## UC HEADLINES

- » Cincinnati enters the AAC Championship semifinals having won eight of 11 games since a 25-day layoff due to COVID-19 issues within the program following its 82-76 loss at Wichita State on Jan. 10.
- » **Keith Williams** was named Second Team All-AAC while **Tari Eason** was tabbed to the AAC All-Freshman Team on Monday.
- » Williams has played a key role in UC's resurgence over the last 11 games, while averaging a team-best 14.8 points and 3.2 assists. He is averaging 15.4 points and 4.4 assists over UC's last five games.
- » Eason, who has led UC in rebounds in 10 games this season, ranked among AAC leaders in blocks (sixth at 1.2), offensive rebounds (sixth at 2.1) and rebounds (11th at 5.6) entering the league tournament.
- » **Jeremiah Davenport** is averaging a team-best 16.3 points with a team-best 22.3-pointers over the last seven games. He ranked among the AAC leaders in 3-pointers per game (8th at 2.0), field goal percentage (11th at .464), 3-point field goal percentage (15th at .364) and points (17th at 11.6) entering the postseason.
- » **Mika Adams-Woods** has scored in double figures in each of the last five games, averaging 12.8 points while shooting 48.8 percent (20 of 41) from the floor with 19 assists.

## GAME PREVIEW

- » Fifth-seed Cincinnati (11-10) battles tournament top-seed Wichita State on Semifinals Saturday in the AAC Championship. Tipoff is 3 p.m. ET on ESPN2.
- » The Bearcats held off a rally from SMU for a 74-71 win in a quarterfinals matchup Friday. Four UC players scored in double figures led by Jeremiah Davenport, who tallied 19 points with a career-high five 3-pointers to go with seven rebounds and four steals.
- » Wichita State rallied for a 68-67 win over USF in the quarterfinals on Friday. Tyson Etienne led the Shockers with 20 points, four 3-pointers, five rebounds and three assists.
- » The winner will face the victor of the other semifinals contest between Houston and Memphis on Sunday. The championship game will tipoff at 3:15 p.m. ET on ESPN.

## SERIES VS. WICHITA STATE

- » UC leads its series with Wichita State 24-13 overall, 1-0 at neutral sites, 13-4 in Cincinnati and 10-9 in Wichita, Kan.,
- » Wichita State claimed an 82-76 win in Kansas on Jan. 27, snapping Cincinnati's six-game win streak in the series and three-game win streak at Charles Koch Arena.
- » UC defeated Wichita State 66-63 in the semifinals of the 2019 AAC Championship en route to winning the tournament title.
- » The Bearcats' most notable win at Wichita State since the Shockers joined the AAC came when No. 8 Cincinnati edged No. 11 Wichita State 62-61 on Mar. 4, 2018 to claim the 2018 AAC regular-season title outright.
- » During the 2018 campaign, then-No. 19 Wichita State snapped then-No. 5 Cincinnati's 39-game home win streak (longest in the nation at the time), posting a 76-72 on Feb. 18, 2018 at BBGT Arena in Highland Heights, Ky.
- » Cincinnati posted a 16-10 mark against Wichita State from 1957-58 through 1969-70 during the Bearcats' membership in the Missouri Valley Conference.
- » During its 13 seasons in the MVC, Cincinnati posted a 286-76 overall record, 128-52 conference mark, won seven league championships, advanced to five consecutive Final Fours (1959-63) and claimed two national titles (1961 and 1962).

## EARLIER THIS SEASON VS. WICHITA STATE

- » **WICHITA STATE 82, CINCINNATI 76 - Jan. 10, 2021**
- » WICHITA, Kan. – Kansas native Zach Harvey scored a career-high 19 points, including 12 in the first half, but Cincinnati couldn't keep pace with Wichita State, falling 82-76 Sunday at Charles Koch Arena.
- » Leading 30-29 at the half, the Shockers shot 58.6 percent (17 of 29) in the final 20 minutes, scoring 52 points.
- » UC (3-7, 1-4 American) went more than eight minutes without a basket after Jeremiah Davenport scored inside to give the Bearcats a 42-41 lead with 13:43 left. Wichita State (7-3, 3-1) built a 64-49 lead on a 24-7 run during the pivotal stretch while UC missed seven shots and converted 7 of 12 free throws.
- » Ricky Council IV scored 11 of his career-high 23 points for the Shockers during the spurt while Tyson Etienne tallied 10 of his 16 points during the run. Morris Udeze matched a career-high with 18 points.
- » UC continued to battle, chipping away at a 65-49 deficit with 5:35 left, to pull within six before time expired.
- » Harvey finished 7 of 10 from the field, making all four of his 3-point attempts for the Bearcats. Keith Williams

scored 11 of his 14 points after intermission. David DeJulius contributed 12 points, seven assists and six rebounds.

- » UC struggled to take care of the ball, committing 15 miscues that Wichita State converted into 28 points.
- » The Bearcats' loss snapped a six-game win streak in the series, including three straight in Wichita, Kan.

## WILLIAMS NAMED SECOND-TEAM ALL-AAC

- » Senior guard Keith Williams has been named to the American Athletic Conference Second Team according to the league's coaches.
- » The Brooklyn, New York, native becomes the 10th Bearcat to receive AAC First or Second Team recognition since the league formed prior to the 2013-14 campaign.
- » Williams, who averages 15.0 points, 4.1 rebounds, 2.4 assists, and 1.2 steals in 2020-21, has led the Bearcats in scoring in 11 games and has scored 10 or more points in 15 of UC's 20 contests.
- » The Bearcats have won seven of their last 10 games since returning from a 25-day layoff due to COVID-19 protocols. Williams has played a key role in UC's resurgence, leading the team in scoring in five games while averaging a team-best 14.9 points and 2.9 assists. He is averaging 17.4 points and 4.4 assists over UC's last five games.
- » Williams enters the postseason ranked among league leaders in points (sixth at 14.9), blocks (tied for 12th at 0.8) and steals (tied for 15th at 1.2).
- » A two-time AAC Weekly Honor Roll selection this season, Williams became the 54th member of UC's 1,000-point club at Tulane (Feb. 7) with a game-high 20 points against the Green Wave. He enters the postseason with 1,125 career points, ranking 37th in school history.
- » The gifted scorer has registered four 20-point game in 2020-21, including a career-high 27 points on 10-of-17 shooting against Furman (Dec. 9). He tallied 24 points with six assists at Tulsa on Feb. 24. He posted his first career double-double with a team-high 19 points and game-best 10 rebounds against UCF (Dec. 22).

## EASON NAMED TO AAC ALL-FRESHMAN TEAM

- » Forward Tari Eason has been named to the American Athletic Conference All-Freshman Team according to the league's coaches.
- » Eason becomes the third Bearcat named to the AAC's All-Freshman team since the league formed prior to 2013-14, joining Gary Clark (2015) and Jarron Cumberland (2017).
- » Eason, who has led UC in rebounds in nine games this season, averages 7.2 points and 5.6 rebounds while shooting 49.2 percent (58 of 118) from the floor entering the postseason.
- » The native of Seattle, Washington, ranks among AAC leaders in blocks (sixth at 1.2), offensive rebounds (sixth at 2.1) and rebounds (11th at 5.6) this season.
- » In league games only Eason's impact has been even greater. He ranks among the AAC's best in field goal percentage (fifth at .512), blocks (fifth at 1.2), offensive rebounds (fifth at 2.3), rebounds (ninth at 5.8) and steals (tied for 13th at 1.2) against conference foes.
- » Eason posted his first collegiate double-double against Tulane (Feb. 26) with a season-high 20 points and season-high 13 rebounds to go with three blocks. He finished 8 of 8 from the field with a 3-pointer. He had 14 points with five rebounds and a season-high four blocks at SMU (Jan. 7).

## GOING FOR THIRD TOURNEY TITLE

### IN A ROW, AGAIN

- » A year after the 2020 AAC Championship was canceled due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, Cincinnati continues to look to defend back-to-back AAC Tournament championships this weekend in Fort Worth, Texas. The Bearcats defeated Houston in the championship game at each of the last two events, posting a 69-57 victory at the FedEx Forum in Memphis, Tenn., in 2019 and outlasting the Cougars, 56-55, at the Amway Center in Orlando, Fla., to claim the event in 2018.
- » In fact, the Bearcats have played in the last three league tournament championship games, falling to SMU, 71-56, in 2017 at the XL Center in Hartford, Conn.
- » In all, UC has won two AAC Tournament titles, played in three tournament championship games and advanced to the semifinals four times in the six-year history of the event.
- » **UPDATE:** Cincinnati owns a 10-4 record all-time at the AAC Tournament, having won seven in a row and nine of the last 10. Bearcats opponents at the event have included UCF (1-0), UConn (1-3), Houston (2-0), Memphis (1-0), SMU (3-1), Tulsa (1-0) and Wichita State (1-0).
- » The school record for most consecutive league tournament titles is five when the Bearcats won the Great Midwest Conference tournament crown during all four years of the league (1992-95) before winning the 1996 Conference USA tournament title during their first year in the league.
- » UC has won 12 league tournament titles in its history: Metro Conference (two: 1976-77); Great Midwest Conference (four: 1992-95); Conference USA (four: 1996, 1998, 2002, 2004) and AAC (two: 2018-19).

## BEARCATS TIP-INS

- » **DAVENPORT OVER LAST SEVEN GAMES:** Sophomore guard Jeremiah Davenport is averaging a team-best 16.3 points with a team-best 22 3-pointers over the last seven games. For the season, he ranks second on the team, averaging 12.0 points to go with 5.0 rebounds. He's shooting 47.2 percent (91 of 193) from the floor with a team-best 44 3-pointers.
- » Davenport entered the AAC tournament ranked among the AAC leaders in 3-pointers per game (8th at 2.0), field goal percentage (11th at .464), 3-point field goal percentage (15th at .364) and points (17th at 11.6).
- » He was named to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll last week, averaging 16.7 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.3 assists while shooting 56.3 percent (18 of 32) from the field and 50 percent (9 of 18) from 3-point range.
- » He tallied a career-high 27 points on 10-of-16 shooting with four triples and five assists against Tulane (2/26) and posted 14 points with four threes and seven rebounds at Tulsa (2/24).
- » In his first career start against SMU (1/7), Davenport posted his first career double-double with 18 points and a career-best 10 rebounds while hitting a trio of 3-pointers.
- » **ADAMS-WOODS' LAST FIVE GAMES:** UC sophomore guard Mika Adams-Woods has scored in double figures in each of the last five games, averaging 12.8 points while shooting 48.8 percent (20 of 41) from the floor with 19 assists. He matched a career-high with 16 points against Tulane (2/26) and Vanderbilt (3/4).
- » He was named to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll on Feb. 15. He averaged a team-best 12.5 points during the week while shooting 50 percent from both the field (8 of 16) and 3-point range (5 of 10) and averaging 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals two weeks ago helping UC to a pair of wins.
- » **COVID-19 CHALLENGES:** It's been a challenging year for all college basketball programs. Here's a look at some of the ways the COVID-19 pandemic has affected Cincinnati.
- » UC finished the regular season with eight scholarship players. Four players have opted out of the program, most recently David DeJulius on Feb. 25.
- » The Bearcats had six games postponed (one of which was rescheduled) from Jan. 13 through Jan. 30, marking a 25-day layoff between games.

- » UC played four games in eight days after the Tulane game was rescheduled from Jan. 16 to Feb. 26.
- » UC added Vanderbilt to its schedule last week after COVID-19 protocols prevented SMU from playing the Bearcats on Thursday.
- » The Bearcats recently came off a stretch of six of eight games on the road before their current three-game homestand. UC's game with Temple (2/12) marked its first home game since a 70-66 loss to Tulsa (1/2) - a span of 41 days.
- » **SAUNDERS BIG DAY:** Freshman Mike Saunders Jr. poured in a career-high 19 points on 6-of-8 shooting with a pair of three against Memphis (2/28). He has started eight games since the start of February.
- » **DEJULIUS RETURNS:** Junior transfer David DeJulius returned to the team and played eight minutes Friday vs. SMU in his first action back since opting out on Feb. 25.
- » A valuable part of the team prior to his departure, DeJulius still ranks among the AAC's leaders in six categories: assists (2nd at 4.6), assist-to-turnover ratio (2nd at 2.3), defensive rebounds (T5th at 4.8), minutes played (10th at 31.8), rebounding (17th at 5.1) and points (23rd at 10.0).
- » He poured in a career-high 26 points on 10-of-18 shooting with four 3-pointers and three steals at Temple (2/4) and contributed 12 points, seven rebounds and four assists at Tulane (2/7) en route to earning AAC Weekly Honor Roll (2/8) accolades.
- » He also was named to the AAC Weekly Honor Roll on Dec. 14 after posting 11 points and seven assists at then-No. 12 Tennessee.
- » He nearly recorded a double-double at SMU (1/7), grabbing a career-high nine rebounds and handing out a career-high 12 assists with three turnovers.
- » The 12 assists were the most by a Bearcat since Steve Logan dished out a school-record 16 assists vs. Coppin State during the 2001-02 campaign. DeJulius becomes only the sixth Bearcat in school history to record 12 or more assists in a game.
- » **BLOCKS BY VOGT:** Senior center Chris Vogt recorded a career-high six blocks vs. Temple (2/12). It marked the most blocks by a Bearcat since Octavius Ellis had six blocks at UConn on Jan. 10, 2015. He enters the postseason ranked sixth in the league with 1.0 blocks per game.
- » **AMONG GREATEST PROGRAMS EVER:** Matt Norlander of CBSSports.com ranked Cincinnati 10th in a ranking of the 68 greatest college basketball programs since the advent of the NCAA Tournament in 1939.
- » The Top 25 ranking, which was announced on Nov. 19, 2020, was based on wins and losses, NCAA Tournament success, conference dominance, NIT titles and the cultivation of NBA talent.
- » Entering this season, the Bearcats had compiled a 1542-765 record with 25 regular-season titles, 33 NCAA Tournament appearances, two national titles, six Final Four appearances, 434 weeks nationally ranked and 39 Top-60 NBA picks since 1938-39.
- » UC's ranking places the Bearcats ahead of 70 of 79 programs who are current members of the ACC, BIG EAST, BIG 12, Big Ten, PAC-12 and SEC.
- » The Top 10 listing: 1. Kentucky; 2. North Carolina; 3. Duke; 4. UCLA; 5. Kansas; 6. Louisville; 7. Indiana; 8. UConn; 9. Villanova; 10. Cincinnati.

## CINCINNATI'S LAST GAME:

- » **CINCINNATI 74, SMU 71 - MAR. 11, 2021**
- » FORT WORTH, Texas - Four players scored in double figures led by Jeremiah Davenport who tallied 19 points with five 3-pointers, seven rebounds and four steals as Cincinnati outlasted SMU 74-71 in a quarterfinal action at the AAC Championship on Friday at Dickies Arena.
- » Fifth-seed UC advances to play top-seed Wichita State on Saturday at 3 pm ET on ESPN2. The Shockers rallied for a 68-67 win over USF earlier Friday.
- » The Bearcats led SMU 30-23 at halftime thanks in part to eight points from Davenport. UC grew its lead to 61-41 with 6:02 left following a pair of free throws by Mika Adams-Woods.
- » However, Kendrick Davis helped SMU mount a near comeback, scoring 19 points during a 30-13 Mustangs' run that ended up three points shy of tying the game.
- » In all, Davis finished with a game-high 35 points on 9 of 17 shooting from the field and 13 of 17 shooting from the free-throw line with four 3-pointers.
- » Keith Williams finished with 14 points and six assists for the Bearcats. Mike Saunders Jr. posted 12 points on 5 of 6 shooting with six rebounds. Adams-Woods added 10 points on a pair of threes and four assists. Tari Eason contributed nine points and seven rebounds.
- » UC finished with 19 assists on 23 made baskets, recorded 11 steals and shot 44.2 percent from the field.
- » The result marks UC's seventh consecutive win at the AAC tournament. The Bearcats entered the event as the two-time defending champion, claiming back-to-back tournament titles in 2018 and 2019. The last time UC lost in an AAC tournament game came via a 71-56 setback to SMU in the 2017 title game.

## BEARCATS IN THE AAC

- » UC's road win at SMU (1/7) marked the Bearcats' 100th AAC victory. UC has won more AAC games than any other league member since the conference formed prior to the 2013-14 campaign.
- » The UC men's basketball program has been a member of nine leagues (not including three stints as an independent) during its 120-year history. The Bearcats have 100 or more conference wins in two other leagues: 128 in the Missouri Valley Conference (1957-58 through 1969-70) and 123 in Conference USA (1995-96 through 2004-05).
- » Cincinnati has claimed three AAC regular-season crowns (2014, 2018, 2020) and two AAC Tournament titles (2018, 2019) while winning an AAC-best 100 conference games.
- » Last season, UC head coach Brannen became the first UC coach since Tay Baker (Missouri Valley Conference) in 1966 to guide the Bearcats to a regular-season league crown in his first season at the helm.

### LAST SEASON LOOKBACK

- » **TEAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS:** Cincinnati (20-10, 13-5 American) earned a share of the 2020 American Athletic Conference men's basketball regular-season championship and received the top seed in the 2020 AAC Championship, March 12-15, at Dickies Arena in Fort Worth, Texas. The event was canceled due to COVID-19.
- » The Bearcats compiled a 13-5 league record, winning 10 of their final 13 conference games to share the regular-season crown with No. 2 seed Houston and No. 3 seed Tulsa.
- » UC extended its streak of 20-win campaigns to 10 consecutive seasons in 2019-20. It continued the longest streak since the Bob Huggins era when UC set a school record, winning 20 or more games for 11 consecutive seasons (1992-2002). It marked UC's 39th 20-win season.
- » Cincinnati led the nation, playing in seven overtime games in 2019-20. The number was also a school and AAC record.
- » UC also played in four consecutive overtime games at the end of February, tying for the NCAA record with Jacksonville (1982), Illinois State (1985) and Dayton (1988).
- » UC rallied from a deficit of 10 or more points for the win in six games in 2019-20, including each of its last two regular-season games.
- » **PLAYER ACCOMPLISHMENTS:** UC's **Jarron Cumberland** and **Trevon Scott** were named AAC First Team honorees as voted upon by the league's coaches.
- » Scott claimed AAC Defensive Player of the Year, the Most Improved Player and the Sportsmanship Award.
- » Jarron Cumberland finished his career as only the fourth Bearcat in school history to achieve 1,700 points and 400 assists for his career.
- » Scott became the first UC player to average a double-double in a season since Dwight Jones averaged 16.6 points and 10.1 rebounds in 1982-83.
- » Scott's 10.5 rebounds per game in 2019-20 were the most by a Bearcat since Pat Cummings averaged 11.3 rebounds during the 1978-79 campaign.

## CINCINNATI HEAD COACH JOHN BRANNEN

John Brannen made an immediate impression in Clifton in 2019-20, becoming the first Cincinnati head coach since 1966 to win a conference regular-season championship in his first season on the job, guiding the Bearcats to a share of the American Athletic Conference title.

The achievement seems to be a pattern for Brannen, who also won regular-season crowns his last two seasons across the Ohio River at Northern Kentucky (2018, 2019) before coming to Cincinnati.

The feat also puts Brannen in rare company nationally as one of only six active coaches to have won a conference regular-season crown in each of the past three seasons along with Gonzaga's Mark Few (eight consecutive West Coast Conference titles), Vermont's John Becker (four American East Conference titles), New Mexico State's Chris Jans (three Western Athletic Conference titles), Michigan State's Tom Izzo (three Big Ten Conference titles), and Murray State's Matt McMahon (three Ohio Valley Conference titles).

Brannen also became the fifth UC coach in history to win a regular-season conference title in his first year leading the program, joining Frank Rice (1929 - Buckeye Athletic Association), John Wiethe (1947 - Mid-American Conference), Ed Jucker (1961 - Missouri Valley Conference) and Tay Baker (1966 - Missouri Valley Conference).

Brannen, who was named UC's 27th head coach in program history on Apr. 14, 2019, had served as NKU's head coach since the 2015-2016 season, taking the Norse to unprecedented success as the school's athletics department underwent reclassification. Since earning active Division I status eligibility prior to the start of the 2016-17 season, the Norse men's basketball program has compiled a 72-30 overall record, making three consecutive postseason appearances (NCAA Tournament [2017, 2019], NIT [2018]), winning back-to-back Horizon League regular-season championships (2018, 2019) and claiming a pair of conference tournament titles (2017, 2019). No other school in the nation has enjoyed NKU's amount of success in its first three years with active status at the Division I level.

Brannen, whose coaching career spans 20 seasons, owns a 113-72 career record as head coach, including a 31-20 mark at Cincinnati. He registered an 81-51 ledger in four seasons at NKU and a 1-1 mark as Alabama's interim head coach at the end of the 2014-15 campaign.

The 2017 Horizon League Coach of the Year, Brannen led the Norse to a 24-11 record in 2016-17, the Horizon League Tournament title and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament in the school's first season of active status eligibility. NKU's win total was an improvement of 15 victories from the previous season, marking the third-best turnaround in the nation behind only UCLA and Minnesota.

Brannen guided NKU to a 22-10 mark, the Horizon League regular-season championship and an NIT appearance in 2017-18. NKU posted a Division I-era record 26 wins with eight losses in 2018-19, claiming the league regular-season championship and tournament title and its second NCAA Tournament appearance in three years.

Brannen's players earned 10 Horizon League postseason accolades at NKU, highlighted by Drew McDonald receiving league player of the year honors in 2019. NKU finished 2018-19 ranked 11th in the nation in both

total assists (592) and assists per game (16.9). The Norse also ranked nationally in field goal shooting percentage (27th at .478), scoring margin (28th at +9.6), assist-to-turnover ratio (32nd at 1.34), three-point shooting defense (34th at .314), rebound margin (43rd at +4.5) and scoring offense (44th at 78.5 points).

Brannen came to NKU after spending six seasons (2010-2015) at Alabama coaching under Anthony Grant, four as an assistant coach and two as the associate head coach. The Crimson Tide made four postseason appearances during his stay. Alabama finished as the runners up at the 2011 NIT, posting a 25-12 overall mark and winning the Southeastern Conference West Division title. The Crimson Tide made an NCAA Tournament appearance the following season and later advanced to the NIT quarterfinals in 2013 and the second round of the NIT in 2015. Brannen served as interim head coach for Alabama's two games in the 2015 NIT. While in Tuscaloosa, Brannen helped sign Alabama's 2011 recruiting class that ranked fifth in the nation according to Rivals.com.

Prior to Alabama, Brannen served as an assistant coach at VCU for three seasons (2007-09) under Anthony Grant, helping lead the Rams to three 20-win campaigns, two NCAA Tournament appearances (2007, 2009) and a showing in the NIT (2008). The 2007 squad posted a 28-7 mark, upsetting Duke in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Brannen helped recruit Larry Sanders, who later was drafted by Milwaukee as the 15th pick in the 2010 NBA draft and also helped recruit four of VCU's five starters on its 2011 Final Four team.

Brannen also was an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure (2004-06) for three seasons, Eastern Kentucky (2001-2003) for three seasons and Charleston for the 1999-2000 campaign.

A native of nearby Alexandria, Kentucky, Brannen attended Newport Central Catholic High School. He began his collegiate playing career at Morehead State before transferring to Marshall for his final two seasons, playing for head coaches Billy Donovan (1996) and Greg White (1997).

Brannen was a first team All-Southern Conference selection as a senior at Marshall in 1996-97 when he led the league in scoring, averaging 20.9 points. He scored 1,008 points in two seasons with the Thundering Herd and still ranks among the school's top 25 players in career free throw percentage (.777), career three-pointers made (14th at 135), career three-point shooting percentage (14th at .386), single-season scoring (12th with 605 points in 1996-97) and single-season scoring average (23rd with 20.9 points during 1996-97).

A Rhodes Scholar finalist, Brannen received scholarships from both the NCAA and Southern Conference. He earned a degree in business management from Marshall in 1997. He was inducted into the Marshall University Athletics Hall of Fame in September 2019.

Following his time at Marshall, Brannen played two seasons of professional basketball in Belgium's First Division before beginning his coaching career.

Brannen and his wife Lisa live in Northern Kentucky and are the proud parents of twin daughters, Jaylee and Katelyn.
