# On the energy of the crowd

"It's interesting I think you feel it as a coach and you feel it as a player... the only thing I actually thought about during the game was that I better learn all these hand signals because nobody can hear a damn thing I'm saying when I'm talking... I look forward to more nights in fifth third like that."

### On the 17-0 run

"We got a long way to go there were certainly moments like that tonight there were a couple of late possessions where we looked out of sync offensively, but I thought you could see moments where it was coming together... I don't wanna be a guy that calls a ton of plays and there were moments like that tonight where I did not have to do that."

### On Mike Saunders Jr. and the team

"I thought he was terrific with his ball pressure... he got downhill there with our secondary break and our primary break and made some nice plays but I think we need to mention too there were guys down there sealing for him and that's not the stuff that shows up on the stat sheet... when everybody does there job there are more opportunities to make plays and we saw some more of that organization tonight and I thought that gave guys the ability to get downhill and do what they do."

### Opening statement

"I thought it was pretty neat in here Tuesday night, well that was even different tonight, that was really special...that's as special of a college basketball atmosphere that I've ever been a part of. I've been a part of some cool ones, but that rivals them all. That's what I expected when I took the job here, and that exceeded expectations in terms of environment and support. We got a long way to go as a team....the second half I thought that there were some really good moments...but listen, we realize that it's not all put together yet. I thought our kids had great effort, great energy...and I thought they started believing in the way that we started to play defense."

## On rebounding

"I've been really disappointed with our rebounding team at the beginning of the year, in practice and scrimmages, but Georgia is a really good rebounding team...and we win the rebounding battle. We have 17 offensive rebounds and I thought [John Newman III] really set a tone for us there tonight. I told them in the locker room, we keep working everyday, we keep having the

right approach, we're gonna have a lot more fun nights here. I want them to enjoy this night, I want them to celebrate, we work so hard in college basketball you should enjoy wins and enjoy having fun, but we wake up tomorrow and we haven't crossed the finish line"
