Parking

Priority Parking is a pre-paid, season long parking pass for Lot K and is the only way to guarantee a place to park at Lincoln Financial Field. Owl Club and Graduate Owl Club* members are able to choose from the Cherry or White Lot based on giving level and priority rank. To join the Owl Club please call 215-204-CLUB (2582).

Cash Parking is available (\$20 for cars) on a first-come, first-served basis (pending availability) in Lot K, as well as in additional lots around the stadium. \$40 for oversized vehicles in additional lots around the stadium.

*All Temple alumni & fans under the age of 30 are eligible to become Graduate Owl Club members.

Temple Owl Club Tailgate Row

Join Owl Club members in an exclusive tailgate location for the 2018 Temple Football season! Tailgate row grants you access to a personalized reserved parking spot to tailgate in Lot K. To purchase a parking spot in this exclusive location, fans must be an Owl Club member at the MVP gift club level (\$2,500) and a 2018 Temple Football season ticket holder.

Temple University Alumni Association

Alumni Tailgate Village: It's free to visit Alumni Tailgate Village, but for the ultimate Temple tailgate, sign up for one (or all) of the Alumni Tent tailgate parties. Registration includes unlimited food, 2 drink tickets (plus cash bar), protection from the weather, comfortable seating, and special alumni giveaways. Tailgate Village opens 3 hours before kickoff.






NCAA COMPLIANCE

Responsibility of the Institution

Each institution shall comply with all applicable rules and regulations of the Association (NCAA) in the conduct of its intercollegiate athletics programs. It shall monitor its programs to assure compliance and to identify and report to the Association instances in which compliance has not been achieved. In any such instance, the institution shall cooperate fully with the Association and shall take appropriate corrective actions. Members of an institution's staff, student-athletes, and other individuals and groups representing the institution's athletics interests shall comply with the applicable Association rules, and the member institution shall be responsible for such compliance. [NCAA Constitution 2.8.1]

How Do You Know If You Are An Athletics Representative? You are considered a representative of athletics interested (i.e. Booster) if you are or have ever been a member of any group that supports or promotes the athletics program (e.g. Owl Club), or if you have helped in any way to recruit student-athletes. According to the NCAA, once an individual is identified as a representative of athletic interest, the individual retains that status for life. There are rules that govern your contract with prospective student-athletes (PSAs) and current student-athletes. Your actions can affect the eligibility of individual student-athletes or teams to compete in NCAA and conference competition.



Prospective Student-Athlete or Prospect: Any individual who has started taking classes for the ninth grade (seventh grade for Men's Basketball) *Making contact with a prospective student-athlete is in direct violation of NCAA recruiting standards and would jeopardize the eligibility of the prospect.

Extra Benefits: Includes the provision of any free or reduced meal, transportation, housing, clothes, service, entertainment, or other benefit not available to all students who are not athletes. *This means under no circumstances may you provide a prospect, recruit, or enrolled student athlete with any item of benefit – no matter how small the item may seem. Gifts of any kind are prohibited.

Any of the above actions constitute a violation of NCAA regulations. Such actions jeopardize the eligibility of prospective student-athletes and compromise the integrity of the athletic department.

TEMPLE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS OF ALL REPRESENTATIVES, AND RESERVES THE RIGHT TO WITHHOLD ANY BENEFIT OR PRIVELEGE ASSOCIATED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ATHLETICS.

Temple Owls Fan Code of Conduct

The Temple Athletic Department is committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for all fans, both inside Lincoln Financial Field and throughout the parking areas. In conjunction with the Philadelphia Eagles, staff members will proactively intervene to support an environment where our fans can enjoy the event experience free from the following behaviors:

- Abusive, foul or disruptive language and obscene gestures.
- · Intoxication or other signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption or other drug use
- · Fighting, taunting or threatening remarks or gestures.
- · Throwing objects of any kind
- Sitting in a location other than the fan's ticketed seat.
- Displays of affection not appropriate in a public setting.
- · Obscene or indecent clothing.
- · Any disruption to the progress of the event by fans actions.
- Any behavior which otherwise interferes with other fans enjoyment of the game.

Each fan should hold his or her ticket and be ready to display it to event staff or stadium security to verify their seat location. Violations of the Code of Conduct may result in the Guest being ejected, arrested by police or having his/her tickets revoked. All Season Ticket Members are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their Guests and/or persons using their tickets.

TEMPLE FOOTBALL GAME DAY EXPERIENCE

Tickets

Remote Ticket Office: The box office at Lincoln Financial Field is located at the Xfinity Gate. The Remote Ticket Office is open two (2) hours prior to kickoff through the start of the third quarter.

Re-Entry Policy: There is no re-entry at Lincoln Financial Field.

Game Day Ticket Issue: Fans with ticket issues should go to the General Public Will Call located at the Remote Ticket Office next to the Xfinity Gate at Lincoln Financial Field.

Will Call Locations:

- Public Will Call: Located at the Remote Ticket Office at the Xfinity Gate and opens (2) two hours prior to game.
 A photo I.D. is required to pick up tickets. Tickets must be picked up by the account holder who ordered the tickets.
- Temple Player Guest Entrance: Located at Tork Club & Suite Entry on the northeast side of the stadium and opens 90 minutes prior to game.
- Non-Football Recruits: Located at Tork Club & Suite Entry on the northeast side of the stadium and opens 90 minutes prior to game.
- Visiting Team Guest Entrance: Located at the West Sales Ticket Window by the Verizon Wireless Gate and opens 90 minutes prior to game time.
- High School Team Guest Entrance: Located at West Sales Ticket Window by the Verizon Wireless Gate on the southwest side of the stadium and opens 90 minutes prior to game time.
- High School Coach Entrance: Located at West Sales
 Ticket Window by the Verizon Wireless Gate on the
 southwest side of the stadium and opens 90 minutes
 prior to game time.
- Temple Student & Student Guest Entrance: Located at the South Gate and opens 90 minutes prior to game.
 Temple Students may pick up their ticket using their
 Temple I.D. at the West VIP Ticket Window. Student
 Guests tickets can be purchased for \$10 at the South
 Gate for the student section.

Guest Services

Stadium Gates: Stadium gates open 90 minutes prior to game.

Security: Fans are encouraged to report issues and concerns by contacting nearby event staff or security personnel. Call the In-Stadium Hotline at (267) 570-4444. Texting to 78247 then the word ASSIST<space> followed by your issue and location.

Bag Policy: All fans in attendance may be subjected to increased security measures when entering the stadium. Please plan to arrive earlier than normal for the game, as enhanced security measures may delay access to the stadium. Continuing this season, the clear bag policy will be in place at Lincoln Financial Field which will limit the size and type of bags that may be brought into stadiums. Game Day Programs: Programs are free. Programs can be picked up, while supplies last, at the Temple Bookstore Merchandise Tables on the Concourse behind section 120.


