PENN STATE WELCOMES CINCINNATI

Penn State women's basketball hosts Cincinnati for the teams' first meeting in program history on Friday, Nov. 7. The Lady Lions will honor members of the armed forces in their Military Appreciation Game.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State defeated Bucknell in its season opener 83-55 to remain undefeated against the Bison and improve to a 51-13 record in season openers.
- » Kiyomi McMiller and Gracie Merkle guided the Lady Lions, each contributing 24-point performances. McMiller was effective in all aspects of her first Lady Lion outing, combining for seven assists, six rebounds and four steals to go with her 19th career double figure scoring performance. Merkle was the most efficient Lady Lion in terms of shooting percentage, racking in 11-of-13 shots from the field.
- » As a team, Penn State showed relentless defense, forcing 21 turnovers and converting 27 points off of those mis-cues. The team also compiled 14 steals, their most since Nov. 21, 2024 against Marshall.
- » Offensively, the Lady Lions produced 54 points in the paint to outscore the Bison 54-22 in that category while shooting at a 53.6 mark from the field.
- » Every player that touched the court for PSU scored at least two points with four freshmen making their collegiate debuts in Nyla McFadden, Shayla Smith, Viktoria Ranišavljević and Rachael Okokoh. Both transfers also made their first Lady Lions appearances with McMiller and Amiya Evans contributing meaningful minutes.

2024-25 IN REVIEW

- » Penn State finished the 2024-25 campaign with a 10-19 overall record and a 1-17 Big Ten conference record.
- » The Lady Lions concluded last year's campaign with a loss on the road at Rutgers.
- » PSU recorded a win over no. 9 Ohio State on January 18, marking the team's first win over a top 10 opponent since defeating no. 8 Ohio State in 2012.
- » The Lady Lions set a program record for non-conference home wins, spanning over three seasons of 17-straight wins in the Bryce Jordan Center against out-of-conference opponents. Their win over Drexel last season marked the program record.

WHAT A WIN ON FRIDAY WOULD MEAN

- » A win over Cincinnati on Friday would move the Lady Lions to 2-0 to begin the 2025-26 campaign. It would also be the first win over Cincinnati in program history, with the teams never meeting before Friday's contest.
- » Penn State would move to 205-36 all-time in games played in Rec Hall with a win over the Bearcats.
- » A victory over Cincinnati would be the Lady Lions 1,023 win in program history.

LADY LIONS IN THE RANKS

- » Merkle finished the 2024-25 campaign ranked third in the nation and first in the conference in field goal percentage (.670). Among power 4 players, she ranked first in field goal percentage, 15th in double-doubles (13), 20th in rebounds per game (8.6) and 23rd in blocks per game.
- » After one game to kick off the 2025-26 campaign, Merkle sits 30th in field goal percentage (84.6) in the country.
- » Merkle and McMiller each produced 11 made field goals in their first performances which ranks ninth in the nation and first in the Big Ten in week one of the season.
- » Moriah Murray sat 21st in the nation in three pointers per game (2.63) and second in the BIG.
- » As a team, the Lady Lions ranked 14th in the nation in assists per game (17.7) and fifth in the Big Ten.

RAINING MURRAYS

- » Murray had an impactful second season in a Blue & White jersey, finishing the 2024-25 campaign averaging 10.4 points per game.
- » The Dunmore, Pa. native also combined for nearly 100 three pointers throughout the season (93), posting seven outings with five-plus shots made from long range.
- » Murray had a career high 28 points against Bucknell in the season opener last year, totaling eight threes to achieve the second largest single-game three-point total in program history.

MERKLE MANIA

- » Merkle led the team in scoring last season as the tallest-ever Lady Lion in school history standing at 6-6. She averaged 15.5 points per game throughout the 2024-25 campaign.
- » The redshirt-junior center posted double figure scoring in 23 out of 28 games she played in last year while notching 13 double-doubles including four in each of her last five performances in Big Ten play.
- » Merkle put up career numbers in PSU's overtime win against Drexel, scoring a personal PSU best 31 points and grabbing 11 rebounds.
- » The Mount Washington, Ky. native finished the campaign ranked third in the country in field goal percentage (.670)

and first in the conference.

- » Merkle is 74 points away from 1,000 career points and 16 rebounds away from 600 boards in her career.
- » She was named to the Lisa Leslie Center of the Year Watchlist ahead of the 2025-26 campaign, one of the Naismith Starting 5 honors awarded annually. Merkle joins 20 of the best women's basketball centers across the country on the prestigious list.

MCMILLER, MCTHRILLER

- » Sophomore transfer McMiller had a strong rookie campaign at Rutgers last season. She averaged 18.7 points 4.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game.
- » The Silver Spring, Md. native produced 18, 10-plus point outings, 10, 20-plus-point performances and had three games surpassing the 30-point mark.
- » McMiller collected a slew of awards throughout her first collegiate season including two Big Ten Freshman of the Week nods and a WSBWA Tamika Catchings Freshman of the Week honor. The sophomore guard also garnered All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honors as selected by the media.

TWO-SPORT PHENOM

- » Maggie Mendelson will join the Lady Lions in the 2025-26 campaign following the conclusion of the Penn State volleyball season.
- » She becomes Penn State's first two-sport athlete since Mac Hippenhammer played both football and baseball for the Nittany Lions in 2018-19.
- » The Lady Lions are no stranger to a dual volleyball-basketball player with head women's volleyball coach Katie Schumacher-Cawley playing for both teams in 2001-02.
- » Mendelson played both sports at her previous stop in Nebraska, where she averaged 2.0 points and 2.2 rebounds over 22 games with the Huskers basketball program.
- » In total, she has appeared in three NCAA Tournament runs on the women's volleyball side, including a National Championship chase with Penn State last season during which she averaged 1.05 kills/set and 0.90 block/set in six matches.

INTERNATIONAL FLARE

- » The Lady Lions have four international players on their 2025-26 roster, the most on a single roster in program history.
- » Vitória Santana returns as a senior for her second season with Penn State after playing for Brazil in 3x3 this past summer. She averaged 2.2 points and 1.9 rebounds per game in 2024-25.
- » Téa Cléante joins the Lady Lions from Dunkerque, France. She has played for the French national team since the U17 level and has helped her home country to two gold medals at the European Basketball Championships. In her most recent gold medal campaign, Cléante averaged 13.3 points, 3.7 assists and 1.4 rebounds per game, posting 16 points, seven assists and three steals in the championship contest.
- » Viktoria Ranisavljevic has played for the Swiss national team since she was 13 years old, while playing at the U16 level as one of the youngest players in her country to play for the FIBA U16 European Championship Division B squad. She av-

eraged 23.8 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game with the U20 Division B team in 2024. In 2025, she made her debut with the senior national team at the EuroBasket qualifiers and helped her team to their first European Championship since 1956.

- » Rachael Okokoh arrives in Happy Valley from Montreal, Quebec. She was a key contributor for the Canadian national team throughout her career. The forward played for Team Canada in the 2023 Americup and the Canadian U17 World Cup in 2024. She was also a consistent member of Team Ontario in the Canadian Provincial Championships.
- » Kiyomi McMiller also had the opportunity to represent her home country of Nicaragua this past summer in the 2025 FIBA COCABA Women's Championship. She helped her team to their first medal in 61 years, averaging 28.2 points, 6.2 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game in the bronze medal run.

HONEY, WE'RE HOME

- » The Penn State women's basketball team makes a more permanent return to Rec Hall after playing one-off games in each of the last two seasons.
- » The Lady Lions are set to play at least 11 contests in the historic venue throughout the 2025-26 campaign.
- » PSU holds a 204-36 record in games played in the building on Curtain Road after two losses in the previous two 'Return to Rec' games in 2024 and 2025.
- » After playing in Rec Hall in the AIAW Tournament in 1976 and then a handful of games the following season, the Lady Lions made Rec Hall their permanent home for the 1979-80 campaign until midway through the 1995-96 season.
- » Throughout its time in Rec, Penn State produced four undefeated home seasons.
- » The Lady Lions hold a 28-2 record against Big Ten opponents as a member of the conference in games held in Rec Hall.

TRANSFER TALK

- » Head Coach Kieger picked up two transfers in the portal this offseason.
- » Sophomore Kiyomi McMiller signed with the Lady Lions after playing her rookie season at Rutgers, where she averaged 18.7 points, 4.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists.
- » Kieger also brought on senior transfer Amiya Evans after playing three seasons at Georgia. Throughout her career, Evans averaged 2.3 points and 3.2 rebounds per game.

2025-26 FRESH FACE FRESHMEN

- » The Lady Lions introduce five freshmen to their roster for the 2025-26 season.
- » Penn State has three international freshmen in Téa Cléante, Viktoria Ranisavljevic and Rachael Okokoh join Penn State from France, Switzerland and Canada respectively.
- » Shayla Smith arrives in Happy Valley from Philadelphia, where she was the fastest player in the league to reach 1,000 career points, a record previously held by Dawn Staley of South Carolina. Smith totaled 2,666 throughout her four years, becoming the all-time leading scorer at Universal Audenried Charter and averaged double figure scoring all four years. She put forth a personal best 27.5 points per game in her senior campaign. The freshman guard was a two-time Public League Player of the Year. She also played for the 16U Philly Rise EYBL Championship team and earned a spot on first team 16U Nike EYBL in 2023.



NOTES AND HEADLINES

- » Nyla McFadden joins the Lady Lions from Fort Lauderdale, Fla. where she played for St. Thomas Aquinas. She helped her team to back-to-back state championships during her freshman and sophomore campaign. McFadden played her junior season at Mt. Zion Academy before returning to St. Thomas Aquinas for her senior campaign. The forward played travel basketball for Essence EYBL out of Florida.

2024-25 BIG POSTSEASON AWARDS

- » Gracie Merkle garnered All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honors at the conclusion of the 2024-25 campaign.



THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Cincinnati

- Cincinnati fell to Lehigh in its season opener on Tuesday, Nov. 4, 88-85. The Bearcats fought back from an early double-digit deficit to create 15 lead changes and five tie scores throughout the contest.
- Mya Perry led the squad in shooting, putting up 31 points on 11-of-17 shooting from the field including 6-of-8 from beyond the arc. Two other Bearcats posted double figure scoring performances: Reagan Jackson (21) and Caliyah DeVillasee (14).
- Last season, Cincinnati finished with a 15-14 overall record including 7-11 in Big 12 Conference action. The Bearcats finished their season losing to Arizona State in the Big 12 Tournament.
- Jackson is Cincinnati's lead returning scorer, averaging 9.2 points throughout the 2024-25 campaign.
- The Bearcats have eight newcomers on their roster highlighted by the no. 15 ranked freshman class in the country according to ESPN.
- Dee Alexander was recognized as the Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year and finished ranked no. 11 in ESPN's final rankings before suffering an ankle injury during preseason which will leave her out indefinitely.

- Penn State and Cincinnati have never faced one another in each program's history.
