Team Notes

- Cincinnati's all-time record now stands at 674-619-50.
- Saturday's game was the fourth meeting all-time between Cincinnati and BYU and second as Big 12 foes.
- Twenty-two seniors were recognized prior to the game for Senior Day: Harris Adams, Cyrus Allen, Ben Blevins, Deondre Buford, Jeff Caldwell, Dontay Corleone, Jack Dingle, Gavin Gerhardt, Trevon Gola-Callard, Jake Golday, Patrick Gurd, Jalen Hunt, Rob Jackson, Brady Lichtenberg, CJ McCray, Matthew McDoom, Isaiah Rogers, Joe Royer, Stephen Rusnak, Tawee Walker, Xavier Williams, Logan Wilson.
- Cincinnati had four captains pre-game: redshirt senior defensive lineman Dontay Corleone, redshirt senior offensive lineman Gavin Gerhardt, redshirt junior quarterback Brendan Sorsby, and redshirt senior cornerback Logan Wilson.

Offensive Notes

- Redshirt junior Brendan Sorsby's 300 passing yards marked his third-such game of the season and fifth of his career.
- Sorsby, who was tied for the national lead with 18 first-half passing touchdowns entering the game, threw for another one on Saturday. In the first half vs. BYU, he was 10-of-17 for 117 yards and a TD.
- Senior Cyrus Allen's second-quarter touchdown reception was his 11th of the season, which ties him with Armon Binns and Mardy Gilyard for third-most receiving touchdowns in a season in school history. Allen also leads the Big 12 in touchdown receptions.
- Senior Jeff Caldwell's 19-yard touchdown catch from Sorsby in the fourth quarter was his fifth scoring grab of the season, second to Allen.
- Redshirt junior running back Evan Pryor missed the last two games due to injury. In his return to action, he had a 28-yard rush to contribute to the run game.
- Cincinnati went 3-for-4 on fourth-down conversions, entering the night as the nation's leader (13-of-15, 86.7 percent).

Defensive Notes

- Redshirt junior Christian Harrison (nine solo) and redshirt junior Antwan Peek Jr. each recorded a career-high 11 tackles.
- With his nine tackles, redshirt senior Jake Golday now has 102 on the season. He's the first Bearcat with 100-plus tackles since Ivan Pace Jr. logged 137 stops in 2022.
- Cincinnati held BYU quarterback Bear Bachmeier to 127 passing yards, his season-low against an FBS team.

Special Teams Notes

- Manny Covey's scoop and 57-yard punt return was a career-long.
