CINCINNATI - The University of Cincinnati baseball team continues an eight-game road swing next weekend at Houston. The Bearcats (19-18, 8-8 American Athletic Conference) and Cougars (16-23, 4-12 AAC) are slated for a Friday doubleheader started at 3 p.m. ET and Saturday and Sunday games set for a 3 p.m. first pitch and 1 p.m. start, respectively.

All four games will air on the ESPN+ platform and live stats will also be available on BearcatStats.com.

SERIES BUSINESS

• Houston leads the all-time series 39-12. The teams first met in 1958 and last matched up in 2019 in Houston.

ABOUT THE BEARCATS

- UC is 21-19 and 10-10 in AAC play after splitting a four-game series at USF last weekend.
- As a team, UC is hitting at a .278 clip with 65 doubles and 50 home runs with double-digit hits in 22 games.
- On the mound, UC has a team ERA of 6.04 with 356 strikeouts over 215 walks.
- UC's hurlers have struck out five or more batters combined in all but one game this season (Feb. 20 at Clemson).

TURN IT UP!

• The Cincinnati infield has turned an AAC-best 41 doubles places this season and trails only Auburn (47) nationally.

GOING, GOING, GONE

- The Bearcats have belted 50 home runs thus far in 2021, leading the AAC and ranking No. 20 nationally.
- Jace Mercer and Cole Harting lead the club with eight home runs apiece.

LAST TIME OUT

- UC split a weekend series at USF, getting a win in the Friday night cap and Sunday's series finale.
- Eric Santiago hit .471 after collecting eight hits, including two doubles, with three runs scored, two RBIs and a stolen base.
- Jace Mercer had six hits, including a double and a triple, two runs scored, two RBIs and two SB.
- Joey Bellini had three RBIs and five hits, including a double.
- Sunday starter Jalen Wade pitched a gem, going 6.0 innings in a no-decision, giving up one run on four hits, striking out three in a 96-pitch outing, his longest since throwing 102 pitches against Xavier on May 8, 2018.

YOUNG THUNDERCATS

- CF Cole Harting has put together an impressive freshman campaign in the leadoff spot, making 37 starts.
- Harting has belted eight homers and eight doubles among his 42 hits which have brought in 27 runs.
- He is second on the team with 12 stolen bases.
- Harting tied the school record for hits in a game, going 6-for-6 in the Sunday matchup at Xavier, hitting two homers with five RBIs and a double.
- He is the sixth player to accomplish the feat, the first since Logan Parker had six against West Virginia on May 13, 2006.

YOUNG THUNDERCATS

- Ryan Nicholson has overcome a slow start and has his hit .291 in AAC play. His 23 walks are a team best.
- Nicholson had the walk-off hit against No. 5 Louisville in extra innings at UC Baseball Stadium.

DUAL ROLES FOR MCCARTHY

- LHP Dean McCarthy has split time as a starter and reliever this season, making 13 appearances in 2021.
- The grad transfer from Elon made seven starts to open the campaign but his last six trips to the rubber have been out of the bullpen.
- He has pitched 51-2 innings, going 3-3 with two saves.

SCHOENLE TABBED AS AAC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- LHP Evan Shawver takes the ball on Saturday, making his first start since an abbreviated outing at ECU on April 3.
- He threw 44 pitches in two innings and left due to soreness.
- He's 2-1 with a 1.74 ERA and 34 strikeouts in 31.0 IP.

SANTIAGO HAS BIG WEEK VS. WICHITA STATE

- 3B Eric Santiago earned a spot on the American's weekly honor roll after hitting .571 (8-14) for the series with two runs scored, a double and two runs driven in.
- He laid down a crucial sacrifice bunt on Sunday which led to the go-ahead-run scoring in the bottom of the seventh.
- UC's leader this season with nine doubles made his 200th career start in the WSU series finale, playing in the 209th game at Cincinnati which moved him into eighth place all-time on the career games played chart.

MOVE ... GET OUT THE WAY

- UC has hit 72 batters this season, a mark which leads the American and ranks fifth nationally.
- Georgia State (80) lead the NCAA.

KNOCKING OFF THE CARDS ...

- UC walked off No. 5 Louisville 13-12 on March 30, its first win over a ranked foe since Oregon State in the NCAA Regional on June 1, 2019.
- The Tuesday win came on a one-out single from Louisville native Ryan Nicholson in the bottom of the 10th inning. The Bearcats trailed 8-2 in the middle of the fourth and 12-11 in the middle of the 10th.

PRESEASON HONORS APLENTY

- LHP Evan Shawver, 3B Eric Santiago and DH Wyatt Stapp were preseason All-American Athletic Conference selections, the first time in UC history three players earned preseason honors. Stapp is a two-time preseason all-conference honoree while Santiago and Shawver were tabbed for the first time.
- Stapp batted .283 in 46 at-bats with 13 hits, 11 RBIs, eight runs, two doubles and two stolen bases in 2020.
- Santiago started all 15 games for UC last season, posting a .314 batting average with 16 hits, one home run, nine RBIs, seven runs and three doubles in 51 at-bats.

FLASHBACK TO 2019

- Head Coach Scott Googins led the Bearcats to one of the most successful seasons in program history in 2019. The Bearcats won the American Athletic Conference Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Baseball Tournament for the first time in 45 years.

#BearcatsUnited was established this past spring in light of a number of continued injustices towards people of color., a combined departmental effort to increase awareness of social justice and inequality issues.

The baseball team is wearing a #BearcatsUnited patch on its caps this season. The football team wore a decal on the rear helmet bumper and other UC have worn patches on their uniforms and worn a combination of t-shirts with messages to show the combined unity of our community.

Baseball student-athlete Nate Moore helped lead the charge to rename UC's baseball stadium in June 2020. Moore and baseball Coach Scott Googins were featured on the Behind the Bearcats podcast to talk about how the name change push came together.

Following the renaming of the baseball stadium, SAAC made a formal statement which stated its goals for the 2020-21 year, including: establishing a mandatory day off for athletic-related activities on Voting Day, creating a Black Student-Athlete Association, supporting racial equality across campus, bringing awareness to gender discrimination, standing alongside the LGBTQ+ community, promoting local businesses across the University, implementing Bias Training and Educational Classes and celebrating Black History Month.

To date, SAAC has created the Bearcast Your Vote initiative, which has successfully assisted in getting nearly 100% of UC's student-athletes registered to vote in their respective home states.

The Black Student-Athlete Association was implemented in September and will be led by Arthur Greenlee IV from men's track and field and Shannon Williams from volleyball, with coaches and staff members serving as advisors.

POWERFUL MINDS WEEK

- The American Athletic Conference's Pow6rful Minds Week takes place Oct. 4-10, coinciding with Mental Illness Awareness Week.
- With the inception of its Pow6rful Minds Campaign in the fall of 2017, The AAC SAAC has helped create awareness to mental health issues and the resources available for student-athletes.
- The definitive goal has been to end the stigma related to seeking help and promoting academic and personal success through a healthy, powerful mind.

AAC RACIAL EQUALITY ACTION GROUP

- The AAC has created content online regarding the AAC REAG, which contains important information and updates from schools across the conference footprint.
- Niki Cianciola, UC's Director of Sport Services, track and field student-athlete Arthur Greenlee IV and women's basketball student-athlete Zenzele Apesemaka-Vital were elected to the AAC REAG board.

The department created its own social justice statement, which now hangs proudly on the main floor of the Richard E. Lindner Center.



UC Baseball Stadium has been the home of the Cincinnati Bearcats baseball team since the end of the 2004 season.

The first game played at the 3,085-seat, on-campus facility occurred on May, 20 2004 when the Bearcats hosted UAB in the final series of 2004. The opening game was played on a Thursday night, before a crowd of 2,200.

Since its opening, the stadium has seen a UC great recognized within the facility. In May 2005, coaching legend Glenn Sample was honored with the walkway outside the field being named Glenn Sample Way.

The stadium, which was voted the favorite road stadium in the BIG EAST Conference to visit, is located directly east of the spot where Johnny Bench Field, the Bearcats' previous home, sat for a number of years.

Acting on a recommendation by President Neville G. Pinto, the UC Board of Trustees unanimously voted on June 23, 2020 to remove the name of the late Cincinnati Reds owner and philanthropist Marge Schott from the university's baseball stadium and a second space. The stadium held the name of Marge Schott Stadium from 2006-2020.

SCOTT GOOGINS • HEAD COACH • FOURTH SEASON • OHIO WESLEYAN '92

Scott Googins was named the 28th head baseball coach at the University of Cincinnati on June 6, 2017 and will enter his fourth season in the spring of 2021.

Prior to a pandemic-shortened 2020, Googins led the Bearcats to one of the most successful seasons in program history in 2019.

Despite a slow 1-9 start, UC found itself as the No. 2 seed in the American Athletic Conference Tournament where they were yet to win a game. After winning its first three, UC went on to trounce UConn 22-5 to win the AAC Tournament title and advance to the NCAA postseason for the first time in 45 years.

With the automatic bid, the Bearcats were shipped west to reigning CWS champion Oregon State for NCAA Regional action. On the big stage the win streak continued with a dramatic 7-6 victory over the national-host Beavers.

The magic came to an end with a loss the next day to eventual CWS runner-up Michigan. UC's historic 2019 season came to a close with a 31-31 final tally.

The team broke numerous records during the campaign. Six Bearcats earned All-AAC Tournament honors with AJ Bumpass being named the tournament MVP. Three players were named to the Corvallis Regional All-Tournament Team. Bumpass was later drafted by the Cincinnati Reds. The win over Oregon State marked Googins' 400th in his storied career.

In his first season, Googins guided UC to its best finish since 2011 as the Bearcats finished at 28-28 overall and an even 12-12 in AAC play, one of the toughest RPI conferences in the nation. UC led the nation in double plays, turned a triple-play for the fifth time in school history and earned numerous individual achievements.

Shortstop Manny Rodriguez was drafted in the tenth round while pitchers Cam Alldred and J.T. Perez also were selected in the MLB draft. All three were all-conference honorees (Rodriguez and Perez on First Team, Alldred on Second), marking the first time UC has ever had two first team honorees and three total honorees in AAC history. Nine different players earned weekly conference accolades throughout the season.

Googins made the move across town after 12 seasons as the head coach at Xavier. The all-time winningest coach at XU, he compiled a 341-357 record with four NCAA Tournament appearances including back-to-back regional finals berths (2016 & 2017) and six regular season or conference tournament championships.

Before taking the head coaching role at Xavier, Googins served as an assistant at Miami (OH) and Indiana.

The native of Granville, Ohio played catcher at Ohio Wesleyan from 1989-92, moving into a coaching role as a senior and staying on after graduation.

Googins and his wife, Jody - a former volleyball standout at Xavier - live in West Chester, Ohio, with their daughter, Ellie, and two sons, Tommy and Charlie.

**JD HEILMANN**

PITCHING COACH / RECRUITING COORDINATOR

J.D. Heilmann began his third stint as an assistant coach at Cincinnati in 2017.

Heilmann is regarded as one of the top pitching coaches in college baseball and is known for his ability to develop and relate to pitchers.

He previously coached at UC from 2009-13, serving as the Bearcats pitching coach and recruiting coordinator and was responsible for bringing former All-American and current Chicago Cubs infielder Ian Happ to the Queen City.

Heilmann joined Head Coach Scott Googins' staff after working as the general manager of the Midland Baseball program, overseeing 18 amateur teams with ages ranging from 8-18. He also served as Prep Baseball Report's scouting supervisor (2016-17) and Scouting Director (2014-16) and was an associate scout for the Atlanta Braves (2015-17).

Under Heilmann's tutelage, seven Bearcats have gone on to pitch in professional baseball. Six were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft – right-handers Connor Walsh (2014), Zach Isler (2012), Christian McElroy (2012) and Dan Jensen (2011). Brian Garman (2010) and Kevin Johnson (2010) and Ryan Atkinson (2015) signed a free-agent contract with the Arizona Diamondbacks.

Prior to Cincinnati, Heilmann served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Xavier University for seven seasons and in 2009, he helped the Musketeers to a school record for wins en route to their first Atlantic-10 Tournament Championship and NCAA appearance.

Prior to coaching at Xavier, Heilmann briefly coached at Division II Northern Kentucky University and at local Division III power Mount St. Joseph. At both stops, Heilmann was in charge of the development of the pitching staff, as well as assisting in recruiting. While at Mount St. Joseph, Heilmann played a key role in the Lions' success, which included a Heartland Conference Championship in 2000 and a NCAA Regional runner-up finish in 2000.

In addition to his years on the collegiate level, Heilmann spent five summers as both an assistant and head coach in the nationally recognized Midland summer baseball organization. He helped guide his teams to success on the national level, evidenced by a fourth-place finish in 1999 and two second-place finishes in 1997 and 2002.

Heilmann played for the Bearcats in 1997 earned a communications degree while completing his eligibility at UC following a transfer from Ball State.

A 1993 Moeller High School graduate, Heilmann helped the Crusaders capture a State Baseball Championship, while earning All-City and All-League honors.

Heilmann and his wife Raegene have two children, Dax and Ryley.

**KYLE SPRAGUE**

HITTING COACH / INFELDERS

Kyle Sprague joined the University of Cincinnati baseball staff in the summer of 2017.

His work on offense came through the loudest during the team's historic 2019 season when the Bearcats' bats went on a torrential pace during the postseason. During the 4-0 AAC Tournament run, UC broke the tournament records for runs (51), RBI (47) and hits (60). Seven homeruns and four in the championship game were also AAC Tournament records. The 22-5 title win over UConn was the largest margin of victory ever in the tournament while they tied for the most number of hits in a game. Eleven different players got a hit during the 4-0 tournament week. All six all-tournament honorees were offensive players with slugger AJ Bumpass named tournament MVP.

During the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, UC ranked 12th in the nation in triples per game, 14th in doubles per game, 21st in on-base percentage, 30th in scoring and 31st in slugging percentage.

Sprague came to UC after two seasons on Head Coach Scott Googins' staff at Xavier University as the volunteer assistant coach. Sprague directed XU's camps, assisted in all facets of the program and coached first base during games.

During his two seasons at Xavier, the Musketeers won a BIG EAST Conference regular season championship (2016), two-straight league tournament championships (2016 & 17) and played in consecutive regional finals in the NCAA Championship (2016 & 17).

Sprague worked with hitters and infielders and assisted with outfielders at Xavier. The Musketeers set a school record with a .977 fielding percentage in 2017 after tying the previous record with a .974 mark in 2016.

Sprague has previous experience in the American Athletic Conference having served as a volunteer assistant coach at UCF from 2014-2015. UCF achieved a program-best No. 6 ranking during the 2015 campaign.

Before coming to Orlando, Sprague held the volunteer assistant position during the 2012-13 season at Gardner-Webb. While with the Runnin' Bulldogs, catcher John Harris was a Johnny Bench Award nominee and the team set a program best in fielding pct. at .969.

Sprague has extensive experience as a camp instructor, working at the Marc Wilkins Baseball Academy from 2007-12 and for Cal Ripken Baseball in 2009. He also has served as a camp instructor at Clemson, Vanderbilt, Tennessee, LSU and Mississippi State, among others.

The Mansfield, Ohio, native graduated from Malone (Ohio) University with degrees in business administration and sports management. He played collegiately at Malone and Tiffin University.

Sprague and his wife Erin live in Cincinnati.

Lee Sponseller rejoined the Cincinnati baseball staff in August 2020 as the volunteer assistant coach.

He will work with the outfielders as well as the hitters and perform other duties necessary for the advanced development of the student-athletes.

He also had a short stint as UC's volunteer director of player development.

Sponseller previously coached at Ohio Dominican, serving as the volunteer assistant coach, handling the team's hitting and outfielders as well as assisting with base running. He played at Ohio Dominican, finishing his career with a .367 batting average with 26 homeruns and 108 RBI.

From there, he spent one year as a graduate transfer at Coastal Carolina, hitting .290 during the season with six homeruns and 42 RBI, including three grand slams.

Sponseller earned a bachelor's degree in finance and economics from Ohio Dominican in May 2017 and graduated with an MBA from Coastal Carolina in August 2018. He currently resides in Mason, Ohio.
