships in just three seasons as a member of the league. The Lady Toppers put together a 27-7 record and a 16-2 mark in C-USA play; the team also pieced together a 12-game winning streak entering the NCAA Tournament, culminating in a 67-56 win over Southern Miss in the C-USA championship game on March 11.

Following the season, Clark-Heard was invited to serve as an assistant coach for the United States U-23 National Team in the inaugural Four Nations Tournament in Tokyo, Japan. During her second stint with the red, white and blue, Clark-Heard helped to push the Americans to an undefeated record and the championship in the event, defeating their opponents by an average of 32 points along the way.

Following the 2014-15 season, Clark-Heard was recognized for her outstanding accomplishments, earning Conference USA Coach of the Year and 2015 United States Marine Corps/WBCA NCAA Division I Regional Coach of the Year honors. Her selection as a WBCA Regional Coach of the Year also made her a finalist for the Pat Summitt Trophy, awarded annually to the 2015 United States Marine Corps/WBCA NCAA Division I National Coach of the Year.

MICHELLE CLARK-HEARD

HEAD WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH | 2ND SEASON

Clark-Heard was named an assistant coach for the 2015 U.S. Pan American Women's Basketball Team, joining head coach Lisa Bluder of the University of Iowa and fellow assistant coach Scott Rueck of Oregon State University on the 2015 staff. In Toronto, Clark-Heard helped lead the United States to a silver medal in her international assistant coaching debut, falling just short in the gold medal game against the host Canadians.

In 2013-14, Clark-Heard helped WKU win its final seven regular season games before reeling off three straight in New Orleans, La. in March 2014 to win the Sun Belt Conference Championships with a 61-60 win over Arkansas State after WKU faced a 14-point deficit in the second half. The season also saw WKU defeat Georgetown in the Puerto Rico Classic after facing a 16-point deficit in the second half.

The season was capped by a 87-74 loss to fifth-ranked Baylor in Waco, Texas in the opening round of the 2014 NCAA Tournament, ending the longest NCAA Tournament appearance drought in program history.

The run to the tournament helped WKU secure a 24-9 record and finish with 20-wins for the second straight season. Her consecutive 20-win seasons to begin her time at WKU marked the first time in Sun Belt Conference history that a team had won 20 games in back-to-back years following a season in which it had won less than 10 games.

Her success in 2013-14 followed a massive improvement on the floor in 2012-13.

In her first year as a Division One coach in 2012-13, Clark-Heard helped WKU to a 13-win improvement over the 2011-12 season output. It was the largest in Sun Belt Conference history as WKU turned a 9-21 mark into a 22-11 record. WKU's eight win improvement in conference play from five wins to 13 wins was tied for the largest in league history. The Lady Toppers also became the first team in Sun Belt Conference history to win 20 games in the season following a year in which the team won less than 10 games earlier this season.

Her first season at WKU also showcased her ability to develop players. The duo of Chastity Gooch and Alexis Govan averaged a combined 12.7 ppg in 2011-12 but posted 36.5 per outing in 2012-13. The duo combined for 1,203 points after posting 381 last season. The team also saw major improvement in nearly all statistical categories, including improving free throw shooting by over 11 percent to .739, the third highest mark in school history.

Clark-Heard spent five years as an assistant coach to Jeff Walz at Louisville from 2007-12. During her time with the program, the Cardinals made three Sweet 16 appearances and their first Final Four appearance, finishing as the National Runner-Up in 2009.

Showing her prowess as a recruiter, she was instrumental in bringing in the No. 12 recruiting class to UofL in 2008, then followed with three consecutive Top 10 classes in 2009, 2010 and 2011. The 2010 recruiting class was the highest ranked class in school history, No. 5 nationally.

Among the most notable players Clark-Heard coached at Louisville was overall number one pick in the 2009 WNBA Draft, Angel McCoughtry and overall number eight pick in the 2013 WNBA Draft, Shoni Shimmell. Overall, she coached five players at Louisville that went on to be drafted in the WNBA Draft.



Prior to her time at Louisville, Clark-Heard spent two seasons as the head coach at Kentucky State, taking the reigns of the program in June 2005. She took over a program that had won just one game during the 2004-05 season. In her first season she led the Thorobrettes to a 5-23 record, four of the wins were against Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference opponents. Her team was picked to finish 11th in the SIAC but ended the season in ninth place. In her second season at KSU, she guided the Thorobrettes to an impressive 19-9 record, finishing tied for fourth place in the SIAC. Clark-Heard earned SIAC Coach-of-the-Year honors after the impressive turnaround. Her 2006-07 Thorobrettes were the second most improved team in NCAA Division II women's basketball during the 2006-07 season.

Before being named head coach at Kentucky State, Clark-Heard spent three seasons at Cincinnati as an assistant and four years at Nebraska in the same role. The Bearcats advanced to postseason play in two of her three seasons there while she helped Nebraska reach the NCAA Tournament twice during her time with the team. She was also responsible for helping sign McDonald's All-American Janice Bright for the Cornhuskers in 2001 while coaching alongside current Louisville coach Jeff Walz and under former WKU coach Paul Sanderford.

A four-year letterwinner on the Hill (1987-90), Clark-Heard was part of four NCAA Tournament teams during her Lady Topper career. She also helped guide the Lady Toppers to a pair of Sun Belt Conference Tournament championships (1988 and 1989) and two conference regular-season titles (1989 and 1990). She played in 118 games during her four years in the Hill, scoring 790 points and pulling down 615 rebounds. WKU amassed 89 victories during her four years in uniform, winning 70 percent of the games over that span and putting together three 20-win seasons.

Upon graduation from WKU, she spent eight years working within a recreational setting in Kentucky, including five years in Bowling Green and three with the Louisville Metro Parks Department.

While in Louisville, she served as head junior varsity coach and assistant varsity coach at DuPont Manual High School for the 1994-95 season. Additionally, she played professionally with the Kentucky Marauders of the Women's Basketball Association in 1994-95.

The Louisville native earned Kentucky High School State Player of the Year honors in 1986 while playing at Atherton High School and was inducted into the Atherton Hall of Fame in 2003.

She married Luther Heard on August 16, 2003.
