# Volleyball Home Opener Set for Friday at St. Ursula Academy

The Bearcats will look to remain a leader in the American Athletic Conference

UC Volleyball will look to stay dominant in conference play when it hosts Tulsa and SMU this weekend in its first home matches of the season. The Bearcats will host the Golden Hurricane on Friday at 7 p.m. and then host the Mustangs on Sunday at 1 p.m. All home matches are set to be played at St. Ursula Academy in Cincinnati, just a short drive down the road from the UC campus on E. McMillan St.

# // WEEKEND RECAP

- · Cincinnati started conference play 2-0 last weekend by defeating USF and UCF on the road
- Both matches were won 3-0 as the Bearcats did not drop a set all weekend
- On Friday, UC won 25-22, 25-19 and 25-17 over the Bulls
- The team totaled 12 blocks in the match, led by Maya Muldrow's eight
- Muldrow also had nine kills while Erica Kostelac led with 13 and Carly Nolan finished with 11
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Maya Eller led the team in the opening AAC match with 16 digs
- On Sunday the Bearcats won in straight sets by scores of 25-22, 25-18 and 25-21 at UCF
- The team had a season-high eight aces, led by Nolan and Eller who had two each
- Jade Tingelhoff led all in the match with 35 assists while adding in 12 digs for a double-double
- · Nolan repeated with another double-double, totaling 16 digs and 14 kills on Sunday
- At 2-0 in conference play, Cincinnati is tied with Wichita State and SMU with the best AAC record entering the second weekend of conference action
- The Shockers travel to USF and UCF this weekend while the Mustangs play at ECU and at Cincinnati

#### // ROAD WARRIORS

- The Bearcats have battled through a tough schedule this season as they return home after playing their first five weeks and 14 matches of the 2017 season on the road
- Three of the team's 12 non-conference opponents were ranked nationally when they faced UC
- UC did play one weekend in Cincinnati when they participated in the Xavier Tournament
- That weekend started with a five-set triumph against crosstown rival Xavier on September 1

# // HOME-OPENING SUCCESS

- In its last 20 home-opening games dating back to the 1997 season, UC is 13-7 in its first game of the season played on home court
- The Bearcats dropped their last two home-openers but had a streak of winning ten straight from 2002-2011
- UC has won six of its last ten home-openers

# // A STRONG START

- The Bearcats have not dropped a set in its first two conference games this season, winning sixstraight to open the 2017 campaign
- UC has not won six-straight sets to start conference play since it did so during the 2011 season
- That year, the Bearcats beat UConn 3-0 and St. John's 3-0, both at home, to start Big East action
- After those first two 3-0 victories, UC went on to win its next two sets to make it an 8-0 run
- Despite two other teams also starting 2-0 in AAC play this season, both have dropped a set
- · Wichita State won 3-1 at Temple, losing the second set of the match
- SMU beat Tulane 3-1, dropping the first set of the match but then taking the next three

# // KNOW THE FOE: TULSA

Tulsa sits at an even 7-7 overall and 1-1 so far this season. The Golden Hurricane began AAC play at home. They beat Houston 3-1 and then fell to Tulane 3-1 at home last weekend. Emily Thorson leads TU offensively with 3.82 kills per set while Lindsey Ledyard leads the team with 7.87 assists per set. Tulsa's current digs per set leader is Taylor Horsfall (5.16) while Ebony Carter leads in blocks

# // SERIES HISTORY: BEARCATS vs. GOLDEN HURRICANE

Cincinnati is 4-3 all-time against Tulsa. Last season, each team won its road match. The Bearcats took a 3-2 victory in Tulsa and the Golden Hurricane won 3-1 in Cincinnati. Tulsa went 8-12 in the conference last season and finished 19-13 overall.

# // KNOW THE FOE: SMU

SMU currently sits at 8-5 overall and 2-0 in AAC action. The Mustangs opened conference play at home last weekend by defeating Tulane 3-1 and Houston 3-0. Lauren Mills and Katie Hegarty are tied for the team-lead in kills per set with 3.74 this season. Mills was named the AAC offensive player of the week on Monday. Kendall Patterson leads by averaging 9.60 assists per set. Defensively, Montana Watts averages 4.62 digs per set while Lexi Nordmann has 1.19 blocks per set so far this year.

# // SERIES HISTORY: BEARCATS vs. MUSTANGS

Cincinnati and SMU have met a total of eight times with he Bearcats winning just once. That lone victory came last season in front of a record volleyball crowd of 2,018 at Fifth Third Arena. UC took all three sets in that victory. Earlier during the 2016 season, the Bearcats fell to the Mustangs 3-2 in Dallas.

# // NOLAN ON THE ATTACK

At this point in the season, Carly Nolan finds herself ranked in several statistical categories both in the conference and nationally. On a conference level, she leads with 4.10 kills/set and leads in points with a 4.56/set average. Nationally, her 12.76 attacks/set ranks 7th (leads the American) while her kills per set total ranks her 47th in the NCAA.

# // MORE CONFERENCE RANKS

- · Jade Tingelhoff ranks fifth in the league with 9.04 assists/set
- Jasmine Jones is 7th in blocks/set wtih 1.12 while Maya Muldrow is 11th in the same category with 1.02 blocks/set

# // SMILE FOR THE CAMERA

Speaking of the conference, the American Athletic Conference has announced the fall broadcast schedule for the American Digital Network with Bearcats volleyball set to be aired live October 26 when UC travels to Dallas to face SMU.

#### // DEBUTS

Five different players have made their debuts for the Bearcats this season, including three true freshman, one redshirt freshman and one junior transfer. The rookies that saw action in the first two matches of the season included Emily Azzara, Maya Eller and Chrysanthi Stamatiou. They joined Erica Kostelac (redshirt) and Jasmine Jones, a transfer from UNC Greensboro. Kostelac currently is second on the team with 98 total kills while Eller is second in digs with a total of 122. Eller also leads the team in aces with 13 this season.

# Week 1: Bluegrass Battle

# Week 3: Redbird Classic

- September 8-9 UC traveled to Normal, Illinois, to participate in the Redbird Classic
- The tournament started with a 3-1 loss to Seton Hall, followed by a 3-0 defeat at the hands of Dayton
- The Bearcats concluded the event with a 3-2 loss to host Illinois State
- · Nolan was named to the all-tournament team, her third consecutive honor

# Week 4: Michigan Challenge

- Last weekend, the Bearcats went 1-2 at the Michigan Challenge
- They opened up with a 3-0 loss to NC State, but rebounded nicely later that same day with a 3-0 victory against Milwaukee
- UC finished with a 3-0 loss to #21 Michigan as the Wolverines were able to protect home court

# BEARCATS NOTES // WEEK #6 • vs Tulsa, vs SMU

in 2017. Returning this year are Jordan Thompson, the AAC Player of the Year, Jade Tingelhoff, the AAC Setter of the Year, and Carly Nolan, who, along with Thompson and Tingelhoff, was named First Team All-Conference. The lone honoree not returning to reigning AAC Coach of the Year Molly Alvey's lineup is Second Team All-Conference Ciara Hill, who was a senior last year.

#### // SOMETHING NEW - PART I

During the 2017 season, the Bearcats will play their home matches at St. Ursula Academy's Gymnasium and Convocation Center, which is located just two miles from campus, while an \$87 million renovation of Fifth Third Arena continues to progress. The Bearcats will play nine home matches this year with the first coming September 29 with Tulsa coming to town.

# // SOMETHING NEW - PART II

Not only will the Bearcats play in a new venue, they also will play a new conference foe as the Shockers of Wichita State have joined the league this year. The teams met last year in a match at WSU with the Bearcats scoring a 3-1 victory. The match marked the first time the two programs had played one another and are now scheduled to meet twice this season (once in Wichita and once in Cincinnati). Similar to the Bearcats (11), the Shockers have made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, including the 2016 event, and have been selected to win the AAC this year, just three points ahead of UC in the preseason poll (see next note).

# // PRESEASON HONORS

Heading into the season, the Bearcats are once again viewed as one of the teams to beat in the American Athletic Conference as the league coaches picked UC to finish second in a very close race with AAC debutante Wichita State. The Shockers received 116 points and seven first-place votes while the Bearcats tallied 113 points and the remaining five first-place votes. Individually, Thompson was a unanimous selection as the AAC Preseason Player of the year and joined both Tingelhoff and Nolan as preseason all-conference honorees with Tingelhoff earning a spot on the list as well.

# // SUMMER TOURS

During the summer, three with ties to the program were traveling overseas for competitions as members of the US Collegiate National Team program. Jordan Thompson, who was invited to the Team USA Tryouts, was selected to her second US CNT, this time joining a squad that would tour Thailand (May 9-30). Her selection came one year after she competed for the CNT in China with associate head coach Phillip White serving as an assistant coach. Two UC coaches also were in action this summer as head coach Molly Alvey was tabbed to lead the CNT-Europe squad while assistant coach Kevin Carroll served as an assistant with the team. The US squad made stops in Italy, Slovenia and Croatia before participating in the Global Challenge in Croatia (July 10-14).

# // STRONG ACADEMICS

Following the 2016 season, several academic awards were bestowed upon the Bearcats, both as a team and individually. As a team, UC was one of 149 women's Division I programs to carry a 3.30 GPA or higher and was named an AVCA Team Academic Award recipient. Individually, 12 Bearcats were honored with AAC All-Academic honors, including Lise Alaiwan, Dasha Cabarkapa, Lindsey Dinkelacker, Ciara Hill, Erica Kostelac, Carly Nolan, Elly Ogle, Parker Shepherd, Jordan Thompson, Jade Tingelhoff, Abby Williams and Sabrina Wolf. To earn the honor, each individual maintained better than a 3.00 GPA throughout the academic year.

#### // SENIOR YEAR

Two players are entering their final collegiate seasons with the program. Those two seniors include Maya Muldrow (Raleigh, N.C./Wakefield) and Parker Shepherd (McKinney, Texas/McKinney Boyd).

# // HELLO! MY NAME IS...

Seven new faces have joined the program this year, including four freshmen, one junior transfer and two new members of the coaching staff. On the court, the rookie class includes Emily Azzara (Louisville, Ky./Sacred Heart Academy), Maya Eller (Concord Township, Ohio/Lake Catholic), Megan Kissel (Mason, Ohio/CHCA) and Chrysanthi Stamatiou (Thessaloniki,

Greece/Hellenic College) and will join Jasmine Jones (Stafford, Va./Brooke Point), a junior that transferred in from UNC Greensboro. New the staff for 2017 is assistant coach Kevin Carroll and volunteer coach Jake Neiheisel.

#### **LOOKING BACK AT 2016**

# // THOMPSON EARNS ALL-AMERICA HONORS

Following a stellar sophomore campaign, Jordan Thompson earned a pair of honors from the AVCA, including all-region before being tabbed a 2016 All-American. Thompson is just the eighth Cincinnati player to earn All-America accolades and only the third Bearcat to garner the national award as a sophomore. She was the first unanimous Player of the Year in American Athletic Conference history and was a unanimous pick to the all-conference first team for the second consecutive season. The right side hitter recorded her 1,000th career kill on Nov. 25, breaking a school and league record as the quickest player to 1,000 kills and the only person to reach the milestone as a sophomore. She ended the season ranked sixth in the NCAA with 4.92 kills per set, sixth with 5.50 points per set, eighth with 580 total kills and ninth with 648.5 total points.

#### // BEARCATS GRAB AAC HONORS

The American Athletic Conference handed out several honors to the Bearcats in 2016, including three major awards, including Jordan Thompson being named (unanimously) the 2016 AAC Player of the Year; Jade Tingelhoff earning 2016 AAC Setter of the Year honors; and head coach Molly Alvey being named the 2016 AAC Coach of the Year. Thompson and Tingelhoff were named AAC All-Conference First Team with Carly Nolan also earning the same honor. Ciara Hill was selected to the AAC All-Conference Second Team as well.

#### // NCAA RETURN

The Bearcats earned an at-large berth into the 2016 NCAA Tournament, making their first appearance since the 2011 campaign. UC was placed in the Gainesville, Fla., region and squared off with Florida State in the first round, dropping a 3-1 decision to the Seminoles. The selection to the tournament, UC's first as an at-large participant since 2010, marked the 10th time in program history the Bearcats have been part of the national event.

# // THOMPSON OVER 1,000 KILLS

On Nov. 25, 2016, Jordan Thompson became the 18th player in school history to reach 1,000 career kills when she did so in the third set of a 3-1 victory over Memphis. She broke a program and American Athletic Conference record as the quickest player to 1,000 career kills and the only player to ever reach the milestone as a sophomore.

# // BLOCK PARTY

Cincinnati recorded 18.0 blocks in a 3-1 win over Middle Tennessee State on Aug. 27 at the DISH Tennessee Classic. The total was the most for any UC team since November 16, 2007, when it tallied 18.5 blocks in a 3-1 loss to Notre Dame. Alison Kimmel earned a career-high nine blocks while Maya Muldrow tied a career best with eight. Elly Ogle (six), Ciara Hill (six), Jordan Thompson (four) and Carly Nolan (three) also got in on the blocking action.

# // UP NEXT

The Bearcats hit the road once again, this time heading East. UC is slated to play at UConn on Friday, October 6 and at Temple on Sunday, October 8. The team will return home the following weekend for matches on October 13 and 15.
