GAME AT A GLANCE

THE RUNDOWN

Cincinnati is off to its best start since the 2018-19 season, in which it won nine-straight games after a season-opening loss. The Bearcats made a statement this past week at the Hall of Fame Classic in Kansas City, dismantling No. 14 Illinois, 71-51, and nearly knocking off No. 12 Arkansas, 73-67, in a game it led with two minutes to play. The former was the team's largest over a ranked opponent since Georgetown on March 5, 2011 (69-47). UC trailed 23-8 but outscored the Illini 63-28 over the final 32 minutes.

David DeJulius earned All-Tournament honors after scoring 24 points (two from a career-high) in the title game. Mike Saunders Jr. came into his own as well, earning career-highs of 20 points and five assists in those consecutive nights off the bench. He was also 9-for-10 from the foul line in the Illinois game. He is 4-for-8 from deep after going 5-for-23 as a freshman last year, averaging 10.0 ppg compared to 3.5.


UC won its first four games, all at home, winning the turnover battle by an average of 5.0 per game. The Bearcats rank 33rd (and first in AAC) in three-point defense at 25.8 percent. They have held opponents to 17.2 percent the last four games. Mika Adams-Woods also remains in 19th and atop the league lead with a 4.25 assist/turnover ratio. The Bearcats' narrow defeat to Arkansas also marked their first time trailing in the second half and losing the rebounding battle on the season.

CINCINNATI TRADITION

Cincinnati, ranked the No. 9 basketball program all-time by CBS' Matt Norlander in 2019, boasts 1,848 all-time wins, good for No. 12 nationally. The Bearcats have produced 32 All-Americans (last: Jarron Cumberland in 2019), 86 All-Conference selections, 57 NBA Draft picks (last: Jacob Evans III in 2018) and 54 members of the 1,000-Point Club. The program has spent 434 weeks Ranked in the AP Top 25, 212 in the Top 10 and 45 at No. 1. Jack Twyman and Oscar Robertson are both members of the Basketball Hall of Fame, with Robertson earning a spot on the NBA's 75th-Anniversary Team this fall.

BEARCAT FAMILY RUNS DEEP

- » Wes Miller has made it a priority to connect several classes and generations of UC basketball alumni, a model which his alma mater, UNC prides itself.
- » DerMarr Johnson was hired as the Director of Player Development. He was the NBA's sixth-overall pick from the vaunted 1999-00 UC team that spent several weeks at No. 1. After an injury-shortened career, he served as a student assistant under Mick Cronin and completed his degree in 2019.
- » Kyle Washington is in his first year as a GA. He played his final two years at UC after transferring from N.C. State, helping the Bearcats to consecutive 30-win seasons for the first time ever (2016-18), averaging 12.1 ppg with 10 double-doubles.

BIG THREE

This past summer, Johnson and fellow alum James White took part in the Big3 league which was split among Las Vegas and New Orleans. White was a second-round pick of the Portland Trail Blazers in 2006 after scoring 1,088 points in three years as a Bearcat.

YOUNG, WILD AND FREE

Head coach Wes Miller enters the season as the nation's winningest coach under 40. His 185 wins rank ahead of LSU's Will Wade (177) and New Mexico's Richard Pitino (159).

BLOCK PARTY

Hayden Koval (337) and Abdul Ado (249) enter the season as the nation's top-two active shot blockers. Koval ranks 48th all-time. Abdul's 59.4-career field goal percentage ranked 22nd nationally as of the end of the 2020-21 season. More info is available on their player pages.

FAMILIAR FACES

Koval, Jarrett Hensley and A.J. McGinnis all came from UNCG, while John Newman III was committed as a transfer before ultimately following Miller to the Queen City. Cincinnati is the only team with three transfers from the same school. The former three also all played at Link Year Prep in Missouri.

AGE IS JUST A NUMBER

Abdul Ado (Oct. 10, 1997) and Hayden Koval (March 8, 1998) are the 10th and 12th oldest players in Division I. Cincinnati's average age of 21.56 heading into Opening Night ranks fourth behind Drake, Penn State and Chattanooga.

PRESEASON ALL-AAC

Jeremiah Davenport earned a second-team nod from the league this season. He also gained recognition on the AAC All-Tournament Team in 2021 after averaging 12.7 points and 6.0 rebounds to go with nine treys as the Bearcats stormed to the championship game. He collected 12 double-figure scoring games overall.

SAUNDERS' RECOGNITION

Sophomore guard Mike Saunders Jr. was named

to Jon Rothstein's 20 Under-The-Radar Breakout Players for the 2021-22 season. Noted things to watch were his "major burst on the open floor," and a key cog in rebuilding the program to begin the Wes Miller era.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

Davenport is one of four siblings in his family to play collegiate basketball. His mother played at Morehead State, while his brothers Michael (St. Bonaventure), Joshua (Winthrop) and sister Naomi (West Virginia) all played at the Division I level.

PUBLISHED AUTHOR

Few coaches, or anyone in particular, can say they published a book while in school. Wes Miller authored "The Road to Blue Heaven," a diary of his senior season as a Tar Heel.

THE JET SPEAKS TO THE TEAM

Two-time NBA champion and Emmy winner Kenny Smith (TNT's Inside the NBA) spoke to the team over Zoom on Oct. 25, offering advice on succeeding on and off the court. Smith and Wes Miller are members of the North Carolina Basketball family, and Smith even left Miller a voicemail during his playing days that served as inspiration.

FULL CIRCLE ON THE STAFF

C.B. McGrath, the special assistant to the head coach, was an assistant at North Carolina from 2003-17, spanning Miller's entire time as a player. McGrath, a former Kansas team captain, later served as UNC Wilmington's head coach from 2017-20.

ROBERTS RECOGNIZED

Assistant coach Mike Roberts was selected to participate in the TopConnect Basketball Virtual Symposium in August, a prestigious program that provides the nation's top assistant coaches with leadership development and networking opportunities. Roberts, one of 65 men's and women's coaches honored, was at Indiana the last two seasons after serving as Wes Miller's associate head coach at UNCG from 2011-19.

NCAA TOURNAMENT REGULARS

Cincinnati joins Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State, North Carolina, Michigan, Wisconsin, VCU as programs to make at least nine of the past 10 NCAA Tournaments.

EARLY LOOK AT 2022-23 ROSTER

Cincinnati signed three freshmen in the November signing period, reaching No. 27 in the 247Sports national rankings. The Bearcats inked Josh Reed (Atlanta, Ga.), Sage Tolentino (Kāne'ohe, Hawaii) and Daniel Skillings (Blackwood, N.J.). All three boast top-150 rankings as well.

GRIDIRON MEETS HARDWOOD

The Bearcats' 73-68 win over Georgia marked the first time the top-two teams in the AP's football poll met during the basketball seasons since Clemson played Alabama on Dec. 13, 2015. The Crimson Tide and Bulldogs did finish in the top-two in 2017 and of course met during the SEC hoops season.

STARTING OUT ON TOP

With the win over Presbyterian, Wes Miller became the third coach in program history (Tay Baker in 1965, Anthony Chez in 1902) to win his first four games at Cincinnati. The Bearcats' blowout win over Illinois allowed him to become the only one to ever start 5-0. Nine of UC's last 10 coaches have won their debuts.

RULING THE AAC

- » UC's road win at SMU (1/7) marked the Bearcats' 100th AAC victory. UC has won more AAC games than any other league member since the conference formed prior to the 2013-14 campaign.
- » The UC men's basketball program has been a member of nine leagues (not including three stints as an independent) during its 120-year history. The Bearcats have 100 or more conference wins in two other leagues: 128 in the Missouri Valley Conference (1957-58 through 1969-70) and 123 in Conference USA (1995-96 through 2004-05).
- » Cincinnati has claimed three AAC regular-season crowns (2014, 2018, 2020) and two AAC Tournament titles (2018, 2019) while winning an AAC-best 100 conference games.

LAST TIME OUT

KANSAS CITY — A hard-fought battle with No. 12 Arkansas fell the Razorbacks' way one too many times, and Cincinnati was defeated for the first time of the Wes Miller era in a 73-67 decision on Tuesday night in the Hall of Fame Classic championship game.

"The athleticism and ability to pursue the ball with Arkansas is a little bit different than what we saw the last few nights," Miller said. "They had 18 offensive rebounds, and our turnovers are the things that will stick out offensively, particularly those down the stretch, and you can lose a game by one or two possessions and those are the ones you'll think about."

David DeJulius finished with a season-high 24 points, besting his 21 against Alabama A&M (Nov. 16). It marked third 20-point game in two years as a Bearcat, and he earned All-Tournament Team honors as well.

Arkansas (5-0) earned three crucial offensive rebounds to eventually draw a foul with a 68-67 lead and 21.8 seconds remaining. After sinking a pair, a charge was called on the Bearcats with 9.6 ticks left.

Hayden Koval's triple from the top of the key tied it at 63 with 3:43 left and was his second of the night. After some traded baskets, DeJulius sank a pair of foul shots to regain a 67-66 advantage at 2:25.

Back-to-back incredible possessions by Mike Saunders Jr., the first a beautiful feed and reverse layup for Viktor Lakhin and the second a pull-up triple, gave Cincinnati a 54-53 lead just shy of the eight-minute mark. DeJulius' baseline floater rattled home to increase the lead to three by a 7:19 media stoppage.

Cincinnati missed seven of first eight shots but only trailed 8-4 after DeJulius lane floater. Abdul Ado's lay-in at 9:13 gave Cincinnati its first lead, 14-13.

The Bearcats led 30-26 at the half despite Mika Adams-Woods missing the final eight-plus minutes due to three personal fouls.

Ody Oguama's touch-shot down low in traffic put Cincinnati back ahead 40-38 at 14:29 and were his first points of the game. A Razorback layup at the 13-minute mark put them ahead 41-40, the Bearcats' first second-half deficit of the season, but DeJulius found Oguama for his second-straight bucket inside for another lead. DeJulius struck again with a step-back, transition triple in front of his bench at 11:38 to put UC ahead, 45-43, at the media timeout.

Cincinnati (5-1) returns home Saturday to host Monmouth at 2 p.m.

MONMOUTH SERIES HISTORY

- » It's the first meeting all-time between the schools.
- » Graduate-transfer forward Walker Miller is the younger brother of Cincinnati head coach Wes Miller.
- » There are 10 sibling vs. sibling games in Division I this season among eight overall matchups (the other two are conference home-and-homes). It is the only game featuring coach vs. player.
- » Head coach King Rice enters his 11th season at Monmouth, and like Miller, is a former captain at North Carolina. The four-year letterwinner under Dean Smith (1988-91) finished third on the school's all-time assists list and is a three-time MAAC Coach of the Year, in addition to John McLendon National Coach of the Year honors in 2016.



CINCINNATI HEAD COACH WES MILLER

Wes Miller was named the 28th University of Cincinnati men's basketball head coach on April 14, 2021.

Miller comes to UC after a decade as the head coach at UNC Greensboro.

Regarded as one of the top young coaches in college basketball, Miller built the Spartans into perennial championship and NCAA Tournament contenders, was named as ESPN.com's No. 1 Coach Under 40 in May 2020 and also was tabbed for The Athletic's 40 Under 40 list a year ago. His 185-career wins coming into the 2021-22 season also put him in the national lead for coaches under 40, ahead of LSU's Will Wade (177) and New Mexico's Richard Pitino (159).

"I am incredibly excited to welcome Wes into the Bearcats family," Cunningham said. "He is an extremely dynamic coach and mentor who impressed me with his drive, focus and attention to detail. He's a proven winner as a head coach and was able to rebuild a program and lead a remarkable turnaround at UNCG over the last decade. We cast a very wide net in this search and Wes emerged as the right coach to lead the Bearcats into the future."

"I'm absolutely thrilled to be the head coach at the University of Cincinnati," Miller said. "I'm thankful for President Pinto and [AD] John Cunningham for bringing me into the Bearcats family. I am honored to lead such a storied program and excited to get to work. I also can't thank UNCG enough because I wouldn't be here without my players and athletic director Kim Record. This last decade coaching the Spartans has been extremely rewarding."

Miller's collegiate head coach and mentor Roy Williams had high praise for his former player.

"Wes Miller is one of the most outstanding young coaches in our game and what he did at UNC- Greensboro makes me believe he is THE most outstanding," Williams said. "As a player at North Carolina he came closer to reaching his full potential than any player I've ever coached. His energy, his determination, his intelligence and his care for young people convinces me that he will continue at that level. I am so happy for him and the University of Cincinnati Basketball program and I look forward to being in the stands!"

AT UNCG

• The Spartans all-time winningest head coach, Miller totaled 185 wins in 10 seasons with four Southern Conference Regular-Season Championships. Over the last five years, UNCG has five-straight 20-win seasons, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two NIT appearances, two Southern Conference Tournament Championships, 125 wins and 70-20 record in conference play.

- UNCG won 21 games during the 2020-21 season along with the SoCon regular season and tournament championship and earned its second NCAA Tournament appearance in four years.
- The Spartans won 20 or more games in each of the last five seasons, including a program record 29 in 2018-19. Miller led UNCG to NCAA Tournament appearances in 2017-18 and 2020-21.

AS AN ASSISTANT COACH

- Miller, who also spent the 2010-11 season as an assistant coach at UNCG, also spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Elon and High Point. Miller also ran his own basketball camps in Charlotte and Greensboro for two summers.

PLAYING DAYS

- In three seasons as a player at North Carolina under Coach Williams, Miller helped the Tar Heels to the national championship in 2005, two Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships and one ACC Tournament title.
- He was team captain as a senior in 2006-07, leading UNC to 31 wins and the NCAA Elite 8 as well as the ACC regular-season and tournament titles, and a final No. 3 national ranking.
- A fan favorite at UNC, Miller authored a book entitled *The Road to Blue Heaven*, which was published as a diary of his experiences as a North Carolina basketball player.
