NOTABLE NOTES

CHASING WIN NO. 1

Canisius is still searching for its first win of the 2025-26 season after dropping its first six season-opening contests. A second half surge from Dayton on Friday night erased a seven point Canisius lead at halftime.

HEATING UP

Canisius tallied eight three pointers in last Friday's defeat at St. Bonaventure, marking the most field goals made in a single game since Mar. 6 2025 against Rider. Sophomore **Irene Rey Pineda** was perfect from behind the three point arc, cashing in on all three of her shots. As a team, the Golden Griffins went 47.1% (8-for-17) from three-point land.

LIMITING THE LONG BALL

The Golden Griffins have held their opponents to a 24.7 three point percentage through the first five games of the season. The Griffs' most effective night against the long ball came against Eastern Michigan, holding the Eagles to a 20.0% clip from behind the three point arc.

LIMITING TURNOVERS

Turnovers have plagued Canisius through the early parts of the season. The Blue and Gold have committed 20-or-more turnovers in four of their five games to start the season. The Griffs turned the ball over a season-low 18 times at St. Bonaventure last Friday.

Average bench points per game for Canisius in the 2024-25 season which ranked second in the conference. In Tuesday's contest at Syracuse, the bench scored a season-high 30 points.

Shariah Gailes scored 22 points on Tuesday, her largest single-game point total in her two seasons at Canisius. The figure ties her career-high set at IU Indy.





Canisius has qualified for the MAAC Tournament for 36 straight seasons, dating back to 1989-90.



Junior **Shariah Gailes** was named to the 2025-26 Preseason All-MAAC Third Team. Gailes led the Golden Griffins and ranked third among the conference last season in rebounds per game (8.1) and free throw percentage (77.2).

WHAT IS A GRIFFIN?

The Griffin is a mythical creature of supposed gigantic size that has the head, forelegs and wings of an eagle and the hindquarters, tail and ears of a lion. They are well known for their speed, ability to fly and having eyes like an eagle as well as the strength and courage of a lion.

Griffins have been known for centuries as symbols of strength and vigilance, have been called "The Hounds of Zeus" in Greek mythology and are said to have mastery of both the land and sky.

They are thought to be from India, where the natives of the land made their talons and claws into drinking cups because the talon of a Griffin was said to detect poison in a liquid. Griffins would find gold in the mountains and line their nests with it and as a result, were forced to become great guardians of the nests to keep the hunters away.

BUILDING OFF LAST YEAR

Head coach Tiffany Swoffard won 10 games in her first year at Canisius, including a 9-11 mark in MAAC play and a berth into the 2025 MAAC Championship, despite inheriting a roster that returned only 1% of its scoring from the previous season and being picked last in the MAAC Preseason Poll. The 2024-25 campaign was highlighted by a three-game win streak to end the regular season, solidifying a postseason opportunity.

BENCH PRODUCTION

Canisius is averaging 20.0 points per game from its bench to start off the 2025-26 campaign. Likewise, the Blue and Gold ranked second in the MAAC with 19.4 bench points per game last season. Head coach **Tiffany Swoffard** used more than 10 players in her rotation for 30 of the 31 games played throughout last season. To start this season, Swoffard has used 12-or-more players in each of the Griff's five games.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

Canisius ranked second among the conference in rebound margin last season. **Shariah Gailes** collected 234 total rebounds and **Yasmine Djibril** tallied 146 to lead the charge for the Blue and Gold. Both returning players also ranked in the top 25 among the MAAC in rebounding.

ALL ABOUT GROWTH

Player development remained a pillar of Coach Swoffard's coaching philosophy going into her second season. Senior **Franka Wittenberg** played the best season of her career, notching a 41.5% field goal percentage, 31.0% three-point field goal percentage (33.3% in conference play), and averaging 8.4 points per game and 2.5 assists per game. Wittenberg earned MAAC Player of the Week honors on December 29th. Junior Mary Copple saw significant increases as well, with doubledigit increases in field goal and three-point percentage from her freshman year. Last season, Copple ranked 11th in MAAC play in three-point field goal percentage (36.6%). Additionally, the 2024-25 season was impacted by forward and post player development under the direction of Swoffard. Shariah Gailes led the team in rebounding, ranking third in the MAAC in rebounds per game (8.1) and second in offensive rebounds per game (2.7). Gailes also ranked 15th in field goal percentage for the MAAC (44.1%), averaging 9.1 points per game for the Griffs. Gailes scored double-digit point totals 13 times and posted a team-high eight double-double performances in the 2024-25 season.

PLAYING DEFENSE

In their most recent matchup, Canisius held Cornell to 62 points, marking the lowest point total that the Golden Griffins have given up this season. Prior to Sunday's contest, the Griffs managed to hold St. Bonaventure to 66 points, a change in dynamic to the first three games where Canisius struggled to hold programs such as Michigan and Syracuse to under 90 points.

MAKING IT COUNT AT THE LINE

Despite the early season struggles, Canisius has been able to take advantage at the free throw line. The Golden Griffins converted all seven of their free throw attempts in Sunday's game against Cornell, marking the first time that the Griffs were perfect from the charity stripe since Jan. 9 2025 when Canisius went 14-for-14 at Rider. The Blue and Gold average 13.4 made free throws per game which ranks second among the conference. Last year, the Griffs placed seventh in the MAAC with 13.4 free throws made per game. Senior **Franka Wittenberg** has converted a team-best 81.3% (min. 10 attempts) from the stripe this season.

SCHEDULE BREAKDOWN

Canisius is scheduled to host 14 regular season contests inside the Koessler Athletic Center in the 2025-26 season, including 10 MAAC games and four non-conference matchups. The non-conference slate was highlighted by former Canisius head coach Sahar Nusseibeh's return to Buffalo when the Griffs hosted Eastern Michigan on Nov. 7. Other non-conference matchups that are still to be played include Mercyhurst and Wright State. Canisius opens up MAAC play on Dec. 19 when they host Siena. For the second-straight year, the MAAC schedule will be unbalanced. Each school in the 13-team league will play eight conference opponents twice (one at home, one on the road) and four other conference rivals one time, each. Per MAAC scheduling policy, each school is guaranteed to play its closest geographic opponent, but the rest of the opponents that a school plays only one time were chosen at random. For this season, Canisius will not host Marist or Merrimack, and the Griffs will not play road games at either Rider or Saint Peter's.

TRUSTING THE DEPTH

Through the first four game of the season, 11 of Canisius' 12 active players are averaging double digit minutes per game. The upperclass core of Wittenberg, Gailes, Rey Pineda and Djibril all average over 20 minutes per contest. Of the starters that have taken the court in the initial three games this season, only three of them fit the 20-or-more minutes per game category. Individuals such as Irene Rey Pineda, Corniya Clay and Evie van der Woude have provided the Golden Griffins with a cushion of depth.

A WIN WOULD...

A win on Friday would give Canisius its first win of the season, snapping a six-game losing skid.

REY OF LIGHT OFF THE BENCH

Sophomore Irene Rey Pineda has been the most productive contributor off the bench this season for the Griffs, leading the team in field goal percentage (.421) while also averaging 9.7 points per game which is second-most on the team. The Madrid, Spain native tallied a career-high 12 points in Tuesday's loss to Eastern Michigan including two crucial three-pointers in the second quarter. Rey Pineda also dished out a career-high four assists in Sunday's loss to Cornell.

TWO-POINTER SUCCESS

Canisius saw its second highest conversion of two-point field goal attempts in program history last season. Since this data was first produced for the 2009-10 season, Canisius has only one more productive season within the three point arc, shooting at a 46.2% clip in the 2016-17 season. In the 2024-25 season, 53.1% of Canisius' total points came off of two-pointers, the highest split since the 2018-19 season when the Griffs saw a program-high 55.7% of points come off of two-pointers.

BIG EXPECTATIONS FOR GAILES

A junior forward from Brooklyn, Ohio, **Shariah Gailes** completed the 2024-25 season leading the team in rebounding and second in scoring. She ranked third in the MAAC in rebounds (8.1) and second with 2.7 offensive rebounds per game. Gailes notched eight double-doubles, ranking second in the MAAC in that category. Heading into the 2025-26 season, Gailes was named to the Preseason All-MAAC Third Team, voted on by all 13 coaches within the conference.

HISTORY MAKING HIJAB

In last year's game against Duquesne, then freshman (now sophomore), **Yasmine Djibril** and the Dukes' Kiandra Browne made history by being first-ever NCAA Division I Basketball game between two Muslim players wearing hijab. Djibril wears a hijab every game while being a stablizing figure on the boards.



A long-time assistant coach with 14 years of NCAA Division I coaching experience at both the Power 5 and mid-major levels, Swoffard takes over the Golden Griffin program after spending the 2023-24 campaign as a member of the Penn State women's basketball coaching staff.

In her one season on staff at Penn State, Swoffard helped lead the Nittany Lions to their first 20-win season since 2016-17, which resulted in a WBIT berth and an appearance in the tournament's semifinal round. Swoffard oversaw the development of the Penn State post players and served as the team's rebounding coordinator, as the Nittany Lions finished the year in the top half of the Big Ten in both rebounds per game and rebounding margin.

Before joining the staff at Penn State, Swoffard spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Miami (Ohio) in the Mid-American Conference (MAC). From 2019-23, six RedHawks earned All-MAC accolades, while 20 student-athletes earned All-MAC Academic honors. In addition to her role as recruiting coordinator, Swoffard was the team's offensive coordinator in 2022-23, where Miami (Ohio) ranked fourth in the MAC in league scoring average, as the Red-Hawks posted an average of 72.1 points per game against conference rivals.

Swoffard joined the RedHawks' staff after spending four years as an assistant coach at Toledo, where she played an integral role in all aspects of the program, including perimeter-player development, recruiting, academic support and opponent scouting. She served as Toledo's recruiting coordinator and worked with both the guards and post players.

During her time with the Rockets, Swoffard helped lead Toledo to an 81-49 overall record and a 43-29 mark in MAC play, including a pair of 20-win seasons in 2016-17 and 2018-19. Swoffard was in her second year as an assistant coach with the Rockets when the team won the MAC Tournament following the 2016-17 season. During her tenure, Toledo garnered 12 All-MAC selections, made an NCAA Tournament appearance and earned two WNIT berths.



Prior to Toledo, Swoffard spent five seasons at Mercer, where she handled recruiting, on-court development, academic support and in-office administration and worked with both the guards and post players. She mentored five all-conference athletes and 17 academic all-conference recipients. Swoffard helped lead Mercer to its first 20-win season in two decades in 2012-13, and its first appearance in a postseason tournament since 1985.

Before her stint at Mercer, Swoffard spent four seasons (2007-10) as an assistant coach at the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith. There, she was responsible for arranging team travel, updating game statistics, scouting opponents, organizing film exchange, ordering equipment, scheduling community service projects and assisting with scheduling. Swoffard also coordinated recruiting visits, identified possible recruits, facilitated camps and served as the program's recruiting coordinator. While on staff there, Arkansas – Fort Smith finished third at the 2008 NJ-CAA National Tournament and she also assisted with the program's transition to the NCAA Division II level.

Swoffard started her collegiate coaching career at NCAA Division III Rowan University in Glassboro, N.J., where she was a graduate assistant coach from 2005-07. Before that, she spent two seasons as the junior team head coach of the Georgia Metros Nike Elite AAU Basketball program.

A native of Chattanooga, Tenn., Swoffard was a four-year letterwinner at Austin Peay from 1998-2002, including two consecutive years in which the Lady Governors captured the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament championship and went on to play in the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament (2000-01 and 2001-02).

An active member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), Swoffard earned her bachelor's degree in business administration with an emphasis in marketing from Austin Peay in 2002. She went on to earn her master's degree in business administration from Rowan in 2007.

Walton helped guard Franka Wittenberg have a career season in 2024-25, seeing significant increases from her previous school. In the 2023-24 season at Fresno State, Wittenberg recorded 32.2% field goal percentage, 26.8% three-point field goal percentage while averaging 3.8 points per game and accumulated 28 assists. At Canisius, Wittenberg improved to 41.5% field goal percentage, 31.0% three-point field goal percentage (33.3% in conference play) while averaging 8.4 points per game and totaled 74 assists on the season.

A native of Decatur, Ga., Walton went on to play and serve as team captain at the University of Manitoba.

Under the new coaching staff and Roman's direction, Copple saw her numbers catapult to 32.5% field goal percentage, 32.8% three-point field goal percentage (36.6 in conference play) while averaging 4.6 points per contest.
