CINCINNATI — The University of Cincinnati volleyball team will begin the 2023 season at home with the Tribute to #10 tournament, scheduled from Friday to Sunday inside Fifth Third Arena.

The Bearcats will host Alabama State, Xavier and Indiana State for the six-match, three-day tournament. Admission is free for all Cincinnati home matches.

The tribute match in which the program will honor and celebrate Stephanie Meinig-Rosfeld will take place on Saturday night when Cincinnati plays Xavier at 6 p.m. inside Fifth Third Arena.

Cincinnati's matches will be broadcast nationally on ESPN+ and all matches can be followed at StatBroadcast.

// SERIES HISTORY

- · Cincinnati and Alabama State have met once in program history. The Bearcats swept the Hornets in 1996.
- The Bearcats own a 27-13 all-time record against their crosstown rival Xavier. The two teams met a
 season ago, resulting in a five-set road loss for the Bearcats. Then-freshman Caroline Endres dished out
 a career-high 68 assists good for the sixth-most assists in a single match in program history since the
 implementation of rally scoring.
- Cincinnati is 6-2 all-time against Indiana State, with the last meeting coming in 2019. The Bearcats swept
 the Sycamores on Sept. 7 to win the 2019 Auto-Owners Insurance Spartan Invitational. Jordan Thompson
 had 10 kills on .409 hitting with 14 digs and three blocks.

// TRIBUTE TO #10

- UC announced on August 19, 2022 that its home tournament will be named Tribute to #10 in honor of former volleyball student-athlete and coach Stephanie Meinig-Rosfeld.
- Meinig-Rosfeld was a standout middle hitter for the Bearcats from 1997-00, who also served as an assistant coach for the program before passing away in 2004.
- A two-time First Team All-Conference USA selection, Meinig-Rosfeld still holds the C-USA record for total blocks (593). She also holds Cincinnati's record for most games played (502) and ranks second in program history in total blocks (593) and block assists (518).

// FOREIGN TOUR PAYS DIVIDENDS

- The Cincinnati volleyball program had the opportunity to take a 10-day foreign tour to Europe this summer with stops in Hungary, Slovenia, Croatia and Italy.
- The team trained and played local teams in each country along with sightseeing and experiencing the cultures of each location. The Bearcats competed against the Hungarian National Team, Nova KBM Branik (a Slovenian Club Team) and the Italian National Team.

// ALL EYES ON THE 'CATS

- Cincinnati volleyball will be showcased on ESPNU during the 2023 season as part of the Big 12's national television schedule. Cincinnati is set to host Houston for the nationally-televised contest on Sunday, Oct. 29.
 First serve is scheduled for 1 p.m. ET inside Fifth Third Arena.
- The league's national television schedule includes 12 volleyball matches across its television partners ESPN and FOX Sports.

// THIS IS VOLLEYBALL COUNTRY

- The Big 12 is one of only two leagues to have a team advance to the National Semifinals in three of the last four seasons (Baylor 2019, Texas 2020 & 2022). The conference joined the Big Ten as the only leagues last year to have five or more teams in the NCAA tournament and go undefeated in the opening round (5-0). The Big 12 finished the regular season with the highest RPI of any league.
 Four Big 12 schools are ranked in the AVCA/Taraflex Division I Preseason Coaches Poll. Texas is ranked No.
- Four Big 12 schools are ranked in the AVCA/Taraflex Division I Preseason Coaches Poll. Texas is ranked No.
 1 after winning the Big 12's fourth volleyball national championship a season ago. Baylor is No. 15, BYU is
 No. 17 and Houston is No. 19 to mark the first time since 2008 that the Big 12 has had four teams ranked
 inside the top 20 of the preseason poll. Kansas, UCF, TCU and lowa State received votes.

// STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- This season marks the first year that Cincinnati will compete in the Big 12. The Bearcats will face 11 teams
 that saw action in the 2022 postseason: nine NCAA Tournament teams and two National Invitational
 Volleyball Championship teams.
- Of the 21 opponents on the schedule, 14 finished inside the top-100 in the 2022 RPI rankings.

// RETURNING TALENT

- The Bearcats return nine letterwinners, including four starters, from a season ago.
- The roster features the return of all-conference selections Abby Walker and Carly Glendinning.
- Walker, a 6-foot-1 middle blocker, garnered her second consecutive Second Team All-Conference nod after averaging 2.51 kills and 0.82 blocks per set as a sophomore. The 2021 AAC Freshman of the Year started and played in every match (30) and set (112) last season.
- Glendinning, a 6-foot-2 outside hitter, averaged a team-best 2.97 kills per set to go along with 1.26 digs and 0.30 blocks per set in 2022. She registered 16 double-digit kill performances, including a stretch of eight straight to open conference play. She led the team in kills nine times as a true freshman.

// NEW KIDZ ON THE BLOCK

- Cincinnati welcomes eight newcomers to the 2023 roster, including five true freshmen and three transfers.
- UC's freshman class features Zeta Washington (Ponte Vedra, Fla.), Nina Horning (Lake Orion, Mich.), Lilian Entenmann (Columbus, Ohio), Vivian Campbell (Oswego, III.) and Kayla Hostetler (Hebron, Ky.).
- The Class of 2023 was ranked No. 21 by Prep Dig, marking the highest-rated recruiting class in
- program history. Transfers Carly Skrabak (Marquette), Jadyn Bauss (SMU) and Katelyn Lefler (Illinois State) also join the

- The 2023 roster features a trio of super seniors: Elissa Alcantara, Jadyn Bauss and Carly Skrabak.
- Alcantara enters her second year as a Bearcat. She will look to play a larger role on the right side this season after averaging 1.46 kills per set in 12 matches in 2022. She spent her first two years at Colorado before transferring to Florida Southwestern Community College for the 2021 season.
- Bauss, a six-foot outside hitter, joins the Bearcats from a familiar foe in SMU. She appeared in 98 career matches across 334 sets. She totaled 752 career matches across 334 sets. She totaled 732 kills, 899 digs, 80 aces, 66.5 blocks and 26 double-doubles in four years with the Mustangs. She was a two-time AAC weekly honor roll selection and finished fourth in the AAC in service aces (36) in
- Skrabak, a 5-foot-6 libero, will join the Bearcats as a graduate transfer in 2023. She spent the last three seasons at Marquette, playing in two straight NCAA Tournaments, including a Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2022. She has totaled 1,487 digs in her decorated career — good for 60th nationally amongst active career leaders in 2022.
- Last season, Skrabak was named BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Week three times, tabbed to the NCAA's top liberos list and earned a spot on the All-BIG EAST Championship Team.

THERE'S A NEW EGGLESTON IN TOWN

- Outside hitter Shaye Eggleston is back for the Bearcats after an impressive debut year in the Red
- Eggleston, who transferred from Alabama in spring 2022, averaged 2.12 kills, 2.45 digs and 0.31 aces per set in her first season with the Bearcats.
- She led the team in service aces (33) and doubledoubles (6) and was second in digs (269).
- Her sister Logan Eggleston spent the last five years at Big 12 foe Texas. Logan was named Big 12 Conference Player of the Year for the last three seasons and is a five-time All-Big 12 First-Team honoree. She led Texas to its third NCAA Championship title and was named the NCAA Championship Most Outstanding Player in 2022.

// FROM THE MUSIC CITY TO THE QUEEN CITY

- Former club teammates and high school competitors Carly Skrabak (Franklin, Tenn.) and Shaye Eggleston (Brentwood, Tenn.) will reunite to compete for the Bearcats this season. Both are expected to start and steady the backrow.
- The duo grew up 15 minutes from each other and played club for Tennessee Performance Volleyball Club.

LEFLER READY TO LEAD

- Lefler, a six-foot setter, joins the Bearcats from Illinois State where she appeared in 38 career matches across 139 sets. She totaled 1,005 assists, 287 digs, 70 kills and 28 aces in two years with the Redbirds.
- The Menomonee Falls, Wis., native appeared in 10 matches across 37 sets in 2022 before being sidelined with an injury for most of the season.
- Lefler brings NCAA Tournament experience to the Bearcats' roster. She was a member of the 2021 Missouri Valley Conference Championship Team that earned a berth to the NCAA Tournament.
- Her attributes as a player physicality, length, can be offensive, and, as Coach Alvey puts it, her ability to be a "leader of the team."

FRESHMAN STAR POWER

- Freshman Zeta Washington comes to UC as the highest-rated recruit in program history. She is the No. 6-ranked middle blocker and No. 31-ranked player in the Class of 2023, according to Prep Dig.
- A 6-foot-2 middle blocker, Washington led Ponte Vedra to back-to-back state titles in 2019-20 and headlined a team that posted a 51-game winning streak. She posted 313 kills in her senior season, as well as her junior and freshman years. She finished her high school career with 1,088 kills at a .504 kill percentage.
- Washington grew up around sports being that her father is former professional tennis player Mal Washington. He won four tournament championships on the ATP Tour and advanced to the men's singles final at Wimbledon in 1996.

// IT RUNS IN THE FAMILY

- Freshman Nina Horning, a 6-foot-5 outside hitter, is no stranger to collegiate volleyball. One of five in her family, three of her sisters have competed in the sport at the next level. Shannon played volleyball at Ashland, Sophie played volleyball at Saint Francis and Hannah played volleyball at Michigan State. Her mother, Deb Murdock, also competed in track & Field at Marquette.
- Horning is the No. 28-ranked outside hitter and No. 50-ranked player in the Class of 2023, according to Prep Dig. She was a two-time national champion for her club, Legacy Volleyball Club — the No. 1 team in Michigan and No. 3 team in the country. She was named a finalist for the 2022 Miss Volleyball Award in Michigan.
- Horning was a four-year varsity letterwinner at Lake Orion High School. She garnered First Team All-State recognition twice and was named an AVCA All-American. Her 1,930 kills set the high school's record.
