

Postgame Notes Cincinnati vs. TCU Nov. 30, 2024 | Nippert Stadium

Team Notes

- Cincinnati's all-time record now stands at 667-615-50.
- The Bearcats honored 28 seniors prior to Saturday's game: Trevor Adams, Jared Bartlett, Joey Beljan, Derrick Canteen, Brian Doneghy II, Landon Fickell, Mason Fletcher, Nathan Hawks, Xzavier Henderson, Jacob Hoying, Luke Kandra, Corey Kiner, Jamoi Mayes, Michael McCalmont, Mehki Miller, Josh Minkins, Nijal Mooney, Jayden Perry, Eric Phillips, Evan Prater, Caleb Schmitz, Francis Sherman, DJ Taylor, Dartanyan Tinsley, Darian Varner, Phillip Wilder, John Williams, and Brady Young.
- Cincinnati had four captains pre-game: redshirt junior defensive tackle Dontay
 Corleone, redshirt senior safety Derrick Canteen, redshirt senior offensive lineman
 Gavin Gerhardt, and redshirt senior offensive lineman Luke Kandra.

Offensive Notes

- With his third reception of the game, redshirt junior tight end Joe Royer broke Travis Kelce's single-season record for receptions by a tight end. It was Royer's 46th catch of the year, besting Kelce's 45 catches in 2012. He finished with seven on the day and 50 for the season.
- Corey Kiner eclipsed the 100 yards rushing for the third straight game and the sixth time this season, collecting 110 yards on 23 carries. He now has 13 career 100-yard rushing performances, which is tied for fifth all-time in school history with James Bettis (1978-81).
- Kiner's career total comes to 2,562 following Saturday's game, putting him in eighth place all-time in school history in career rushing. He passed James Bettis (2,498, 1978-81) to move into the eighth spot.
- Kiner's 46-yard rush in the second quarter tied for his longest of the season. His previous 46-yard run came at UCF on Oct. 12.
- Redshirt sophomore quarterback Brendan Sorsby's fourth-quarter rushing touchdown was his ninth of the season, which broke a four-way tie to move him into third place on UC's single-season QB rushing touchdown list. Tony Kapetanis (11,

- 1979) and Desmond Ridder (12, 2020) are the only quarterbacks in school history with more rushing touchdowns in a season.
- Sorsby's 93 rush yards were the second-most of his career, two weeks removed from 143 at lowa State.
- Sorsby ran for 351 yards over the final five games.

Defensive Notes

- Redshirt senior linebacker Jared Bartlett posted a career-high 10 tackles. He finished with a team-high 69 stops for the season.
- Freshman linebacker Montay Weedon earned his second-straight start. Last week, he became the fourth true freshman to start on defense for the Bearcats.
- Junior safety Trevon Gola-Callard's third-quarter interception was his first as a Bearcat and fifth of his career.
- Junior cornerback Jordan Robinson and freshman star Jiquan Sanks each had career-highs of six tackles.
