CINCINNATI – The University of Cincinnati volleyball team returns to Cincinnati for a pair of non-conference matches this week. The Bearcats will travel to rival Xavier on Thursday night for the Queen City Classic. First serve is scheduled for 6 p.m. inside the Cintas Center.

UC will then open the home portion of its schedule against Kent State at 1 p.m. on Saturday. The match will serve as Cincinnati's annual Tribute to #10.

SERIES HISTORY

- The Bearcats own a 27-14 all-time record against their crosstown rival Xavier. The two teams met a season ago, resulting in a four-set home loss for the Bearcats.
- Cincinnati will look to snap a two-match losing streak to Xavier. The Musketeers have won three of the last four meetings.

LAST TIME OUT

- Cincinnati went 2-1 at the Bellarmine Classic, picking up wins over IU Indy and Bellarmine. Abby Walker and Sydney Nolan earned All-Tournament accolades for their performances. Walker averaged 2.60 kills per set at a .435 clip while Nolan averaged 3.90 kills, 2.30 digs and 0.60 blocks per set.
- Faith Frame averaged 4.30 digs across 10 sets played. She posted a new season high of 18 digs against both UAB and Bellarmine.

IN THE RANKINGS

- The Bearcats lead the Big 12 and rank 17th in the nation in blocks per set (2.95).
- In the Big 12, Walker ranks fourth in blocking (1.32) and ninth in hitting percentage (.406).

FRESHMEN FILLING ROLES

- The Bearcats have a trio of freshmen playing key roles. Faith Frame has earned the libero jersey, while Fallon Stewart is starting as the outside hitter, with Lilly Gillespie coming in as a defensive specialist.
- Frame is averaging 3.79 digs per set while Stewart is fourth on the team in both kills (2.35) and digs per set (1.53).

INJURY BUG BITES BEARCATS

- The team has dealt with significant injury challenges over the past two seasons, and the 2024 campaign is no different, with Zeta Washington and Irbe Lazda both sidelined with injuries.
- In 2023, the Bearcats lost their two starting outside hitters prior to Big 12 play. In total, six Bearcats missed at least one match due to injury.
- Two seasons ago, the team was without its starting setter, and Ligia Williams suffered a season-ending injury after just six matches.

TRIBUTE TO #10

- UC announced on August 19, 2022 that its first home match(es) will be named Tribute to #10 in honor of former volleyball student-athlete and coach Stephanie Meinig-Rosfeld.
- Meinig-Rosfeld was a standout middle hitter for the Bearcats from 1997-00, who also served as an assistant coach for the program before passing away in 2004.
- A two-time First Team All-Conference USA selection, Meinig-Rosfeld still holds the C-USA record for total blocks (593). She also holds Cincinnati's record for most games played (502) and ranks second in program history in total blocks (593) and block assists (518).

MILESTONE WATCH

- Senior Abby Walker is 120 kills away from reaching 1,000 career kills.
- Fifth year Irbe Lazda needs 232 kills to reach 1,000 career kills.

BEST OF THE BEST WESTERN INVITE

- Seniors Abby Walker and Katelyn Lefler were named to the Best Western Invitational All-Tournament Team.
- Walker averaged a monster 2.22 blocks per set to go along with 3.00 kills per set at a .382 clip while Lefler averaged 9.11 assists, 1.44 digs and 1.00 block per set at the setter position
- Cincinnati's block was on full display, dominating the category with a plus-22 advantage (33-11). In its victory over BGSU, UC notched 15 blocks, which ranks fifth in the nation for a three-set match.
- Abby Walker posted a career-high nine blocks in wins against both BGSU and Chicago State, tying her for seventh in the nation for blocks in a three-set match.

250 FOR ALVEY

- Head coach Molly Alvey earned her 250th career win with a three-set victory over Chicago State on Aug. 31. She took Cincinnati to the NCAA Tournament in 2016 and 2018 before leading the Bearcats to one of the greatest seasons in school history in 2019. She guided the Bearcats to a first-ever Sweet 16 appearance in the NCAA Tournament and an American Athletic Conference regular season championship.

RETURNING TALENT

- Cincinnati returns 12 letterwinners, including four starters, from a season ago. The Bearcats bring back four of their top six point scorers, including Zeta Washington (3.44 pts/s) and Abby Walker (3.01 pts/s).
- Setter Katelyn Lefler returns at the setter position after dishing out 1,011 assists last season. She was the first Bearcat since 2019 to eclipse 1,000 assists in a single season.
- Cincinnati returns 78.8% of its blocking, 72.7% of its point-scoring and 70.8% of its kill production.

NEW 'CATZ ON THE BLOCK

- Cincinnati welcomes eight newcomers to the 2024 roster, including six true freshmen and two transfers.
- UC's freshman class features Janelle Green, Faith Frame, Fallon Stewart, Gretchen Sigman, Amanda Mack and Lilly Gillespie. The Class of 2024 was ranked No. 37 by Prep Dig, marking the second consecutive year with a top-40 recruiting class for the Bearcats.
- Transfers Sydney Nolan (UNC) and Irbe Lazda (Towson) also join the Bearcats.

IMPACT TRANSFERS POISED TO LEAD BEARCATS

- Transfers Irbe Lazda (Towson) and Sydney Nolan (UNC) bring a wealth of experience to the 2024 squad and will look to make an immediate impact on the court.
- Lazda, a 6-foot-3 right side, joins the Bearcats after an impressive three-season stint at Towson (2021-23), where she led the Tigers to two NCAA Tournaments. She will be using the NCAA's extra year of eligibility, having initially begun her collegiate career at UTEP (2019-20).
- Nolan, a 6-foot-4 outside hitter, arrives in Clifton after a standout freshman season at UNC. She earned ACC All-Freshman honors, led UNC with a .391 hitting percentage (7th in the ACC), and averaged 1.06 blocks per set. She will shift to the outside hitter position, a role she played in club.

BACK FOR MORE

- Named to the Big 12 All-Rookie Team, Zeta Washington made history as the first Bearcat to earn a yearly Big 12 volleyball honor. She led the Bearcats with a .316 hitting percentage and ranked second on the team in both kills (250) and blocks (88) in 2023.
- Washington posted 13 double-digit kill performances as a freshman, including 10 in conference play, and recorded five or more blocks in eight matches.
- One of her standout moments came in her collegiate debut, where she delivered a 25-kill performance (25k-2e-42a) in a four-set victory over Kennesaw State.

ABBY UNLEASHED

- Walker, a 6-foot-1 middle blocker, has been a cornerstone of the Bearcats' volleyball program, playing in every set over the last three seasons (333). She led the team in points (325), kills (260), and service aces (23), while also ranking second in hitting percentage (.277) and third in blocks (78) in 2023.
- Due to team injuries over the past two seasons, she has split her time between the right side and middle blocker positions.
- She was a two-time All-Conference selection in the American and named its Freshman of the Year in 2021.

QUEEN CITY CONNECTION

- Former high school teammates and best friends Sydney Nolan and Kayla Hostetler are set to reunite on the court as they compete for the Bearcats this season. The duo attended Notre Dame Academy in Northern Kentucky.
- Cincinnati natives Julie Wittekind and Lilly Gillespie played one season together at Turpin High School.
- All four athletes previously played club volleyball for NKVC.

IT RUNS IN THE FAMILY

- Nina Horning:** Three of her sisters have competed in collegiate volleyball
- Zeta Washington:** Father, Mal Washington, is former professional tennis player. Mother, Jennifer Carper, swam at the University of Arizona
- Janelle Green:** Father, Trent, was a quarterback in the NFL for 15 years. Brother TJ played football for Northwestern; brother Derek played football for SMU
- Lilian Entenmann:** Father played basketball at Stetson and professionally in Germany. Brother currently plays at Kent State
- Fallon Stewart:** Father played baseball at the Florida and continued his career with the Yankees while mother played basketball for UCF. Brother played volleyball at Purdue Fort Wayne
- Faith Frame:** Sister plays for Creighton softball
- Molly Harrison:** Sister plays volleyball at Tufts University, brother plays baseball for Miami (OH)
- Sydney Nolan:** Father played baseball at Findlay

TWO-TIME OLYMPIC MEDALIST

- Former University of Cincinnati volleyball standout Jordan Thompson claimed silver at the 2024 Paris Olympics. She became the first Bearcat to win an Olympic medal at multiple Games.
- She was also the second Bearcat to medal from the 2024 Paris Olympic Games, joining Annette Echikunwoke (silver, hammer throw).
- One particularly special moment occurred off the court in Paris when Thompson connected with her former college coach, Molly Alvey, before the team's final pool play match.

"I have a really close relationship with that whole coaching staff still, so to have Coach Molly come over and have time to share this experience with her, it meant a lot because she played a massive role in me getting to this point," Thompson said to NCAA.org. "To say that her impact was huge is an understatement. She helped me not only as a player, but as a person and growing into the woman that I am today. She had confidence for me when I didn't have it for myself and really pushed me because she saw the potential and so that meant the world to me. I feel like it's not just an amazing experience for me, but to share that with her I think is such a gift and I feel really honored."

OUR NEXT HALL OF FAMER

- Jordan Thompson was announced to the 2024 James P. Kelly UC Athletics Hall of Fame Class.
- The 2024 Class will officially be inducted on Friday, Sept. 20 at Fifth Third Arena. Thompson will return to campus that week and attend UC's match on Sept. 19 versus Morehead State.
- She earned the American Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year accolade in 2015 and followed that up as a three-time unanimous AAC Player of the Year in 2016, 2018 and 2019. She was the first volleyball player in AAC history to earn unanimous honors and receive the award three times. Thompson led Cincinnati to its best season in school history with a Sweet 16 appearance in 2019, collecting AVCA All-America First team honors.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS UNDER ALVEY

- Cincinnati received the American Volleyball Coaches Association Team Academic Award for the 10th consecutive year after compiling a 3.7224 GPA during the 2023-24 academic year.
- The team also earned the additional distinction of AVCA Team Academic Honor Roll, representing the top 20% of GPAs nationally by division.
- The award, initiated in the 1992-93 academic year, honors collegiate and high school volleyball teams that display excellence in the classroom by maintaining at least a 3.30 cumulative team GPA.

GLENDINNING'S DUAL IMPACT

- Glendinning continues to make impressive strides both on and off the court. As an industrial management major and a member of the Lindner Business Honors program, she is committed to excelling in her academic pursuits.
- This summer, Glendinning interned at Dayton Freight, gaining valuable insights into logistics and operations. She will also continue to work at Top Tier Lessons throughout the year.
- In summer 2022, she interned at Motz Group, the company who installed the new turf fields at UC.
- Glendinning earned the Jean Stephens Award this past spring, an honor given to student-athletes who exemplify the character and values of a past UC employee.

THIS IS VOLLEYBALL COUNTRY

- The Big 12 finished the 2023 season with five ranked teams, the most for the league since 2009 and tied for the most in Big 12 history.
- The Conference had seven teams selected to the 2024 Women's Volleyball Championship, the second time in the last three years the Big 12 has placed seven teams into the tournament.
- Four new teams join the Big 12 in Arizona State (preseason pick No. 3), Utah (preseason pick No. 9), Colorado (preseason pick No. 10), Arizona (preseason pick No. 12).

RECORD CROWDS FILL FIFTH THIRD

- Last season, Cincinnati broke its volleyball attendance record when 3,358 fans packed inside Fifth Third Arena for its rivalry match against Xavier.
- The Bearcats set a new school record with a total attendance of 19,123 and averaged 1,366 fans per game, ranking 53rd nationally.
- Additionally, UC achieved six new top-10 attendance records in 2023.
- Seventy-seven schools in Division I finished 2023 with an average attendance of more than 1,000. In 2022, 59 schools averaged 1,000 fans per game and in 2021, even with COVID protocols, 40 averaged more than 1,000.

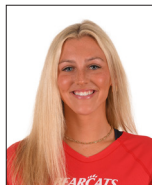

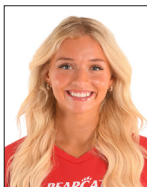

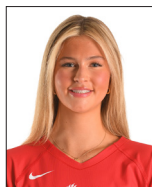
