CINCINNATI – The University of Cincinnati volleyball team hosts Texas Tech at 6 p.m. on Wednesday inside Fifth Third Arena.

The Bearcats will remain at home for a nationally-televised contest versus No. 22-ranked Houston on Sunday. First serve is scheduled for 1 p.m. on ESPNU.

// SERIES HISTORY

- Cincinnati and Texas Tech will face off for the first time in history.
- Texas Tech enters Wednesday with an 8-14 overall record and 1-9 mark in the Big 12. The Red Raiders were recently swept in a home series against Houston.

// LAST TIME OUT

- Cincinnati split a pair of five-set matches at West Virginia to move to 10-9 overall, 3-6 in the Big 12.
- The Bearcats registered a season-high 16 blocks in Friday's win, behind a career-high nine stuffs from redshirt sophomore Ligia Williams. Junior Abby Walker set a new season high in kills (17) while hitting at an efficient .361 clip.
- Senior outside hitter Elissa Alcantara averaged 4.00 kills per set in two matches against WVU. She posted a career-high 23 kills on Thursday and followed the performance with 17 kills on Friday.

// MADE IN THE MIDDLE

- Cincinnati has received valuable contributions from middle blockers Ligia Williams and Zeta Washington in Big 12 play. Washington is averaging 2.73 kills per set at a .320 clip and 0.92 blocks per set while Williams is averaging 1.63 kills per set at a .237 clip and 1.30 blocks per set.
- In Big 12 matches only, Williams ranks third in blocks per set (1.30). She posted a career-high nine blocks in UC's win at West Virginia. She has registered five-or-more blocks in six Big 12 matches.
- Washington has recorded double-digit kills in six Big 12 matches, including three straight. She totaled 19 kills at a .359 clip in UC's win over TCU.
- Overall, Williams (1.19) and Washington (1.03) rank eighth and 12th, respectively, in the Big 12 in blocks per set.

// DIGGIN' THE DEFENSE

- The Bearcats have out-dug their opponents in 14 of 19 matches this season.
- Cincinnati has held the advantage in digs in each of its Big 12 victories: K-State (72-65), TCU (80-70) and WVU (66-63). UC ranks third in the Big 12 and 85th nationally in digs per set (15.16).
- Cincinnati posted a season-high 91 digs against South Carolina on Sept. 9. It marked the most digs in a single match since October 15, 2021 when the Bearcats had 93 against Tulsa.

// STEADY SKRABAK

- Graduate student Carly Skrabak is averaging 4.11 digs per set as the team's starting libero - good for fourth in the Big 12. She has led the team in digs in all but two matches this season. She's currently 16th among active career DI leaders with 1,795 career digs. She is 205 digs away from 2,000 in her career.
- Skrabak has posted 20-plus digs on six occasions. Her season-high of 24 digs came against UCF on Sept. 21. The mark leads the Big 12 for a four-set match in conference play.

// NEXT 'CAT UP

- Outside hitters Carly Glendinning and Elissa Alcantara have taken over the attacking duties for the Bearcats.
- Since September 22, Alcantara is averaging 2.56 kills per set across 32 sets played. She has led the Bearcats in kills in three straight matches, including a career-high 23 kills at WVU on Oct. 19. Her previous career high of 22 kills came against Arizona on Nov. 1, 2019. Glendinning is averaging 2.36 kills and 2.67 digs per set across 33 sets played. She has recorded three double-doubles over the last eight matches.

// QB1

- Junior setter Katelyn Lefler has recorded 12 double-doubles in 19 matches this season. She has posted a double-double in four consecutive matches, including a 48-assist, 18-dig performance in UC's five-set win over West Virginia.
- She has recorded 40-plus assists eight times, with her season-high 55 assists coming against South Carolina on Sept. 9.
- Lefler ranks seventh in the Big 12 and 74th nationally with 9.78 assists per set. The Bearcats rank sixth in the Big 12 and in the top-100 in the nation in the category (12.05).

// ALL EYES ON THE 'CATS

- Cincinnati volleyball will be showcased on ESPNU during the 2023 season as part of the Big 12's national television schedule. Cincinnati is set to host Houston for the nationally-televised contest on Sunday, Oct. 29. First serve is scheduled for 1 p.m. ET inside Fifth Third Arena.
- The league's national television schedule includes 12 volleyball matches across its television partners ESPN and FOX Sports.

// THIS IS VOLLEYBALL COUNTRY

- Five Big 12 schools are ranked in the AVCA/Taralex Division I Coaches Poll. Texas is No. 5, BYU is No. 8, Kansas is No. 14, Baylor is No. 20 and Houston is No. 22. UCF and Iowa State received votes.
- Entering this week, eight Big 12 schools are in the top 50 of the RPI rankings. Texas is No. 3, BYU is No. 11, Baylor is No. 21, Kansas is No. 25, Iowa State is No. 36, Houston is No. 37, UCF is No. 42 and TCU is No. 49. The eight schools inside the top 50 ties for the most of any league. Cincinnati is No. 140 in RPI.
- The Big 12 is one of only two leagues to have a team advance to the National Semifinals in three of the last four seasons (Baylor – 2019, Texas – 2020 & 2022). The conference joined the Big Ten as the only leagues last year to have five or more teams in the NCAA tournament and go undefeated in the opening round (5-0). The Big 12 finished the regular season with the highest RPI of any league.

// INJURY BUG BITES THE BEARCATS

- Junior starting outside hitter Shaye Eggleston has missed the last 13 matches due to injury.
- Graduate student and starting outside hitter Jady Bauss suffered a season-ending injury in the Bearcats' Big 12 opener against UCF on Sept. 21. Bauss led the Bearcats in kill in eight matches and finished with double-digit kills in 10 of her 11 matches played, including 20-plus kills on three occasions.
- Freshman middle Zeta Washington missed the first three matches of the season due to injury.
- In total, six Bearcats have missed at least one match this season due to injury.

// NON-CON NUGGETS

- Cincinnati concluded its non-conference slate with a 7-3 record. It marked the most non-conference wins since the Bearcats went 8-4 against out-of-conference opponents in 2019.
- Abby Walker was named to the Tru by Hilton Dayton Beaver Creek All-Tournament Team.
- Jady Bauss was named Most Valuable Player of the Golden Eagle Tournament while Abby Walker and Zeta Washington were selected to its All-Tournament Team.

// GO OFF ROOK

- Zeta Washington was named Big 12 Rookie of the Week, the league announced on Tuesday, Sept. 5. She averaged 5.00 kills and 1.00 blocks per set while hitting .492 in a 3-0 weekend for the Bearcats.
- She finished the week leading Conference players in both points per set (5.86) and kills per set (5.00) while ranking third in hitting percentage (.492). She is the first Bearcat to procure a weekly Big 12 volleyball honor.
- Washington dropped a 25-piece in her collegiate debut against Kennesaw State on Sept. 1. She hit .524 with 25 kills and only three attacking errors on 42 swings. She added three blocks and a service ace in the four-set win.
- She added 10 kills at a .412 clip and four blocks (two solo) in a sweep of Tennessee Tech on Sept. 2. She was named to the Golden Eagle Invite All-Tournament Team for her performance.

// GOLDEN EAGLE TOURNEY CHAMPS

- Cincinnati won the Golden Eagle Tournament (Sept. 1-2), picking up wins over Kennesaw State, ETSU and Tennessee Tech. It marked Cincinnati's first non-conference tournament title since 2021 when the Bearcats won the NKU Invitational.
- Jady Bauss was named Most Valuable Player while Abby Walker and Zeta Washington were selected to the All-Tournament Team.
- Bauss averaged 4.63 points, 3.82 kills and 2.55 digs per set. She led the Bearcats in kills twice, including a 17-kill performance in a four-set win over ETSU. Walker averaged 2.82 kills and 0.67 blocks per set while hitting .491. She registered a season-high 15 kills at a .519 clip (15-1-27) in a four-set win over Kennesaw State.

// RECORD CROWDS FILL FIFTH THIRD ARENA

- Cincinnati broke its volleyball attendance record on August 26 with 3,358 fans packed inside Fifth

Third Arena. It shattered the previous record of 2,057 set on Nov. 2, 2018.

- In addition, Aug. 25's attendance of 1,513 was the fifth-most in program history.

// ACES UP OUR SLEEVES

- The Bearcats totaled 18 service aces against Xavier on Aug. 26, breaking the program and Big 12 records for service aces in a four-set match. The 18 service aces surpassed the program and Big 12 records of 17, set in 2004 and 2005, respectively. The mark ranks second in the country for a four-set match.
- Shaye Eggleston had a career-high seven aces while Bauss tied her career high with five. Eggleston tied the individual program record for aces in a four-set match. The mark also is tied for fourth nationally in the category.

// STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- This season marks the first year that Cincinnati will compete in the Big 12.
- The Bearcats will face 11 teams that saw action in the 2022 postseason: nine NCAA Tournament teams and two National Invitational Volleyball Championship teams.
- Of the 21 opponents on the schedule, 14 finished inside the top-100 in the 2022 RPI rankings.

// RETURNING TALENT

- The Bearcats return nine letterwinners, including four starters, from a season ago.
- The roster features the return of all-conference selections Abby Walker and Carly Glendinning.
- Walker, a 6-foot-1 middle blocker, garnered her second consecutive Second Team All-Conference nod after averaging 2.51 kills and 0.82 blocks per set as a sophomore. The 2021 AAC Freshman of the Year started and played in every match (30) and set (112) last season.
- Glendinning, a 6-foot-2 outside hitter, averaged a team-best 2.97 kills per set to go along with 1.26 digs and 0.30 blocks per set in 2022. She registered 16 double-digit kill performances, including a stretch of eight straight to open AAC play. She led the team in kills nine times last year.

// NEW KIDZ ON THE BLOCK

- Cincinnati welcomes eight newcomers to the 2023 roster, including five true freshmen and three transfers.
- UC's freshman class features Zeta Washington (Ponte Vedra, Fla.), Nina Horning (Lake Orion, Mich.), Lilian Entenmann (Columbus, Ohio), Vivian Campbell (Oswego, Ill.) and Kayla Hostetler (Hebron, Ky.).
- The Class of 2023 was ranked No. 21 by Prep Dig, marking the highest-rated recruiting class in program history.
- Transfers Carly Skrabak (Marquette), Jady Bauss (SMU) and Katelyn Lefler (Illinois State) also join the Bearcats.

// FROM THE MUSIC CITY TO THE QUEEN CITY

- Former club teammates and high school competitors Carly Skrabak (Franklin, Tenn.) and Shaye Eggleston (Brentwood, Tenn.) will reunite to compete for the Bearcats this season.
- The duo grew up 15 minutes from each other and played club for Tennessee Performance Volleyball Club.

// FOREIGN TOUR PAYS DIVIDENDS

- The Cincinnati volleyball program had the opportunity to take a 10-day foreign tour to Europe this summer with stops in Hungary, Slovenia, Croatia and Italy.
- The team trained and played local teams in each country along with sightseeing and experiencing the cultures of each location. The Bearcats competed against the Hungarian National Team, Nova KBM Branik and the Italian National Team.
