Team and Series Records

- Cincinnati improves to 4-0 on the season while Mount St. Mary's falls to 1-3.
- The matchup just the second all-time meeting between the two schools. The Bearcats won the previous one, a 69-59 victory Nov. 15, 2010 in Fifth Third Arena.

Team Notes

- Cincinnati held a 21-0 advantage in points off turnovers, a 16-0 lead in fast-break points and a 34-18 edge in points in the paint.
- The Bearcats outscored the Mountaineers 42-19 after halftime.
- Mount St. Mary's started the game 7-for-13 from deep before going 3-for-14 the remainder of the game.
- Nine of 10 Bearcats to see the floor collected at least one rebound.
- Cincinnati trailed for just 5:29 of 120 minutes played in their previous three games this season, all
 coming in the first half against Georgia State. Mount St. Mary's more than quadrupled that, leading
 for 22:45 as the Bearcats were in front for 13:49.
- Dating back to the 1996-97 season, Cincinnati has had 38 occasions in which a player has gone for at least 13 points, 10 rebounds and four blocks. In that span, it has never had two players accomplish the stat line as Baba Miller and Moustapha Thiam did Sunday night. Miller and Thiam are the first pair of teammates to nationally record the stat line in the same game in at least the last five seasons.

Player Notes

Baba Miller

- Miller recorded his ninth-career double-double and third this season.
- Miller's four blocks marked a season high and tied his career-best set Dec. 10, 2024 against Jacksonville.
- Miller's 11 boards tied a season high.
- He's led the Bearcats in rebounding in all four contests this season.

- Thiam notched his third-career double-double and first in a Bearcats uniform.
- Thiam blocked four shots against the Mountaineers, his eighth-career game of at least four blocks and his second in a Cincinnati uniform. He blocked four shots against Dayton on Nov. 11.
- The contest was Thiam's sixth-career contest with double-figure rebounds.

Day Day Thomas

- Thomas notched his 32nd-career double-figure scoring game and third this season.
- The game marked the 10th time Thomas led the Bearcats in scoring and 25 time he led Cincinnati in assists.

Keyshuan Tillery

- Tillery poured in a career-high nine points.
- Tillery hauled in a personal-best three rebounds.

Cincinnati Head Coach Wes Miller

- Cincinnati head coach Wes Miller improved his overall record to 271-194. Miller moved his record at the helm of the Bearcats to 86-59.
- The contest marked Miller's first game coached against Mount St. Mary's.
