



Postgame Notes
Cincinnati at Colorado
Oct. 26, 2024 | Folsom Field

Team Notes

- Cincinnati's all-time record now stands at 667-611-50.
- UC's all-time record vs. Colorado falls to 0-2. The previous meeting was in 1972 in Boulder.
- Cincinnati had four captains pre-game: redshirt junior defensive tackle Dontay Corleone, redshirt senior safety Derrick Canteen, redshirt senior offensive lineman Gavin Gerhardt, and redshirt senior offensive lineman Luke Kandra.
- Former Cincinnati star defensive end and Super Bowl champion Derek Wolfe was among several alumni who attended the game, including All-America punter Kevin Huber.

Offensive Notes

- Redshirt sophomore quarterback Brendan Sorsby finished the night completing 16-of-30 passes for 180 yards and two touchdowns. It was his fifth game of the year with multiple touchdown passes. He also rushed for 48 yards on nine carries.
- Sorsby's 21-yard rush on 3rd-and-14 was his season-long, and it set up the Bearcats' second touchdown of the night.
- Sorsby's first quarter touchdown pass was his eighth first-quarter TD pass of the season. He has tossed eight touchdowns for 671 yards with two interceptions in the first quarter this season.
- Junior running back Evan Pryor's 40-yard catch in the first quarter was his career-long. He added his fifth rushing touchdown of the year in the second quarter.
- Senior running back Corey Kiner rushed for 94 yards, bringing his career total to 2,101. He moved into 12th place all-time in school history in career rushing, passing former Bearcat Steve Cowan (1969-71, 2,033 yards), Richard Hall (2002-04, 2,053), and Tion Green (2012-16, 2,072).
- Redshirt junior wide receiver Tony Johnson caught four passes for 54 yards and a touchdown, his third receiving score in his last four games.

- Redshirt junior tight end Joe Royer caught four passes for 50 yards and a TD. He now has 36 receptions on the season, nine away from tying Travis Kelce's single-season school record for receptions by a tight end (45, 2012).

Defensive Notes

- Redshirt junior linebacker Jake Golday led UC with a season-high 10 tackles.
- Sixth-year linebacker Jared Bartlett recorded a sack in the first quarter. He leads the Bearcats with 5.5 sacks this season.
- Cincinnati entered the game leading the Big 12 in forced fumbles with nine. UC forced two more fumbles on Saturday, plays recorded by redshirt sophomore linebacker Jonathan Thompson and redshirt senior wide receiver Evan Prater

Special Teams Notes

- Senior punter Mason Fletcher had a 52-yard punt in the first quarter, marking his seventh punt of 50 or more yards in 2024 and his 32nd punt of 50+ in his career. He punted three times for 135 yards (45.0 average).
- Fletcher's career average of 44.40 ranks behind only Cincinnati All-America punter and former Cincinnati Bengal Kevin Huber (45.47), who attended the game.
