2020: His 2020 campaign was one of his most successful, earning First-Team All-American Athletic Conference honors after toting the ball 144 times for 673 yards and seven scores along with 14 receptions for 202 yards and a pair of additional touchdowns ... ran for a season-high 184 yards and a TD against Houston ... set a career mark with a 72-yard dash vs. the Cougars ... his 184 yards against UH was UC's sixth-best, single-game total over the last 20 years and fifth-best yards per carry average (11.5) ... tallied three 100-yard games, going for 184 vs. Houston, 105 at SMU and 102 vs. USF ... hauled in a career-long 60-yard reception for a TD against Army West Point ... had a season-high four receptions for 64 yards and a TD in the opener against Austin Peay ... totaled four TDs against the Governors, three rushing and one receiving, earning AAC Honor Roll accolades

... earned his bachelor's degree in criminal justice in April 2020.

2019: Returned after missing 2018 and played in 12 games, rushing for 526 yards and five TDs ... his 5.3 yards per carry was tops among the three UC rushers with 100 or more carries ... also tallied eight receptions for 70 yards and a score ... totaled a season-best 123 yards on 13 carries with a TD against UConn ... carried a season-high 17 times for 91 yards and two TDs vs. Tulsa ... also had a 28-yard TD reception vs. the Golden Hurricane ... named to the 2019 AAC All-Academic Team.

2018: Missed the season due to an injury suffered in preseason practice.

2017: Led the team in rushing despite missing three games due to injury ... averaged 5.9 yards per carry, toting the ball 87 times for 513 yards and a pair of touchdowns... rushed for 70 or more yards three times and broke out with 149 yards on 17 carries at Tulane ... his 57-yard rush at Tulane, was UC's longest running play from scrimmage ... also hauled in 14 passes out of the backfield for 135 yards and a TD ... made his UC debut at Michigan with 25 yards rushing and 24 yards receiving ... hauled in a season-best 29-yard catch at Miami (OH) ... tallied his first career score on a nine-yard scamper at Navy ... scored the next week against Marshall ... had his first career receiving TD against UCF ... had his second best rushing total against SMU, finishing with 91 yards.

Played for Jed Richman at Lawrence Central in Indianapolis ... Recorded 2,953 career rushing yards, good for 6.9 per rush ... Averaged 140.6 rushing yards per game ... Scored 37 career rushing touchdowns ... Ran for 1,705 yards as a senior with 22 touchdowns ... Posted 1,242 yards during junior season, scoring 15 touchdowns ... Chose UC over Indiana, Ball State, Miami (Ohio), Toledo and Western Michigan.

2020: Started 10 games at safety, QBing a UC defense which led the American and ranked in the NCAA Top-15 in rushing, pass efficiency, scoring and total defense ... UC has forced a turnover in 20-straight games, the longest active streak in the NCAA FBS, and totaled AAC highs with 55 passes defended and 16 interceptions ... totaled 40 tackles, 1.0 for a loss and two interceptions ... his fourth-quarter pick at UCF led to the Bearcats go-ahead touchdown in a huge road win ... finished with seven tackles in the AAC Championship game vs. Tulsa and set a season high with nine stops against Georgia in the Peach Bowl.

2019: A 2019 First-Team All-American Athletic Conference selection ... was one of the leaders of UC's defense which led the American in scoring defense for the second-straight season and also forced an AAC best 25 turnovers ... led UC and ranked No. 7 in the league in tackles, averaging 7.6 per game and totaling 106 tackles and three interceptions in 14 starts ... finished with a career-high 16 tackles against UCF, reset his career high in tackles three times this year while finishing with seven or more stops in 10 games ... had a career-long, 38-yard interception return against UConn and was the AAC Defensive Player of the Week on Nov. 25. 2019.

2018: Started 12 games in the back of the defense, ranking among the team's Top-8 tacklers with 49 stops ... also added three passes defended, a fumble recovery vs. Ohio and an interception with a 23-yard return against Miami (OH) ... set a career best with seven tackles against Ohio and Tulane and had ... totaled four or more tackles in seven games ... hauled in his first career interception against Miami (OH) during a pelting rain storm ... returned the ball the to 1-yard line, being tackled just short of the end zone and setting up Michael Warren II's second rushing score ...finished the Ohio game with seven tackles and a fumble recovery ... had seven stops and a PBU against Tulane ... closed out the campaign with six stops a rainy Military Bowl vs. Virginia Tech.

2017: Played in all 12 games on special teams and as a reserve defensive back ... recorded five tackles ... had his first career tackle at Michigan ... set his career mark with two stops at Navy and at USF.

PRIOR TO UC: A three-star pick from 247Sports.com and Rivals.com who is regarded as one of the top players in Columbus ... Scout.com lists him as a two-star prospect ... Rivals ranked him as one of the top 45 players in the state of Ohio following the 2016 season ... was a second-team selection to the 2016 Associated Press All-Central District football team ... recorded 54 tackles, four interceptions, three forced fumbles, three passes defended and a fumble recovery as a senior ... also returned kicks, averaging 27.8 yards per return on six attempts ... was an offensive target, hauling in 224 receptions for 514 yards and eight TDs ... averaged 20.6 yards per reception ... tallied 53 tackles in his first two seasons as a varsity player for the Scots, along with five passes defended and a forced fumble ... coached by Byron Mattox ... also played basketball and ran track.


