Team and Series Records

- Cincinnati improves to 3-0 on the season while Dayton falls to 2-1.
- The matchup was 93rd all-time meeting between the two schools with Cincinnati improving to 62-31 overall and 39-12 at home.

Team Notes

- Cincinnati improves to 3-0 this season and 20-2 since the start of last season when leading at halftime.
- The Bearcats led for the final 39:44 of the contest after Shon Abaev opened the scoring.
- The game was the first victory for the Bearcats when turning the ball over at least 20 times since a 70-67 overtime win at East Carolina Feb. 16, 2020.
- The game marked the first time going back to at least the 1996-97 season the Bearcats won when committing at least 24 turnovers.
- Cincinnati limited Dayton to 7.7% (2-for-26) from deep. It marked the lowest 3-point percentage by a Cincinnati opponent since West Virginia shot 4.5% (1-for-22) in a 62-39 Bearcat victory Jan. 30, 2008

Player Notes

Kerr Kriisa

- Kriisa recorded a season-high eight assists.

Baba Miller

- Miller notched his 10th-career game with double-digit rebounds, including all three games this season.

Day Day Thomas

- Thomas scored a season-high 20 points, his sixth-career 20-point game.
- He notched his 31st-career double-figure scoring game.

- Thomas became the first Bearcat to go at least a perfect 12-for-12 from the free-throw line since David DeJulius went 12-for-12 against Houston Feb. 6, 2022. He became the fifth Bearcat to accomplish the feat dating back to the 1996-97 season.

Moustapha Thiam

- Thiam blocked four shots against the Flyers, his seventh-career game of at least four blocks and his first in a Cincinnati uniform.

Cincinnati Head Coach Wes Miller

- Cincinnati head coach Wes Miller improved his overall record to 270-194. Miller moved his record at the helm of the Bearcats to 85-59.
- Miller improves to 2-1 in his career against Dayton.
