Team and Series Records

- Cincinnati improves to 2-0 on the season while Georgia State falls to 0-2.
- The matchup was the second all-time meeting between the two schools. No. 2 seed Cincinnati earned a 68-53 victory over the No. 15 seed Panthers in the opening round of the 2018 NCAA Tournament at Bridgestone Arena in Nashville.

Team Notes

- Cincinnati held a 36-14 advantage in points in the paint, a 23-11 edge in points off turnovers and a 17-8 lead in fast-break points.
- The Bearcats led for 33:36 of the contest.
- Nine of 10 Bearcats who saw the floor scored.

Player Notes

Baba Miller

- With 24 points and 11 rebounds, Baba Miller became the first Bearcat with consecutive double-doubles since Dan Skillings did so March 26, 2024 and Nov. 4, 2024.
- Miller became the first Bearcat with back-to-back double-doubles to open a season since Bobby Brannen in 1997-98.
- Miller became the first Bearcat to record at least 24 points, 10 rebounds and three blocks in a game since Eric Hicks accomplished the feat against North Carolina A&T Dec. 30, 2005.
 - Cincinnati has had nine such games by four different players (Kenyon Martin recorded six 24-10-3 games) dating back to the 1996-97 season.
- Miller also connected on 88.9% (8-for-9) of his shots from the field. He's one of 10 players nationally in the last five seasons to go for at least 24 points, 10 boards, three blocks and eight made field goals on 88% or better shooting.
- Miller scored 17 of his points after halftime.

Day Day Thomas

- With 12 points, Day Day Thomas recorded his 30th career double-figure scoring game.

Moustapha Thiam

- Moustapha Thiam went for 10 points and nine boards, marking his 21st career double-figure scoring game.
- Thiam's three steals marked a career best.

Cincinnati Head Coach Wes Miller

- Cincinnati head coach Wes Miller improved his overall record to 269-194. Miller moved his record at the helm of the Bearcats to 84-59.
- The contest was his first game against Georgia State.
