THE RUNDOWN

- Cincinnati is coming off a 96-57 win over Canisius on Sunday in Fifth Third Arena. Five Bearcats finished in double figures, and all 10 available players scored.
- UC dished out 27 assists on 37 made baskets and shot 56.1% from the field —the team's best shooting
 performance since hitting 56.3% against Memphis on March 7, 2020. The 27 assists were also its most in a
 game since 2021.
- Ramiyah Byrd and Caliyah DeVillasee became the first UC duo to record double-doubles in the same game since Dec. 21, 2023. Byrd notched the first double-double of her career with personal bests of 10 points and 11 rebounds, while DeVillasee registered her second with 12 points and 10 assists.
- DeVillasee is just the second Division I player in the last 20 years to total at least 90 points and 40 assists through her first six career games, joining lowa's Caitlin Clark (2020-21).
- DeVillasee was named to the Big 12 Starting Five on Monday after earning Freshman of the Week honors
 the previous week. She was joined on the Week 3 Starting Five by TCU's Marta Suarez (Player of the Week),
 Houston's Jade Jones (Freshman of the Week), Baylor's Taliah Scott and Iowa State's Audi Crooks.
- Last week, DeVillasee averaged 16.5 points, 6.0 assists and 2.0 rebounds while shooting 52% from the field and 50% from 3-point range. She ranked sixth in the Big 12 in assists, 11th in scoring and 14th in field goal percentage. Her 10 assists were the most by any Big 12 player for the week.
- Junior Reagan Jackson scored a team-high 23 points against Canisius for her fourth career 20-point
 performance. She hit five 3-pointers and shot 50% overall. She is averaging 14.8 points on the season and
 leads the team with a 48% clip from 3-point range, which ranks fifth in the Big 12. She also ranks sixth in the
 conference in free throws made (28).
- DeVillasee's program-record 15 assists are tied for the most by any freshman in the nation this season and
 are the second most in a game by any player. The mark also ties the most by a major conference freshman in
 the last 20 years (USC's Minyon Moore, Dec. 3, 2016; Vanderbilt's Aubrey Galvan, Nov. 23, 2025).
- Senior Mya Perry has scored in double figures in all six games and is averaging 18.5 points while shooting 40% from 3-point range. She ranks fifth in the Big 12 in scoring and ninth in 3-point percentage.
- DeVillasee is one of six players the only freshman nationally averaging at least 15 points, six assists
 and three rebounds per game, joining Liv McGill (Florida), Olivia Miles (TCU), Maggie Doogan (Richmond),
 Delaney Gibb (BYU) and Ny'Ceara Pryor (Texas A&M). She ranks sixth in the Big 12 and 14th nationally in
 assists per game (6.8).
- Freshman forward Kylie Torrence is the fourth Bearcat averaging double figures at 11.0 points per game. She is tied for the team lead in blocks (6) and ranks third in rebounds (6.0).
- Redshirt senior Alliance Ndiba has started the last three games and is averaging 6.3 points and 7.3 rebounds during that stretch.
- Cincinnati outscored Canisius 50-38 in points in the paint. Destiny Thomas and Mary Carden each added a season-high nine points.
- Cincinnati will face a challenging non-conference slate, playing four teams that reached the NCAA
 Tournament or WBIT last season and three others that played in the WNIT.
- Friday marks the fourth meeting between Cincinnati and Alabama A&M and the first played outside Cincinnati. The Bearcats lead the series 3-0.
- UC and New Mexico will meet for the first time in program history. The Bearcats will face six first-time opponents in 2025-26.

BIG 12 STARTING FIVE FOR BIT

- DeVillasee was named to the Big 12 Starting Five on Monday after earning Freshman of the Week honors the previous week. She was joined on the Week 3 Starting Five by TCU's Marta Suarez (Player of the Week), Houston's Jade Jones (Freshman of the Week), Baylor's Taliah Scott and Iowa State's Audi Crooks.
- Last week, DeVillasee averaged 16.5 points, 6.0 assists and 2.0 rebounds while shooting 52% from the field and 50% from 3-point range.
- She opened the week with a season-best 21 points on 56.3% shooting at Ball State, adding three steals and two assists in 35 minutes. She followed it with an all-around effort in Sunday's win over Canisius, posting 12 points and 10 assists for the second double-double of her career.
- She ranked sixth in the Big 12 in assists, 11th in scoring and 14th in field goal percentage. Her 10 assists were the most by any Big 12 player for the

RECORD-BREAKING WEEK LEADS TO BIG 12 HONORS FOR DEVILLASEE

- Caliyah DeVillasee was named Big 12 Freshman of the Week on Nov. 17. She became the first Bearcat to win the league's rookie honor.
- The Owings Mills, Md., native became UC's singlegame assist record holder in the Bearcats' 100-61 win over Georgetown College, dishing out 15 assists to break a record that had stood since 2006.
- · Her 15 assists are tied for the most by any freshman in the nation this season and are the second most in a game by any player. The mark also ties the most by a major conference freshman in the last 20 years (USC's Minyon Moore, Dec. 3, 2016; Vanderbilt's Aubrey Galvan, Nov. 23, 2025).
- She paired it with 14 points for her first career double-double and the program's first point-assist double-double since 2022.
- For the week, she averaged 14.5 points, 10.0 assists and 5.5 rebounds per game while posting a 5.0 assist-to-turnover ratio and leading the Big 12 in assists.

KEEP IT 100

- Cincinnati picked up its first win of the season on Nov. 16, rolling to a 100-61 win over Georgetown College. It marked Cincinnati's first 100-point performance since 2003.
- Every player who saw action against Georgetown College scored at least eight points. All five starters finished in double figures for the first time since 2019, and all three reserves set new career highs in points and/or rebounds.
- DeVillasee handed out 15 assists, breaking a 19-year-old mark set by Treasure Humphries on Jan. 25, 2006, against Georgetown University.
- Cincinnati shot 52% from the field and 44% from three (8-18 3FG). It marked the Bearcats' first time shooting above 50% since Dec. 18, 2022, against Southern Indiana (30-60 FG).

DOING A LIL BIT OF EVERYTHING

- Point guard Caliyah DeVillasee is just the second DI player in the last 20 years to total at least 90 points and 40 assists through her first six career games, along with Iowa's Caitlin Clark (2020-21).
- She is one of six players the only freshman nationally averaging at least 15 points, six assists and three rebounds per game, joining Liv McGill (Florida), Olivia Miles (TCU), Maggie Doogan (Richmond), Delaney Gibb (BYU) and Ny'Ceara Pryor (Texas A&M). She ranks sixth in the Big 12 and 14th nationally in assists per game (6.8).
- She scored 14 points against Lehigh, marking the most points scored by a Cincinnati freshman in their collegiate debut since 2017.
- She has scored in double figures in all six games, and has led the team in assists in all but one.

PERRY DROPS 31 IN SEASON OPENER

- Mya Perry erupted for 31 points in her Bearcat debut vs. Lehigh. She tied her career high on 11of-17 shooting, including 6-of-8 from three-point
- Her 31 points were the most by a Bearcat since Ilmar'l Thomas scored 51 on Feb. 24, 2021. It was just the fifth time this century a Bearcat scored 30plus points while hitting at least six threes.
- She is one of just 11 players nationally this season to score 31 or more points while making six threepointers in a game.
- Perry and Jackson combined for 10 three-pointers against Lehigh, becoming the first Bearcat duo to each score at least 20 points and make four or more threes in the same game since March 2, 2020, when Antoinette Miller and Sam Rodgers did so against East Carolina.
- Cincinnati shot 55% (11-of-20) from three-point range against Lehigh, its best performance from beyond the arc since 2023. The performance ranks 20th nationally for a single game this

INJURY BUG BITES BEARCATS

- · The Bearcats will be without Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year Dee Alexander to start the season. She has been ruled out indefinitely with an ankle injury, announced on Oct. 26. Her status will be updated in the coming weeks.
- The Bearcats continue to battle early-season injuries and illnesses, with at least three players unavailable in every game so far. Cincinnati had only eight players see action at Ball State, and two fouled out in the fourth quarter.

CALL 'EM THE SUPER SIX

- Cincinnati welcomes six freshmen to its 2025-26 roster: Dee Alexander, Caliyah DeVillasee, Kali Barrett, Kylie Torrence, Joya Crawford and Paige Whitted.
- The six true freshmen are the second-most on a Power Four roster, behind only Pitt's seven.
- ESPN ranked Cincinnati's class No. 15 nationally, the highest-rated in program history and third in the Big 12, behind Kansas and Kansas State.
- Alexander and DeVillasee both finished in the top 100, at No. 11 and No. 62, respectively.

BIG 12 PRESEASON FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

- Big 12 women's basketball head coaches voted University of Cincinnati freshman Dee Alexander the conference's Preseason Freshman of the Year.
- The five-star guard is Cincinnati's first Big 12 individual preseason award honoree.
- Alexander, a Cincinnati native, finished No. 11 in the final ESPN rankings and was ranked the No. 1 player in Ohio by Prep Hoops. She was just the second player ever to win Ohio Ms. Basketball three straight years and earned back-to-back Ohio Gatorade Player of the Year honors. She also led nearby Purcell Marian to four consecutive state championships.
- She is the first Bearcat signee to be named a McDonald's All-American and is the highestranked recruit in program history.
- Alexander appeared in several national all-star showcases as a senior, including the Nike Hoop Summit and Jordan Brand Classic.

NUMBERS TO KNOW

Cincinnati's freshman class was ranked No. 15 nationally by ESPN, the highest-rated class in program history.



Dee Alexander checked in at No. 11 in the final ESPN rankings, making her the highest-ranked recruit in Bearcats history. She was named the Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year.



Cincinnati is one of only seven programs in the Power Four, and the only program in the Big 12, with an all-female coaching staff.

WATCH LIST ALERT

- Freshman Dee Alexander has been named to the preseason watch list for the 2025-26 Tamika Catchings Award by the board of the U.S. Basketball Writers Association. She is one of two Big 12 freshmen to make the list.
- The USBWA has named a national freshman player of the year since the 1991-92 season. In the 2020-21 season the award was named for Tamika Catchings, the legendary Tennessee star who was a three-time USBWA All-American and the association's national freshman player of the year in the 1997-98 season.

REAGAN READY TO LEAD

- Junior guard Reagan Jackson returns as a two-year starter and the only Bearcat to start and play in every game last season. She is one of the most experienced players on a roster that features eight newcomers, including six freshmen.
- On the court, Jackson has led Cincinnati in three-pointers made in each of the last two seasons, including a career-best 46 in 2024-25
- Off the court, she is the oldest of four, with one brother, Tanson, and two sisters, Kenzie and Tinley.
- Jackson comes from a basketball family with both of her parents playing at Texas Wesleyan. She was coached in high school by her mother Rhonda.

NOTHING LIL (BIT) ABOUT HER

- Freshman Caliyah DeVillasee, often referred to as "Lil Bit," will run
 point for the Bearcats. She was recruited by Kabrina Merriweather,
 who identified her as a key piece of the program's future.
- DeVillasee, a four-star recruit, was ranked No. 1 in Maryland by Prep Hoops and No. 62 nationally by ESPN.
- The 5-foot-7 guard concluded her career at Our Lady of Good Counsel with more than 1,000 points. She earned WCAC First Team and Washington Post All-Met Third Team honors and was nominated for Maryland Gatorade Player of the Year.
- She participated in the Ballislife All-American Game in May in Long Beach, Calif.

DES IS BACK

- After missing last season while recovering from injury, Destiny Thomas returns to the Bearcats' lineup.
- The 6-foot-4 center started two seasons ago for Cincinnati, averaging 4.8 points and 3.9 rebounds per game while shooting 52% from the field.
- Thomas joined the Bearcats alongside the current staff from Memphis, where she earned AAC All-Freshman Team honors after averaging 4.7 points and 5.8 rebounds in 19.3 minutes per game.
- After playing with just one available center for most of last season, the Bearcats now feature significantly more depth in the post.
 Thomas anchors a frontcourt that also includes Alliance Ndiba, Delaney Snyder and Mary Carden.

COMPLETING THE CLASS

- Kylie Torrence, a 6-foot-2 forward from High Point, N.C., was the final signee of the Bearcats' freshman class, completing the Super Six
- Originally committed to Boston College, Torrence reopened her recruitment in March 2025.
- Torrence played on the AAU circuit with Caliyah DeVillasee. The duo helped lead Elevate Elite to an undefeated run to the Adidas Nationals Championship in 2023.
- Torrence was the No. 3-ranked player out of North Carolina and averaged 20 points and nine rebounds in high school.

TRANSFER TALENT

- The Bearcats' roster features two transfers for the 2025-26 season: Mya Perry and Mary Carden.
- Perry, a 5-foot-11 guard, joins Cincinnati after spending the past two seasons at Florida Atlantic University. She earned All-American Athletic Conference Second Team honors in 2024-25.
- Perry recorded 23 double-digit scoring games last season, including six 20-point performances and a career-high 31 points against Memphis in the regular season finale.
- Carden, a 6-foot-6 center, transferred from Oral Roberts, where she appeared in 28 games as a freshman in 2024-25.
- She shot 65.6% from the field, collected 52 rebounds, and recorded three double-digit scoring games. She helped Oral Roberts reach the WBIT and finish the season 24-9.

BACK TO HER ROOTS

- Senior transfer Mya Perry returned home to Ohio to finish her college career with the Bearcats.
- From right outside of Columbus, Perry graduated from Reynoldsburg Summit High School as the program's all-time leading scorer and all-time leader in three-pointers made.
- The 5-foot-11 guard joins Cincinnati after an impressive season at Florida Atlantic. She led the Owls in scoring with 15.5 points per game, ranking among the top five in the conference, and hit a team-best 76 three-pointers — the thirdmost in a single season in FAU history.
- She has nine games of 20-or-more points and has made 142 three-pointers in her career. She enters the season with 763 career points.
- Perry began her collegiate career at Ohio State, where she helped the Buckeyes reach their first Elite Eight appearance in 30 years.

SWISS ARMY KNIFE

- The No. 4-ranked player out of Florida, Barrett graduated as Cardinal Mooney High School's all-time leading scorer. She led Cardinal Mooney to its first-ever Class 3A State Championship and posted a state-leading 24 double-doubles as a
- Barrett's path to Cincinnati is as unique as her game. A military child, she was born in Germany, grew up in Box Elder, South Dakota, and moved to Florida in 2019. She committed to Cincinnati before ever stepping foot on campus.

TENNESSEE TWO STEP

- Freshmen shooting guards Joya Crawford and Paige Whitted both call Tennessee home, separated by just 90 miles. The duo shared the floor in the Basketball Coaches Association of Tennessee All-Star Game.
- Crawford eclipsed 2,000 career points at Dyersburg High School and was a finalist for Tennessee Miss Basketball. She led her team to the 2024 TSSAA Class AAA State Championship, earning State Tournament MVP honors.
- Whitted, a Memphis native from Briarcrest Christian Academy, earned All-State recognition during her standout prep career.

WHEN IN ROME

- · The Bearcats enjoyed a once-in-a-lifetime experience this past August with a foreign tour to Rome, Italy, marking the program's first international trip under head coach Katrina Merriweather.
- Cincinnati played two games during its stay in Rome, gaining valuable on-court experience and team chemistry ahead of the 2025-26 season.
- The team visited some of the city's most iconic landmarks, including the Colosseum, Vatican, Trevi Fountain and Pantheon. They also took part in a cooking class, learning to make authentic Italian pizza, and capped off the trip with a boat tour of the Amalfi Coast.
- Under NCAA rules, programs are permitted to take an international tour once every four years. The 2025 foreign tour also allowed Cincinnati 10 additional practices prior to departure.

- · Dee Alexander made history as the first Cincinnati women's basketball signee to earn a spot in the prestigious 2025 McDonald's All-American Games.
- Cincinnati stood out as one of just seven schools with both a airls' and boys' McDonald's All-American selection in 2025, thanks to Alexander and men's basketball freshman Shon Abaev.

LAYING THE FOUNDATION

- · In just her second season at Cincinnati, Merriweather continued the program's upward trajectory, guiding the Bearcats to their first winning season in five years.
- UC posted its best non-conference winning percentage (.800, 8-2) since 2005-06 and secured its most conference wins (7) since 2019-20.
- Cincinnati has ranked first in the Big 12 in free throws made per game the past two seasons, averaging 16.8 in 2024-25 (fourth nationally) and 15.9 in 2023-24 (eighth nationally).
- The Bearcats have also dominated the offensive glass under Merriweather, ranking second in the Big 12 with 13.1 per game in 2024-25 and first in the league with 14.5 in 2023-24.

SEASON PROSPECTUS

- The Bearcats return five letterwinners from a season ago, including key contributor Reagan Jackson, who ranked third on the team in scoring last season at 9.2 points per game. Destiny Thomas, Alliance Ndiba, Delaney Snyder and Ramiyah Byrd are also back.
- Cincinnati added eight newcomers, highlighted by a six-player nationally recognized freshman class.
 Mya Perry and Mary Carden join as transfers.
- Katrina Merriweather enters her third season as head coach at her alma mater and 10th overall as a bench boss. She has guided three programs to six postseason appearances.
- Cincinnati returns just 24% of its scoring, 30% of its rebounding and 22% of its assists. Of the 24% of returning scoring, 58% comes from Jackson alone.
- The Bearcats will look to replace the presence of five-year starter Jillian Hayes, who left as the program's leader in all-time games played, blocks and free throws made/attempts.

ON THE SIDELINES

- Head coach Katrina Merriweather announced staff promotions and additions ahead of the 2025-26 season.
- Ashley Barlow, Abby Jump and Kabrina Merriweather each were elevated to associate coaches. They will continue to oversee their secondary responsibilities.
- Abby Owings was promoted to director of scouting and analytics/assistant coach while Michal Miller moved into the role of director of player development/assistant coach. Layah Neal was elevated to sport program associate entering her second season with the Bearcats.
- In July 2025, Symone Denham was named Cincinnati's assistant general manager, the first position of its kind. Denham played for Merriweather at Wright State from 2012-16.
- Former Bearcat standout Ana Owens joined Cincinnati's staff as director of operations in October. She played for UC from 2014 to 2018 and ranks in the top 10 in career games played, minutes played, 3-pointers made, free throw percentage and assists.

SISTERHOOD STARTS WITH STAFF

- Prior to returning to Cincinnati, Katrina Merriweather was the head coach for Memphis where a familiar coaching staff started to take
- shape. Katrina Merriweather hired her younger sister Kabrina to help lead the Tigers to a 38-23 record and a postseason appearance in the WNIT Sweet 16 in 2023.
- Prior to Memphis, Kabrina worked as the Director of Operations for New Mexico Lobos where she made the jump to assistant coach in the 2021-22 season. She was also a forward for Florida A&M and Georgia Southwestern State from 2011-15.
- Both Merriweathers have been on the sidelines together since 2021, and have continued that sisterhood bond in Clifton.

THE SISTERHOOD

- Cincinnati is one of only seven programs in the Power Four, and the only program in the Big 12, with an all-female coaching staff.
- Every year, Merriweather has had a former player on staff. At least one from every head coaching stop.
- Merriweather has had a staff member selected to the WBCA Thirty Under 30 List for eight straight years. Owings earned her second honor in 2025.

LAST TIME OUT

NAPLES, Fla. - The University of Cincinnati women's basketball team opened the Florida Gulf Classic with a 72-49 win over Alabama A&M on Friday in Naples, Fla.

Mya Perry and Caliyah DeVillasee powered the Bearcats with a combined 47 points. Perry recorded her third 20-point outing of the season, finishing with a team-high $25\,$ points while going a perfect 7-of-7 from the free throw line.

DeVillasee added a season-high 22 points on 7-of-11 shooting and 7-of-8 at the line. She also pulled down a career-best seven rebounds and dished out three assists. Both Perry and DeVillasee have scored in double figures in every game this season.

Reagan Jackson rounded out Cincinnati's double-figure scorers with 13 points. The Bearcats shot 47 percent from the field and knocked down 22 free throws (.815).

Defensively, Cincinnati held Alabama A&M to 34 percent shooting and just three made three-pointers (.250), while winning the battle on the glass, 43-26.

The Bearcats opened the game with seven straight points and led 14-9 at the first quarter media timeout. Alabama A&M closed the gap with a 6-0 run to make it 16-13 after


Perry halted the run with her second three-pointer early in the second quarter, but the Bulldogs briefly took the lead following another 6-0 spurt. Jackson answered with a three of her own, sparking Cincinnati's 12-2 run to close the half. Perry and DeVillasee combined for 17 points in the second quarter and 29 in the opening half.

Cincinnati scored 19 points in the third quarter, including 13 from the free throw line, while holding Alabama A&M to just nine. The Bearcats never allowed the Bulldogs closer than 16 the rest of the way, cruising to a 72-49 victory.

HEAD COACH KATRINA MERRIWEATHER



Director of Athletics John Cunningham announced the hire of former Bearcats' captain Katrina Merriweather as the 10th women's basketball head coach at the University of Cincinnation March 25, 2023.

Merriweather quickly has become a rising star in the coaching profession, taking three programs to the postseason a total of six times, including a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. She has totaled 180 wins in nine seasons as bench boss.

In just her second season at Cincinnati, Merriweather continued the program's upward trajectory, guiding the Bearcats to their first winning season since 2019-20 and surpassing the previous year's win total. UC posted its best non-conference winning percentage (.800, 8-2) since 2005-06 and secured its most conference wins (7) since 2019-20. The Bearcats also led the Big 12 and ranked among the nation's top five in made free throws per game.

Forward Jillian Hayes cemented her legacy as the first player in program history to earn All-Big 12 honors, landing on the All-Big 12 Third Team in 2024-25 after earning Honorable Mention recognition the previous season.

Merriweather's impact was immediate, successfully navigating Cincinnati's transition from the American Athletic Conference to the Big 12 in her first season at the helm. The Bearcats saw a five-win improvement, posted their best non-conference winning percentage (72.7%) in 15 years, and strung together a six-game win streak—their longest since 2019-20. That season also featured UC's first victory over an SEC opponent since 2004.

Merriweather once again proved her ability to build postseason contenders, leading Cincinnati to the 2024 WNIT—marking the program's 14th postseason appearance and first since 2019.

A four-year letterwinner for the Bearcats' Hall of Fame head coach Laurie Pirtle from 1997-01, Merriweather became the program's first women's basketball player to advance to four consecutive postseason tournaments. Additionally, she helped lead the program to its first-ever NCAA Tournament win as a graduate assistant coach in 2001-02.

Merriweather and USA Basketball earned a silver medal podium finish at the 2023 FIBA Women's AmeriCup in León, Mexico. She was elevated to her first bench coach assignment for the event after previously serving as a court coach for the 2021 USA Women's U19 National Team Trails.

Merriweather led Memphis to a 22-11 season in 2022-23, the program's first 20-win season in more than a decade, and an appearance in the 2023 WNIT Sweet 16.

Merriweather took over a four-win Memphis team and immediately produced 16 wins in 2021-22 before the 22-win campaign this season in which the Tigers clinched the two seed in the 2022 AAC Championships, the program's highest-ever AAC regular season finish, and advanced to a postseason tournament for the first time since 2015-16.

In her two seasons at the helm, the Tigers compiled a 38-23 record and earned three All-Conference selections.

The search was led by Maggie McKinley, Deputy Athletic Director and Senior Woman Administrator, who worked with Cunningham to bring Merriweather back home.

Prior to her tenure at Memphis, Merriweather spent five seasons as the head coach at Wright State, where she took the Raiders to two NCAA Tournaments and was named Horizon League Coach of the Year three times. Merriweather led Wright State to the program's third appearance and first NCAA Tournament win with an upset over four-seed Arkansas in 2021.

In 2018-19, she guided the Raiders to a school-record 27 wins and its first-ever outright Horizon League regular season championship, securing the conference tournament title and reaching the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history.

While at the helm, Merriweather led the Raiders to a 113-47 (.706) record, finishing with the best winning percentage in program history. She was a part of all three of the program's Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances, twice as a head coach in 2019 and 2021 and once as an assistant in 2014. The Raiders also earned 16 All-Conference selections in her tenure.

Merriweather was an assistant under Mike Bradbury for six seasons at Wright State from 2010-16 before becoming head coach.

Prior to Wright State, she was an assistant at Purdue from 2003-06, and at UIC for the 2002-03 season.

With the Bearcats, Merriweather made 27 career starts, including 22 in her senior season, and played in 107 games. She helped lead the program to an 83-41 record in her four seasons.

"I'm beyond proud for Katrina," said Pirtle, who won 310 games over 21 seasons at Cincinnati. "She was a tremendous player in terms of how she handled herself, but most importantly she was a coach and leader on and off the floor. She constantly pulled our team together. This hire should come as no surprise. I speak for all of the UC basketball family when I say we are extremely proud of her and excited to see her come back to lead this program."

The Indianapolis native graduated from Cincinnati in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in English literature and earned a second bachelor in secondary education in 2002.


